#### **UP NEXT: UW TRAVELS TO MEXICO FOR TWO GAMES**

- ▶ Winners of six straight, the Badgers will play an international regular season game for just the second time in history when they take on Saint Louis in the Cancun Challenge on Tuesday, No. 26. The game will be televised on CBS College Sports beginning at 7:30 p.m. UW will play either West Virginia or Old Dominion on Nov. 27.
- ▶ Up next, Wisconsin returns to the mainland, but travels to Charlottesville, Va. to play Virginia in the 2013 Big Ten/ACC Challenge. The Badgers are 6-8 all-time in the Challenge, but lost a rare home game to UVA last season.

#### **KEY NOTES TO CONSIDER**

- **1 GOOD START:** The Badgers are off to a 6-0 start for the second time in the last three years, equaling the school's best start of the Bo Ryan era. UW has not opened the season with seven consecutive wins since starting 11-0 in 1993-94.
- **2 TAKING OFFENSE:** UW is averaging 80.2 points per game, up from 65.0 a year ago and leads the Big Ten shooting 49.4% from the field and 45.2% from 3-point range. For perspective, last season the Badgers shot 42.0% overall and 33.0% from deep.
- **3** FRANKLY, KAMINSKY IS BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Junior Frank
  Kaminsky averaged 26.0 points per game in three contests last week, earning Big Ten
  Player of the Week honors. Kaminsky scored a UW single-game record 43 points vs. North Dakota on Nov. 19 and ranks among the conference's top 10 in scoring (17.3), FG% (.582), 3FG% (.550) and FT% (.833).
- **4 DEKKER DRAWING ATTENTION:** Sophomore Sam Dekker has been named to the preseason Top-50 lists of both the Wooden and Naismith Player of the Year awards. Dekker has scored in double figures in every game this season, averaging 14.7 points, 4.2 rebounds while shooting 35.0% from 3-point range.
- **5 POLL POSITION:** The Badgers moved up to No. 10 in the latest AP Top 25 poll. UW is also ranked No. 11 in the Coaches Poll. Wisconsin's No. 10 AP ranking is its highest since being ranked No. 9 in the Nov. 28, 2011 poll.
- **6** BALANCING ACT: Four different players have led the Badgers in scoring through 6 games this season and the Badgers are the only team in the Big Ten to have 5 players averaging in double figures.

#### **BADGERS GOING INTERNATIONAL**

- ▶ Wisconsin has played just one regular season game outside of United Stats territory, when it traveled to Ottawa, Canada to play a neutral site game against Memphis in the 1996-97 season opener. The Badgers won the game, 49-46.
- ▶ UW has also played holiday tournaments in both the U.S. Virgin Islands and San Juan, Puerto Rico. The Badgers went 2-1 in the 1989 San Juan Shootout, went 3-0 to win the 2005 Paradise Jam in St. Thomas and finished 2-1 to take runner-up in the 2008 Paradise Jam Tournament.
- ▶ Wisconsin also played a 5-game, 8-day exhibition tour of Canada this August, going 4-1 against Canadian colleges and pro teams in Ottawa and Toronto.

# **UW IN HOLIDAY TOURNEYS**

► In Bo Ryan's first 12 seasons at UW, the Badgers have played in a non-conference holiday tournament eight times, owning a combined record of 14-7. Wisconsin won the 2005 Paradise Jam in the U.S. Virgin Islands and took the 2011 Chicago Invitational title in 2012.

#### **ALL-TIME VS. SAINT LOUIS**

- ► Wisconsin and Saint Louis will meet for the fifth time in history on Tuesday with the all-time series deadlocked at 2-2. The teams have not met since 1989 when the Bilikens earned a 73-68 win in Madison in the second round of the NIT.
- ► UW is 9-5 all-time against members of the Atlantic-10 Conference. The Badgers' most recent match up with the conference was an 76-64 win over Richmond in the opening round of the 2004 NCAA Tournament in Milwaukee, Wis.

