OPENING TIP

• Indiana University is ranked #17 in the USA Today Coaches Poll and #19 by AP and will put a 12-game winning streak on the line when it visits Wisconsin on Tuesday night. The Hoosiers are coming off an 89-57 win over Northwestern at home. A win would give IU a 13-game winning streak for the first time since the 2007-08 season. IU defeated Wisconsin, 59-58, three weeks ago in Assembly Hall. IU begins a stretch of three of the next four games away from home. The Hoosiers are second in the nation in points per possession at 1.20.

HOOSIERS AT HOME

• IU has defeated three Big Ten opponents at home by 25 or more points in consecutive games for the first time since the 1987-88 season. IU beat Ohio State (85-60), Illinois (103-69) and Northwestern (89-57).

HEAD COACH TOM CREAN

• **Tom Crean** is in his eighth year of leading the Hoosiers. Over the last four+ years, IU is 110-48 and leads the Big Ten with 19 regular season wins over ranked opponents during that time. During that time, the Hoosiers have appeared nationally ranked in at least one major poll during a season. He has recruited a McDonald's All-American in each of the last five years. Since 2011, the Hoosiers have averaged 23 wins per season compared to 20 averaged at IU from 1995-2008. Seven players have scored 1,000 points in their career under Tom Crean at Indiana. Christian Watford (1,730), Yogi Ferrell (1,720), Verdell Jones III (1,347), Jordan Hulls (1,318), Cody Zeller (1,157), Will Sheehy (1,120) and Victor Oladipo (1,117).

DEFENSE KEYS BIG TEN START

• According to KenPom.com, IU is ranked first in the Big Ten in defensive efficiency in conference games at 92.5. In conference games only, IU ranks third in scoring defense (64.0) and leads in steals (7.6) and is second in rebound margin (+10.4)

YOGI UP FOR OSCAR ROBERTSON AWARD

• Senior **Kevin "Yogi" Ferrell** is one of 20 finalists for the Oscar Robertson Award presented to the National Player of the Year by the USBWA. With his nine assists vs. Illinois, he became the IU all-time leader, surpassing Michael Lewis who had 545 from 1997-00. Ferrell now has 559 assists and needs 11 points to surpass Christian Watford as the top scorer during the Tom Crean Era. He now ranks 10th all-time at IU with 1,720 points. Ferrell was named Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday after he averaged 16.5 points and 7.5 assists against Illinois and Northwestern. He enters his final conference season as the Big Ten's active leader in scoring, assists, three-point field goals made (235) and is the only senior in the league to have started every game he has played (122).

RECORD NIGHT AGAINST ILLINOIS

• The Hoosiers set a Big Ten record for three-pointers in a conference game by making 19 against Illinois last week. In two games last week, IU made 32 of 64 long distance attempts.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE BADGERS

• Indiana rallied from a nine-point first half deficit and **Kevin "Yogi" Ferrell** hit a go-ahead jumper in the final minute as IU took a 59-58 victory. Sophomore Robert Johnson had a key steal in the final minute and Ferrell also added four free throws late in the game. Ferrell led the Hoosiers with 19, freshmen OG Anunoby added 11 and Thomas Bryant had 10.

IU INSIGHT

• Sophomore guard **James Blackmon, Jr.**, (15.8 ppg) had surgery on his right knee on Jan. 5, and is not expected to return this season. In his two years with the Hoosiers, IU is 21-0 anytime he shot 47.0 percent or higher from the field. He is the Big Ten sophomore class career leader in scoring averaging 15.7 ppg.

• Since the 2011-12 season, the Hoosier offense is first in the Big Ten in points scored (77.7), field goal percentage (47.9), and three-point field goal percentage (40.5).

• The Hoosiers lead the Big Ten in scoring (86.1), field goal percentage (52.3), three-point FG percentage (44.7), steals (7.7) offensive rebound percentage (38.9), and turnovers forced (14.6).

