QUICK HITS

- The Wolverines will enter Saturday's action with a 2-2 overall record and a 0-1 Big 12 Conference clip. UVU last split a pair of duals against Pac-12 foes Oregon State and No. 22 Stanford this past Sunday in Corvallis, Oregon. After dropping a tightly contested 18-16 match to Oregon State, the Wolverines responded by knocking off the 22nd-ranked Stanford Cardinal by a score of 19-16. UVU split each dual meet at five matches apiece, but bonus points proved to be the difference for Oregon State in Sunday's opener, and for UVU in the nightcap victory over Stanford.
- Junior 125-pounder Taylor LaMont, 133-pound redshirt freshman Ty Smith, 149-pound sophomore Cameron Hunsaker and senior 174-pounder Demetrius Romero all went a perfect 2-0 for UVU in dual competition last Sunday. Smith led the group by knocking off a pair of top-20 foes on the day in the 18th-ranked reigning Pac-12 champion Devan Turner Oregon State (4-1) and No. 18 Jason Miranda of Stanford (5-1). The two-time UVU NCAA qualifier LaMont too defeated a pair of nationally ranked opponents by defeating No. 24 Brandon Kaylor of Oregon State (19-5) and No. 26 Jackson DiSario of Stanford (12-8). Fellow two-time UVU NCAA qualifier Romero too defeated a ranked foe with an 11-3 major decision over No. 27 Tyler Eischens of Stanford, while Hunsaker had what might be considered the win of the meet with a first period upset fall over No. 12 Jaden Abas of Stanford (2:16) to earn recognition from NCAA Wrestling as the No. 4 Moment of the Week.
- UVU freshman 157-pounder Danny Snediker and sophomore heavyweight Chase Trussell too picked up wins in dual action for the Wolverines last Sunday, while freshmen Tyson Humpherys (133) and Kase Mauger (125) led the way in bonus matches by going 2-0 and 2-1, respectively.
- Saturday's action will mark UVU's final dual meets of the condensed 2020-21 season. UVU will finish its regular season by taking part at the USAFA Round Robin event on Saturday, Feb. 20.

ABOUT UTAH VALLEY

After the successful outing at Oregon State, UVU now finds itself ranked as high as 18th on the latest InterMat Tournament Ranking, as well as 26th by TrackWrestling and 28th by WIN Magazine. Individually, the Wolverines now have four ranked wrestlers led by the 125-pound junior LaMont who is now ranked as high as fourth nationally by Inter-Mat. The 2019 Big 12 champion Romero is also ranked in the top-five, as he is tabbed fifth in a number of the different polls. With their big outings last week, Smith and Hunsaker have also made their way into the rankings as Smith is now ranked as high as No. 16 at 133 and Hunsaker is ranked 27th at 149.

Romero and LaMont remained undefeated on the season, as the 174-pound Romero will enter Saturday with a perfect 10-0 mark while LaMont is 6-0 at 125. Smith are next with 6-1 and 7-2 respective records. Mauger also holds a 5-1 clip at 125 pounds.

ABOUT THE COMPETITION

The host Jackrabbits will enter Saturday with a 4-6 overall record and a 1-5 Big 12 Conference mark after falling to both NDSU (18-16) and No. 12 Iowa State (19-12) in Fargo last weekend. South Dakota State holds wins on the year over Oregon State (20-12), Air Force (24-14), No. 21 Stanford (23-15) and Little Rock (28-10). The Jacks were ranked in the InterMat Top-25 Dual poll a week ago but have since fallen out after dropping contests to NDSU and Iowa State last week. SDSU is ranked 19th in the current WIN Magazine Tournament poll and 26th in the latest TrackWrestling poll. The Jacks return a pair of 2020 NCAA qualifiers in 197-pounder Tanner Sloan and 165-pounder Tanner Cook. Danny Vega also returns, who was an alternate at the national meet at 125 pounds. SDSU currently has six ranked grapplers in Saturday's probable lineup led by Sloan checking in at No. 4 at 197. Zach Price is next at No. 10 at 133, while Clay Carlson is 15th at 141, Cade DeVos is No. 16 at 157, Vegas is 25th at 125 and Cade King is 28th at 174.

Saturday's matchup will mark the 16th all-time meeting between UVU and SDSU. The Wolverines will enter the contest holding to a slight 8-7 series advantage, but South Dakota State has won six straight meetings and is 4-3 at home.