## **ALL-TIME VS. WEST VIRGINIA**

- ► UW and West Virginia have played 3 times with the Badgers owning a 2-1 lead in the all-time series. Wisconsin won the most recent meeting, 69-62, in Morgantown, West Virginia on Dec. 19, 1973.
- ► The Badgers are 20-17 all-time against members of the Big 12 Conference, including a 70-65 win over Kansas State in the second round of the 2011 NCAA Tournament in the most recent meeting.

#### **ALL-TIME VS. OLD DOMINION**

- ► The Badgers have faced Old Dominion just one time in history, pulling out an 84-81 win at the Kohl Center on Nov. 21, 2005.
- ► Wisconsin is 6-6 all-time against teams from Conference USA with the last such match-up was a 78-52 home win over Louisiana Tech one month after beating Old Dominion.

# **NOTES FROM UW'S LAST GAME**

#### #12 WIS 76, ORU 67 - 11/23/13 - Kohl Center

- ► A 76-67 win over Oral Roberts pushed Wisconsin to 6-0 and equaled its best start of the Bo Ryan era. UW was also 6-0 to open the 2011-12 season.
- ► For the third time on the season, the Badgers finished with 5 players scoring in double figures:

  Frank Kaminsky (21), Josh Gasser (15), Ben Brust (12), Traevon Jackson (11) and Sam Dekker (10).

  UW had 5 players in double digits a TOTAL of 3

times all of last season.

- ► The Badgers shot just 30.4% (7-23) from 3-point range, but went 15-for-18 at the free throw line and out-scored ORU 34-22 in the paint. UW also converted 12 offensive rebounds into a 15-2 advantage in second-chance points. ORU had just 3 offensive boards.
- ► UW jumped out to a 9-0 lead and built a 17-point cushion midway through the first half. ORU closed with 4, 66-62, with 3:18 left. However the Badgers made their final 8 free throws, going 6-for-6 in the final minute.
- ► **Brust** led UW with 8 rebounds, while **Jackson** dished a team-high 7 assists.

# **UW IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY**

- ▶ Under Bo Ryan (since 2001-02), Wisconsin owns an overall record of 123-30 (.804) in nonconference games, including a mark of 94-7 (.931) at the Kohl Center.
- ► A year ago, the Badgers reached 9 nonconference wins for the 11th-consecutive season. UW has averaged 10.5 non-conference wins under Bo Ryan.

#### STARTING SOMETHING

Wisconsin is off to a 6-0 start for the 2nd time in the last 3 years, equaling the team's best start in Bo Ryan's 13 seasons. The Badgers also started 6-0 in open the 2011-12 season before losing at then-No. 5 North Carolina, 60-57.

# **POLL CLIMBING**

- ▶ With a perfect 6-0 start, the Badgers have climbed to No. 10 in the AP Top 25 and No. 13 in the Coaches Poll.
- ▶ Wisconsin was last ranked in the AP top-10 when it checked in at No. 9 in the Nov. 28, 2011 poll before losing at No. 5 North Carolina, 60-57, and dropping a home game to No. 16 Marquette, 61-54, that week.
- ► In Bo Ryan's 13 seasons, the Badgers have spent a total of 27 weeks in the AP top-10, climbing as high as No. 1 on Feb. 19, 2007.

**RECORD-SETTING WIN OVER UND** 

- ▶ Wisconsin topped the 100-point mark for the first time since a 105-70 win over Eastern Illinois on Dec. 28, 1995.
- ► Kaminsky scored a Wisconsin school-record 43 points on 16-for-19 shooting (6-for-6 from 3-point range and 5-for-6 at the free throw line). Kaminsky's total surpassed the record of 42 held by Ken Barnes (vs. Indiana, 3/8/65) and Michael Finley (at Eastern Michigan, 12/10/94).
- ► Kaminsky's 43 points are the most scored by a Division I player this season. (more on Page 4)
- ► UW scored 55 points in the first half, its most since scoring 58 in the second half of a 99-55 win over Prairie View A&M on Nov. 14, 2010.
- ► The Badgers finished 12-for-20 from 3-point range (.600), shooting at least 60.0% from distance for the first time since hitting 15 of 25 (.600) vs. Kennesaw State on Nov. 12, 2011.
- ► Sophomore **Sam Dekker** matched his career high with 19 points, while **Traevon Jackson** added 14 points and **Ben Brust** had 10.

