OPENINGTIP -

- For the first time since its WAC Tournament games were cancelled in March due to COVID-19, Utah Valley will take the court to open the 2020-21 season against Division II foe Adams State on Thanksgiving Day at the UCCU Center in Orem. The game will tip-off at 11 a.m. MT.
- Utah Valley returns just two letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with an 11-19 record and an eighth place finish in the WAC. JJ Overton (7.2 ppg.) and Trey Woodbury (7.2 ppg.) are back after combining to score an average of 14.4 points per game last season. The Wolverines return just 20 percent of its scoring from a season ago.
- Utah Valley lost 79.8 percent of its scoring from a season ago, which ranks eighth in the nation. Kentucky leads the nation in the replacement scoring category as the Wildcats lost 94 percent of its scoring from last season.
- Utah Valley welcomes 16 new players to its roster this season, including Fardaws Aimaq, who each had to sit out last season due to NCAA transfer rules. The Wolverines have added 10 new transfers (Le Tre Darthard, Evan Cole, Blaze Nield, Tim Fuller, Jaden McClanahan, Cade Whicker, Colby Leifson, Asa McCord, Trey Farrer, and Jordan Brinson) to this year's roster. Aimag (Mercer) also joins the team after redshirting last season.
- Graduate forward Evan Cole was named to the 2020-21 Preseason All-WAC team as selected by the media in the Western Athletic Conference preseason honors. Cole spent the last three seasons at Georgia Tech (2017-20). He played in 27 games for the Yellow Jackets last season, averaging 4.4 points and 3.6 rebounds per game. He shot 47.1 percent from the field last season, connecting on 48 of 102 shots. During his three seasons at Georgia Tech, Cole played in 69 games while averaging 3.9 points and 3.0 rebounds a contest.
- The Wolverines were selected to finish sixth by the media and seventh by the coaches in the WAC preseason polls. UVU received 74 points in the media poll to finish sixth. The Wolverines received 28 points in the coaches' poll for the seventh spot. NM State earned the top spot in both polls.
- Mark Madsen enters his second season as the head coach of the Wolverines. The two-time NBA champion, former Los Angeles Lakers assistant coach, and former Stanford basketball star went 11-19 during his first season with UVU. He is just the third head coach in UVU's Division I history. Madsen took over the Utah Valley program last season after serving the past six seasons as an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Lakers. He was a two-time NBA champion as a player with the Lakers (2001 and 2002), and played for the Minnesota Timberwolves for six seasons

ABOUT ADAMS STATE

Adams State is a Division II team that plays in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC). The team finished 8-20 overall and were 6-16 in league play ast season. The Grizzlies return four players from last season, including Cole Arceneaux, Kaelin Crane, Trace Dimeff and Rylan O'Brien. Adams State is playing Weber State on Wednesday night in Ogden. The Grizzlies were selected to finish 13th in the 2020 Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) Preseason Coaches Poll. The Grizzlies were originally scheduled to open the 2020-21 regular season on Friday, Nov. 27 in Denver when they were to play Metro State University-Denver and Saturday, Nov. 28 when they were play Colorado Christian. However, due to the uncertainty that is COVID-19, all four schools agreed to reschedule those games to Saturday, Jan. 2 and Sunday, Jan. 3, with both games beginning at 7 p.m.

SERIES HISTORY VS. ADAMS STATE

Utah Valley and Adams State have met on the basketball hardwood just one time with the Wolverines taking a 79-57 win over the Grizzlies on Dec. 16, 2003 at the UCCU Center. UVU Hall of Famer Ronnie Price scored a game-high 21 points in the 2003 win over the Grizzlies. UVU holds an all-time 58-0 record against non-Division I programs.