NDSU is currently receiving votes for the NWCA Top 25 Coaches Poll and ranked 24th in the latest InterMat Dual poll. The Bison will enter with a 5-3 overall record and a 3-2 mark in Big 12 Conference duals. North Dakota State defeated SDSU, 18-16, last weekend but also fell to No. 12 Iowa State by a score of 32-6. The Bison also hold wins on the year over Oregon State (19-15), Fresno State (29-15), California Baptist (30-6) and a second over South Dakota State (21-13). North Dakota State returns a trio of 2020 NCAA qualifiers in Dylan Droegegmuller (141), Jared Franek (157) and heavyweight Brandon Metz. The Bison will also enter Saturday with six grapplers in their probable lineup currently ranked led by No. 12 Franek (157). Metz is next by being ranked as high as No. 17 (heavyweight), Kellyn March is 26th (133), Luke Weber is 28th (165), Droegegmuller is 32nd (141) and Riley Habisch is 33rd (174).

Saturday's contest will mark the 15th all-time meeting between UVU and NDSU. North Dakota State will enter the matchup holding to an 11-3 series advantage and having won the last two meetings. The Wolverines have won two of the last four contests, however, as UVU defeated NDSU in both 2016-17 and 2017-18.

Air Force holds a 2-4 overall record and a 2-4 clip in Big 12 action. The Falcons last split a pair of Big 12 duals by knocking off No. 21 Northern Colorado, 31-7, and dropping a tight contest to West Virginia, 20-17. Air Force also holds a win over Fresno State (43-7) on the year.

The Falcons didn't have any NCAA qualifiers a season ago, but currently have six wrestlers ranked. Jared Van Vleet leads the way as he's ranked 13th at 133. Lenny Petersen is next by being ranked 19th at 141, Cody Surratt is 24th at 174, Wyatt Hendrickson is 28th at heavyweight, Cody Phippen is 30th at 125 and Dylan Martinez is 33rd at 149.

UVU RETURNS TWO FORMER NCAA QUALIFIERS

After having three NCAA qualifiers a season ago, Utah Valley returns a pair of former NCAA qualifiers this year in redshirt junior Taylor LaMont and redshirt senior Demetrius Romero. Both two-time former NCAA qualifiers for UVU, LaMont will drop a weight class and compete at 125 pounds for UVU in 2020-21, while Romero will bump up a weight class and compete at 174 this year. LaMont has previously qualified for the NCAA Championships in 2019-20 and 2017-18 (missed 2018-19 with an injury), while Romero has qualified in 2018-19 and 2017-18 (missed 2019-20 with an injury).

NATIONALLY RANKED WOLVERINES

2019 BIG 12 CHAMP ROMERO HEALTHY IN 2020-21

After missing last season with a knee injury, two-time UVU NCAA qualifier and 2019 Big 12 champion Demetrius Romero is back for his redshirt senior season for Utah Valley in 2020-21. Romero, who will now bump up a weight class and compete at 174 pounds this season, went 28-5 at 165 in 2018-19, won the program's first Big 12 title, and just missed out on earning All-American honors by advancing to the Blood Round at the 2019 NCAA Championships.

UTAH VALLEY 2019-20 SEASON RECAP

With 2019 NCAA qualifiers Matt Findlay (149) and Demetrius Romero (165) both sidelined all of 2019-20 with injuries, UVU went 3-11 in dual meets on the year and 2-7 in Big 12 Conference matches. UVU picked up an early season victory over Sacred Heart and then managed to win a pair of late Big 12 Conference season contests over West Virginia and Northern Colorado. UVU then had three grapplers qualify for the 2020 NCAA Championships--Taylor LaMont (133), Kimball Bastian (174) and Tate Orndorff (285)--and one NWCA First Team All-American crowned in former heavyweight Tate Orndorff.

LAMONT WINS 2020 U23 GRECO-ROMAN NATIONALS

After posting a third-place finish at the 2020 U.S. Senior Nationals in Greco-Roman competition in October, redshirt junior 125-pounder Taylor LaMont then wrestled his way to winning the 2020 U23 Greco Nationals championship in November. LaMont, who is a current U.S. National Team member in Greco, went a perfect 4-0 at the event to win the 60 kg championship. He also outscored his opponents by an impressive tally of 30-3 on his way to winning the 2020 U23 Greco Nationals. LaMont is an unprecedented seven-time age-group World Team qualifier and will look to earn a spot on the Olympic team for the first time this spring.

ROMERO AND DELGADO EARN FREESTYLE A-A HONORS

Senior 174-pounder Demetrius Romero and junior 141-pounder Isaiah Delgado both recently earned freestyle All-American honors after placing at the 2020 U23 and Junior Nationals in November. Romero posted a fifth-place finish by going 5-2 at 79 kg in the U23 bracket, while Delgado placed sixth at 61 kg in the Juniors bracket after going 4-3 at the renowned national tournament.