• The Hoosiers are 3rd in the country in 3FG percentage and field goal percentage, 4th in scoring, 5th in scoring margin, 8th in three-point field goals made, 17th in assists and 21st in rebound margin.

• In seven conference games, IU's opponents are turning the ball over at a rate of +4 above their own average.

• IU has shot 50 percent or better in 24 of its last 53 games. IU has shot 40 percent or better from three-point range in a national-best 32 contests in that time frame.

MORE YOGI

• **Ferrell** is second in the Big Ten in scoring during conference games at 18.9 per game. He is one of two active players in the country to have at least 1,550 career points (1,720), 500 assists (559) and 350 rebounds (390) (other is Juan'ya Green, Hofstra) He was named second team Preseason All-American by *The Sporting News* and *USA Today*, in addition to garnering third team honors from *Athlon Sports* and fourth team mention in *Blue Ribbon Magazine*. For the season, he is averaging 17.1 points (4th in Big Ten), 4.3 rebounds and 6.1 assists (4th in Big Ten).

ODDS AND TRENDS

• The Hoosiers have notched 50 percent or better shooting in 27 out of 40 halves played so far this season.

• The 103 points scored by the Hoosiers against Illinois, marked the second time in the Crean Era that IU had eclipsed the century mark in a conference game (103 vs. Iowa in 2012). It also marked just the third time in 22 years IU has scored over 100 in a Big Ten game.

• Senior graduate transfer **Max Bielfeldt** had 16 points, eight rebounds, two blocks and three steals against Illinois. He also added 13 points and four rebounds against Northwestern. He had his best day as a collegian with 18 points, 14 rebounds, two assists and two steals off the bench at Rutgers. He is fifth in the league in shooting making 58.4% of his shots. His 12 three-point field goals this season eclipses the 11 he made in three years at Michigan.

• Sophomore **Robert Johnson** is third in the Big Ten in three-point field goal percentage making 47.2% of his shots. Team is 14-0 when he starts. He forced a game-winning steal in the final seconds against Wisconsin and had 13 points, seven rebounds and six assists against Illinois and added nine points against Northwestern.

• Senior **Nick Zeisloft** is second on the team in three-point field goals with 39. He hit five of eight long distance shots and finished with 15 points against Minnesota. He is shooting 42.4 from long range.

• Freshman **Thomas Bryant** is a two-time Big Ten Freshman of the Week honoree. He had his first career double-double with 19 points and 13 rebounds against OSU. He leads the Big Ten in field goal shooting making 72.2% of his shot attempts. He had 19 points, four rebounds and three blocked shots at Nebraska and also had 10 points at Minnesota.

• Junior forward **Troy Williams** had 21 points and five assists with no turnovers against Illinois. He matched his career-high with 23 points against Ohio State. He is eighth in the league in rebounding (6.7) and in field goal percentage (56.6) and is sixth in the Big Ten in steals (1.3). He has had nine assists in his last two games.

• Junior **Collin Hartman** has moved into the starting lineup with Blackmon's injury. He had 11 points against Northwestern. He is averaging 6.6 points, 3.1 rebounds, and is shooting 53.3 from the field and 56.6 from long distance since moving into the starting lineup. His Big Ten three-point shooting percentage is 2nd in the league.

• Freshman **OG Anunoby** is averaging 7.3 points and 3.3 rebounds in Big Ten games. He scored a career-high 11 points against Nebraska and Wisconsin. He has shot 64.3 from the field and made seven of 11 three-point field goal attempts.

• Freshman **Juwan Morgan** had a season-high seven points in the win over Northwestern. He also had two rebounds, two blocks and a steal in the Wisconsin win and also had two points and four rebounds against Ohio State.

• Junior walk-on **Ryan Burton** played 10 minutes against Rutgers and scored a career-high six points when he drained both of his long distance attempts. He also hit a three-pointer against Northwestern.

