UVU opens WWC slate at home this weekend

The Utah Valley University wrestling team will begin its Western Wrestling Conference dual season this week at home against South Dakota State and No. 20 North Dakota State. The duals will close a three-match homestand and will mark the final regular season home contests of 2013-14 for the Wolverines.

Thursday's contest against the first-place Jackrabbits will begin at 4 p.m. while Friday's versus the ranked Bison will start at 7 p.m. Both will take place in the PE Building and will feature live video at uvu.edu/uvutv and live results via TrackWrestling.com.

"We are looking forward to beginning the conference season but we've still got a couple of things that we need to work on," UVU head coach Greg Williams said. "We're trying out some new conditioning drills and we are hoping that they will make a difference. The kids are working hard and we're hoping to have our 10 best kids healthy and ready for the conference tournament."

Friday's dual meet against the Bison will mark Senior Night for three Utah Valley grapplers as seniors Avery Garner (141 pounds), Curtis Abner Cook (165) and Monte Schmalhaus (174)

will all be recognized for their stellar careers in Orem prior to the contest. All three are team captains for UVU this season and Garner is currently leading the group with a 9-6 overall record and a team-best 8-2 clip in duals.

UVU will enter the week with a 4-6 overall record (0-0 WWC) and is coming off of a 23-18 come-from-behind victory over Boise State at home last Saturday. The Wolverines trailed the Broncos 12-0 after three bouts and 18-10 with three to go but Jade Rauser (125), Chasen Tolbert (133) and the senior Garner helped Utah Valley come back to take the dual as they won the final three bouts of the evening.

Rauser, who was wrestling in his first match since November due to an injury, took care of business with a 10-1 major decision over BSU's Rami Haddadin. Tolbert then followed that up by pinning Ben DeMulle in just 49-seconds to give Utah Valley its first lead of the night at 20-18. Garner, who was named the WWC Wrestler of the Week on Tuesday, then secured the dual for the Wolverines by defeating three-time NCAA qualifier Brian Owen by decision, 6-3.

UVU, who went 3-2 in WWC duals last season, is currently led

by heavyweight Adam Fager as he is ranked 13th in his weight class by InterMat and 12th by Amateur Wrestling News and holds a 15-6 record. Rauser (4-1) also finds himself back in the national rankings, as he will enter the weekend ranked 17th by InterMat and 14th by AWW. Both Fager and Rauser qualified for the NCAA Championships for UVU last year.

About South Dakota State

The Jackrabbits are currently in first place in the conference standings with an unblemished 2-0 mark in league duals. SDSU picked up its conference wins over Wyoming (18-17) in Gillette, Wyo., and Air Force (18-14) in Brookings, S.D., a couple of weeks ago. Overall, the Jacks are 3-5 on the season and will come to Orem on the heels of a pair of non-conference losses to No. 5 Northern Iowa (29-12) and Ohio (32-6) last Saturday.

Cody Pack leads the Jackrabbits on the season as he holds a 20-6 record and is currently ranked 17th at 157 pounds.

Thursday will mark the ninth all-time meeting between the Wolverines and Jacks. Utah Valley will enter the contest with a 7-1 all-time series advantage over SDSU as well as having won the last six meetings between the two.

About North Dakota State

The Bison (7-4, 1-0 WWC) are ranked 20th in this week's USA Today/NWCA/AWN Division I Coaches Poll, which is the highest NDSU has ever been rated in school history. North Dakota State is coming off of a 23-17 loss to No. 15 Wisconsin in Madison last weekend, but prior to that NDSU had reeled off five straight victories. During that stretch, the Bison defeated Cal Poly (35-6), Bakersfield (27-12), Boise State (26-15), No. 20 Oregon State (19-17) and Air Force (41-6).

Steven Monk (22-1) leads North Dakota State as he is ranked third in the nation at 165 pounds while Hayden Zillmer (20-5) is 13th at 174 pounds and Kurtis Julson (15-7) is 20th at 184.

Friday's dual will also mark the ninth all-time meeting between UVU and the Bison but NDSU holds a 7-1 series advantage. Utah Valley last defeated North Dakota State, 18-15, in Fargo on Feb. 7, 2009.

Up Next for the Wolverines

Utah Valley will close its regular season next week with three road conference duals. The Wolverines will take on Northern Colorado in Greeley on Wednesday (Feb. 12), Air Force in Colorado Springs on Friday (Feb. 14) and Wyoming in Laramie on Saturday (Feb. 15).

