UTAH VALLEY HOSTS WAC TEXAS SCHOOLS UTRGV, STEPHEN F. AUSTIN

Utah Valley continues Western Athletic Conference play this week at Clyde Field where the Wolverines will host UTRGV on Thursday and Stephen F. Austin on Saturday. Thursday's match against UTRGV will kick off at 7:30 p.m., while Saturday's game against SFA will begin at 6 p.m.

The Wolverines head into this week's matches after dropping a 3-0 decision to Seattle U on the road last week. Despite outshooting the Redhawks 14-9 on the night, Utah Valley couldn't find the back of the net in the setback.

Utah Valley has scored 26 goals this season with Webber leading the team with six goals. Heather Stainbrook and Carter have each scored five goals, while Nicole Ray and Sydney Bushman each have three. Lee and Isabella Steward have to goals apiece. Webber and Lee front the team in assists with five each. Stainbrook and Carter each have four assists. Webber leads the team in points with 17, followed by Stainbrook and Carter with 14 apiece. Webber also fronts the team in shots (53) and shots on goal (28). The Utah Valley defense has three shutouts this season with Idalia Serrano in goal for two of them. Leah Wolf and Serrano also have a combined shutout. Serrano leads UVU with 29 saves with nearly 900 minutes played.

ABOUT UTRGV

UTRGV enters this week with a 2-8-3 overall record and a 0-3-3 record in WAC play. The team's last three matches, all at home, have resulted in draws. Last week, the Vaqueros played Grand Canyon to a 0-0 tie before playing California Baptist to a 1-1 draw. UTRGV still seeks its first WAC win of the season. Amy Hislop and Ana Recarte-Pacheco lead the team with three goals apiece. Three other Vaqueros have one goal this season. Hislop and Recarte-Pacheco also front the team in points with seven each. Hislop leads the team with 22 shots, including a team-best eight on frame. Emma Lööv leads the team in goal with 36 saves and a 1.59 goals against average. She has registered two shutouts.

SERIES HISTORY VS. UTRGV

Utah Valley and UTRGV will meet on the pitch for the 10th time on Thursday night. Utah Valley holds an all-time 8-1-0 record against the Vaqueros, including a perfect 3-0-0 record at home. UVU has won three straight. The two teams last met on March 6, 2021 in Edinburg, Texas with the Wolverines taking a 3-1 win. UVU's lone setback to the Vaqueros was a 3-1 loss in Texas on Sept. 30, 2018.

ABOUT STEPHEN F. AUSTIN

Stephen F. Austin enters the week with a 4-8-1 overall record. The team holds a 3-3-0 mark in WAC play. The Ladyjacks travel to play Seattle U on Thursday night before traveling to play Utah Valley on Saturday night. The team split a pair of home matches last week, defeating California Baptist, 2-1, before falling 1-0 to Grand Canyon. Jayme Bailey leads the team with three goals this season, followed by Reaganne Crane and Lily Hargrove with two apiece. Five other players have one goal. Crane leads the team with three assists. Lydia Sattler leads the team in the box with 60 saves and a 2.10 goal against average. She also has one shutout.

SERIES HISTORY VS. SFA

Utah Valley and Stephen F. Austin will meet on the pitch for just the second time on Saturday night. Utah Valley holds an all-time 1-0-0 advantage with the first meeting coming last season with the Wolverines taking a 1-0 win in Abilene, Texas in the semifinals of the WAC Tournament.

UTAH VALLEY RANKS NO. 8 IN LATEST UNITED SOCCER COACHES PACIFIC REGION TOP-10 POLL

Utah Valley is ranked No. 8 in the latest United Soccer Coaches Pacific Region Top-10 Poll released on Monday. The Wolverines have spent seven straight weeks in the poll.

After debuting at No. 10 in the week one poll, Utah Valley has since moved up four spots to No. 6 in the latest poll. The Wolverines are the only WAC team and the only non-Pac-12 team in the poll. The Pacific region consists of teams from the Mountain West Conference, Pac-12, and WAC.