KEEPING IT IN THE FAMILY

UVU doesn't have just one set of brothers, but it has two sets of brothers on its roster this season as well as a pair of cousins. Redshirt sophomore Will Edelblute (125) and redshirt freshman Sam Edelblute make up one set or brothers, while redshirt junior Spencer Heywood (165) and freshman Sammy Heywood (133) make up the other. Redshirt freshman RJ Bingham (165) is also first cousins with freshman Tanner Lofthouse (165), and they are both nephews of associate head coach Ethen Lofthouse.

UVU 2020 BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP

With five podium finishes at the 2020 Big 12 Championships, UVU tallied 33 total points on its way to placing 11th at last year's conference championship. Current volunteer assistant coach Kimball Bastian (174) and departed heavyweight Tate Orndorff led the way by each placing fifth, while Cameron Hunsaker took seventh at 149, and Taylor LaMont (133) and Tanner Orndorff (197) both finished eighth.

THIS IS (NOW) BIG 12 COUNTRY

Following a nine-year stint in the Western Wrestling Conference, the Wolverines now call the Big 12 Conference home for the sport of wrestling. UVU, along with all five of its fellow former WWC member institutions, were officially added as affiliate members to the Big 12 on July 29, 2015. The new-look Big 12 now consists of core members Iowa State, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State and West Virginia, as well as affiliates Utah Valley, Air Force, North Dakota State, Northern Colorado, South Dakota State and Wyoming, as well as 2017-18 newcomers Fresno State and Northern Iowa. The move is unprecedented for Utah Valley, as it was not only an NCAA Division I Independent just 15 years ago, but also its entire athletics department competed at the Junior College level (NJCAA) until the 2003-04 campaign.

ABOUT UTAH VALLEY'S NCAA HISTORY

Until 2003, Utah Valley University competed as a Junior College (NJCAA) athletic program. The 2003-04 season was the school's first competing at the NCAA Division I level and also marked the first season that it added the sport of wrestling. In the summer of 2009, UVU's provisional status was lifted and the program became a full member of NCAA Division I on July 8, 2009. Until then, UVU teams and individuals were not eligible to compete in NCAA championship events. After three seasons as a Division I Independent (2003-06), the Wolverine wrestling team spent nine years in the Western Wrestling Conference (2006-15) before joining the Big 12 Conference as an affiliate member in July of 2015. UVU also became a university in 2008, changing its name from Utah Valley State College (UVSC) to Utah Valley University (UVU).

GREG WILLIAMS

Head Coach | 15th Season | Utah State '85

Entering his 15th year of coaching at the helm of Utah Valley University wrestling, head coach Greg Williams has guided his Wolverines from a Division I Independent to a member of the Big 12 Conference during his tenure. Williams has also sent at least one Wolverine grappler to the NCAA Championships in each of the past 11 seasons. He has also coached a trio of All-Americans during his career -- in senior 125-pounder Benjamin Kjar (placed fourth) in 2011, senior 133-pounder Jade Rauser (placed eighth) in 2016 and sophomore

heavyweight Tate Orndorff (NWCA First Team) in 2020 -- and took a program best six NCAA qualifiers to nationals in 2019.

After spending nine seasons of competition as a member of the Western Wrestling Conference, Williams helped his team get into one of the most prestigious conferences in the nation in the Big 12 Conference in the summer of 2015. His Wolverines are one of eight wrestling affiliates to join the Big 12 in the sport of wrestling for the 2015-16 season, as they along with Air Force, Fresno State, Northern Colorado, Northern Iowa, North Dakota State, South Dakota State and Wyoming all now call the Big 12 home.

In arguably the program's best season of competition, Williams helped his Wolverines spend a school record of 10 consecutive weeks in the NWCA Top 25 Coaches Poll in 2018-19 as well as send a program record six grapplers to the 2019 NCAA Championships. Williams also helped his Wolverines earn their highest NWCA Top 25 Coaches Poll ranking in program history by being ranked as high as No. 21 after knocking off both No. 13 Purdue and No. 15 Rutgers early in the season. Williams also helped lead a total of six of his wrestlers land a spot into the individual national rankings on the season, as well as helped crown the program's inaugural Big 12 champion in 165-pounder Demetrius Romero and guide a program record of five grapplers to podium finishes at the Big 12 Championships. After suffering a number of key injuries during the second half of season, UVU finished with a 10-14 overall record and a 1-8 Big 12 clip in 2018-19.

