2015-16 Team Notes:

- ▶ Wisconsin opened the season at the Cougar Classic, which was held at Yeamans Hall Club in Charleston, S.C. The Badgers shot a 63-over 303-315-309=927 and placed 17th after finishing Day 1 and Day 2 in 15th and 18th, respectively.
- ▶ In its second tournament of the year, UW hosted the East-West Match Play Challenge at University Ridge. The Badgers participated in the consolation match play tournament after finishing the 36-hole stroke play rounds in tie for fifth with UC Davis at 19-over 296-299=595. The Aggies won the tiebreaker, granting UW the sixth seed. Wisconsin fell to seventh-seeded SMU, 2 and 3, in the first round before losing to UC Davis, 5 and 0, in the final round. Jessica Reinecke lost, 4 and 3, in the individual championship, while Ali Nageotte took seventh by winning, 1-up.
- ▶ At the Windy City Collegiate Championship, the Badgers placed 14th. The team entered the final round in 15th but jumped Virginia Tech by shooting a 7-over 295.

2015-16 Individual Notes:

- ▶ Gabby Curtis was the Badgers' top finisher through the first two tournaments. At the Cougar Classic, she tied for 35th with an 8-over 70-80-74=224. Curtis improved her placing at the East-West Match Play Challenge, as the sophomore (+1, 73-72=145) finished in a tie for ninth after two rounds of stroke play. She owns Wisconsin's best average at 74.38 strokes per round.
- ▶ Becky Klongland showed the most improvement from the Cougar Classic (+18, 82-80-84=246) to the East-West Challenge (+4, 75-73=148), as she jumped from 104th at the first tournament to tied for 16th at the stroke play competition.
- ► Tess Hackworthy and Jessica Reinecke got their first taste of collegiate golf at the East-West Challenge. Hackworthy (81-79=160) competed in the team competition, finishing the stroke play rounds in 50th at 16-over. Participating as an individual, Reinecke (75-76=151) went 7-over during stroke play before making it to the championship as the four seed in the individual match play tournament. She took second after dropping the final, 4 and 3, to Michigan's Kathy Lim.
- ▶ Michelle Cheung led the Badgers at the Windy City Collegiate Championship, as the junior picked up the best 54-hole score of her career at an even 216.
- ▶ Brooke Ferrell earned her best performance of the year at the Windy City Collegiate. The Edgerton, Wisconsin, native went for a 1-over 73-71-73=217 to place 28th. Ferrell's 54-hole score was a season-low and her 28th-place finish was a season-best.
