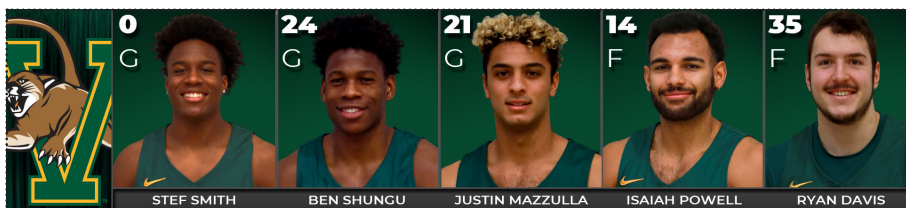

Justin Mazzulla finished in double figures with 12 points including 10 in the second half. The senior hit 4-of-5 field-goal attempts and matched Davis with six boards. Stef Smith netted nine points and two rebounds.

LAST MEETING WITH HARTFORD

F. 8, 2020 | Ryan Davis scored the game-winning layup with four seconds left on the clock to give Vermont a 69-68 win over Hartford at Chase Gym. As the game came down to the wire and the Cats leading 67-66, Traci Carter drove to the foul line and drained the go-ahead jumper. UVM answered on the other end of the floor when Ben Shungu found a wide-open Davis under the basket and the sophomore banked in the go-ahead score. The Hawks tried to push the ball up the floor as the clock approached triple zeros but stepped on the sideline for the costly turnover.

Everett Duncan racked up a season-high 18 points on 7-of-10 shooting. The redshirt senior knocked down 4-of-7 attempts from long range and dished out two assists. Davis followed with 16 points for his third straight double-figure scoring effort. He shot a similar 6-of-10 from the field and pulled down seven boards, including five on the offensive glass.

AE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Ryan Davis was named 2021 Kevin Roberson Player of the Year last Thursday. He is the fifth straight Catamount and eighth UVM player to win the award. Davis averaged 18.8 points per game for the second-highest scoring average in the league and boasted the conference's top field-goal percentage at 57.8%.

WHAT WOULD HAVE BEEN

Saturday is a rematch of what would have been last year's America East Championship Game. The contest was later canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. By rule, UVM was crowned conference champion as the highest remaining seed in the tournament.

2012 AE SEMIFINAL MATCHUP - DOUBLE OVERTIME THRILLER

Saturday will be the first postseason matchup between the two programs since the 2012 America East Semifinal - John Becker's first year at the helm. Sophomore Sandro Carissimo scored a career-high 18 points, including six in extra time, to help second-seeded Vermont earn a 77-73 victory over No. 6 Hartford in double overtime. Freshman Four McGlynn tallied 16 points off the bench, while Matt Glass had 15 and Luke Apfeld chipped in with 13 as the fourth Catamount in double figures.

UVM IN THE AE TOURNEY

- UVM has won the tournament a record eight times - 2003, 2004, 2005, 2010, 2012, 2017, 2019, and 2020.
- UVM is 44-30 all-time in the AE Tournament

AE REGULAR SEASON TITLE

The Cats earned a share of the America East regular season championship with UMBC. The regular season title is the 11th in school history, breaking a tie with Northeastern for the most in league history, and UVM's fifth straight. Gonzaga's nine-year run is the only active streak longer than UVM's run.

CATS IN THE TOP 3

In 2020-21, UVM finished in the top three spots in the America East standings for the 13th consecutive season. As of right now, the Catamounts are one of two schools to land in the top three of their conference standings - Gonzaga (West Coast). Kansas has a chance to join the group depending on the remaining outcome of the Big XII schedule.

DAVIS VS. HARTFORD

In three career games, Ryan Davis has averaged 10.0 points and 3.3 rebounds per game against Hartford. The Schaumburg, Illinois product has also averaged 2.3 offensive boards per game versus the Hawks. He has shot 57.1% overall from the field and 60.0% inside of the three-point arc.

SMITH VS. HARTFORD

In the last two seasons, Stef Smith has a similar 10.7 scoring average. The senior has drained 42.1% of his overall shots, but has an even better percentage on his two-point shots at 54.5%.

SEMIFINAL STEF

Stef Smith has scored 20-plus in each of his last two America East Semifinal games. He has put up 24.0 points per game with a 61.3 field-goal percentage and 50.0% three-point percentage. As a sophomore in 2019, he scored 28 points and set the conference semifinal record with eight triples in an 84-51 rout of seventh-seeded Binghamton. Last year, he notched a 20-point game versus UMBC.

PLAYOFF HISTORY W/ HARTFORD

The Cats and Hawks will meet in the playoffs for the seventh time. UVM has won the last four contests including three in the semifinal round.

CATS IN THE SEMIS

UVM has an all-time record of 14-7 in the America East Semifinal but has won its last five games dating back to 2016. The 14 wins are twice as many as any current member - UAlbany has six semifinal victories while Stony Brook follows with five.

PRESEASON TO POSTSEASON

Coming into the season, Vermont was picked as the the preseason favorite for the fifth straight year and the seventh time during John Becker's tenure. From the seven seasons as the preseason frontrunner, the Cats have gone onto win at least a share of the regular season crown six times.

20-POINT TRIPLE THREAT

In the 70-61 win at UMBC on February 18, UVM had three players score 20 points - Ryan Davis (21), Ben Shungu (20), and Stef Smith (20). The Cats are the fourth Division I team this season to accomplish the feat - IUPUI versus Illinois-Chicago on February 12, UCF at Florida State on December 19, and Georgia State at Georgia Tech on November 25.

DOUBLE-DIGIT AE WINS

Vermont secured its 13th consecutive season with at least 10 America East regular season victories. Behind the Cats, no other team in the league has at least two seasons in a row.

MOST WINS SINCE 2016-17

The Catamounts have accrued 119 wins since the start of the 2016-17 season - tied for the 11th-most in the nation. Gonzaga paces the list with 157 victories.

1,200-POINT CLUB

With a total of 29 points in the UMBC series, Stef Smith became the 24th Catamount in program history to score 1,200 career points. With three more triples, he will become the sixth player in school history to eclipse the 1,200-point/200-three-pointer mark.

EIGHT IS GREAT

The loss in the regular season finale at UMBC snapped UVM's season-high eight-game winning streak. The Cats have produced at least an eight-game streak in America East play in six out of John Becker's 10 seasons. From the six season, UVM won the regular season title in 2014, 2017, 2018, 2020, and 2021 with tournament crowns in 2017 and 2020.

THE BENCH BOSS

- Became the first coach in America East history to win Coach of the Year four years in a row
- One of seven coaches in the history of America East to record over 100 regular season conf. wins
- Set the program record in 2016-17 for most overall wins and AE history, longest overall and AE winning streak, and only AE team to ever sweep the league's major awards
- Became fastest coach in school history to win 200 career Division I games (288 games)