In 2017-18, he led his Wolverines to a very successful season in which his team compiled an 8-6 overall record and tied for fifth in the Big 12 standings with a 4-4 conference dual record. He also took a program-best five grapplers to nationals and helped Utah Valley break into the USA Today/NWCA Top 25 Coaches Poll for the first time in program history as the team debuted at No. 25 in early February. Williams also coached UVU's first-ever Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational champion and the program's first top-ranked wrestler in the nation in Taylor LaMont in the RPI. Along with holding down the No. 1 ranking in the country in the RPI, LaMont also reached as high as No. 6 in the national polls at 125 pounds and entered the NCAA Championships as the highest seeded wrestler in history at No. 7.

In 2016-17, Williams led his Wolverines to a 5-6 record and a 2-3 clip in Big 12 action. That season, UVU managed to take down a pair of ranked foes in No. 23 North Dakota State in Fargo as well as No. 23 Oregon State of the Pac-12 at home. The Wolverines went on to receive votes for the USA Today/NWCA Coaches Poll for just the second time in program history and sent a pair of grapplers to nationals.

During Utah Valley's inaugural year of competition in the Big 12, Williams helped his Wolverines pick up a 20-19 upset win at No. 18 Oregon State en route to receiving the program's first-ever votes for the top 25 poll. He also helped five Wolverine grapplers earn a spot on the podium at the 2016 Big 12 Championship, with two advancing on to the 2016 NCAA Championships and Jade Rauser earning All-American honors.

After taking a program-record at the time of four grapplers to nationals in 2014, Williams followed that up by sending three in 2015 and two more in 2016. One of his two 2016 qualifiers was Jade Rauser, who not only earned All-American honors that season, but also became the school's first-ever four-time NCAA qualifier.

In all, Williams has coached 35 NCAA qualifiers, three All-Americans, seven conference champions, and a total of 30 NWCA Scholar All-Americans since UVU became a full NCAA Division I member prior to the 2009-10 campaign. He has also helped his team land a spot on the NWCA Division I Top 30 Scholar All-American Teams list 11 times over the past 12 seasons, which includes three top-five finishes. Williams also helped coach the program's inaugural NCAA Elite 90 Award recipient in 2018-19 in Matt Findlay, who held

the highest cumulative GPA of any of the 330 participants in the 2019 NCAA Championships with a 3.94 GPA while studying biology and minoring in Russian.

In 2009-10, Williams had his most successful year when he led his team to a 10-3 overall record and a second-place conference finish with a 4-1 WWC record. That year he also coached UVU's first-ever NCAA Division I qualifiers as three Wolverine wrestlers punched their tickets to the NCAA Championships. That same season Williams also picked up Utah Valley wrestling's inaugural victory over a nationally-ranked program when his Wolverines upset the then eighth-ranked Boise State Broncos at home by a score of 22-20.

In 2008-09, Williams coached his Wolverines to a school-record in victories with an 11-3 clip. Williams' Utah Valley grapplers also posted a 4-1 record in the Western Wrestling Conference that season as well.

In Williams' 14 seasons of coaching at UVU, he has tallied an overall record of 91-112. In his first season of coaching at Utah Valley (2006-07), he posted a 6-12 record and his squad finished at 9-11 in 2007-08 and also picked up the Wolverines' first Western Wrestling Conference dual victory with a 39-4 win over South Dakota State. In 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2012-13, Williams respectively led his Wolverines to a 5-4, 6-10 and 6-4 records. He also helped his squad's post a 6-9 tally in 2013-14 ago (2013-14), a 2-9 clip in 2014-15, a 4-10 record in 2015-16, and 3-11 in 2019-20.

Williams is the second coach in Utah Valley's short history, as the institution added the sport of wrestling prior to its first season of NCAA Division I competition, 2003-04.

Williams brings over 20 years of coaching experience to UVU, including 13 years as the owner and coach of the Elite Wrestling Club prior coming to Utah Valley.

He is a 14-time coach of the Utah National Wrestling Team and during his coaching career has tutored over 70 high school All-Americans.

Williams' pupils include former UVU assistant coach, Justin Ruiz, who was previously the No. 1 ranked Greco wrestler at 211 lbs. Ruiz was a two-time All-American at Nebraska and a bronze medalist at 2005 World Championships.

He began his coaching career at Sky View High School in Smithfield, Utah, where he led the school to an 87-8 record.

Williams, a native of San Diego, California, graduated from University High School in 1979 where he was a California State Champion. From there, he moved on to Utah State University in Logan, Utah, where he was an All-American wrestler and a three-time NCAA qualifier for the Aggies. Williams graduated from Utah State in 1985 with a degree in Marketing Education. He and his wife Kristin have two children, Alexis and Taylor.