CLYDE FIELD MAGIC

Utah Valley holds an impressive 95-41-14 (.680) all time record at Clyde Field. The team has lost just nine matches over the past five seasons on the home pitch. UVU went 8-1-1 in 2021, 4-1-2 in 2020, 8-1-1 in 2019, 3-4-1 at home in 2018, 5-1-0 in 2017, 5-2-1 during the 2016 season and were unbeaten at home during the 2015 season with a 9-0-1 mark. UVU ranked 10th in the nation in attendance in 2021 as the Wolverines drew an impressive 14,828 fans during the season, an average of 1,483 per game. UVU is 3-1-1 at Clyde Field this season. UVU has lost just two games at Clyde Field over the past two seasons.

FAITH WEBBER NAMED WAC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK FOR OCT. 4

Utah Valley sophomore forward Faith Webber has been named the TicketSmarter Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Women's Soccer Offensive Player of the Week for the week ending on Monday, Oct. 3.

Webber scored three second-half goals, including the game winner to help Utah Valley erase a 3-0 second half deficit to come back and defeat California Baptist, 4-3. Webber became just the seventh player in UVU history to record a hat trick. It marked the first hat trick for UVU since the 2018 season.

The Grand Blanc, Michigan native also scored the equalizer after Utah Valley fell behind 1-0 at Grand Canyon to help the Wolverines come back and defeat the 'Lopes 2-1 on the road.

On the week, Webber had four goals, eight points, 14 shots, 11 shots on goal, and one game winner as UVU went a perfect 2-0 in WAC play last week.



UTAH VALLEY UPSETS NO. 13 BYU IN PROVO

Four different Wolverines found the back of the net to lead Utah Valley to a come-from-behind 4-2 road win at No. 13 BYU on Saturday night in a UCCU Crosstown Clash game at South Field in Provo.

The win over the 13th-ranked Cougars is the highest nationally

ranked opponent that UVU has ever beaten, surpassing its win in 2021 over No. 25 Memphis in the NCAA Tournament. The win is also its first win over BYU in program history. The Wolverines did tie No. 23 UCF 0-0 earlier this season at Clyde Field.

"I couldn't be prouder of the effort the team put in," said Utah Valley head coach Chris Lemay. "I thought they executed the game plan well. I thought we took our chances. Obviously, we were up against a very good side in BYU. We knew that it would take everything that we had. We showed up and we gave it everything for a full 90 minutes. The result was fair and well earned."

Utah Valley improves to 4-1-2 overall with the win while BYU falls to 3-2-2 on the season.

BYU struck first in the fifth minute after Brecken Mazingo kicked a left-footed shot into the upper 90 to give the Cougars an early 1-0 lead.

Utah Valley's Hannah Lee scored the equalizer in the 12th minute after a free ball was rebounded by Jenna Shepherd. Shepherd one-touched the rebound to Lee who fired it off the far post and into the back of the net from about 20 yards out to tie the game 1-1.

Carter took the ball on the right side of the box and moved it to Lee who imme-

diately passed it to the top of the box to Stainbrook. Stainbrook then fired a shot with her left foot past the BYU keeper on the left side and into the net to give the Wolverines a 2-1 lead.

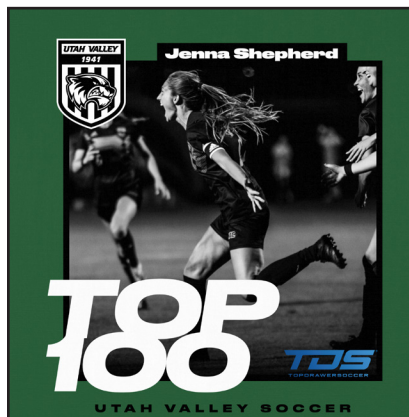
With just seven seconds to go in the half, Kathryn Wynn sent a corner kick into the box where Sydney Bushman headed it off the post. Isabella Stewart then cleaned it up by heading it across the line to give the Wolverines a 3-2 lead at the half.

Julianna Carter dribbled down the right side of the field and then split a pair of BYU defenders just inside the box and then fired a shot past the BYU keeper and into the back of the net to extend UVU's lead to a 4-2 advantage.

