UP NEXT: UW OPENS HOMESTAND VS. NORTH DAKOTA

- Wisconsin opens up a three-game, five-day homestand Tuesday night against North Dakota. The Big Ten Network will carry the game live beginning at 7 p.m. The Badgers will then host Bowling Green on Thursday, Nov. 21 and Oral Roberts on Saturday, Nov. 23.
- Following the three-game home set, Wisconsin will travel to Mexico for the Cancun Challenge. UW will face Saint Louis in the semifinals on Nov. 26 and either West Virginia or Old Dominion on Nov. 27.

KEY NOTES TO CONSIDER

GOOD START: So far the Big Ten Conference owns 4 combined wins over teams from the 'Power 6' conferences. With wins over St. John's and Florida, Wisconsin is responsible for two of them (Michigan State over Kentucky and Ohio State over Marquette are the other two wins).

The Big Ten has also won a total of 5 road or neutral games in 2013-14 and the Badgers account for 2 of them (along with Minnesota at Richmond, Penn State at Penn and Ohio State at Marquette and Michigan State over Kentucky in Chicago).

- 2 POLL POSITION: The Badgers moved up 8 spots in the latest AP Top 25, checking in at No. 12 this week. UW is also ranked No. 15 in the Coaches Poll. Wisconsin's No. 12 AP ranking is its highest since being ranked No. 11 in the Dec. 26, 2011 poll.
- 3 TOP-RANKED TAKEDOWNS: With a 59-53 win over No. 11 Florida, Wisconsin improved to 31-11 (.738) at home under Bo Ryan against AP Top-25 teams. That includes a sparkling 21-6 mark vs. teams ranked in the top 15.
- KOHL CENTER DOMINANCE: During the Bo Ryan era (2001-present) very few teams have enjoyed the type of home success Wisconsin has experienced. The Badgers are 182-18 (.910) at the Kohl Center over the last 13 seasons, the fourth-best mark in the nation. That includes a sparkling 91-7 home record against non-conference opponents.
- 5 BALANCING ACT: The Badgers have displayed great balance in scoring so far this season as 4 players are averaging in double figures and 6 players have scored 10 or more in a game this season. Wisconsin also had at least 4 players hit multiple 3-pointers in each of the season's first 2 games.

SERIES VS. NORTH DAKOTA

► Wisconsin and North Dakota will meet for the 6th time Tuesdsay, but just the second with UND as a member of Division 1. The Badgers won the only other Div. 1 meeting, 85-53 on Nov. 14, 2010 at the Kohl Center.

Ben Brust, Josh Gasser and Duje Dukan were freshmen when the two teams played in 2010. Gasser made his first-career start vs. UND, tallying 7 points, 6 boards and 4 assists. Brust and Dukan were scoreless in 7 and 4 minutes, respectively.

- Wisconsin is 7-1 all-time against teams from the Big Sky.
 UW's only loss to the conference was 73-69 decision in Bo Ryan's fourthever game with the Badgers at the Big Island Invitational in 2001.
- ► UW and UND have a storied hockey rivalry with the Badgers owning a 86-65-12 lead in the series.
- ► UW Hall of Famer Theresa Huff is the mother of North Dakota guard Troy Huff. Theresa is the Badgers all-

NOTES FROM UW'S LAST GAME

#20 WIS 69, GB 66 - 11/16/13 - Green Bay, Wis.

- ▶ Wisconsin improved to 19-1 all-time against the Phoenix, including a 3-1 mark in games played in Green Bay. In the Bo Ryan era, the Badgers are 29-7 (.806) against their in-state rivals Green Bay, Milwaukee and Marquette.
- ► The Badgers are now 68-66 (.507) in road games under Ryan, owning the highest win percentage and most wins of any Big Ten team over that span (2002-present).
- ► Wisconsin went on a 10-0 run late in the second half, turning a 54-50 deficit into a 60-54 lead with 6:03 remaining.
- ► Frank Kaminsky led the Badgers with 16 points, the second-highest total of his career, while adding a career-high 8 rebounds and a career-best 4 blocks, including a block of GB's Kiefer Sykes' (32 points) would-be game-tying shot with 0:05 remaining.
- ► Sam Dekker finished with 13 points and 7 rebounds. He has scored in double figures in all three games this season and 12 of the last 15.
- ▶ **Josh Gasser** scored 11 points and 6 rebounds, going a 6-for-6 at the free throw line. He is a perfect 14-for-14 on the season at the line.
- ► Having played just 1 minute of action in UW's first two games, freshman **Bronson Koenig** set career marks with 7 points (3-for-3 from the field), 2 assists, 1 block and 1 steal with 23 minutes.

