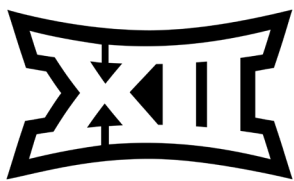

BARRACLOUGH EARNS FIRST BIG 12 WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

"I'm happy Terrell was nominated by other coaches in the league to be the first Big 12 Wrestler of the Week for this season. Terrell has been locked in and awaiting his moment to shine. He is dedicated to his craft of becoming the best wrestler he can be and I'm glad that it was displayed in a top three national win last week," said UVU head coach Adam Hall.

Barracough opened his 2024-2025 campaign with a major decision over Guillermo Escobedo before earning a victory over No. 3 Hunter Garvin of Stanford in a battle in which he was up 7-1 after two periods before holding on for the victory.

At the Menlo Invite this weekend, he won the 165-weight class with two victories by fall, first over Bradyn Rawlings (Fontbonne University) and then in the first-place match against Evan Manzo of CSU Bakersfield. He won in the semifinals over Stanford's Zach Hansen with a major decision.

HALL ADDS UTAH NATIVE TERRELL BARRACLOUGH

Adam Hall brought in Utah native Terrell Barracough to join the Wolverines for the 2024 season. He is a transfer from Penn State where he spent four years in State College. The



165-pounder opens the season high as No. 7 in the FloWrestling poll. Finished his Penn State career going 42-18 while competing in three different weight classes. He finished last season going 12-2 for the Nitany Lions.

A native of Kaysville, Utah he wrestled at Utah power Layton High School where he was a team captain for two seasons and helped the Lancers win fourth UHSAA State Titles.

DRURY FINISHES 4TH AT FREESTYLE NATIONALS

Haiden Drury finished fourth this summer at the U23 Freestyle Nationals in Geneva, Ohio. He finished the weekend going 5-2 in the tournament as the No. 8 seed. His impressive showing including a quarterfinal victory over Kollin Rath (Stellar Trained). He took his first loss of the tournament in the semifinals to No. 4 Joshua Sanders (Spartan Combat RTC). He defeated NC State's All-American Ryan Jack in the consolation semifinals before falling to Northern Iowa's Cael Happel in the third-place match.

He was joined in the Freestyle field by 133-pounder Kase Mauger and Caleb Uhlenhopp who did not place in the tournament.

MCCLURE RUNNER-UP IN FARGO

UVU Freshman Smokey McClure finished the 2024 U.S. Marine Corps Freestyle Junior Nationals as the runner up in the 144-pound weight class. He defeated some of the top seeds in the tournament as the No. 11 seed picking up wins over the No. 3 seeded Kyrel Leavell (Indiana), Oklahoma's No. 2 seed Jace Roller, but fell in the finals to California's Daniel Zepeda.



Follow incoming freshman Hudson Rogers finished with a 4-2 record at 175 pounds with Jake Castagneto going 3-2. They both failed to place in the prestigious tournament.

HALL SIGNS FOUR ON NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

Utah Valley wrestling signed four new student-athletes to join the Wolverines for the 2025-2026 season. Three hail from the Beehive state led by FloWrestling Big Board No. 51 Layne Kleimann. They also added Jason Worthley (Westfield High School in Taylor, Utah), Geronimo Rivera Jr. (Layton High School) and Ian Fritz (Topsail High School in Hampstead, North Carolina).

RUSHTON NAMED NWCA SCHOLAR ALL-AMERICAN

The National Wrestling Coaches Association named Mahonri Rushton an NCAA Division I Men's Scholar All-American. It marks the second time that Rushton has earned the honor. The McCall, Idaho native is studying biology at Utah Valley. He finished last season 8-9 overall and placed fifth at the Reno Tournament of Champions at 184 with a 5-1 record. He moved down a weight class to 174 and represented Utah Valley at the 2024 Big 12 Championships. A total of 338 student-athletes earned the honor from 78 different institutions.

11 EARN SPOTS ON THE ACADEMIC ALL-BIG 12

The Wolverines had 11 named to the Winter Academic All-Big 12 team. Jack Forbes and Mahonri Rushton earned their second consecutive perfect GPA. Haiden Drury, Tanner Lofthouse earned first-team honors for the first time. Jaxon Garoutte and Kase Mauger earned their second nominations. UVU Alums, Jacob Armstrong and James Emmer finished their careers with their fourth selections.

