### GAME 14: The Facts

• The Purdue men's basketball team looks to end 2015 on a high note and open league play with a victory for the second straight season with its Big Ten opener at defending champion Wisconsin on Tuesday night.

• The contest will be televised by the Big Ten Network (BTN) with **Brian Anderson** and **Jon Crispin** calling the game courtside at the Kohl Center, beginning at 7 p.m. ET / 6 p.m. CT.

• On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** will handle the call on the 27-station Purdue Sports Network. Coverage begins with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip. The satellite radio broadcast on SIRIUS (Ch. 84) and XM (Ch. 84) will be the Wisconsin feed.

• Live stats will be available on [StatBroadcast.com](http://StatBroadcast.com). As always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

### Scouting Purdue

• Purdue ended non-conference play with a 12-1 mark after an impressive 68-55 win over Vanderbilt on Dec. 22 in a raucous Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers outscored the Commodores 45-29 in the second half to overcome a three-point halftime deficit.

• **A.J. Hammons** turned in a dominating 21-point, 10-rebound, seven-block performance against the Commodores. **Rapheal Davis** (14) and **Caleb Swanigan** (13) added 27 points between them as the trio combined for 48 points between them.

• Despite playing just 21.3 minutes per game, Hammons leads the team in scoring (13.3) and blocks (2.9) while adding 8.2 rebounds per game. **Isaac Haas** (12.2), **Caleb Swanigan** (11.3) and **Rapheal Davis** (10.8) all average in double figures as well.

• Purdue hasn't defeated Wisconsin since March 3, 2013 (four games).

### Scouting Wisconsin

• The Badgers, the 2015 NCAA runners-up, lost much production from last year's team, but still present a big challenge to the Boilermakers in the league opener for both teams.

• Returning preseason All-Big Ten performers **Nigel Hayes** and **Bronson Koenig** as well as a strong freshman contributor in **Ethan Happ**, the Badgers have a strong nucleus heading into Big Ten play.

• Hayes leads the Badgers in scoring (16.2) and assists (4.2). Koenig averages 14.4 points per game, while Happ averages 11.5 points and 8.3 rebounds per game. The matchup between Happ and Swanigan features two of the top rookies in the league.

### The Coaches

• **Matt Painter** (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 224-126 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 224 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.

• **Greg Gard** (UW Platteville, 1995) will coach in just his second game in charge of the Badgers' program. Gard had served as a longtime assistant at Wisconsin under **Bo Ryan** (retired Dec. 15) before being elevated.

Since the start of the 2009-10 season, Purdue is 5-1 in Big Ten openers. Under Matt Painter, the Boilermakers are 6-4 in league openers, including 2-2 on the road.

■ **Painter Moving Up the Charts**

- **Matt Painter** has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list, and will lead his squad into his 351st game in his 11th season on Tuesday against Wisconsin.
- Painter owns a 224-126 (.640) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
- With the 12-1 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .640 winning percentage.

■ **Program Stability**

- Purdue has had just two head coaches, **Gene Keady** and **Matt Painter**, since the start of the 1980-81 season, a span of 35 years.
- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years, and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

■ **Painter Now Third-Longest Tenured Big Ten Coach**

- Following the resignation of **Bo Ryan** on Dec. 15, **Matt Painter** (age 45) is now the third-longest tenured coach in the Big Ten.
- Michigan State's **Tom Izzo** (21st year) and Ohio State's **Thad Matta** (12th year) are the only Big Ten coaches at their respective schools for a longer time than Painter.
- In just 10 years, Painter is one of 20 coaches in Big Ten history to record 100 career Big Ten wins. He is third among active coaches on the list.

■ **Purdue in Big Ten Openers**

- Purdue is 65-45 all-time in Big Ten openers including 6-4 under head coach **Matt Painter**, winning five of its last six Big Ten Openers. Purdue is 2-2 under Painter on the road in Big Ten openers

■ **Tight in Big Ten Games**

- If last year's results are any indication, Purdue can expect more close games in Big Ten play. The Boilermakers have played 10 straight regular-season league games decided by 10 or fewer points and all but two of its league games a year ago were decided by 10 or fewer points (home vs. Indiana and Michigan).
- Purdue has played 11 straight Big Ten road games decided by 10 or fewer points, dating to a 19-point loss at Nebraska on Feb. 23, 2014.

■ **Success at the Kohl Center**

- Wisconsin owns a 216-25 record at the Kohl Center, including a 106-14 (.883) record against Big Ten teams since the 2001-02 season, the building's first season.
- However, Purdue is one of just three teams to have won three games against the Badgers at the Kohl Center.