KOHL CENTER AMONG TOUGHEST

Wisconsin has only lost a TOTAL of 18 home games in the Bo Ryan era.

In 13 seasons under Ryan, the Badgers are an incredible 182-18 (.910) at the Kohl Center. UW's .910 winning percentage since 2001-02 is good for 4th in the nation. Only Duke, Kansas and Gonzaga have better home records in that span (pg 9).

- ► Three of UW's 5 longest home win streaks have come under Bo Ryan, including the school-record 38 straight from 12/7/2002 to 1/25/2005.
- Over the last 12 years, 135 of the Badgers' 182 home wins have come by at least 10 points (74.2%).

UW IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY

- ► Under Bo Ryan (since 2001-02), Wisconsin owns an overall record of 120-30 (.800) in nonconference games, including a mark of 91-7 (.929) at the Kohl Center.
- ► The Badgers reached 9 non-conference wins in 2012-13 for the 11th-consecutive season. UW has averaged 10.5 non-conference wins under Bo Ryan.

STARTING SOMETHING

Wisconsin is off to a 3-0 start for the 2nd time in the last 3 years and the 9th time in Bo Ryan's 13 seasons. The Badgers' last 4-0 start came in 2011-12 season when UW opened the year 6-0.

ROAD WARRIORS

Under Bo Ryan, Wisconsin is renowned for its incredible home record, but the Badgers have also enjoyed remarkable success on the road.

► Since Bo Ryan was hired in 2001, Wisconsin has been the Big Ten's best road team, owning the most true road wins (68) and best road win percentage (.507) in the conference.

In fact, in that era Wisconsin is the only Big Ten team with a road record of .500 or better.

FOR OPENERS

- ► Wisconsin won its season opener with an 86-75 win over St. John's on Nov. 8. The Badgers have now won each of their last 12 regular-season openers. UW's last loss in the opener came in Bo Ryan's first game as head coach when the Badgers dropped a 74-69 contest at UNLV.
- ► Including this season's 11-point win, the Badgers have won their last 12 openers by an average of 28.0 points per game.
- ▶ UW also notched its 16th-consecutive homeopening win with a 59-53 victory over No. 11 Florida on Nov. 12. That game marked the first time the Badgers faced a ranked team in their home opener since knocking off No. 4 Kansas, 67-62, in 1968.

FREE THROW IMPROVEMENT

► Last season, Wisconsin ranked last in the Big Ten shooting just 63.4% at the free throw line. In the Badgers first game of the 2013-14 season, they made 25-of-30 free throws (83.3%), including each of their final 14 attempts.

On the season, UW is shooting .738 from the free throw line, making 45-of-61 at the line. That mark ranks 3rd in the Big Ten.

- ► Since Bo Ryan joined the Badgers in 2001, UW is 93-19 (.894) when attempting 25 or more free throws in a game, including 6-0 last season.
- ▶ Junior Josh Gasser leads the Big Ten with a perfect 14-for-14 mark at the line. He is one of just two players on the conference's statistical leaderboard without a miss (PSU's Donovon Jack is 6-for-6).

WRECKING THE RANKED

▶ With its 59-53 win over No. 11 Florida, Wisconsin improved to 31-11 (.738) at home under Bo Ryan against AP Top-25 teams.

That includes a sparkling 21-6 mark against teams ranked in the top 15.

Dating back to last season, the Badgers have 4 straight home games against ranked teams. Overall, UW has won 8 of its last 12 games against the top 25.