UTAH WRESTLING HALL OF FAME ANNOUNCEMENT

Former UVU head coach Greg Williams was inducted into the Utah Wrestling Hall of Fame in October. During his 18-year career leading the Wolverines, Williams coached the first five All-Americans in program history, including all-time wins leader Ben Kjar, who became the first to achieve the feat when he reached the semifinals and placed fourth at the NCAA Championships in 2011. Jade Rauser (2016), Tate Orndorff (2020), Taylor LaMont (2021), and Demetrius Romero (2021) also earned All-America status under Williams' tutelage. In 2021, LaMont and Romero became the first multiple semifinalists and All-Americans in the same season in program history.

UVU WINS EIGHT WEIGHT CLASSES AT MENLO OPEN

Utah Valley wrestling had 22 compete on Saturday at the Menlo Invite hosted by Menlo College. The Wolverines came away with eight titles in the ten weight classes and had both finalists at 125, 133, 141, and 157 classes with rematches from UVU wrestle-offs. 17 of 22 in the tournament placed in the first tournament of the season.

FORBES UPSETS #23 HARLEY ANDREWS IN LINCOLN

Jack Forbes pulled off the night's upset with a 5-4 decision over No. 23 Harley Andrews. Forbes came out after the ten-minute break and went up 3-1 when he scored on a takedown over No. 23 Harley Andrews. They each scored reversals in the second, but the UVU heavyweight held a 5-3 edge. He would hold on for the upset victory 5-4 despite being warned for stalling and Andrews narrowing it to a one-point bout.

BROTHERS

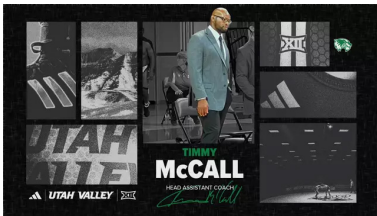
Utah Valley has another set of brothers of the 2024-2025 roster with Kaden and Kael Bennie on this year's team. Kaden a freshman on this year's squad helped lead Layton High School to a pair of state championships and earned All-American honors. He wrestled club for Sanderson Wrestling Academy.

Kael a redshirt freshman finished last season 13-4 in his redshirt season at Utah Valley. He competed in at the Mines Rookie Opn where finishd fifth, and went 5-0 at the Spokane Open. Bennie helped lead Layton to thee 2023 State championship by winning th 6A crown he was a four-time All-American in High School.

This is at least the fifth set of brothers to share the roster at the same time. The 2020-2021 Wolverines feeatured three sets of brothers with Sam and Will Edelblute being joined by Spencer and Sammy Heywood, and Grant and Taylor LaMont.

WOLVERINES WELCOME TIMMY MCCALL

"I am so excited to add Timmy, Beth, and Tanner to the Wolverine family! Timmy brings a wealth of knowledge to Utah Valley from his extensive coaching experience at NC State. His passion and care for his athletes are hard to match. He truly loves the guys he works with, which shows through his dedication to them. I look forward to watching him grow as a coach in this new role!" said UVU head coach Adam Hall.



His time at NC State started in 2015 when he was a training athlete with the Wolfpack RTC and competed internationally. He saw great success there, including winning the 2017 Henri Deglane Challenge and finishing as the runner-up at the 2016 Bill Farrell and the 2018 Dave Schulz tournaments. In 2018, he took home third at

the 2018 World Team Trials while adding a second-place finish at the 2019 Grand Prix of France / Henri Deglane Challenge.

McCall moved into an assistant role with the Wolfpack in 2019 and helped them win four consecutive ACC Championships and aided in the development of 17 ACC Champions, including 2020 ACC Wrestler of the Year Hayden Hidlay and five-time All-American Trent Hidlay.

At the NCAA level, he worked with 15 All-Americans during his four years in Raleigh, and NC State had three top-10 team finishes at the NCAA Championships during that span.

McCall competed collegiately at the University of Wisconsin and was a two-year starter in Madison. He placed seventh at the Big Ten Championships in 2014 with a 3-2 record and finished with a 17-16 overall record while qualifying for his first NCAA Championship, where he finished with a 1-2 record.

In the 2014-2015 season, they set a career-high with 23 overall wins and finished fourth at the Big Ten Championships. He was ranked No. 13 to start the year at 197 and reached as high as No. 9. He finished 3-2 at the 2015 NCAA Championships.

McCall is married to his wife, Beth, and they have a son, Tanner.

HOCHSTRASSER ADDED TO UVU STAFF

He joins the UVU staff after a successful run with the Sons of Atlas Wrestling Club.