UVU PICKED SIXTH BY MEDIA AND SEVENTH BY COACHES IN PRESEASON POLLS

Utah Valley was picked to finish sixth by the media and seventh by the coaches in the WAC's preseason polls. New Mexico State was picked to win the league in both polls. The Aggies received all available eight first place votes from the coaches and 10 of the 12 first place votes from the media. In the coaches' poll, Grand Canyon was picked to finish second with UT Rio Grande Valley third and California Baptist fourth. Seattle U was fifth, followed by WAC newcomer Tarleton sixth. UVU was selected seventh, Dixie State eighth, and Chicago State ninth. On the media side, Grand Canyon was selected second, UT Rio Grande Valley third, and California Baptist fourth. Seattle U was picked fifth, followed by Utah Valley in sixth, Dixie State seventh, Tarleton eighth, and Chicago State ninth.

EVAN COLE NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-WAC TEAM

Graduate forward Evan Cole has been named to the 2020-21 Preseason All-WAC team as selected by the media in the Western Athletic Conference preseason honors. Cole, a 6-foot-10, 230-pound graduate forward, spent the last three seasons at Georgia Tech (2017-20). Fast Facts About Madsen

- » Enters his second season at the helm of the UVU men's basketball program. He is the third coach in UVU's Division I history. Went 11-19 overall and 5-10 in WAC play during his first season with the Wolverines.
- » Two-time NBA champion, former Los Angeles Lakers assistant coach, and former Stanford University basketball star Mark Madsen was officially named the men's basketball head coach at Utah Valley University in April.
- » Madsen takes over the Utah Valley program after serving the past six seasons as an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Lakers. He was a two-time NBA champion as a player with the Lakers (2001 and 2002), and he played for the Minnesota Timberwolves for six seasons
- » Following his playing career, Madsen served as an assistant coach during the 2009-10 season with the Utah Flash of the NBA G League before returning to his alma mater, Stanford University, where he earned an MBA from the Stanford Graduate School of Business in 2012
- » In 2012, he was named an assistant coach at Stanford on Johnny Dawkins' staff and spent the 2012-13 season working in recruiting, opponent game planning, and player skill development.
- » Spent four years as a player at Stanford (1996-2000), where he earned All-American honors in each of his final two seasons while helping the Cardinal to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including the 1998 Final Four.
- » Earned the nickname "Mad Dog" while at Stanford for his aggressive style of play. The nickname stayed with him throughout his NBA career.
- » Madsen averaged 10.9 points and 7.0 rebounds per game during his four seasons with the Cardinal. He ranks fourth all-time in field goal percentage (58.7) and sixth in rebounds (857). During his time at Stanford, the team compiled an impressive 105-24 overall record.
- » He was recently inducted into the Stanford Athletics Hall of Fame.
- » A native of Danville, Calif., Madsen earned his undergraduate degree in economics from Stanford in 2000.
- » Graduated from San Ramon Valley High School.
- » He and his wife, Hannah, have one son, William. They have a baby boy due in February.

UVU SWEEPS GRAND CANYON FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 2014

Brandon Averette led four other Wolverines in double figures with career-high 23 points to help lead Utah Valley to an 92-80 win over Grand Canyon on Feb. 22 in front of a season-high 5,236 fans at the UCCU Center. Former athletic director Michael Jacobsen was honored prior to the game and at halftime as he was inducted into the UVU Athletics Hall of Fame. With the win, Utah Valley completes the two-game regular season sweep over the 'Lopes for the first time since 2014.

UTAH VALLEY DROPS HEARTBREAKER AT NEW MEXICO STATE, 84-82

Utah Valley was unable to hold onto its late lead as New Mexico State hit an off-balance three, just before the buzzer, to secure the 84-82 win in the Pan American Center on Feb. 15. TJ Washington hit a pair of free throws to give the Wolverines the lead with six seconds to go before the Aggies came down and banked in a three from the left wing, leaving just 0.6 seconds on the clock. UVU was then unable to get a shot off as the Aggies came away with the win.

