The Marquette University men's basketball team (7-2, 0-0 BIG EAST) heads to rival Wisconsin (6-4, 0-0 Big Ten) Saturday afternoon at 12:30 p.m. CT for its annual matchup with the Badgers. ESPN2 will feature MU's eighth national television broadcast of the campaign, with Bob Wischusen (play-by-play) and Dan Dakich (analyst) calling the action. Following Saturday's matchup, MU will take a break in their schedule to focus on finals and won't return to action until hosting Chicago State on Dec. 21.

MU-UW Rivalry Reaches 122nd All-Time Meeting

Marquette's all-time series with Wisconsin dates back to 1917, with the first meeting coming in just MU's second season of competition.

Wisconsin owns a 66-55 edge in the previous matchups, with each squad enjoying an extended run of success at various points in the series. Marquette's best streak came between 1969 and 1984 when the team claimed 15-straight wins and 19-of-21 overall.

MU has met Wisconsin more times (121) than any other opponent in program history. Notre Dame and Marquette have met on 118 occasions dating back to 1920, the second-most matchups against any single opponent in the record book.

The Golden Eagles dropped a 49-38 decision to the No. 2 ranked Badgers at the BMO Harris Bradley Center on Dec. 6, 2014 in the most recent matchups. Guard Matt Carlino led the team with 18 points, but was the only player with more than six points for Marquette.

Marquette's last victory in the Kohl Center came on Dec. 11, 2011 when No. 16 Marquette held off No. 9 Wisconsin 61-54. Guard Darius Johnson-Odom led all scorers with 17 points and Vander Blue added nine points and eight boards.










Improved Shooting Touch Key During Win Streak

The Golden Eagles are in the midst of a six-game winning streak, thanks in large part to an improved shooting touch.

During the streak, Marquette is shooting 50.8 percent (186-of-366) from the floor and 50-of-121 (41.3 percent) from behind the 3-point line. Both of those numbers are well above the season averages of 48.0 and 34.0 percent, respectively. The team's defensive effort has been just as important, holding opposing squads to just 34.8 percent from the field and 65.3 points per game (down from season average of 70.6 ppg.).

Marquette hasn't won seven-consecutive games since the 2011-12 campaign when the team accomplished the feat on two occasions. MU opened the year 10-0 that year and later in the season rattled off seven-straight in BIG EAST play.

State's Recent Prep Standouts Well Represented On Rosters

Saturday's matchup between Marquette and Wisconsin will more than likely feature heavy contributions on both sides from some of state's top prep standouts in recent years.

A total of 15 players (8 - MU, 7 - UW) on the two rosters hail from the great state of Wisconsin, including the leading scorers for both teams in Marquette's Henry Ellenson (16.7 ppg.) and Wisconsin's Bronson Koenig (15.8 ppg.). Along with playing on an annual basis, the fact many of the student-athletes have competed against each other in high school and on the AAU circuit makes each roster very familiar with its respective opponent.

While half of Marquette's roster calls Wisconsin home, only three MU players have limited game experience in the actual series. Sophomores Duane Wilson (31) and Sandy Cohen III (10) have seen minutes in just one game and junior Jajuan Johnson has totaled just 20 minutes in a pair of appearances. Junior Luke Fischer didn't become eligible for Marquette until mid-December last year and missed the Badger game.

Freshman Class Making An Impact

Led by freshman of the year candidate Henry Ellenson, Marquette's nationally ranked recruiting class has been making a big impact early in 2015-16.

During the team's six-game winning streak, the starting lineup has featured a trio of newcomers (Ellenson, Haanif Cheatham and Traci Carter) and both Sacar Anim and Matt Heldt have seen minutes off the bench.

Through the team's first nine outings, the newcomers are accounting for at least 40 percent of the team's per game averages in points, rebounds, assists and steals.

Marquette's first complete recruiting class under head coach Steve Wojciechowski was a consensus top-10 group and was rated as high as fifth nationally by ESPN.com and FoxSports.com.