Utah Valley outshot BYU on goal 7-5. The Cougars just edged UVU in total shots 17-15. BYU had four corner kicks to UVU's three. Lee led UVU with five shots, including two on frame. Stainbrook had three shots, while Faith Webber had two.

HOME UNBEATEN STREAK ENDS AT 11 GAMES

No. 18 Alabama snapped Utah Valley's home unbeaten streak on Sept. 6 with a 4-1 win over the Wolverines. With the loss, the streak ends at 11 games. Prior to the loss to Alabama, UVU's last loss at Clyde Field was on Aug. 28, 2021 in a 4-2 loss to No. 25 USC. The Wolverines are 3-0-1 at home this season.



UVU'S SHEPHERD NAMED TO TOPDRAWERSOCCER.COM'S TOP-100 WATCH LIST

Utah Valley junior defender Jenna Shepherd has been named to TopDrawerSoccer.com's Division I Preseason Top-100 watch list, highlighting the top women's soccer players in the nation. Shepherd was listed at No. 58 on TopDrawerSoccer.com top-100 watch list. She was the only player from the WAC named to the list.

UVU PICKED SECOND IN PRESEASON WAC COACHES' POLL, SHEPHERD NAMED PRESEASON

WAC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Utah Valley was selected to finish second in the 2022 Western Athletic Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll. Junior Jenna Shepherd



was named the WAC Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, while being joined by Sydney Bushman, Julianna Carter, and Heather Stainbrook on the Preseason All-WAC Team.

Utah Valley has won WAC Tournament championships and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in three out of the last seven seasons (2015, 2017, 2020) and has made an appearance in the WAC Tournament championship match in six of those seven seasons (2021, 2020, 2019, 2017, 2016, 2015).

Utah Valley returns 13 players, including eight starters that went 13-7-2 last season and finished second in WAC play with a 6-2-2 mark.

The Wolverines received four of the 12 first place votes and 110 points to earn the second spot in the 12-team poll. Grand Canyon received eight first place votes and 117 points for the top spot. Stephen F. Austin is ranked third (90), followed by California Baptist in fourth (84), New Mexico State fifth (74), and Seattle U sixth (72). Abilene Christian was selected seventh (62), Utah Tech was eighth (46), and Sam Houston ninth (42). UTRGV was picked 10th (39), followed by Southern Utah in 11th (25), and Tarleton 12th (21).

ABOUT UVU'S ATHLETICS NCAA HISTORY

Until 2003, Utah Valley University competed as a NJCAA athletic program. The 2003-04 season was the school's first competing at an NCAA Division I level. In the summer of 2009, UVU's provisional status was lifted and the program became a full member of NCAA Division I on July 8, 2009. Until then, UVU teams and individuals were not eligible to compete in NCAA championship events. The Wolverines spent six seasons as an independent before the Great West Conference became an all-sports league in 2008 and began its first full season in 2009. UVU also became a university in 2008, changing its name from Utah Valley State College (UVSC) to Utah Valley University (UVU). Utah Valley is the first and last school ever to jump from the junior college ranks to NCAA Division I status.

- Has had four players earn All-Region honors (Breanna DeWaal, 2017), (Amber Tripp, 2019, 2021), Jenna Shepherd (2020, 2021) Isabel Jones-Dawe, 2020), Sadie Brockbank (2021), and Heather Stainbrook (2021).
- Led his team to the WAC Tournament championship match in four of his five seasons with the team (2017, 2019, 2020, 2021).
- Led Utah Valley to a WAC Tournament championship in his first season at UVU in 2017, earning the WAC's auto bid to the NCAA Tournament.
- Breanna DeWaal also earned WAC Tournament MVP honors and was named to the United Soccer Coaches All-District team.
- His team registered a goal at Stanford, becoming the only team during the 2017 season to score a goal on Stanford's home pitch.
- Associate Head Coach at Cal (2013-16)
- Helped Cal to back-to-back 13-win seasons.
- Four NCAA Tournament appearances
- Led Cal recruiting to the third-ranked recruiting class in the nation in 2016
- Helped Cal to 51-22-11 record in four seasons with 14 players earning all-Pac 12 honors.
- Assistant coach at San Diego State where he helped team to a Mountain West regular season title and tournament championship.
- Helped SDSU to the NCAA Sweet 16 and a No. 4 national ranking.