- Last season, UW posted seven wins over teams ranked in the AP Top-25 (7-6 overall), with all 7 wins coming vs. teams ranked in the top 15.
- ► UW's 7 victories against teams ranked in the top 15 was the most in the country, tied with Indiana.

TRIPLE THREAT

▶ UW is shooting 41.0% from 3-point range (25-for-61) on the season, the second-highest mark in the Big Ten (Nebraska leads at 41.9%).

UW shot 33.0% from 3-point range a year ago, good for 7th in the Big Ten.

- ► The Badgers shot a blistering 47.8% from 3-point range (11-for-23) in their opening win over St. John's, and followed it up by shooting 45.0% from deep (9-for-20) against Florida.
- ► Wisconsin is tied for third in the Big Ten averaging 8.3 made 3-pointers per game, trailing Minnesota and Michigan.
- ► Individually, UW had at least 4 players hit multiple 3-pointers in each of its first 2 games.

Ben Brust is 5th in the Big Ten averaging 2.3 3-pointers per game.

► Wisconsin has 6 players shooting 37.5% or better from behind the arc (Dukan, Dekker, Brust, Gasser, Jackson and Kaminsky).

TRENDS TO TRACK

- ▶ Dating back to Feb. of 2011, UW has won 59 of its last 60 games when leading or tied with 5:00 left.
- ► UW has won 92 of its last 93 games when shooting a higher FG% than its opponents, including a mark of 18-0 last season.
- ▶ UW has won 43 of its last 44 games when shooting 45% or better from the field, including its opening win over St. John's (46.3%) and a perfect mark of 13-0 in 2012-13.

GUARDING THE GLASS

After graduating three seniors in the frontcourt from a year ago, the Badgers are leaning heavily on the rebounding ability of their guards in 2013-14.

Through 3 games, Wisconsin's top 3 rebounder are all guards - **Ben Brust** 16, **Josh Gasser** 16 and **Traevon Jackson** 14.

- ► UW's starting guard trio has accounted for 46.0% of the Badgers rebounding production.
- ▶ Posting solid rebounding numbers is nothing new for Brust and Gasser. Despite being just 6-foot-1, Brust has 5 career double-doubles and ranked 19th in the Big Ten last year with 5.1 boards per game. Two years ago Gasser finished 4th on the Badgers in rebounding with 4.2 per game and posted the school's first-ever triple-double in 2011.

2013-14 SCHEDULE

▶ Wisconsin's non-conference schedule features three teams in the preseason AP Top 25, including No. 10 Florida, No. 17 Marquette and No. 24 Virginia. The Badgers opening opponent St. John's and their foe in the Cancun Challenge, Saint Louis, also received votes in the preseason poll.

Including Big Ten play, the Badgers are scheduled to play 7 games against teams in the preseason AP Top 25.

▶ UW's schedule will feature at least 13 games against teams who qualified for the 2013 NCAA Tournament field. Overall, the Badgers schedule will have 23 games against teams that competed in the 2013 postseason.

OH, CANADA

- ► The Badgers played a 5-game exhibition tour of Canada in August, visiting Ottawa and Toronto. UW went 4-1 on the trip with wins over Ryerson, Ottawa and two of pro team A-Game Hoops. Wisconsin's set-back came in the first game of the trip to Carleton, who has won 9 of the last 11 national championships.
- ► Sophomore **Sam Dekker** led the Badgers, averaging 19.4 points, 8.2 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game, while shooting 60.0 percent (9-for-15) from 3-point range. Junior **Frank Kaminsky** averaged 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- ► Senior **Ben Brust** and junior **Traevon Jackson** averaged 10.4 points apiece, while sophomore **George Marshall** chipped in 9.0 ppg and junior **Duje Dukan** averaged 8.8 ppg off the bench.
- ► UW shot 51.0% overall from the field and 73.7% from the free throw line (73-for-99).

NEW LEVELS OF WINNING AT UW

- ► The Badgers won 23 games in 2012-13, the 9th-highest single-season win total in school history. Ryan-led teams own each of the top 9 spots in the UW record book for single-season wins.
- ► Ryan's teams have won at least 20 games in 10 of his 12 seasons, including each of the last 7. Illinois (10) is the only other Big Ten team with 10 20-win seasons since 2001-02.