Cohen III Dials Long Distance In Win Over SJSU

Entering Tuesday night's game against San Jose State, sophomore forward Sandy Cohen's career high in scoring was 12 points against Providence on Jan. 3, 2015.

With 12:42 left in the first half against the Spartans, Cohen III had already surpassed that mark en route to a personal-best 24-point effort. The Seymour, Wisconsin native had never made more than four field goals in an entire game, but against SJSU he was 6-of-10 from behind the 3-point line 8-of-15 from the floor overall. He also found time to chip in five rebounds, three assists and a trio of steals in 32 minutes.

Cohen III has been doing more than scoring this season, however, and along with his 9.3 points per game is chipping in 4.1 rebounds and 3.3 assists per contest while shooting 42.1 percent from behind the 3-point line.

Henry Ellenson One Of Nation's Top Freshmen

Freshman forward Henry Ellenson was a consensus top-10 recruit as a senior at Rice Lake High school and has displayed the reasons for the lofty ranking early in 2015-16.

The freshman of the year candidate is ranked ninth (16.7 ppg.) in the country in scoring through games of Dec. 9 and ninth in rebounding (8.8 rpg.) among the nation's first-year players. Among all players in the BIG EAST, he owns fourth and second in those categories, respectively.

Ellenson has reached double figures in scoring in all but one contest and already owns four double-doubles. He netted a personal-best 23 points in the victory over San Jose State.

LSU's Ben Simmons, who Ellenson posted a double-double (16 points, 11 rebounds) against on Nov. 23, and Troy's Jordan Varnado are the only players ranked in the top-10 in both categories.

Marquette Jumps Ahead Early On Last Three Opponents

Marquette's offensive attack has gotten to work early and often in the team's last three outings against Grambling State, Maine and San Jose State.

In the three matchups, the Golden Eagles have combined to outscore GSU (14-0), Maine (22-0) and SJSU (31-7) by a score of 67-7 after the opening jump ball.

Marquette jumped ahead 14-0 against Grambling State and didn't allow the Tigers to score until the 13:08 mark of the first half. MU's defensive effort held GSU to 0-for-10 from the field to begin the contest.

Last Saturday afternoon's win over the Black Bears saw Marquette open the game with a 22-0 run, thanks to a personal nine-point streak by freshman Henry Ellenson. Maine finally got on the scoreboard at the 14:52 mark and MU knocked down each of its first eight attempts from the field.

With 10:02 left in the opening stanza against SJSU, Marquette found itself in possession for a 31-7 lead thanks in large part to 17 points by sophomore Sandy Cohen III.

Carter Making Most Of Starting Assignments

Marquette head coach Steve Wojciechowski inserted freshman guard Traci Carter into the starting lineup against LSU and the Philadelphia native has made the most of his opportunity in the last five outings.

During the team's current six-game winning streak, Carter is contributing 7.3 points, 7.0 assists, 5.0 rebounds and 2.3 steals per contest and owns an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.5. He has been stuffing the final box score with stats and in the win over Maine he finished with 10 points, seven rebounds, seven assists and four steals in 22 minutes.

In a team-high 37.0 minutes per contest at the Legends Classic (Nov. 23-24), Carter chipped in 8.0 points, 6.5 assists, 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 steals per contest. Each of his personal-best marks have come in the last five games, including a 10-assist effort in the victory over Grambling State. Against Arizona State in the title game, Carter finished with 13 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals.

He is ranked among the BIG EAST leaders in assists per game (3rd, 5.4), assist-to-turnover ratio (6th, 2.7) and steals per game (4th, 1.7).

Helping Hands Lead MU To Win Over Grambling State

Unselfish play has been a key component of the current winning streak and last Wednesday night's victory over Grambling State was a perfect example.

The Golden Eagles assisted on 30-of-34 (88.2 percent) made field goals, marking the team's highest total since collecting 33 helpers versus the Tigers on Nov. 12, 2013. Eight different players had at least one assist and freshmen Traci Carter (10 assists) and Haanif Cheatham (six assists) both collected personal-best totals.