#18 ALABAMA RECAP

OREM—No. 18 Alabama scored three first-half goals and despite a strong second half for Utah Valley, the Wolverines could not recover in a 4-1 loss to the Crimson Tide on Tuesday at Clyde Field.

The setback snaps UVU's 11-match unbeaten streak. It marks the first loss at home for the Wolverines since dropped a 4-2 decision to No. 25 USC on Aug. 28, 2021. The game marks UVU's first loss of the season as the Wolverines fall to 3-1-2. Alabama improves to 5-1-1 on the season. Alabama is the second nationally ranked team that Utah Valley has played this season. UVU tied No. 23 UCF on Aug. 25.

"Alabama is a really good team and against any good team you can't afford to play one half of soccer," said Utah Valley head coach Chris Lemay. "I was really proud of the way we played in the second half but to give them a three goal lead and then try to figure out playing at our ability is never going to work at this level. I'm happy with the second half but didn't come out of the gates playing at the speed this game requires."

Alabama got on the scoreboard early after Ashlynn Serepca got the ball across the line to put the Crimson Tide up 1-0 in the seventh minute. Alabama's Reyna Reyes then scored just three minutes later in the 10th minute to put the Tide up 2-0.

Serepca sent ball down the middle of the box to Riley Parker Mattingly who then punched it into the back of the net to give Alabama a 3-0 advantage in the 23rd minute.

Utah Valley's Megan Sullivan sent a long ball from 45 yards out into the box where it deflected off the outstretched hand of the Alabama keeper. Sydney Bushman then kicked it into the back of the net in the 47th minute to cut into the Alabama lead 3-1.

Alabama's Sydney Vincens picked up a UVU miss hit inside the box and one-touched it to Kate Henderson who then ball into an empty net to help Alabama extend its lead to a 4-1 advantage in the 72nd minute.

Alabama outshot Utah Valley 20-14, including a 15-6 advantage on frame. UVU did outshoot Alabama 10-8 in the second half as the Wolverines had numerous opportunities that came up just short.

Heather Stainbrook led the Wolverines with four shots, including one on goal. Bushman and Faith Webber each had three shots with two on goal. Alabama recorded five corner kicks to UVU's three.

#13 BYU RECAP

PROVO—Four different Wolverines found the back of the net to lead Utah Valley to a come-from-behind 4-2 road win at No. 13 BYU on Saturday night in a UCCU Crosstown Clash game at South Field in Provo.

The win over the 13th-ranked Cougars is the highest nationally ranked opponent that UVU has ever beaten, surpassing its win in 2021 over No. 25 Memphis in the NCAA Tournament. The win is also its first win over BYU in program history. The Wolverines did tie No. 23 UCF 0-0 earlier this season at Clyde Field.

"I couldn't be prouder of the effort the team put in," said Utah Valley head coach Chris Lemay. "I thought they executed the game plan well. I thought we took our chances. Obviously, we were up against a very good side in BYU. We knew that it would take everything that we had. We showed up and we gave it everything for a full 90 minutes. The result was fair and well earned."

Utah Valley improves to 4-1-2 overall with the win while BYU falls to 3-2-2 on the season.

BYU struck first in the fifth minute after Brecken Mazingo kicked a left-footed shot into the upper 90 to give the Cougars an early 1-0 lead.

Utah Valley's Hannah Lee scored the equalizer in the 12th minute after a free ball was rebounded by Jenna Shepherd. Shepherd one-touched the rebound to Lee who fired it off the far post and into the back of the net from about 20 yards out to tie the game 1-1.

Carter took the ball on the right side of the box and moved it to Lee who immediately passed it to the top of the box to Stainbrook. Stainbrook then fired a shot with her left foot past the BYU keeper on the left side and into the net to give the Wolverines a 2-1 lead.