Prior to Ryan's arrival, the Badgers had just four 20-win seasons in 103 years of basketball.

▶ Under Ryan, Wisconsin has <u>never</u> finished lower than 4th in the Big Ten standings. UW's active streak of 12 consecutive seasons in the Big Ten's top 4 is the 2nd-longest in league history and the longest since Purdue had a run of 13 in a row 80 years ago.

- ▶ Wisconsin returns 58.0% of its minutes played from last season. The Badgers will bring back 57.7% of their scoring, 40.3% of their rebounding and 65.2% of their assists.
- ▶ UW returns a pair of players that earned 2013 honorable mention accolades in senior **Ben Brust** and sophomore **Sam Dekker**. Brust, who started all 35 games a year ago, led the Badgers in scoring (11.1 ppg), finished fourth in rebounds (5.1 rpg) and second on the team with 79 assists.

Dekker led all Big Ten reserves in scoring, averaging 9.6 points per game in 22.3 minutes per game. A 2013 Big Ten All-Freshman Team selection last season, Dekker scored in double figures in 9 of UW's final 12 games, including a team-high 14 points in the team's NCAA tournament loss to Ole Miss.

- ▶ Junior **Traevon Jackson** is UW's other returning starter, having opened 29 games for the Badgers last season. A 2013 All-Big Ten Tournament selection, Jackson led the Badgers with 99 assists and 35 steals.
- ► With the graduation of 3 front court starters - Jared Berggren, Mike Bruesewitz and Ryan Evans junior **Frank Kaminsky** will anchor UW's front court. Kaminsky averaged 10.3 minutes and 4.2 points a year ago.

Sophomore guard **George Marshall** is also back after averaging 15.8 minutes and 4.1 points per game as a redshirt freshman last season.

FOUR TO REDSHIRT IN 2013-14

▶ Junior **Jordan Smith** (17 career games), sophomore **Zak Showalter** (22 career games) and a pair of freshmen, **Riley Dearring** and **Aaron Moesch** have all elected to redshirt the 2013-14 season.

ROSTER ADDITIONS IN 2013-14

- ▶ UW will also return a pair of players who sat out all of last season in juniors **Josh Gasser** and **Duje Dukan**. A 2012 Big Ten All-Defensive Team honoree,
 Gasser started 66 games over his first two seasons at UW but missed all of 2012-13 with a torn ACL.
- ► The Badgers welcome a 6-man freshman class in 2013-14, highlighted by ESPN Top-100 recruits guard **Bronson Koenig** (La Crosse, Wis.) and forward **Nigel Hayes** (Toledo, Ohio).

Wisconsin's roster will also feature forwards Vitto Brown (Bowling Green, Ohio) and Aaron Moesch (Green Bay, Wis.) as well as guards Riley Dearring (Minnetonka, Minn.) and Jordan Hill (Pasadena, Calif.).

▶ UW's six-man freshman class is the school's largest freshman class since 2005-06 (Devin Barry, Morris Cain, Kevin Gullikson, Joe Krabbenhoft, Marcus Landry and Mickey Perry). The last time the Badgers had five scholarship true freshmen was in 2008-09 (Jared Berggren, Ryan Evans, lan Markolf, Jordan Taylor and Rob Wilson).

SEASON PREVIEW

- ► Wisconsin begins its 115th season of men's basketball in 2013-14 and the 13th season under head coach Bo Ryan.
- ▶ Ryan is the second-longest tenured head coach in the Big Ten (Tom Izzo, 19th season) and ranks 12th in conference history with 144 career Big Ten wins. With a career record of 144-60 (.706), Ryan owns the highest Big Ten winning percentage among coaches with at least 10 years of experience.
- ▶ Ryan enters his 30th season overall as a head coach, boasting a career record of 674-216 (.757). He currently ranks 35th on the NCAA's all-time wins ledger. Among active Div. 1 coaches with at least 400 career wins, Ryan's .757 win percentage ranks fourth, trailing only Roy Williams (.795), Mike Krzyzewski (.763) and John Calipari (.762).
- ▶ In 2012-13, the Badgers ranked second in the Big Ten and finished 7th nationally by averaging 16,843 per game. Wisconsin has led the Big Ten in attendance in 9 of the last 11 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 13 years.
- ► This season, the Badgers sold out the 2,100-person Grateful Red (the third-largest student section in the Big Ten) in under two hours.