Through games of Dec. 9, MU ranks first in the BIG EAST Conference and ninth in the nation in assists per game (19.4). During the current win streak, that average jumps to 21.5 assists per contest.

Lineup Features Numerous Offensive Weapons

Last season, Marquette was forced to rely on just two players, Matt Carlino and Duane Wilson, to handle a majority of the scoring load. This year's lineup features multiple options and Saturday afternoon's box score provided evidence.

In the victory over Maine, Marquette had five players collect double figures in points, including a pair (Henry Ellenson, 23, and Luke Fischer, 21) with over 20 points. Through eight nine, the Golden Eagles have had at least five players net 10-or-more points on four occasions (Belmont, Arizona St., Grambling St., Maine).

In the team's 32 games last season, Marquette had five-or-more players net at least 10 points just twice. In eight of the team's nine contests this season, Marquette has had at least four players finish with 10-or-more points.

Marquette Claims Legends Classic Title

Marquette claimed the 2015 Legends Classic title last Tuesday night at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y., downing Arizona State 78-73 in overtime.

The Golden Eagles trailed the Sun Devils by as many as eight points late in the second half, but were able to tie the score at 67-67 on a pair of charity tosses from freshman forward Henry Ellenson and force overtime (team's second extra session game in 2015-16). Of the team's 11 points in overtime, nine came via the free throw line and Marquette never trailed after regulation concluded. Ellenson finished with a double-double and junior center Luke Fischer chipped in 18 points and eight rebounds.

MU downed LSU 81-80 in the semifinals, thanks to 16 points each from Ellenson, guard Duane Wilson and guard Jajuan Johnson.

The Golden Eagles are now 31-9 in multi-team tournaments since 2004-05 and this year's event championship marked the first for the squad since claiming the 2011 U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam with a victory over Norfolk State in the title matchup.

Nationally Ranked Bailey, Hauser Join Program

Head coach Steve Wojciechowski announced the signings of nationally rated prep prospects Brendan Bailey (American Fork, UT/American Fork HS) and Sam Hauser (Stevens Point, WI/Stevens Point Area HS) on Nov. 11.

Hauser is ranked the 73rd-best prospect by Scout.com, 80th on CBSSports.com and 82nd on ESPN.com's Top 100. He helped lead SPASH (27-1) to the WIAA Division I state title in 2014-15 under head coach Scott Anderson, contributing 25 points in the title game against Germantown. He chipped in 18.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.3 assists per game while shooting a state-best 50.6 percent from behind the 3-point line.

A nationally ranked prospect, Bailey is currently rated 43rd by Scout.com 48th by Rivals.com, 67th by CBSSports.com and 96th in the ESPN.com Top 100. As a junior at American Fork High School under head coach Doug Meacham, Bailey contributed 15.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game.

Walk-ons Give Marquette Roster Depth

Marquette's 2015-16 roster features a trio of walk-ons, giving the Golden Eagles the much-needed depth during practice sessions they lacked in 2014-15.

Senior forward Michael Mache is the lone returner in the group and was named a team captain this preseason. Freshman guard Cam Marotta is a second-generation Marquette player, following in the footsteps of his father, Marc (1981-84), who was a three-time Academic All-American. Marotta wears No. 52 in honor of his father, who passed away unexpectedly this past spring. Freshman guard Christian Haffner was the league player of the year as a senior and concluded his career with 1,712 points.

Marquette Making Strides Off The Court

Under the direction of Master Strength & Conditioning Coach Todd Smith, the Golden Eagles have been making tremendous strides in the weight room across-the-board.

While each player on the roster features improvements in multiple measurement areas, highlights include the following individuals. Freshman forward Henry Ellenson has increased his weight by 10 pounds while maintaining his body fat percentage and has also improved his bench press from 185 pounds to 230 pounds. Sophomore forward Sandy Cohen checked in at 178 pounds when he arrived on campus in the summer of 2014 and is now listed at 195 pounds. He has also added 50 pounds to his bench press. Redshirt sophomore guard Duane Wilson moved his squat numbers from 200 pounds to 330 pounds and his bench press has improved by 60 pounds.