Fager & Rauser Ranked on Latest InterMat Poll

Junior Adam Fager is currently ranked 13th by InterMat in the heavyweight division, while sophomore Jade Rauser is currently ranked 17th at 125 pounds. Fager leads the team in victories with 15 and placed at both the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invite (4th) and Midlands (7th) in December, while Rauser (4-1) recently returned to the lineup from an injury for the Wolverines.

Fager Debuts at 13th on 1st NCAA Ranking

Junior Adam Fager is not only ranked nationally by InterMat but he also debuted at 13th at heavyweight on the first of three NCAA Coaches' Panel Rankings. The NCAA released the rankings last week. Fager is the lone Wolverine to be ranked in the Top-33 of his weight class.

Fager & Schmalhaus Place at Midlands

Junior heavyweight Adam Fager and senior 174-pounder Monte Schmalhaus both placed at the Midlands Championships over Christmas break as they took seventh and eighth, respectively, in their weight classes. The two placers set a new program high for Utah Valley at the renowned tournament.

Make it Six Straight at the CKLV Invite

This season marked the sixth consecutive year that UVU has had at least one wrestler finish in the top eight at the CKLV Invitational as Adam Fager (HWT) placed fourth in

early December. Jade Rauser (125) also finished eighth in 2012, while Josh Wilson (149) finished fifth in 2011 and Benjamin Kjar (125) took seventh in both 2010 and 2009 and eighth in 2008. Flint Ray (133) also placed eighth for the Wolverines in 2009. This season's fourth-place finish by Fager was the highest-ever finish by a Wolverine at the tourney.

UVU to Host 2014 WWC Championships

Utah Valley will host the Western Wrestling Conference Championships for the first time on March 8, 2014. The event will be held at the UCCU Center on the campus of Utah Valley University and will double up as the NCAA West Regional. There, berths to the 2014 NCAA Wrestling Championships will be on the line.

UVU Returns Two NCAA Qualifiers

Sophomore Jade Rauser (125) and junior Adam Fager (heavyweight), who both competed for UVU at the NCAA Championships in Des Moines, Iowa, last year, each are back in 2013-14. Rauser went 21-10 (6-1 duals) last season while Fager went 20-12 (6-4 duals). The two along with departed senior Josh Wilson (149) represented UVU at Nationals for the fourth straight season. Wilson finished his run with a 2-2 record, while Rauser went 1-2 and Fager went 0-2.

Wolverines Return Nine Starters

UVU returns nine of its 10 starters from its 2012-13 squad that went 6-4 overall and 3-2 in WWC action. The lone starter that is gone is the former two-time NCAA Qualifier and one-time WWC Champion Josh Wilson (149) that graduated last year. Jade Rauser (125), Chasen Tolbert (133), Avery Garner (141), Chase Cuthbertson (157), Abner Cook (165), Monte Schmalhaus (174), Ethan Smith (184), Derek Thomas (197) and Adam Fager (HWT) are all slated to start at their respective weight class.

UVU Places 3rd at '13 NCAA West Regional

UVU had its highest finish in program history at the NCAA West Regional/WWC Championships in Laramie, Wyo., on March 9 by placing third (its previous high was fourth). The Wolverines got all 10 of their wrestlers into the medal rounds (5 in the finals & 5 in the 3rd-place bouts) to help them place third. UVU finished with 70 points, just nine back of the winner Wyoming (79). North Dakota State placed second with 76 points.

Wolverines Finish 3rd in WWC

Utah Valley finished third in the WWC dual standings last season with a 3-2 record. UVU defeated No. 22 Air Force 23-9, Northern Colorado 39-0 and South Dakota State 22-18 and fell to then No. 16 Wyoming 20-12 and then No. 25 North Dakota State 18-15.

It's Good to be Home

UVU went 4-1 at home last year and is 17-7 in the friendly confines of the PE Building over the past six seasons. The Wolverines are also over .500 all-time at home as they will enter the week with a 27-25 home record.

Head Coach Greg Williams



Entering his eighth year at the helm of Utah Valley University, head wrestling coach Greg Williams has taken Wolverine wrestlers to the NCAA Championships in each of the past four seasons. In 2011 he also coached UVU's first-ever wrestling All-American in 125-pounder Ben

Kjar, as Kjar placed fourth at the 2011 NCAA Wrestling Championships.