2012-13 LOOK BACK

Record: 23-12 | **Big Ten:** 12-6 (T4th)

- ► Wisconsin advanced to the 2013 NCAA Tournament, finishing with a 23-12 record, including a 12-6 mark (fourth place) in the Big Ten.
- ► The Badgers earned a No. 5 seed in the 2013 NCAA Tournament, their 15th consecutive appearance in the Big Dance. UW lost to Ole Miss in the second round, 57-46.
- ► UW is one of just five schools with an active NCAA tournament streak of at least 15 years, joining: Kansas (24), Duke (18), Michigan State (16) and Gonzaga (15). UW's 15 consecutive NCAA tournament appearances is the third-longest streak in Big Ten history.
- ▶ Wisconsin head coach Bo Ryan was named consensus 2013 Big Ten Coach of the Year for the third time in his career (also 2002 and 2003). Only Gene Keady (7) and Bob Knight (5) have won the honor more times than Ryan.
- ► The Badgers made a run to the 2013 Big Ten Tournament championship game, knocking off 6th-ranked Michigan and No. 3 Indiana in the quarterfinals and semifinals, respectively. UW lost to Ohio State, 50-43, in the title game.

ZACH BOHANNON

5th-Sr. | F | 6-6 | 206 | Marion, Iowa

- ► Has appeared in 56 career games, with 39 coming at Air Force. Transferred to UW in the summer of 2011 and played a total of 80 minutes scoring 17 points in 17 games for UW last season.
- ► Fifth-year walk-on has already earned undergraduate and graduate degrees and is currently pursuing his MBA. Younger brother of former Badger 1,000-point scorer Jason Bohannon (2007-10).

BEN BRUST

Sr. | G | 6-1 | 196 | Hawthorn Woods, III.

► Second on the team averaging 11.3 points per game and is tied for the team lead with 5.3 rebounds per game. He is also second on the team with 7 assists. Has gone 7-for-17 (.412) from 3-point range and has now hit multiple treys in 19 of his last 20 games.

Brust has made 146 career 3-pointers and needs 20 more to crack UW's all-time top-10 list.

- ▶ One of the most prolific 3-point shooters in UW history, Brust earned honorable mention All-Big Ten in 2012-13. Set single-season record with 79 treys last season and ranked 8th in the Big Ten shooting .389 from deep in 2012-13. Also tied single-game record with 7 made 3-pointers on two occasions.
- ▶ Developed into all-around player for UW last season, posting 5 double-doubles and ranking among the team leaders in points (11.1, 1st), rebounds (5.1, 4th), assists (79, 2nd), steals (34, 2nd), ast-to-TO ratio (1st, 2.0) and charges drawn (2nd with 10).
- ► A NASCAR enthusiast, Brust served as a spotter on Brendan Gaughan's team at Road America and was a social media correspondent at the Brickyard 400 this past summer.

DUJE DUKAN

R-Jr. | F | 6-9 | 220 | Deerfield, III.

- ► Has appeared in all 3 games averaging 6.7 ppg in 12.7 minutes per game. Dukan set career highs in points (15), rebounds (5) and minutes played (21) against St. John's. Dukan is shooting 75.0% from 3-point range, connecting on 3-of-4 from long range.
- ► Redshirted in 2012-13 after suffering from mono in the fall. He has appeared in 22 total games and had scored 11 career points entering 2013-14.
- ▶ Born in Split, Croatia and raised in the Chicago area, Dukan grew up in the Bulls locker room as his father, Ivica Dukan, has worked in the team's scouting department since 1992.