• With Blackmon out, the Hoosiers have turned to freshman walk-on **Harrison Niego** who has seen 20 minutes of action in Big Ten play and hit a three-pointer and has four steals.

• For the second time under **Tom Crean**, the Hoosiers have put together a 12-game winning streak. IU won 12 to start the 2011-12 season.

• Crean announced the addition of **Jackson Tharp** to the 2015-16 roster, effective immediately. Tharp has been an undergraduate manager at IU since the 2012 after playing at Zionsville High School. He earned All-Hoosier Crossroads Conference honors as a junior and senior at Zionsville. He is 6-4, 205, and will wear #24. He had an assist in his first game against Illinois.

POSTGAME NOTES VS. NORTHWESTERN

- The Hoosiers 32-point victory is the largest margin of victory in the series since Indiana beat Northwestern 95-61 on 2/4/96 in Bloomington.
- The Hoosiers have beat their last three Big Ten opponents at home by at least 25 points (Ohio State-25, Illinois-34, Northwestern-32). The last time Indiana achieved this was the 1987-88 season (Minnesota-29, Northwestern-29, Michigan State-37).
- The last time the Hoosiers had back-to-back 30-plus point wins in Big Ten play at home was the 2000-01 season (Wisconsin-30, Minnesota-36).
- The last time IU went back-to-back Big Ten games (home or away) by 30 or more points was during the 2001-02 season. After a 85-51 win at Penn State on Jan. 23, 2002 they turned around and beat Illinois in Assembly Hall, 88-57, on Jan. 26, 2002.
- The last time Indiana had three 25-plus point Big Ten wins in a season was in 2012-13. (at Purdue-37, vs. Nebraska-29, vs. Purdue-28).
- The last time IU opened Big Ten play with a 7-0 record was the 1992-93 season when they opened 13-0.
- The last time Indiana won 12 games in a row was the start of the 2011-12 season, when the Hoosiers began the year 12-0.
- The 12-game win streak is the third-longest active streak in the country (SMU-18, UAB-13).
- The Hoosiers opened the game on a 13-2 run and held Northwestern scoreless until the Wildcats converted a field goal at the 16:28 mark.
- In the first four minutes and last four minutes of each half combined, the Hoosiers outscored the Wildcats 42-13.
- Indiana held a 40-23 advantage on the glass (11-5 on offensive glass), and have won or tied the rebounding battle in each of the last 12 games – all IU wins.
- The Hoosiers held a 14-0 advantage on second chance points.
- IU is a combined 32-of-64 (50 percent) from 3-point range in its last two games. With 13 threes tonight, IU has now recorded 10-or-more threes in 12 games. In nine games this season, Indiana has shot over 45 percent from 3-point range.
- Indiana shot 30-of-57 from the field (52.6 percent) and have shot 50 percent or better in 13 games this season.
- The Hoosiers shot 16-of-20 from the free throw line (80 percent) and have shot 80 percent or better in three games this season. IU limited Northwestern to 2-of-8 from the foul line.
- Indiana had 21 assists for the night, their fifth game this season with at least 20 assists and ninth game with 18 or more. The Hoosiers had a 21-10 assist-turnover ratio against Northwestern. Indiana leads the Big Ten in assists per game at 17.8.
- Senior Kevin “Yogi” Ferrell scored 17 points and moved into 10th on the Hoosiers all-time scoring list, passing Eric Anderson (1989-92). Ferrell now has 1,720 points and is 10 points behind Christian Watford for ninth on the list.
- Ferrell added six assists with just one turnover and is the all-time leader in assists in school history with 559. Ferrell moved into third alone in assists in Big Ten games with 266 (Quinn Buckner 313 is 2nd).
- Ferrell converted 3-of-6 from 3-point range and is third on the Hoosiers all-time list for 3-pointers with 235. Ferrell is third in Big Ten only games with 132. Jordan Hulls is second in both categories with 254 and 134, respectively.