SECOND HALF SURGE GIVES UVU FIRST WIN AT GRAND CANYON SINCE 2014

Utah Valley used a late second-half surge to knock off Grand Canyon, 73-69, on the road on Jan. 25 in Phoenix. The win was the Wolverines first win in GCU Arena since 2014 when UVU won the WAC regular-season championship. Utah Valley shot 49.1 percent from the field with seven shots from downtown. The Wolverines held the 'Lopes to just 40 percent from the floor and 19 percent from beyond the arc. UVU shot a season-low 43.5 percent from the foul line, its first time shooting under 50 percent since 2018 at Weber State. Utah Valley took care of the ball, finishing with just eight turnovers on the night. Washington led the charge with 24 points on 4 of 9 shooting from deep, to go along with four assists. Jardine notched his third double-double of the season, finishing with 10 points and a team-leading 13 rebounds. Isaiah White chipped in 10 points.

OLOJAPOKE BREAKS UVU'S SINGLE SEASON BLOCKS RECORD, ON TRACK TO BREAK SINGLE SEASON FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE MARK

Utah Valley senior forward Emmanuel Olojakpoke is one of the nation's leaders in total blocks at 79. With his 72nd block against CSU Bakersfield on Feb. 20, Olojakpoke broke Akolda Manyang's UVU record of 71 swats set during the 2017-18 season. Olojakpoke currently has 81 blocks this season with at least two games remaining to add to it. Olojakpoke also currently holds the best single season field goal percentage mark in UVU history at 69.1 percent. He has knocked down 65 of 94 shots this season.

WOLVERINES BREAK SINGLE SEASON TEAM BLOCKS RECORD

With its five blocks in its win over Grand Canyon on Feb. 22, UVU upped its block tally to 145 on the year and surpassed the 2017-18 team for the most blocks ever in a single season at UVU. The team currently has 157 team blocks. This season's team is just the fifth team to even record 100 or more blocks in a single season. This year's UVU team also currently holds the best blocks shots per game average in UVU single season history at 5.2 per game.

UVU RANKED 13TH NATIONALLY IN BLOCKS, OLOJAKPOKE 10TH

As of March 10, Utah Valley ranks 13th in the nation in total blocks with 157 swats. The Wolverines also rank 11th nationally in blocks per game at 5.2 a contest. Individually, Emmanuel Olojakpoke is ranked tied for 10th nationally with 81 blocks. He also ranks tied for 10th in blocks per game at 2.7. With 81 blocks already this season, he has broken the UVU single season blocks record of 71 held by Akolda Manyang during the 2017-18 season.

TJ WASHINGTON RECORDED CAREER-HIGH 13 ASSISTS IN WIN OVER GRAND CANYON.... SECOND MOST ASSISTS EVER RECORD-ED IN A SINGLE GAME IN UVU HISTORY

Utah Valley senior guard TJ Washington dished out a career-high 13 assists in Utah Valley's 92-80 win over Grand Canyon on Feb. 22 at the UCCU Center. The 13 assists are the second-most assists ever recorded in a single game in UVU history. Washington was just one assist shy of tying Brandon Randolph's record of 14 assists set in a 114-101 win at BYU on Nov. 26, 2016.

UTAH VALLEY HAS WON 37 OF ITS LAST 46 GAMES AT HOME

Utah Valley won a school-record 22 straight games at home dating from a win over UTSA on Nov. 29, 2017 to a win over UTRGV on Jan. 17, 2019. The previous UVU home win streak record was 17 games, which was set from the 2004-05 season to the 2005-06 season. UVU holds an impressive 37-8 (82.2 percent) record at home since a win over Seattle U on March 4, 2017. Utah Valley holds an all-time 187-52 (78.2 percent) record in its 14th season this season at the UCCU Center. The Wolverines are averaging 13.7 wins a season on their home hardwood. UVU finished the 2018-19 season with a school-record 16-1 mark. The team went 14-1 at home during the 2017-18 season. UVU went 6-7 at home this season.