■ **Trying to Stop the Skid**

- However, Purdue has lost four straight games to Wisconsin, dating to March 3, 2013. Purdue lost two games during the 2013-14 season and two games last year (at Wisconsin; in Big Ten Tournament).
- The skid is tied for the sixth-longest active losing streak to a single opponent.

■ **Gameday Adjustments**

- Last year, Purdue went 0-4 when being outscored in the paint. Already this year, Purdue has won three games when being outscored in the paint (Vermont, Florida, Pittsburgh).
- It did lose to Butler when being outscored in the paint on Dec. 19.

■ **Making More Than They Shoot**

- The goal of all good teams is to make more free throws than their opponents shoot and through 13 games this year, Purdue is doing that.
- The Boilermakers have made 221 free throws while opponents have shot just 212 free throws.

### ■ Win When Shooting More

• Purdue has won 27 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including nine times this year.

### ■ Automatic When Scoring 90

• Purdue has won 78 straight games when scoring between 90-99 points.

### ■ What a Difference a Year Makes

• One year ago, on December 22, 2014, Purdue lost to Gardner-Webb, 89-84, to fall to 8-5 on the season entering Big Ten play. The loss to Gardner-Webb was the third straight loss for the Boilermakers and came on the heels of blowout setbacks to Vanderbilt and Notre Dame.

• One year later, Purdue has reversed its fortunes, going 25-9 since that loss to Gardner-Webb.

### ■ Boilermakers Hot at Home

• Purdue enters Saturday's game against Iowa having won 15 straight games at Mackey Arena.

• Since the start of last year, Purdue is now 23-3 at home and its 15-game winning streak is the 14th-longest streak in the country and the second-longest winning streak in the Big 10 (Maryland - 20).

• **Matt Painter** now owns five double-digit homecourt winning streaks in his 11 years at Purdue, and the current 15-game homecourt winning streak is tied for the sixth-longest streak in Mackey Arena.

### ■ Defense Lives Here

• Purdue has returned to its roots in bolting out to a 12-1 start and a top-15 national ranking, winning with impressive defensive efforts, likely staking claim to being the top-defensive team in America.

• According to **Ken Pomeroy**, Purdue leads the country in adjusted defensive efficiency (.87.3) as well as effective field goal percentage (.381). The Boilermakers are second nationally in 2-point field goal percentage defense (.367), trailing just San Diego State (.366).

• In the NCAA ranks, Purdue is the only school in the country to rank in the top 20 of four major defensive categories (FG percentage defense, scoring defense, rebound margin and 3-point percentage defense).

• Purdue leads the country in field goal percentage defense at 33.9 percent. Michigan State is second at 35.3 percent.

• Over the last 33 games (25-8 record) dating to last year, Purdue has held foes to 37.1 percent shooting (703-of-1,894).

• Purdue is the only team in the country to have held two opponents to 40 points or less.

• Purdue has held four of its 13 opponents under 30.0 percent shooting and eight of its 12 foes to 59 points or less.

• When holding foes under 59 points during the Painter era, the Boilermakers are 111-4.

### ■ Chairman of the Boards

• Purdue has had at least one double-digit rebounder in 11-of-13 games, including eight straight. The only games Purdue didn't have a double-digit rebounder came against Old Dominion and Florida.

• The Boilermakers have outrebounded all 13 foes this year and rank eighth nationally in rebound margin (+12.2). Dating to last year, Purdue has outrebounded 17 of its last 18 opponents (Wisconsin in the Big Ten Tournament).

• Purdue has outrebounded six of its 13 foes by double-digits.

• In the second half of the last three games, Purdue has outrebounded its foes, 71-38, an average of 23.7 to 12.7 rebounds per half.

### ■ Rare Sellout

- Purdue drew a sellout crowd of 14,846 fans against Vanderbilt, the first non-conference sellout since the Mackey Arena renovation was completed prior to the 2011-12 season.
- Purdue is averaging 13,012 fans through its nine home dates so far this year, which is over 2,500 more fans per game this year than through last year's non-conference slate (10,473 fans per game).

### ■ May I Assist You With That?

- Purdue has four players, all sophomores or younger, that have some impressive assist-to-turnover ratios. The quartet of **Vince Edwards**, **P.J. ### ■ Hammons Flexes Muscles, Inside and Out

- A.J. Hammons** was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Dec. 7 after averaging 20.0 points and 11.5 rebounds per game in victories over Pittsburgh and New Mexico. He shot 17-of-25 (.680) from the field.
- Hammons has had four double-doubles in the last seven games, averaging 15.6 points, 9.1 rebounds and 3.0 blocks during that span. Hammons is shooting 45-of-70 (.643) from the field over the last seven games.
- In the second half this year, Hammons is shooting 68.5 percent from the field and 79.2 percent from the free throw line.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 145-31 (.824) record at home over the last 11 seasons, including a remarkable 82-7 (.921) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