In 2009-10, Williams had his most successful year when he led his team to a 10-3 overall record and a second place conference finish at 4-1. That year Williams also coached UVU's first-ever NCAA Division I qualifiers as three Wolverine wrestlers punched their tickets to the NCAA Championships.

In the past four seasons, Williams has helped guide 10 wrestlers to the NCAA Championships. This past year (2012-13), he matched a program high by sending three of his wrestlers to Nationals. He has also coached a total of four conference champions and 15 Academic All-Americans during his tenure in Orem.

Williams coached his first conference champion that season as Flint Ray (133 lbs.) became the first Wolverine to win his weight bracket at the WWC Championships. In 09-10, Williams picked up UVU's inaugural victory over a nationally-ranked program as his Wolverines upset the then ranked No. 8 Boise State Broncos at home by a score of 22-20.

In 2008-09, Williams coached his Wolverines to a school-record in victories with an 11-3 clip. Williams' Utah Valley grapplers also posted a 4-1 record in the Western Wrestling Conference that season as well.

In Williams' seven seasons of coaching at UVU he has tallied an overall record of 53-47. In his first season (2006-07), he posted a 6-12 record and in 2007-08 his squad finished at 9-11 and also picked up the Wolverines first dual victory in Western Wrestling Conference action with a 39-4 win over South Dakota State. In 2010-11 Williams led his team to a 5-4 record, in 2011-12 he led his young squad to a 6-10 clip and this past season his team went 6-4.

Williams is the second coach in Utah Valley's short history as the school will begin its 10th season of NCAA competition this fall.

Williams brings to UVU over 20 years of coaching experience, including 13 years as the owner and coach of the Elite Wrestling Club prior coming to Utah Valley.

He is a 14-time coach of the Utah National Wrestling Team and during his coaching career has tu-

tored over 70 high school All-Americans.

Williams' pupils include current UVU assistant coach, Justin Ruiz, who was previously the No. 1 ranked Greco wrestler at 211 lbs. Ruiz was a two-time All-American at Nebraska and bronze medalist at the World Championships in 2005.

He began his coaching career at Sky View High School in Smithfield, Utah, where he led the school to an 87-8 record.

Williams, a native of San Diego, California, graduated from University High School in 1979 where he was a California State Champion.

From there, he moved on to Utah State University in Logan, Utah and was an All-American and a three-time NCAA qualifier for the Aggies.

Williams graduated from Utah State in 1985 with a degree in Marketing Education. He and his wife Kristin have two children, Alexis and Taylor.

2013-14 UVU Season Preview

After sending three wrestlers to the NCAA Championships a year ago and placing third in the Western Wrestling Conference, head coach Greg Williams is anticipating a big 2013-14 campaign from his veteran Utah Valley University wrestling squad.

The Wolverines will welcome back nine of their 10 starters from last year's team that went 6-4 overall and 3-2 in the WWC as well as two who wrestled at the "Big Show" in Des Moines, Iowa. The lone starter from the 2012-13 season who has since departed is two-time NCAA Qualifier and one-time conference champion Josh Wilson (149 pounds).

"We have high expectations for this year," Williams said. "We only lost one wrestler last year in Josh Wilson but we have three seniors this year that will provide us good leadership. We also return nine guys who wrestled for us at conference last year, so we're definitely expecting great things."

Williams will look to his three seniors -- 141-pounder Avery Garner, 165-pounder Curtis Abner Cook and 174-pounder Monte Schmalhaus -- to lead his team this year as he has named them all team captains. The trio of Wolverines had successful 2012-13 campaigns as together they combined to go 56-31 and Garner and Schmalhaus both recorded 20-win seasons. All three also capped last season by placing second in their respective weight classes at the NCAA West Regional/WWC Championships.

"We came fairly close of achieving our goal of winning conference last year, and we feel like that it is something we can accomplish this season," added Williams. "We expect all of our individuals to do well as we return two NCAA Qualifiers and three seniors who were all runners-up at last year's conference tournament. Those three are definitely hungry and really want to make it to the NCAA Tournament this season."

The eighth-year head coach will also anticipate big things from his two returning NCAA Qualifiers: sophomore Jade Rauser (125 pounds) and junior heavyweight Adam Fager. After wrestling at the NCAA Championships last year, both Rauser and Fager are ranked nationally in a number of preseason polls. Rauser is ranked as high as 13th by InterMat while Fager comes in at 20th on a couple of the polls.

