OPENING DRIVE

In the program's 83rd season of football, West Alabama snagged its 350th career victory in the Tigers' 10-7 result versus the Choctaws of Mississippi College on Sept. 23.

The defense has held opposing offenses to 30.2% on third downs this season. Last week against UWG, the Tigers limited the Wolves to 3-of-18.

WEST FLORIDA SERIES HISTORY

West Florida started football in 2016, and they have been a force from the start. In six seasons, the program has had one losing season and four seasons of nine wins or more and three with double-digit wins.

In the second year of the program (2017), UWF made it to the NCAA Division II National Championship game. After a 6-5 season in 2018, the Argos finished 13-2 in 2019 en route to the program's first national title in the fourth year of existence.

UWF and UWA will meet for the eighth time in the all-time series. The Argos hold the slight edge, 4-3. However, in Livingston, each team has won two games, including UWA's last win over UWF in 2018, 45-7.

GSC SUCCESS

West Florida currently enters as the best team in the GSC when it comes to wins with a 22-3 conference record since 2019, four games ahead of Valdosta State and five ahead of Delta State.

Overall, UWF is 39-7 overall during that stretch.

Meanwhile for UWA, the Tigers are 11-8 away from Tiger Stadium and are 22-19 overall in the last four seasons (excluding the 2020-21 shortened COVID year).

DEFENDING THE PASS

UWA's Uriah Ratliff, who had an interception against West Georgia, is third in the GSC with five pass breakups.

The Tigers also have Artavious Washington (3) and Devonte Harris (2) who are also in the top-25 in the GSC.

INTERCEPTION CITY

So far in six games, UWA has had an interception in each game this season, picked off the opposing quarterback nine times, including three in its win at Limestone in Week 2.

The Tigers are 21st in Division II in team interceptions with nine, trailing the national leaders in Harding, New Haven and Central Missouri.

Leading the charge is Artavious Washington, who has three of the team's nine interceptions. The senior won the GSC Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 5 after his two INTs versus Angelo State. He is 23rd in the nation in interceptions per game.

On the other end of the ball, UWF is also tied for 21st in the country with nine picks. The Argos' Ralph Ortiz leads the team with three INTs, followed by Quincy Milhomme's two.

NELSON: THE ALL-PURPOSE SPECIALIST

Dearrius Nelson has been one of UWA's top return men in 2023. Between his efforts on kickoff and punt returns, he has 274 yards between the two, second in the GSC and 47th in Division II.

Nelson is averaging 21.6 yards per kickoff return for 68th in the country, and on punt returns, he is averaging 5.8 yards per punt for 45th.

350...BAGGED

West Alabama's 350th win in program history came in dramatic fashion, as the Tigers dropped the Choctaws of Mississippi College on Sept. 23. UWA started football in 1938 and is 350-449-14 in 82-plus seasons of football.

UWA's first victory came in 1938, when the Tigers turned away the Gamecocks of Jacksonville State by a 7-0 decision.

The Tigers' 300th win came against Delta State at home in 2016 with a 54-42 score.

GILLILAND SECOND IN WINS AMONG GSC ACTIVE COACHES

The winningest coach in UWA football history, Brett Gilliland is second among the active Gulf South Conference coaches in total wins at their current school, trailing Todd Cooley of Delta State. Below is the list:

STOPPING THE RUNNING GAME

Despite allowing 164 rushing yards against the Statesmen in Week 6, the Tigers are still in the top-50 nationally in rushing yards on defense with a 109.5 average. UWA is ranked 42nd in the category.

In Week 4 against the "Run-and-Gun" Choctaws, who was in the top-10 nationally in rushing offense, the Tigers held them to 109 yards.

The only team better on rushing defense is West Florida, averaging 90.2 yards per game for 24th in Division II.

A BRICK WALL...WITH SOME PUNCH

UWA has 42 tackles for a loss, with 12 of those coming by sacking the quarterback. Averaging just under seven TFLs per game, the Tigers are 41st in the country in the category and are third the GSC.

Jamarcus Smith had a memorable day for the defense at Limestone on Sept. 9, totaling nine tackles with 1.5 for a loss, including a nine-yard sack. To add the cherry on top, he also had an interception.

Davonta Jackson (6.0) and Jamal Ellis (5.0) lead the Tiger defense in the category. The duo are third and sixth, respectively, in the GSC.

THREAT ON THIRD DOWNS

UWA leads the Gulf South Conference when it comes to third down efficiency on the defensive side of the ball with a 30.2 percentage. The mark is 23rd nationally in Division II.