EVAN ANDERSON

R-Jr. | C | 6-10 | 245 | Stanley, Wis.

- ► Has appeared in 26 career games, including 12 last season, totaling 73 minutes and 15 career points.
- ► Got engaged in the summer of 2013 and restores old cars as a hobby.

JOSH GASSER

R-Jr. | G | 6-3 | 190 | Port Washington, Wis.

▶ Led the Badgers with 19 points and 8 rebounds in 35 minutes of action vs. St. John's. Gasser made his first shot attempt in 2 years (a 3-pointer) and finished 3-for-5 from behind the arc and a perfect 8-for-8 at the free throw line.

He is 4th on the team averaging 10.0 ppg, tied for the team lead with 5.3 rpg and third on the team with 33.3 minutes per game.

Owns the top mark in the Big Ten, going a perfect 14-of-14 at the free throw line. Is also shooting 40.0% (4-for-10) from 3-point range.

- ► Returns after missing all of last season with a torn left ACL suffered during practice on Oct. 27, 2012. A 2012 Big Ten All-Defensive Team selection, he started 66 games in his first two seasons, including 30 as a true freshman.
- ▶ Owns the only triple-double in school history and first Big Ten freshman to do it since Magic Johnson in 1977 with 10 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists at Northwestern (1/23/11). Shot .452 from 3-point range in 2011-12, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten.
- ► A former high school quarterback, Gasser has earned a reputation as one of the toughest players on the team. During the 2012 NCAA Tournament, Gasser held SEC leading scorer, John Jenkins, to 3-of-13 shooting while battling a flu that kept him out of practice and awake the night before.

TRAEVON JACKSON

Jr. | G | 6-2 | 208 | Westerville, Ohio

► Ranks 3rd on the team averaging 10.3 points and is 5th with 4.7 rebounds per game. Jackson has also led the Badgers in assists in all 3 games.

Made the game-clinching shot in the win over Florida with an elbow jumper with 9.8 seconds left.

- ► A converted 2-guard, Jackson took over the point guard role after Gasser was lost last season. Led the Badgers with 99 assists and 35 steals, earning 2013 All-Big Ten Tournament Team after averaging 11.0 ppg and 3.0 apg during the three games.
- ► Connected on three game-winning or game-tying shots in the final minute last season: game-tying 3-pointer with 29 seconds left to force overtime in a win over Iowa, made game-winning jumper with 2.1 seconds left in win over Minnesota and drained a 25-foot 3-pointer as time expired to win at Penn St.
- ► The son of Ohio State and NBA All-Star Jimmy Jackson, Traevon has trained in each of the last few summers in Ohio with Trey Burke among others.

FRANK KAMINSKY

Jr. | F/C | 7-0 | 234 | Lisle, III.

▶ Led UW with 16 points, the 2nd-highest total of his career, and added career highs with 8 rebounds and 4 blocks. He is now averaging 8.7 points and is tied for the team lead with 5.3 rebounds per game.

Ranks 4th in the Big Ten averagin 2.3 blocks per game and is 10th with 1.7 steals per outing.

- Averaged just 4.2 points and 10.3 minutes per game last season but should step into a feature role in the Badgers' front court. Showed potential with 19 points in 23 min. at Illinois (2/3/13) and a 16-point game (4-4 on 3FGs) against Samford (12/29/12).
- ► Father, Frank is 7th-leading scorer in Lewis Univ. history; mother, Mary, played volleyball at Northwestern; aunt & uncle also played hoops at NW.

GEORGE MARSHALL

R-So. | G | 5-11 | 182 | Chicago, III.

- ► Missed game at Green Bay after suffering a concussion at practice on Nov. 15. Is averaging 12.5 minutes per game off the bench.
- ▶ Played 35 games (6 starts) in 2012-13 as a redshirt freshman. Just the second freshman to start season opener under Bo Ryan (with Devin Harris), he shot 38.% from 3-point range (11th in the Big Ten) and tallied a career-high 20 points in a loss at lowa.
- ► Used friendship with Marty Nesbitt, one of President Obama's closest friends, to facilitate a private team meeting with Obama in 2012.

