MORE ON THE MATCHUP

VERMONT vs. MAINE

All-Time Series: Maine, 51-34

- Maine leads the all-time series with the Catamounts by a 51-34 margin, however UVM most recently used a 55-52 victory on Jan. 4 to end a seven-game losing streak against the Black Bears.

- Vermont on Wednesday has the opportunity to sweep the regular season series for the first time since 2009-10. That year, the Catamounts captured their second consecutive America East Championship and went on to upset seventh-seeded Wisconsin in the NCAA Tournament First Round.

- Between 1998 and 2010 the Green and Gold captured 10 wins in 13 tries in the Pine Tree State, being outlasted by the Black Bears in 1999, 2003 and 2005.

- The Catamounts also topped Maine in the only previous game not played on either campus, taking a 70-57 decision at Binghamton in March 2007 to advance to the America East Quarterfinals. That result was part of a 12-game winning streak that ran from 2006-11.

SCOUTING MAINE

- The Black Bears (11-12, 4-4 AE) begin the week with UMBC in a tie for fifth place in America East. The group is coming off of a closely-contested 58-52 setback at Binghamton on Saturday (Jan. 28) in a game that had 14 ties and 17 lead changes. Sigi Koizar had a team-high 14 points on 4-of-10 shooting from the field and Laia Sole had six rebounds.

- On paper, Maine sits sixth in the conference in scoring offense and third in scoring defense, averaging exactly as many points per game as it surrenders (58.6). With that in mind, an interesting statistical matchup will take place as Maine's field goal percentage of 40.6 will go up against the Catamounts' conference-leading field goal percentage defense of just 35.8.

- Koizar, a senior from Austria, boasts 13.1 points per game to lead the team to go with nearly three assists nightly. Blanca Millan stands out with 1.8 steals per game, while Tanesha Sutton guides efforts on the glass with just under five boards day-to-day.



NEWS AND NOTES

UMBC TIME CHANGE

- Vermont's Saturday, Feb. 11 game against UMBC at Patrick Gymnasium has been moved to a 1 p.m. start. It was previously slated for a 2 p.m. tip.

CATS IN THE RECORD BOOK

- As a junior, Sydney Smith has etched her name in the UVM record book by virtue of sinking 150 career 3-point field goals. She entered the season 10th all-time with a total of 122 between her freshman and sophomore campaigns in Burlington and now sits fifth in the category.

GOOD THINGS COME IN THREES

- In the Jan. 4 win over Maine, Vermont allowed just three second quarter points, representing a tie for the fewest allowed by Vermont in a single 10-minute period. In a Feb. 28, 2016 win over Stony Brook, UVM surrendered just three points in the fourth quarter in preserving a 44-37 victory over the Seawolves at Patrick Gymnasium.

ALL THE 'WRIGHT' REASONS

- Sophomore Candice Wright continues to leave a mark in the record book, registering 80 blocks in less than two seasons and sitting ninth all-time in that category. As a freshman last year, Wright logged 50 blocks, setting a single-season program record.
- Wright holds the distinction of being the fastest Catamount in program history to reach 70, needing just 42 games to eclipse the mark.


CRYMBLE EARNS WEEKLY HONOR

- Following her combined 60 percent shooting performance against New Hampshire (Jan. 16) and at UMass Lowell (Jan. 19), freshman Hanna Crymble was named America East Rookie of the Week on Monday, Jan. 23. She averaged 19.5 points over the week and had a double-double (24 pts, 10 reb) in a win at UMass Lowell. Ten of her points on the night during a 19-0 third quarter run.

DAWN OF A NEW DAY

- A 1997 graduate of West Chester University, head coach Chris Day arrives in Vermont following a three-year stint as an assistant at the University of Pennsylvania. Penn. The squad amassed 67 wins during his tenure, punching two tickets to the NCAA Tournament and captured two Ivy League titles.

LAST TIME OUT



Jan. 28: Sydney Smith had a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds and three other Catamounts had at least nine points as Vermont topped Stony Brook 53-43 at Patrick Gymnasium on Saturday.

Candice Wright led all scorers with 15 points in addition to three blocks. She now has registered a total of 80 blocks in her career, passing Lauren Buschmann for ninth place all-time in program history. Buschmann logged 78 with the Catamounts from 2009-13.

A total of six charity stripe points in the last two minutes by Wright (5) and Hayley Robertson sealed the win for Vermont.

LAST TIME VS. MAINE

Jan. 4: Senior Kylie Butler tied a season-high with 12 points and Vermont did not trail in the second half as the Catamounts picked up a 55-52 win over Maine to tip off America East play Wednesday night at Patrick Gymnasium.

UVM dominated in the second quarter, beginning with a quick layup down low from Butler on a feed from Candice Wright. The Catamounts surrendered just three points in the period in holding Maine to just 1-for-7 (14.3 percent), constructing a 16-0 run over 7:12. Five different Catamounts supported the run.

- Comes to Vermont from the University of Pennsylvania, where he served as an assistant coach for three seasons (2013-16).
- While at Penn, Day assisted the Quakers to a 67-21 (.761) record, including a 36-6 (.857) mark in Ivy League play and two trips to the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2015-16, Penn amassed a program-record 24 victories to culminate a three-season streak of 21-plus wins.
- Previously, the Philadelphia native had stops at Indiana (2012-13), Saint Joseph's (2005-12) and La Salle (2004-05).
- Under his guidance, Indiana doubled its Big Ten win total from the 2011-12 season.
- Spent three seasons as head coach at Division III Widener University (2000-03) in Chester, Pennsylvania, helping the squad to its first postseason appearance in 20 years.



ALISA KRESGE | ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

- The 2016-17 campaign is Kresge's first at Vermont.
- Joins the UVM staff following a six-year stint at her alma mater, Marist College, where she recruited and coached 19 MAAC All-Conference selections and 31 All-Academic honorees.
- Guided the Red Foxes to a 173-42 record during her tenure as an assistant, including five consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (2010-14) and five consecutive MAAC Tournament Championships (2010-14).
- Played at Marist from 2003-07, helping the squad become the first MAAC men's or women's basketball program to reach the NCAA Sweet 16.



BRIAN DONOGHUE | ASSISTANT COACH

- Enters his first season on the Catamounts staff.
- Most recently was the head coach at Division III King's College (2005-16) in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, compiling an overall record of 163-129.
- Under his guidance, the Lady Monarchs made seven trips to the Freedom Conference Tournament and five appearances in the WBCA Division III Academic Top 25.
- King's advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2012 and won 24 games, one short of tying a program record.
- In 2012, Donoghue was also named Mid-Atlantic Coach of the Year by D3Hoops.com.



CAROLINE COYER | ASSISTANT COACH

- Arrives in Burlington after a four-year playing career at Villanova, where she led the Wildcats to three straight WNIT appearances (2014-16).
- Punched a ticket to the NCAA Tournament in 2013.
- In May of 2015, she was named to the USA Basketball Women's Pan American Games roster, with the team capturing the silver medal after posting a 4-1 record.
- As a senior in 2015-16, Coyer led Villanova in points per game (14), assists per game (4.4), and steals (43), while also reaching double figures in scoring in 20 games.