With just seven seconds to go in the half, Kathryn Wynn sent a corner kick into the box where Sydney Bushman headed it off the post. Isabella Stewart then cleaned it up by heading it across the line to give the Wolverines a 3-2 lead at the half.

Julianna Carter dribbled down the right side of the field and then split a pair of BYU defenders just inside the box and then fired a shot past the BYU keeper and into the back of the net to extend UVU's lead to a 4-2 advantage.

Utah Valley outshot BYU on goal 7-5. The Cougars just edged UVU in total shots 17-15. BYU had four corner kicks to UVU's three. Lee led UVU with five shots, including two on frame. Stainbrook had three shots, while Faith Webber had two.

The Lancers scored again in the 25th minute after Makayla Soll headed a pass forward to Kaylee Hauck who then lofted a shot into the goal from long range to give CBU a 2-0 advantage. CBU's Hauck scored again with her left foot from 20 yards out to give the Lancers a 3-0 lead in the 53rd minute.

UVU then got things going in the 59th minute as Isabella Stewart sent a ball to the top of the box to Heather Stainbrook. Stainbrook then sent it over to Webber on the right side of the box where she fired a shot towards the far post and into the back of the net to cut the CBU lead to a 3-1 advantage.

In the 69th minute, Hannah Lee dribbled down the right side of the field and sent a ball to Julianna Carter on the right side. Carter then poked it towards the top of box where Webber fired a shot that made it past the CBU keeper on the left side to make the score 3-2.

Stainbrook then made a move around a CBU defender and sent the ball into the middle of the box where Webber shot it into the goal to give the Wolverines their first lead of the game, 4-3. The goal gave Webber a hat trick—the first hat trick since Sadie Brockbank scored four goals in 2018.

"We never stopped believing in us," said Webber. "Playing in front of the home crowd after playing such a long stretch of road games and having such a large home crowd and playing front of our fans was amazing."

Utah Valley outshot California Baptist 28-8, including a 19-4 edge in shots on frame. The Wolverines forced CBU keeper Noa Schumacher into 15 saves, which are the most saves ever recorded in a single game in CBU history. Webber led UVU with a match-high 11 shots, including nine on frame. Stainbrook and Lee each had five shots. UVU had eight corner kicks while holding the Lancers without a corner kick.

Idalia Serrano played the first half in goal for UVU, while Hailey Hillock played the second half in the box with one save. The UVU defense helped the Wolverines maintain possession for nearly 60 percent of the match.

The win marks the second straight comeback win for UVU, which also came back from a 0-3 second half deficit against California Baptist to beat the Lancers 4-3 on Friday night in Orem.

"I'm very proud of our team and I love the grit and effort they put in tonight to pick up the win," said Utah Valley head coach Chris Lemay. Grand Canyon took a 1-0 lead in the 18th minute as Brenna Alderson sent a ball up the right side from beyond midfield to Bekah Valdez. Valdez then made a move to free up a cross inside the box and Gianna Gourley then found the back of the net to give the Lopes a 1-0 advantage.

Utah Valley scored the equalizer in the 54th minute as Hannah Lee kicked it forward from midfield to Julianna Carter who then flicked it forward to a sprinting Webber. Webber then fired a shot from the top of the box into the back of the net to tie the game, 1-1.

With just over two minutes to play in the match, Lee dribbled towards the box on the left side and fired a shot at the top of the box. GCU's keeper then pushed the shot out, but Carter beat her defender to the ball and put it across the line for what would prove to be the game winner in the 88th minute.

Utah Valley outshot Grand Canyon 15-9 on the night and had an 8-2 advantage on frame. UVU had three corner kicks to GCU's two. Webber, Stainbrook, and Carter led the Wolverines with three goals each. Carter had a match-high three shots on frame. Leah Wolf played all 90 minutes in the box, collecting one save.

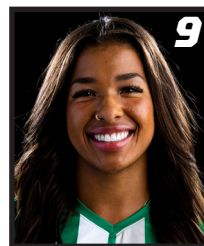

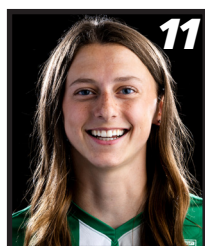
