1972-73 Wisconsin develops its first women's badminton team under Coach Nelson Neal.

1973-74 Wisconsin places third at the WWIAC Championship.

1974-75 Wisconsin is defeated in a triangular competition with UW-LaCrosse and Iowa.

1975-76 Wisconsin finishes third in the Madison Invitational. The Badgers place fourth at the WWIAC Championships.

1976-77 Wisconsin places second in the Carthage Invitational and ties with Platteville for first place in the Platteville Invitational.

1977-78 Wisconsin finishes the season with a dual record of 4-1 and a second-place finish at the WWIAC Championships. The Badgers place 12th in their first AIAW National competition.

1978-79 Ann French (Elmhurst, IL) places among the top eight quarter-finalists in AIAW singles competition; named an All-American. French also named the Broderick Award winner for 1979. The Broderick Award honors the "outstanding collegiate competitor in badminton". She received the honor as a freshman at Wisconsin.

1979-80 Ann French (Elmhurst, IL) places among the top eight quarter-finalists in AIAW singles competition; named an All-American the second consecutive year.

1980-81 Ann French (Elmhurst, IL) and Claire Allison (Ontario, Canada) win the AIAW national doubles title; both named All-Americans. Claire Allison places second in the AIAW singles competition as a freshman.

1981-82 Ann French (Elmhurst, IL) and Claire Allison (Ontario, Canada) win the AIAW national doubles title; both named All-Americans. Claire Allison again the runner-up singles champion losing in the finals to Claire Choo of Northern Illinois.

1982-83 Wisconsin wins the National Intercollegiate Badminton Championships at George Washington University in Washington, D.C. Claire Allsion (Ontario, Canada) wins the singles title, 11-3, 11-2 over J. Kitzmiller of Stanford. Allison teamed with Sandy Colby (Chicago, IL) in the doubles competition to win her second title. They defeated Nobauer and Cook from Arizona State, 15-8, 15-5.

NOTE: Badminton was dropped as an intercollegiate sport in the spring of 1983.