WASHINGTON NAMED WAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK FOR NOVEMBER 18-24

Utah Valley senior guard TJ Washington has been named Western Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week for Nov. 18-24. This is his first-ever WAC Player of the Week honor. The Tulsa, Okla. native averaged 19.3 points, 5.7 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game last week. He opened the week with a then career-high 22 points as he led Utah Valley's comeback from 16 points down at No. 9 Kentucky to cut the lead to just one point, 67-68, with 3:26 to go before eventually falling 74-68. Washington also added five rebounds and five assists against the Wildcats. He then scored 10 points with three rebounds and two assists in a loss to Lamar last Thursday. Washington capped the week by scoring a career-high 26 points in a 68-62 road win at North Dakota State in the Summit League/WAC Challenge. He also grabbed a career-high nine rebounds in the victory.

WASHINGTON FEATURED ON ESPN'S TOP-10 PLAYS

Utah Valley senior guard scored a career-high 22 points with five threes in Monday night's loss at No. 9 Kentucky. A shot fake from beyond the arc that made his opponent fly through the air, and then the drive and finish at the basket was featured as the No. 10 play on Monday night on ESPN SportsCenter's Top-10 plays of the night. Washington helped lead UVU's comeback after being down 16 points to cutting the lead to just one point, 67-66, with 3:26 to play.





COMEBACK FALLS JUST SHORT IN LOSS AT #9 KENTUCKY, 82-74

Utah Valley's comeback bid fell just short as the Wolverines dropped a hard-fought 82-74 contest on the road against No. 9 Kentucky at Rupp Arena in Lexington on Nov. 18. Down by 16 points, 28-44, with 17 minutes to play in the game, UVU went on an 8-2 run over the next two minutes, led by Emmanuel Olojakpoke and Trey Woodbury to bring the deficit to 36-46. Both teams exchanged buckets over the next six minutes, with TJ Washington hitting three straight shots from deep to keep the Wolverines within striking distance. Washington and Jamison Overton led the charge as UVU used a 17-6 surge to cut the lead to just two points, 58-60, with 6:45 left in the game. A layup by Brandon Averette followed by another three by Washington cut the lead to one, 67-68, with 3:26 to go but a 7-0 run gave the Wildcats control of the game for good. Kentucky made free throws down the stretch to seal the 82-74 win. Washington led the Wolverines with 22 points, including five made threes, to go along with a team-high five assists and five rebounds. Woodbury added 17 points on three shots from deep and a perfect 4-of-4 from the charity stripe and Overton also scored in double figures with 10 points.

BLOCK PARTY

Utah Valley's 11 blocks in its 72-55 win over Westminster is the second-most blocks in a single game in UVU history. Brandon Morley and Emmanuel Olojakpoke each had five blocks, which ranks 10th on the UVU individual single game record charts. The 11 blocks are the most blocks in a single game since UVU recorded 11 blocks in a win over Chicago State on Jan. 12, 2017. The all-time UVU single game record for blocks is 12 set by the 2012-13 team in a win over NJIT on Jan. 5, 2013.

ABOUT UVU ATHLETICS' NCAA HISTORY

Until 2003, Utah Valley University competed as a NJCAA athletic program. The 2003-04 season was the school's first competing at an NCAA Division I level. In 2004-05, UVU played it first full Division I schedule. As a program transitioning from junior college to DI, UVU was termed "provisional" and remained that way until 2009. UVU'S provisional status was lifted and the program became a full member of NCAA Division I on July 8, 2009. Until then, UVU teams and individuals were not eligible to compete in NCAA championship events.

The Wolverines spent six seasons as an independent before the Great West Conference became an all-sports league in 2008 and began its first full season in 2009. UVU also became a university in 2008, changing its name from Utah Valley State College (UVSC) to Utah Valley University (UVU). UVU joined the Western Athletic Conference on July 1, 2013. Joining the WAC gave UVU teams the opportunity to play for NCAA automatic bids for the first time in program history.




