OPENING TIP

- Utah Valley heads out on the road for just the second time this season when the team makes the short drive up I-15 to Salt Lake City to take on in-state foe Utah on Tuesday at the Huntsman Center. Tip-off is set for 5 p.m.
- Utah Valley is yet to play with its full roster this season and will likely be without all of its players again this week. Evan Cole and Tim Fuller missed the first three games of the season. Colby Leifson missed the first two games of the year. JJ Overton missed last week's games against Southern Utah and Wyoming.
- Fardaws Aimaq scored a career-high 27 points with a school-record 20 rebounds to lead Utah Valley in a 93-88 setback to Wyoming on Saturday afternoon at the UCCU Center. The redshirt sophomore scored his 27 points on 8 of 12 shooting from the floor and an 11 of 16 mark at the free throw line. He also had three assists and a pair of blocks. Trey Woodbury scored 23 points, connecting on 8 of 18 shooting. He also had five rebounds and eight assists. Jordan Brinson helped with 19 points to go along with five assists. Evan Cole was also in double figures with 12 points.
- Aimaq's 20 rebounds on Saturday breaks the previous UVU single game record of 19 rebounds set by Baylee Steele against BYU on Nov. 9, 2018. Aimaq has now recorded 15 or more rebounds in four of his five games this season. The redshirt sophomore scored his 27 points on 8 of 12 shooting from the floor and an 11 of 16 mark at the free throw line. He also had three assists and a pair of blocks. He leads the nation in total rebounds (78) and ranks second in rebounds per game (15.6), second in defensive rebounds per game (10.2), second in offensive boards per game (5.4), and third in double-doubles (4).
- Utah Valley ranks sixth in the nation in assists per game, dishing out 21.6 a contest. The Wolverines also rank 15th in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.69.
- Mark Madsen enters his second season as the head coach of the Wolverines. The two-time NBA champion, former Los Angeles Lakers assistant coach, and former Stanford basketball star went 11-19 during his first season with UVU. He is just the third head coach in UVU's Division I history. Madsen took over the Utah Valley program last season after serving the past six seasons as an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Lakers. He was a two-time NBA champion as a player with the Lakers (2001 and 2002), and played for the Minnesota Timberwolves for six seasons.

ABOUT UTAH

Utah is 2-1 on the season with wins over Washington and Idaho State. The team dropped its first game of the season in an 82-64 setback at BYU (common opponent) on Saturday at the Marriott Center in Provo. Senior guard Alfonso Plummer led the Utes with 19 points on 4 of 8 shooting from long range against BYU. Junior forward Riley Battin was also in double figures with 14 points in the loss. Plummer leads the team in scoring through three games this season, averaging 17.7 points a contest. Junior forward Timmy Allen also averages double figures at 11.3 points a game. Sophomore forward Mikael Jantunen leads the Utes on the boards, pulling down 6.0 rebounds a game. As a team, Utah is averaging 71.7 points per game while limiting opponents to a 67.7 points per game average.

SERIES HISTORY VS. UTAH

Utah Valley and Utah meet on the basketball hardwood for just the second time on Tuesday. Utah won the only meeting between the two schools with an 87-80 win at the Huntsman Center in 2016. Utah Valley holds an all-time 2-9 record against the Pac-12. UVU took a 70-68 win at Oregon State in Corvallis in 2005 and a 70-68 win over Oregon State on 2010. UVU last faced a Pac-12 opponent on Dec. 6, 2018 when the Wolverines dropped an 80-69 decision at Arizona in Tucson.

SALT LAKE CITY—Isaac Neilson registered a career-high 28-point, 15-rebound double-double and Jordan Poydras scored 21 points in an 87-80 setback to in-state foe Utah on Dec. 6, 2016 at the Huntsman Center in Salt Lake City.

The Wolverines fell to 5-3 on the season with the loss and look to rebound on Saturday when the team hosts in-state rival Utah State. Utah improved to 6-1 on the year with the win.