Ellenson Named to Karl Malone Award Watch List

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced the 20 watch list members for the 2016 Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Award, including Marquette freshman Henry Ellenson.

Named after Hall of Famer and two-time NBA Most Valuable Player Karl Malone, the annual honor recognizes the top power forwards in Division I men's college basketball.

Karl Malone attended Louisiana Tech University and led the Bulldogs to a Sweet 16 appearance and earned All-Southland honors in his three seasons while averaging 18.7 points and 9.3 rebounds per game. Malone achieved great success during his 19 seasons in the NBA as a 14-time NBA All-Star (1988-98, 2000-02), 11-time All-NBA First Team player (1989-99) and a member of the NBA's 50th Anniversary All-Time Team.

Steve Wojciechowski

Head Coach I Second Season
Duke, 1998

The 2015-16 campaign will mark the second at Marquette University for head coach Steve Wojciechowski, who has enjoyed a wealth

of success in collegiate basketball as both a player and a coach.

Wojciechowski (pronounced woe-ju-HOW-skee) was introduced as the program's 17th head coach on April 1, 2014 by Marquette University President Dr. Michael R. Lovell.

From the moment he arrived on campus, Wojciechowski established his "Win Every Day" philosophy as the foundation for the Marquette program. That approach has been extremely successful on the recruiting trail, where the MU staff has been able to assemble a consensus top-10 nationally ranked recruiting class in 2015. The group is highlighted by Wisconsin native Henry Ellenson, the program's first McDonald's All-America honoree in over 30 years and a top-10 rated prospect.

The Golden Eagles claimed their first win under Wojciechowski in the season opener in 2014-15. The 79-63 win over UT Martin at the BMO Harris Bradley Center was his first as a head coach at the NCAA Division I level. The season also produced wins over Georgia Tech, Tennessee and Arizona State and an appearance in the BIG EAST Tournament quarterfinals.

Wojciechowski, 39, had previously served as an assistant coach at Duke since the 1999-2000 season and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2008. As a player and coach, he was a part of Duke's winning tradition, serving on the coaching staff for two NCAA tournament champions. During his tenure, the Blue Devils posted an incredible 441-92 record and competed in the NCAA tournament every year.

Wojciechowski also served as court coach and scout for the USA Basketball Men's National Team. He helped lead on-court duties as well as game preparation from 2006-12, including the program's gold-medal performance at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics. The Olympic teams included NBA greats such as Marquette alumnus Dwyane Wade, Kobe Bryant and LeBron James.

Earning national titles

In 2001, in his second year as an assistant at Duke, Wojciechowski and the Blue Devils won the national championship. The team also captured the Atlantic Coast Conference regular season and tournament crowns and posted a 35-4 record.

Wojciechowski saw one of his former teammates and pupils, Shane Battier, earn the consensus National Player of the Year award in 2001 as well as National Defensive Player of the Year for the third consecutive season.

Wojciechowski achieved repeated success at the highest level with an NCAA title in the 2009-10 season as associate head coach. On the road to the championship, the Blue Devils also won the ACC Tournament, the ACC Regular Season and NIT Season Tip-Off titles. Defense and rebounding were key for the Blue

Devils who had one of the nation's top defenses, holding opponents to 61.0 points per game, and ranked 14th out of 334 teams in rebounding margin.

As a player, Wojciechowski (who was often referred to as "Wojo,") was named the top defensive player in the country his senior year, a two-time All-ACC choice and honorable mention Associated Press All-America. He appeared in 128 career games for the Blue Devils and earned 88 starting assignments.

Wojciechowski is a native of Severna Park, Md., and a first-generation college student, having earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from Duke in 1998. He and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Jack and Charlie.