40TH ANNIVERSARY OF 1976 CHAMPS

Indiana University Vice President and Director of Intercollegiate Athletics **Fred Glass** today announced initial plans for a season long recognition to honor the 40th anniversary of the undefeated 1976 men's basketball team. Indiana's 1976 team remains the last undefeated NCAA men's basketball champion and was selected as the greatest college basketball team of all-time on the 75th anniversary of the NCAA Tournament in 2013.

The season-long honoring of the 40th anniversary is being highlighted by: season tickets being mailed to fans in a folded keepsake replica of the 1976 championship banner; a commemorative patch placed on the back of IU's home and away jerseys throughout the year; a public recognition of that perfect championship season during IU's home game against Wisconsin on January 5, 2016; and the induction of **Bobby Wilkerson** and **Tom Abernethy** into the IU Athletics Hall of Fame. With Wilkerson and Abernethy being inducted tonight, all five starters from the 1976 undefeated team will now be in the IU Athletics Hall of Fame along with head coach Bob Knight.

This season-long recognition continues IU Athletics efforts in recent years to honor the accomplishments the players and coaches from the back-to-back undefeated regular seasons which, among other things, established Knight as a legendary coach and produced four All-Americans, three Big Ten MVP's, and a National Player of the Year. Last season, IU honored the seniors from the 1975 team that won the Big Ten Championship and finished the regular season undefeated with an on-court public recognition.

In 2013, Scott May (represented by his son Scott Jr.), Kent Benson, Isiah Thomas, Steve Alford (represented by his father), and Keith Smart (represented by Todd Meier) were also recognized in a half-time ceremony for being named as some of the greatest players in the 75 year history of the NCAA Tournament. In addition to the induction of Abernethy and Wilkerson in the IU Athletics Hall of Fame this year, Coach Knight was inducted in 2009.

**BUCKNER INDUCTED TO COLLEGE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME**

KANSAS CITY -- Former Indiana University men's basketball All-American **Quinn Buckner**, who helped lead the Hoosiers to a perfect season and the 1976 NCAA Championship, is one of five former college basketball standouts in the 2015 induction class of the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame. The National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame was established in 2006 and Buckner is the fourth former IU player to be inducted, joining Branch McCracken, Walt Bellamy and Isiah Thomas, who were honored in 2006. IU Coaches Bob Knight and Everett Dean also were inducted in 2006.

Buckner joins Kansas State's **Rolando Blackman**, Ohio State's **John Havlicek**, Long Beach State's **Ed Ratleff** and North Carolina's **Charlie Scott** as the headline players in the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame's induction class of 2015. Joining them for the 10th enshrinement ceremony are legendary coaches **Don Donoher** of Dayton, **C. Felton "Zip" Gayles** of Langston and **Lou Henson**, who coached at Hardin-Simmons, New Mexico State and Illinois.

The Class of 2015 was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame on Friday, November 20, 2015, at the Arvest Bank Theatre at the Midland in Kansas City as part of a three-day celebration of college basketball.

The National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame is located in the College Basketball Experience (CBE), a world-class entertainment facility adjacent to Kansas City's Sprint Center, which will serve as the venue of the annual CBE Hall of Fame Classic.

A three-year captain at Indiana for Coach Bob Knight, Quinn Buckner was a key member of IU's 1975-76 NCAA Championship team, which is the last team to go unbeaten throughout an entire season and post-season. He is one of only three players to win a title at the high school, college, NBA and Olympic level, joining Jerry Lucas and Magic Johnson.

In 2006, the first class was inducted into the newly formed National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame. That class included the game's inventor, James Naismith, and possibly its greatest coach, John Wooden. Since that time, eight more classes have been inducted and have included the likes of Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, Danny Manning, Larry Bird, Earvin "Magic" Johnson and Shaquille O'Neal.