Trailing 75-73, Conner Toolson knocked down a shot from long range to give the Wolverines a 76-75 lead with 2:44 to play. Poydras then stole the ball and Brandon Randolph connected on the other end to give UVU a 78-75

Fast Facts About Madsen

» Enters his second season at the helm of the UVU men's basketball program. He is the third coach in UVU's Division I history. Went 11-19 overall and 5-10 in WAC play during his first season with the Wolverines.

» Two-time NBA champion, former Los Angeles Lakers assistant coach, and former Stanford University basketball star Mark Madsen was officially named the men's basketball head coach at Utah Valley University in April.

» Madsen takes over the Utah Valley program after serving the past six seasons as an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Lakers. He was a two-time NBA champion as a player with the Lakers (2001 and 2002), and he played for the Minnesota Timberwolves for six seasons.

» Following his playing career, Madsen served as an assistant coach during the 2009-10 season with the Utah Flash of the NBA G League before returning to his alma mater, Stanford University, where he earned an MBA from the Stanford Graduate School of Business in 2012.

» In 2012, he was named an assistant coach at Stanford on Johnny Dawkins' staff and spent the 2012-13 season working in recruiting, opponent game planning, and player skill development.

» Spent four years as a player at Stanford (1996-2000), where he earned All-American honors in each of his final two seasons while helping the Cardinal to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including the 1998 Final Four.

» Earned the nickname "Mad Dog" while at Stanford for his aggressive style of play. The nickname stayed with him throughout his NBA career.

» Madsen averaged 10.9 points and 7.0 rebounds per game during his four seasons with the Cardinal. He ranks fourth all-time in field goal percentage (58.7) and sixth in rebounds (857). During his time at Stanford, the team compiled an impressive 105-24 overall record.

» He was recently inducted into the Stanford Athletics Hall of Fame.

» A native of Danville, Calif., Madsen earned his undergraduate degree in economics from Stanford in 2000.

» Graduated from San Ramon Valley High School.

» He and his wife, Hannah, have one son, William. They have a baby boy due in February.

Quoting Madsen....

On the loss to Wyoming

"The guys competed and executed the game plan almost perfectly in the second half. We have to build our consistency. As we do that, we are going to be able to weather through the entirety of a game. We will be able to play a tough opponent like Wyoming and come away with the win. That's what we are all shooting for. We've got to be better. After the game, I talked to them about how we have to have a better first half. We had five or six defensive lapses in the first half and consequently we dug ourselves a hole. That's part of the learning process but we cannot have those."

On Aimaq breaking the single game rebound record

"Fardaws is 100% team first. He is one of our team captains and he not only cares about the team but he lives for the team. He lives for winning. He is disappointed, I'm disappointed, we are all disappointed. He has a tremendous work ethic and he has a huge heart. He has worked hard to be in phenomenal physical shape. His timing is unique and he has soft hands. I have an even higher expectation for Fardaws. I think he can and will be better."

advantage with two minutes to go. Utah's Tyler Rawson responded with a shot from long range to tie the game, 78-78. Poydras couldn't get a three to fall and Utah took advantage with a layup on the other end to put the Utes ahead, 80-78, with a minute to go. A Utah three-pointer gave the Utes a five-point edge, forcing UVU to foul and send Utah to the free throw line. Utah then went 4-for-4 at the line over the final 20 seconds to help secure the win.

Neilson connected on 13-of-20 shots from the field and went 2-for-5 at the free throw line for his game-high 28 points. He also pulled down a career-high 15 boards for his third double-double of the season.

Poydras scored his 21 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the field, which included a 4-of-7 clip from long range. The senior guard also dished out four assists on the night. Randolph was also in double figures with 14 points, knocking down 6-of-13 shots on the night. He also tallied a game-high seven assists and pulled down three rebounds.

Jojo Zamora led four other Utes in double figures with 17 points. Kyle Kuzma helped with 16 points while Rawson and Lorenzo Bonam each added 14.

