FIRST PITCH TIDBITS

UVA Wise are looking to thwart an eight-game losing streak on their home turf against Newberry on Wednesday.

- * As of March 7, UVA Wise sits in a tie with Tusculum with a winless showing in conference (0-6)
- * From the field, UVA Wise ranks fourth in the conference in errors with only 15 on the year
- * as a squad, the Cavaliers hit a .266
- * Kara Long is still hot on offense for the Cavaliers... Long ranks second in the conference in batting average with a .509
- * In her last outing, Long went 2-3 against No. 19ranked Wingate, swinging a homer and a double.

The Newberry squad is sitting on a two-game win streak after taking down non-conference Alderson Broaddus doubleheader on Sunday, March 5.

- * Their most recent outing was highlighted by a 19-5 mercy rule win in game one followed by a 14-10 triumph in game two
- * In game two, the Wolves used a 10-run fifth inning led by Sierra Broadon who collected a game-high 4four
- * As a team, Newberry ranks sixth in the conference in batting average (.316) and has racked up a total 200 hits on the yéar
- * On the other hand, Newberry ranks second in the conference in total strikeouts on the year (67)



Now in her 12th season at the helm of the UVA Wise softball program, Karen Bitter has tallied over 250 victories to date, including back-to-back 30-win campaigns in 2013 and 2014. During the 2014 season, UVa-Wise won 37 games for the second-most in a single season in program history and claimed the inaugural Mountain East Conference Tournament title. That followed a 2013 season in which Bitter led the Cavaliers to a 31-21 record.

This past campaign, Bitter guided her team to a 22-27 overall mark and a 16-16 conference record in the team's final season in the Mountain East Conference as the team made it to the conference tournament for the fourth consecutive season. UVa-Wise also gained two wins over nationally-ranked programs in Lenoir-Rhyne University and Shepherd University during the regular season. As well, Bitter notched her 200th career win before claiming her 203rd career victory to break the program's all-time win record.

During the 2018 campaign, the UVa-Wise softball team posted a 29-23 overall record and was 16-16 in conference play as the team advanced to the second round of the MEC tournament gaining a pair of shutout wins over Notre Dame College and Shepherd University.

The 2017 campaign was a monumental one for the UVa-Wise softball team as Co-Head Coach Bitter guided the program to a No. 4 seed and host of the 2017 NCAA Division II Atlantic Regional, marking the first time UVa-Wise has hosted a NCAA postseason event. UVa-Wise later closed out their campaign in the 2017 NCAA Division II Softball Championship Atlantic 1 Regional after earning the first at-large bid into a NCAA postseason event in UVa-Wise

athletics history.

In that same season, Bitter oversaw a spectacular junior year in standout pitcher Taylor Brandts. A four-year letter winner, Brandts is one of the most decorated players in UVa-Wise softball history, becoming the winningest pitcher in program history after she notched her 61st career victory with the Cavaliers win over Chowan University in the Atlantic Regional. Brandts became just the second Cavalier to earn All-American status after receiving All-American honorable mention accolades from both the Division II Conference Commissioner's Association (D2CCA) and Fastpitch News.

During the 2016 season, Co-Head Coach Bitter guided the Cavs back to the MEC tournament for the first time since 2014 as UVa-Wise earned a No. 4 MEC South seed. The Cavs went on a tournament run and advanced to the consolation bracket finals, finishing third in the league championship while eliminating both Wheeling Jesuit University and Concord University.

Co-Head Coach Bitter came to UVa-Wise following a successful stint at fellow NCAA Division II institution Chowan University where she served as pitching coach for three seasons. A Virginia native, Bitter was a member of one of the most successful coaching staffs at the Division II level. The Chowan softball team piled up 30-win seasons in her final two years as the pitching coach and captured consecutive CIAA divisional championships.

Bitter is no stranger to success, whether it is in the dugout or in the circle. The former pitcher began her career at Tabb High School in Yorktown, Virginia, where she caught the eye of coaches at Shepherd University. After enrolling, Bitter became the most accomplished pitcher in the history of the program and is still the holder of several single-season and career school records. After completing her playing career, she joined the coaching staff at Washington College in Maryland, serving as a graduate assistant. After her stop at Washington College, Bitter joined the Chowan staff before the 2009 season as pitching coach where she remained until accepting the UVa-Wise job.

The coach and her husband, Nick (fellow co-head coach), reside in Big Stone Gap along with their two children.



Nick Bitter enters his ninth season as Co-Head Softball Coach at UVA Wise for the 2023 campaign. Bitter collected his first career head coaching victory on April 12, 2015, when UVa-Wise picked up a home sweep of Glenville State. During the 2018 season, Bitter earned his 100th victory as co-head coach in a game one sweep of Glenville State at Cavalier Field.

The co-head coach works with the Cavaliers in hitting and fielding, and played an integral part in UVa-Wise's success during the 2016 and 2017 seasons. Guiding the Cavs back to the MEC tournament for the first time since 2014, Bitter led UVa-Wise to a No. 4 MEC South seed in 2016. The Cavs went on a tournament run and advanced to the consolation bracket finals, finishing third in the league championship while eliminating both Wheeling Jesuit University and Concord University.

With the help of Co-Head Coach Bitter, the Cavaliers mounted on their 2016 campaign success to go on a historical run during the 2017 season. Reaching the 30-win mark for the third time in

the past six years, UVa-Wise concluded that season with an impressive 36-19 overall record. UVa-Wise reached the Mountain East Conference Tournament title game after defeating then-seventh ranked West Virginia Wesleyan in the first game of the championship round. They would extend their season as the team became the first UVa-Wise athletics program to earn an at-large bid into an NCAA postseason event and claimed the school's first ever NCAA postseason win.

Prior to becoming cohead coach, Bitter served as an assistant for three and a half seasons, including being a member of the coaching staff that led UVa-Wise to the inaugural Mountain East Conference Tournament Title in 2014. That season, the Cavs went 37-14 for the second-most victories in a single season in program history. As an assistant

coach in 2014, Co-Head Coach Bitter helped six different Cavs earn MEC All-Conference honors, including Taylor Brandts, who was named MEC Pitcher of the Year.

As a pitcher at Delaware State, Bitter was named Outstanding Athlete of the Year in 2006 while also being a First-Team Black College Baseball selection for his work out of the bullpen.

Before coming to UVa-Wise, Bitter served as associate head baseball coach at Washington College. In his role, he created and developed strength and conditioning regimens for both in-season and off-season workouts, while serving as the team's pitching coach.