Rauser had a stellar red-shirt freshman year in which he went 21-10, 6-1 in duals and led the team in falls with nine. Rauser, who became UVU's first-ever freshman to compete at the NCAA Championships last year, went 1-2 at his first trip to Nationals with a pin over Indiana's Joe Duca. Fager also surpassed 20 victories last season as he went 20-12 and a perfect 6-0 in WWC action. The UVU heavyweight was one of two Wolverines to win a conference title last year. Fager concluded his season by going 0-2 at his first appearance at Nationals but nearly defeated Penn State's Jimmy Lawson in his final match as he fell just 5-4.

Utah Valley also returns four other starters from last year's team in junior Ethan Smith (184), as well as sophomores Chasen Tolbert (133), Chase Cuthbertson (157) and Derek Thomas (197). Both Smith and Thomas will move up to new weight classes this season as Smith will bump up from 157 all the way to 184, while Thomas will shift from 184 to 197.

Tolbert led the way out of the four with 13 victories last season, while Cuthbertson and Smith each recorded 10 and Thomas put up nine. At the conference championships, Tolbert took third while Smith and Thomas both placed fourth.

"We've also had a lot of improvement during the offseason. Chasen Tolbert, Chase Cuthbertson, Ethan Smith and Derek Thomas all worked very hard and are looking good," stated Williams. "There is a lot of experience as well as confidence throughout the lineup. Our workouts are way ahead of where they were last year."

To fill Wilson's spot at 149-pounds will most likely be transfer Trevor Willson, who comes to UVU after wrestling his freshman campaign at Arizona State last season. Willson, a sophomore from Tucson, Ariz., went 1-3 in limited action for the Sun Devils in 2012-13.

"There's not one kid in that lineup that's not planning on going to Nationals," added Williams. "Several of them also feel like they're good enough to step up on that podium. And that is exactly the kind of mentality that we are looking for from them."

In all, the Wolverines will welcome back 15 letterwinners from last year's squad as well as mix in 14 newcomers.

Notable newcomers include Dalton Brady (133/141), a four-time Arizona State Champion from Chandler High School (Queen Creek, Ariz.) as well as a 2013 USA Folkstyle National Champion and a World Team member that placed fifth at the 2011 FILA Cadet Freestyle Championships, and local product Jed Mellen (133), a three-time State Champion from Payson High School (Payson, Utah).

"These are a couple of the most talented wrestlers that we've ever had in the room. We're definitely expecting some great things from them in the future," said Williams when asked about Brady and Mellen. "We also have a few other guys that came in this year that we feel like will make an impact for us as well."

The 11 other newcomers that will wrestle for UVU this season are: Max Adamson (heavyweight from Murray, Utah), Aryn Almberg (184 from Ely, Nev.), Abel Gomez

(184 from Las Vegas, Nev.), Koleton Hardy (149/157 from Brigham City, Utah), Jared Harris (149 from Springville, Utah), Jordan Karst (heavyweight from Las Vegas, Nev.), Richard Larsen (heavyweight from Sandy, Utah), Ty Rosevear (165/174 from Sherwood, Ore.), Tanner Sprenkle (125/133 from Billings, Mont.), Maxwell Sultan (133/141 from Fayetteville, Ga.) and Ross Taylor (165 from Newcastle, Utah). All of them came to Utah Valley from high school except for Taylor who transferred to UVU after spending two seasons at Western Wyoming CC in Rock Springs, Wyo.

Utah Valley will face a challenging schedule this season that features duals against a number of top programs as well taking on stiff competition at some elite tournaments.

"We will face some tough competition this season and we need to rise to that," added Williams. "It will be our challenge to win those matches so our guys can get in the RPI ranking as well as the coaches' poll and have more chances to earn those spots at conference to go to Nationals."

Besides taking third in the regular season in the WWC a year ago, Utah Valley also recorded its highest finish in program history at the 2013 WWC Championships/NCAA West Regional by placing third. The Wolverines finished in third place with 70 points, just nine points back of first-place Wyoming and six behind second-place North Dakota State.

Following its conference season, Utah Valley will host the conference tournament, which doubles up as the NCAA West Regional, for the first time on March 8 in the PE Building.

"We're excited and our entire athletic department is excited to help us host the conference championships this year," concluded Williams. "If we're able to stay healthy, it's going to be a really fun tournament and we're going to have a great chance to win a conference title."