AIMAQ LEADS THE NATION ON THE BOARDS

Fardaws Aimaq leads the nation in total rebounds, pulling down 78 boards through five games this season. He also ranks second in rebounds per game (15.6), second in defensive rebounds per game (10.2), second in offensive boards per game (5.4), and third in double-doubles (4).

DISH MASTERS

Utah Valley is one of the top assists teams in the nation. The Wolverines rank sixth nationally in assists per game (21.6) and 14th in total assists (108). The team also ranks 15th in the country in assist turnover ratio at 1.69. Individually, Blaze Nield ranks 13th nationally in assist turnover ratio at 6.33. Trey Woodbury leads the team in assists at 5.0 a game, followed by Nield at 3.8 a contest.

seconds to play. UVU's Trey Woodbury responded with a three of his own to cut the Pokes' lead to just two points, 90-88, with 38 seconds on the clock. Wyoming's Hunter Maldonado was fouled on his drive to the basket and knocked down his free throws to help Wyoming secure the win.

UVU and Wyoming played to a 12-12 tie over the first five minutes of the game. The two teams then played through two ties and five lead changes before the Pokes used a short 7-2 run to take a 27-21 lead with 9:00 remaining in the first half. Wyoming held onto a six-point lead, 34-28, with 6:09 to go, but an 11-4 UVU run highlighted by a Brinson three and an Aimaq putback slam, gave UVU the lead, 39-38, with 2:41 remaining in the half. Wyoming then outscored the Wolverines 10-2 to take a 48-41 lead into the break. The Wolverines were able to battle through and cut the Wyoming lead to just one point, 62-61, with 11:18 remaining and again, 64-63, with 10:04 to play. The Pokes then built their lead to a 74-69 advantage with 6:28 to play before UVU went on a 7-2 run with back-to-back makes by Woodbury to tie the game, 76-76, with five minutes to play. The two teams then went through three ties and five lead changes to play to an 85-85 tie with 1:44 to go. Wyoming then knocked down its free throws in the final seconds to secure the win.

Aimaq's 20 rebounds breaks the previous UVU single game record of 19 rebounds set by Baylee Steele against BYU on Nov. 9, 2018. Aimaq has now recorded 15 or more rebounds in four of his five games this season. The redshirt sophomore scored his 27 points on 8 of 12 shooting from the floor and an 11 of 16 mark at the free throw line. He also had three assists and a pair of blocks.

Woodbury scored 23 points, connecting on 8 of 18 shooting. He also had five rebounds and eight assists. Jordan Brinson helped with 19 points to go along with five assists. Evan Cole was also in double figures with 12 points. As a team, Utah Valley shot 48.4 percent from the field compared to Wyoming's 53.3 percent mark. The Cowboys knocked down 13 threes in the game, while UVU hit five. The

Utah Valley junior guard Trey Woodbury was named the College Sports Madness WAC Player of the Week for his play in a pair of games against Adams State



and BYU for the week of Nov. 22-28. Woodbury averaged 23.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game to lead the Wolverines to a 1-1 record to open the 2020-21 season. He opened the season with 22 points in a 100-75 win over Adams State.

Woodbury knocked down 9 of 13 shots from the field, including a career-high 4 of 5 mark from long range. He also added four rebounds and four assists. In the setback at BYU, Woodbury scored a career-high 24 points on 10 of 17 shooting, including 3 of 5 from three-point range. He also tallied five rebounds, three assists, and three steals. Over the two games last week, Woodbury averaged 23.0 points 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 1.5 steals per game. He shot 63.3 percent from the field and 70 percent from beyond the arc.