SAM DEKKER

So. | F | 6-7 | 220 | Sheboygan, Wis.

► Leads UW with 15.0 ppg and is tied for team lead at 5.3 rpg. Has scored in double figures in all 3 games and 12 of his last 15. Shooting 44.4% (4-for-9) from 3-point range in 34.3 minutes per game.

With UW trailing 16-4 vs. Florida, Dekker hit back-to-back 3-pointers and scored 10 points over the next 6 minutes to fuel the Badgers' comeback.

BIG TEN, BIG RESULTS

- Since Bo Ryan took over in 2001, Wisconsin has been arguably the best team in the Big Ten. Ryan's clubs have won five Big Ten championships (3 regular season and 2 tournament). Only Ohio State (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourney) has won more titles during Ryan's tenure. Illinois also has 5 titles, but no other Big Ten school has more than 3 rings over that span.
- Ryan's teams have posted a 144-60 (.706) Big Ten record, the best mark in the conference over the last 12 seasons. Michigan St. is second at 137-67 (.672) and Ohio St. is third at 135-69 (.662).
- ► Last season, Wisconsin posted a 12-6 record in the Big Ten, finishing in fourth place. The Badgers have notched double-digit conference wins in 11 of 12 years under Bo Ryan and have never finished lower than fourth place in the Big Ten standings.

UW has posted a winning conference record in each of the last 13 seasons. Among the 6 major conferences, only Kansas (23 seasons) has a longer active streak of finishing above .500 in league play.

ALL WE DO IS WIN, WIN, WIN

Over the last seven seasons (since 2006-07), Wisconsin has accumulated an overall record of 179-64 (.737). That win total and percentage puts the Badgers in pretty exclusive company.

Wisconsin's .737 win percentage ranks 15th among all NCAA Div. I teams in that span.

- ▶ UW has qualified for the NCAA tournament in each of Bo Ryan's 12 seasons in Madison, posting a 16-12 record over that span. Under Ryan, UW has won at least one game in 10 of the 12 NCAA appearances. Among Big Ten teams, only MSU (23) has won more NCAA tourney games than UW since 2001-02.
- ▶ UW has made 15 consecutive NCAA tourneys one of just six schools with an active streak of at least 14 years: Kansas (24), Duke (18), Michigan State (16) and Gonzaga (15).
- ▶ Wisconsin has advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2 of the last 3 seasons and 3 of the last 6.

► Only Kansas (5), Michigan State (5), Duke (4), Louisville (4), North Carolina (4), Ohio State (4) and Syracuse (4) have been to more Sweet 16s in the last 6 years than UW (3).

- ◆ In Bo Ryan's 12 seasons as Wisconsin's head coach, the Badgers have compiled a 182-18 (.910) record at the Kohl Center, including an 91-11 (.892) record in Big Ten home games.
- ◆ In Ryan's first 10 seasons, the Badgers lost at TOTAL of 11 home games. UW has lost 7 in the last two seasons.
- ◆ Four of the eight longest home winning streaks in UW history have happened with Bo Ryan on the sidelines, including the school-record 38-game winning streak from 2002 to 2005.
- ◆ Over the last 13 seasons, 135 of the Badgers' 182 home wins have come by at least 10 points (74.2 percent).

◆ With 294 wins, Bo Ryan has surpassed Hall of Famer Harold "Bud" Foster (265) to become UW's all-time career wins leader. Ryan needs 15 Big Ten wins to supplant Meanwell (158 wins) as the school's leader in conference wins.