"I am proud to announce Andrew as an assistant coach at UVU! I've known Andrew since we were teammates at Boise State, and we competed together post-college. He is respected in the wrestling community, especially in his home state of Utah. I love his passion for impacting young people, and I look forward to watching him

develop as a college coach. I am also excited to welcome his wife, Teighlor, and their three kids, Finnley, Maylee, and Riggs, to our Wolverine Family!" said UVU head coach Adam Hall.

"I am extremely excited to join the Wolverine family. It is inspiring to coach with Adam Hall, Timmy McCall, and Joey Lavallee, who have the same love and enthusiasm for the sport that I do," Hochstrasser said. "I am thankful for this opportunity to help build Utah Valley University and its student-athletes."



Hochstrasser had a storied Utah High School wrestling career, during which he became one of 34 to win four state titles and tallied 170 career wins, which places him fifth in the UHSAA record books. 130 of his 170 victories came via a fall, placing him second all-time in Utah on this way to record 22, 18, 16, and 15 fall streaks.

After high school, he attended Boise State University, where he went 98-14 overall, won a pair of Pac-12 titles, and became a two-time All-American, finishing runner-up in 2011 and fourth in 2009.

The three-time NCAA qualifier continued his success on the United States and world stages. His wrestling career continued on the US and World stages, with two US Open runner-up finishes and two appearances on two World Cup teams. Hochstrasser finished fourth at the 2012 Olympic Team Trials and was a two-time Pan American Games champion.

Hochstrasser spent time at his alma mater on staff at Boise State while also training for international competitions in Boise.

JOEY LAVALLEE NAMED UVU ASSISTANT COACH

"I am so excited to welcome Joey and his wife, Ciena, to UVU Wrestling! Joey brings a wealth of knowledge of the sport and experience as an athlete at both the collegiate and senior levels," said UVU head coach Adam Hall. "I look forward to mentoring him in his journey as an emerging young coach and supporting him in his competitive career as an RTC athlete. Working closely with Athletes in Action, Joey will serve as a strong mentor for our guys. I know he is eager to get to work and will make an immediate impact."

Lavallee finished his collegiate career at Big 12 foe Missouri, where he finished 114-29 in five seasons. The Tigers competed in the Mid-Atlantic Conference (MAC), where he finished his last two seasons with an impressive 29-0 in duals and only fell twice in duals against MAC opponents in his career.

In his 2017 All-American season, he advanced to the NCAA Championship bout at 157 pounds, where he finished second before falling to the top-seeded Jason Nolf (Penn State) in the finals. Earlier in the season, he upset No. 5 Joe Smith (Oklahoma State) and No. 7 Colin Heffernan (Central Michigan).

He has gone on to train for national and international competitions and was a 2022 World Team Trials finalist. He has been involved with Athletes in Action and will continue to train at the Brunson Utah Valley Regional Training Center.

Adam Hall was named the third Head Coach of UVU's wrestling program on February 15, 2024. Hall spent the past eight seasons on staff at NC State including the last three years as the Associate Head Coach.

During his tenure with the Wolfpack in Raleigh, NC State has won six ACC Championships, including four regular season titles. Since his promotion to associate head coach, the Wolfpack have won five consecutive ACC Tournament Championships. North Carolina State has also finished in the top 10 in the NWCA Coaches' Poll for eight consecutive seasons.

Hall's recruiting prowess is evident in NC State's consistent top rankings nationally. Since 2016, the Wolfpack has had five top-5 classes and six straight top-20 classes.

Entering the 2023-24 season, North Carolina State has produced 25 All-Americans, 26 ACC Champions, and four top-10 team finishes at the NCAA Championships with Hall on staff. The Wolfpack have finished 10th at the NCAA Championships in each of the last two seasons.

Before joining NC State, Hall was on staff at Columbia University where he earned his Master of Science in sports management in 2015. He received his undergraduate degree at Boise State University in health science studies in 2011, graduating cum laude while also being named to the Dean's List three times. As a senior in 2010-11, Hall was named the Pac-10 Wrestling Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

On the mat, Hall was a two-time NCAA All-American and two-time Pac-10 Champion at 157 pounds for the Broncos. He won 122 matches during his career at BSU, which ranks second in Boise State wrestling history. Hall finished third at the NCAA Championships in 2010 and won a team-high 32 matches as a junior. He followed that up with a fifth-place finish as a senior in 2011. His post-collegiate career also includes a fifth-place finish at the 2012 U.S. Olympic Trials, and he was also a U.S. Open place-winner in 2013 and 2014.

Originally from Bonners Ferry, Idaho, Hall and his wife, Christine, were married in 2017 and are parents to two children, Theo and Charley.