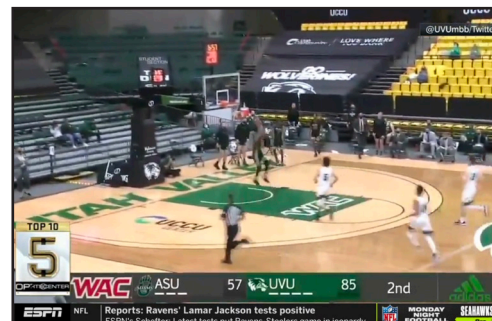
THREE-POINT STREAKING

Utah Valley was picked to finish sixth by the media and seventh by the coaches in the WAC's preseason polls. New Mexico State was picked to win the league in both polls. The Aggies received all available eight first place votes from the coaches and 10 of the 12 first place votes from the media. In the coaches' poll, Grand Canyon was picked to finish second with UT Rio Grande Valley third and California Baptist fourth. Seattle U was fifth, followed by WAC newcomer Tarleton sixth. UVU was selected seventh, Dixie State eighth, and Chicago State ninth. On the media side, Grand Canyon was selected second, UT Rio Grande Valley third, and California Baptist fourth. Seattle U was picked fifth, followed by Utah Valley in sixth, Dixie State seventh, Tarleton eighth, and Chicago State ninth.

EVAN COLE NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-WAC TEAM

Graduate forward Evan Cole has been named to the 2020-21 Preseason All-WAC team as selected by the media in the Western Athletic Conference preseason honors. Cole, a 6-foot-10, 230-pound graduate forward, spent the last three seasons at Georgia Tech (2017-20). He played in 27 games for the Yellow Jackets last season, averaging 4.4 points and 3.6 rebounds per game. He shot 47.1 percent from the field last season, connecting on 48 of 102 shots. During his three seasons at Georgia Tech, Cole played in 69 games while averaging 3.9 points and 3.0 rebounds a contest.

NEW FACES

Utah Valley welcomes 16 new players to its roster this season, including Fardaws Aimaq, who each had to sit out last season due to NCAA transfer rules. The Wolverines have added 10 new transfers (Le'Tre Darthard, Evan Cole, Blaze Nield, Tim Fuller, Jaden McClanahan, Cade Whicker, Colby Leifson, Asa McCord, Trey Farrer, and Jordan Brinson) to this year's roster. Aimaq (Mercer) also joins the team after redshirting last season.

UTAH VALLEY HAS WON 39 OF ITS LAST 50 GAMES AT HOME

UVU holds an impressive 39-11 (78 percent) record at home since a win over Seattle U on March 4, 2017. Utah Valley holds an all-time 189-55 (77.4 percent) record in its 15th season this year at the UCCU Center. The Wolverines are averaging 13.7 wins a season on their home hardwood. UVU finished the 2018-19 season with a school-record 16-1 mark. The team went 14-1 at home during the 2017-18 season and was 6-7 at home in 2019-20. UVU is 2-2 at home this season.

ABOUT UVU ATHLETICS' NCAA HISTORY

Until 2003, Utah Valley University competed as a NJCAA athletic program. The 2003-04 season was the school's first competing at an NCAA Division I level. In 2004-05, UVU played its first full Division I schedule. As a program transitioning from junior college to DI, UVU was termed "provisional" and remained that way until 2009. UVU's provisional status was lifted and the program became a full member of NCAA Division I on July 8, 2009. Until then, UVU teams and individuals were not eligible to compete in NCAA championship events.

The Wolverines spent six seasons as an independent before the Great West Conference became an all-sports league in 2008 and began its first full season in 2009. UVU also became a university in 2008, changing its name from Utah Valley State College (UVSC) to Utah Valley University (UVU). UVU joined the Western Athletic Conference on July 1, 2013. Joining the WAC gave UVU teams the opportunity to play for NCAA automatic bids for the first time in program history.

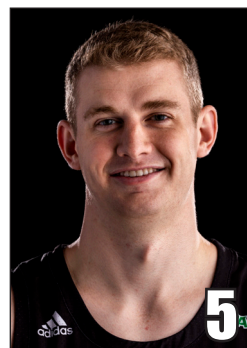

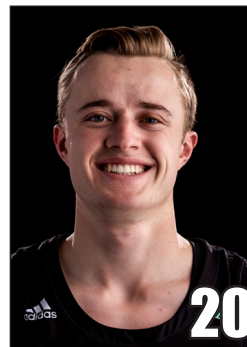