- Ryan set the UW wins record in just 365 games and 11 seasons.
 Foster reached the milestone in 532 games and 25 seasons.
- ◆ Bo Ryan became the 56th NCAA coach to reach the 600-win plateau and is 1 of just 9 active Division I coaches to reach that hallowed ground. Ryan's career winning percentage of .758 is 3rd only to North Carolina's Roy Williams (.797) and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (.763) among active coaches with 600 wins. Among all-time coaches with 600 career wins (regardless of NCAA classification), Ryan's winning percentage ranks 10th.
- Ryan tied legendary Indiana coach Branch McCracken as the 2nd-fastest coach in conference history to record 100 Big Ten wins, doing so in 140 games. Only Bob Knight did it faster (131 games).
- Ryan's .706 (144-60) win percentage in conference games is the 2nd-best mark in Big Ten history, trailing only OSU's Thad Matta (111-45, .712) and surpassing legend Indiana coach Bob Knight (353-151, .700).
- ◆ Indiana's Bob Knight (327) and Purdue's Ward Lambert (331) are the only coaches in Big Ten history to reach 250 wins faster than Bo Ryan, who did it in 343 games.
- ◆ Ryan won his third Big Ten Coach of the Year honor in 2013. Only Purdue's Gene Keady (7) and Indiana's Bob Knight (5) have won the honor more times than Ryan.

With 294 wins, Ryan is the all-time wins leader in Wisconsin history, surpassing Hall of Famer Bud Foster (265). Prior to Ryan's hire at UW in 2001-02, the Badgers had four 19-win seasons (high of 22) in 103 years.

Including last season, Ryan has now led the UW to at least 19 wins in each of his 12 seasons at UW and owns 10 seasons of 20+ wins. In fact, Ryan's teams have accounted for the 9 winningest seasons in school annals.

Wisconsin has averaged 24.3 wins per season during the Ryan era, including a school-record 31 wins in 2007-08.

Big Ten Record

UW pre-Bo Ryan: 607-757 (.445) UW with Bo Ryan: 144-61 (.706)

In the first 96 years of Big Ten play, Wisconsin won at least 11 Big Ten games 9 times (including just once since 1941). Including this season, Ryan has led the Badgers to at least 11 conference wins in 10 of his 12 seasons. He was the first Big Ten coach to win at least 11 league games in each of his first four years.

Ryan has led Wisconsin to a 144-60 (.706) record in Big Ten play, owning the 2nd-highest winning percentage of any coach in Big Ten history.

Ryan is the fastest coach in UW history to reach 100 Big Ten wins, doing so in 140 games. That also ties Branch McCracken as the 2nd-fastest in conference history. Only Bob Knight (131 games) did it faster.

UW has finished among the top 4 in the Big Ten in each of Ryan's 11 seasons. That 11-year stretch of top-4 finishes is the 2nd-longest in Big Ten history, trailing only Purdue's run of 13 in a row from 1920-32.

NCAA Tournament Record

UW pre-Bo Ryan: 7 appearances / 9-6 UW with Ryan: 12 appearances / 16-12

Wisconsin made seven appearances in the first 63 years of the NCAA tournament. Since Bo Ryan took over as head coach, the Badgers have earned 12 consecutive tournament bids and advanced to the Sweet 16 five times.

UW has won 16 NCAA tournament games under Ryan, surpassing the Badgers' total of 9 in the 63 years prior to Ryan.

Wisconsin Coaching Staff

BO RYANHEAD COACH

When Bo Ryan took over as head coach at Wisconsin in 2002, he was promptly dubbed Big Ten Coach of the Year in each of his first two seasons. Last year, his 12th at UW, Ryan proved he is still



thought of in the same light, collecting the third Big Ten Coach of the Year award of his career.

Now as Ryan enters his 30th season as a head coach in 2013-14 - his 13th atop the Wisconsin program - it's difficult to decide which is more impressive, his incredible longevity or his unparalleled success. It is, however, safe to say that the combination of the two is what elevates Ryan among college basketball's elite.

Owning the most wins in UW annals (291 entering 2013-14), Ryan is also one of just 40 coaches in NCAA history to reach the 650-career win plateau. Ryan's career winning percentage of .757 (674-216) is seventh all-time among coaches with 600 career wins.

A member of five Halls of Fame, Ryan has been enshrined into the Wilkes College Athletic HOF (2003), the Delaware County Chapter of the Pennsylvania Sports HOF (2008), the Pennsylvania Sports HOF (2011), the Wis. Basketball Coaches Assoc. HOF (2011) and the Wis. Intercollegiate Athletic Conference HOF (2012).