In Week 1 versus Angelo State, West Alabama had a 3-of-16 mark for a team that had the ball for nearly 29 minutes.

Last week against West Georgia, UWA held the Wolves to 3-of-14 on third down.

10 YEARS FOR GILLILAND

The 2023 season for Gilliland will be his 10th at the helm of West Alabama football, and the head coach has 58 career wins, the most for a football coach in UWA history.

Winning the GSC in 2017, Gilliland has coached two teams to NCAA Tournament appearances, including knocking off Delta State in the opening round at home at the 2017 NCAA Division II Championship.

His 50th win as a head coach came against Shorter during the 2021 season on Oct. 9 from Rome, Georgia. The Tigers clipped the Hawks, 44-7 from Barron Stadium.

INSTANT REPLAY COMES TO THE GSC

There will be a new addition of technology for all Gulf South Conference games in 2023, and that is the installation of instant replay.

The GSC's implementation of sideline video review for officials follows a new policy adopted by the NCAA Football Rules Committee after a successful pilot program from the MIAA in 2022. Unlike the replay policy seen at the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) level, the Gulf South program will utilize coach's challenge to trigger a review.

All targeting plays, however, will be reviewed immediately. In previous seasons, the GSC has reviewed targeting calls at halftime and at the conclusion of contests, resulting in lost game time for student-athletes who had calls later overturned.

The sideline video review system will be a three-camera operation and will be used at each of the nine GSC football stadiums in 2023. The system will provide one sideline and two end zone views of each play. Reviews will take place in a designated review area using wireless technology and a tablet. The GSC referee will be the sole decision maker on any review and will include one additional crew member to consult with during the review process.

Per the current NCAA rule, each team will have one challenge during the game and must have a timeout to initiate a review of a call or play. If a challenge is successful, the team retains the challenge, which may be used only one more time during the game. If the challenge is unsuccessful, the team is charged a timeout and is out of replay challenges for the rest of the game. A team timeout will not be charged if the challenge is successful and the ruling on the field is overturned. Teams will not receive new or additional challenges for overtime period.

SAULSBERRY TO BE RECOGNIZED ON UWA HELMETS IN 2023

During the annual Red-White Spring Football game in March of 2023, the UWA football program unveiled a "CS" emblem on their helmets that will be worn throughout the 2023 season.

"Christian Saulsberry's time on earth being cut short is still heartbreaking to all of us," UWA head coach Brett Gilliland said. "Christian was a great Tiger whose smile and determination will be forever remembered."

"His relentless work in the face of adversity was special and to be admired," Gilliland said. "He and his mother worked so hard to be able to have him live his dream of playing pro ball. I am so thankful that he was able to live that dream with the Edmonton Elks. Please join us in continuing to pray for his mama Melissa Saulsberry-Smith and all of his family."

The former UWA athlete and former member of the Edmonton Elks of the Canadian Football League (CFL), passed away in December 2022 as the result of a shooting in Memphis, Tennessee.

After transferring from Itawamba Community College (Miss.), Saulsberry played two seasons with UWA. He was a two-time All-GSC standout in his career, finishing with 1,224 receiving yards and seven touchdowns in 23 games.

After signing a contact with the Elks, he appeared in eight games during the 2022 season. He was primarily a return man on special teams.

He had 635 yards on kickoff returns and 235 punt return yards. He was ranked ninth in punt return average (12.4) within all of the NFL and CFL.

His mother, Melissa Saulsberry-Smith, served as his "momager." She managed and advocated for him to professional teams.

Leading to his signing with Edmonton, Saulsberry had such pride and excitement about his mom securing his contract with the Elks.

UWA PICKED FOURTH IN GSC PRESEASON POLL

The Gulf South Conference (GSC) football head coaches chose West Alabama to finish fourth in the preseason GSC poll.

UWA concluded the 2022 season with a 5-6 record overall and 3-4 in GSC play, picking up wins over Shorter, Valdosta State and Mississippi College.

The Tigers totaled 44 points in the preseason poll, finishing ahead of West Georgia (52) and last season's co-champions West Florida (56) and Delta State (61). The Statesmen were picked as the preseason favorites thanks to six of the nine first-place votes.

West Alabama will see a new GSC opponent in Chowan (N.C.) for the 2023 season. The Hawks were members of the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) for the last 14 seasons. The Tigers will visit Murfreesboro, N.C. for the matchup on Oct. 28.