BAILEY, CHEANEY PART OF 55TH INDUCTION CLASS TO INDIANA BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

NEW CASTLE, Indiana -- Including the all-time leading scorer in Indiana high school basketball history, the all-time leading scorer in Indiana University and Big Ten Conference history, men who once held the all-time scoring records at Butler University and Indiana State University, a pair of Indiana high school state champion players, the record holder for state finals rebounding, a collegiate national champion player and a coach of two Indiana Mr. Basketballs, the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame announces their 55th mens' induction class.

Damon Bailey remains the all-time leading scorer in Indiana high school basketball history 26 years after he graduated from Bedford North Lawrence High School with 3,134 points. The 1990 Indiana Mr. Basketball, he led the Stars to three state finals appearances, including the 1990 state championship. A 1994 All-American as a senior at Indiana University, he graduated having won more games in an IU jersey than any other player (108) including a school-record 11 NCAA Tournament wins, tied for 2nd in games played (132), the all-time leader in three-point field goals made (166), 5th in three-point % (.437), tied for 2nd in assists (474), and 5th in career scoring (1,741).

Bailey is inducted in his first year eligible (26 years after high school graduation), and becomes just the 9th player inducted into the Hall in their first year of eligibility (joining Steve Alford, Kent Benson, Larry Bird, Dave Colescott, Kyle Macy, George McGinnis, Rick Mount and Oscar Robertson).

Calbert Cheaney set records at Evansville Harrison High School before a remarkable college and pro career. The only player in Harrison history to have his jersey retired, Cheaney holds the single-game school scoring record (47) amongst his 1,064 points. A three-time college All-American and the consensus 1993 National Player of the Year, he re-wrote the Indiana University record book, remaining today the all-time leading scorer (2,613 points) in school and Big Ten Conference history.

Setting the IU record for career starts (130) and graduating 2nd in career games played (132), he left with the school record in field goals made (1,018), 2nd in career FG % (.559), 4th in three-point % (.438) and having led the team in scoring all four years, he held three of the top 13 single-season scoring totals in IU history upon graduation.

EVANS, HENDERSON ON INDIANA BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME SILVER ANNIVERSARY TEAM

NEW CASTLE – Eighteen men have been named to the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame's 2016 Silver Anniversary Team, based on outstanding accomplishments as a senior basketball player 25 years ago.

The team includes 13 members of the 1991 Indiana All-Star squad. Five other all-state players are included to recognize the top of Indiana's high school class of 1991.

1991 Indiana All-Stars include Mr. Basketball Glenn Robinson, **Alan Henderson**, Daimon Beathea, Brandon Brantley, **Brian Evans**, Andy Elkins, Marlon Fleming, Jeff Massey, LaMar Morton, Steve Nicodemus, Andre Owens, LaSalle Thompson and Chris Wilburn.

The remaining five, named to various all-state teams are: Lance Barker, Tony Etchison, Jerry Freshwater, Chad Gilbert and Jason Williams.

Evans played at Indiana from 1992-1996 and was named Big Ten MVP in 1996 after averaging 21.2 points, 7.1 rebounds and shooting 39.2 percent from the 3-point line his senior year. He was also a Third Team All-American and went on to be named Male Athlete of the Year at Indiana and earned the Balfour Award. He finished his career with 1,701 points and 730 rebounds and shot 40.8 percent from behind the 3-point line.

Henderson was an All-American at Indiana in 1995 as he averaged 23.5 points and 9.7 rebounds per game - including a 41-point performance against Michigan State. For his career, he posted 1,979 points and 1,091 rebounds and shot 54.0 percent from the floor.

All Mens Silver Anniversary Team members will be honored at the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame's Annual Men's Banquet on Wednesday, March 23, 2016.

A midday reception, free and open to the public, will be held at the Hall of Fame museum in New Castle. The evening banquet will take place at the Primo Banquet Hall, which is located on the south side of Indianapolis.