### **TAKING OFFENSE**

Wisconsin reached triple digits in a 103-85 win over North Dakota on Tuesday for the first time since 1995. UW followed that up with an 88-point performance against Bowling Green.

On the season, the Badgers have scored 80+ points in 3 of their first 6 games. A year ago, UW reached 80 points a total of 5 times in 35 games.

UW is 54-4 all-time under Bo Ryan when scoring 80+ points in a game.

- ► Through 6 games, the Badgers rank 5th in the Big Ten averaging 80.2 points per game, an increase of 15.2 ppg from last season's 65.0-point average. UW hasn't averaged 80 points in a season since the 1971-72 team scored 80.0 per game.
- ► Wisconsin ranks 14th in the nation and tops in the Big Ten, shooting 45.2% from 3-point range. A year ago, the Badgers shot 33.0% from deep.

UW shot 60.0% (12-for-20) from 3-point range in back-to-back games against North Dakota and Bowling Green, the first time pulling off that feat since at least the 1998-99 season.

- ► The Badgers also lead the Big Ten shooting 49.4% from the field after shooting .420 a year ago.
- ► A year after finishing last in the conference, UW now leads the Big Ten in free throw shooting, connecting at a 75.4% clip from the stripe.

#### **FASTER AND MORE EFFICIENT**

Wisconsin is utilizing a three-guard starting lineup in 2013-14 and, perhaps not coincidentally, is playing at a faster and more efficient pace than at any time during the Bo Ryan era.

- ► According to STATS, Inc., the Badgers had 73 offensive possessions in its 103-85 win over North Dakota, the team's most possessions since an 82-58 loss at Duke on Nov. 27, 2007.
- ► UW is averaging 67.5 possessions per game on the year, which would be the highest of the Ryan era, surpassing the previous high of 67.0 in 2005-06.
- ► Wisconsin is also enjoying its most efficient team in the last 13 seasons (Ryan era), averaging 1.23 points per possession good for 2nd in the Big Ten (lowa leads at 1.25).

### **TRIPLE THREAT**

▶ UW is 14th in the nation and tops in the Big Ten shooting a sizzling 45.2% from 3-point range (56-for-124). Among Big Ten teams, Northwestern is a distant 2nd from long range, shooting 39.4%.

UW shot 33.0% from 3-point range a year ago, good for 7th in the Big Ten.

- ► The Badgers have shot 60.0% from long range twice this season and connected on at least 45% or better in 4 of their 6 games: vs. St. John's (47.8%, 11-23); vs. Florida (45.0%, 9-20); vs. UND (60.0%, 12-20) and vs. Bowling Green (60.0% 12-20).
- ► Wisconsin is also 2nd in the Big Ten averaging 9.3 made 3-pointers per game, trailing only Michigan (10.2 per game).
- ► Individually, UW has 7 players shooting 38.5% or better from behind the arc, including 3 of the Big Ten's top 12 shooters.

▶ **Ben Brust** has hit multiple triples in all 6 games this season, including a season-high 6 against Bowling Green. He ranks 2nd in the Big Ten averaging 2.7 3-pointers per game and **Kaminsky** is 12th in the conference averaging 1.8 per game.

#### DEFENSE WITHOUT FOULING

- ► Even with the new defensive emphasis from officials, the Badgers are again among the nation's best at defending without fouling. UW is averaging just 15.7 fouls per game, which ranks 16th in the nation.
- ► UW's opponents are averaging just 14.0 free throw attempts this season, the lowest per game average in the Big Ten.
- ▶ By comparison, UW finished 3rd in the nation averaging 14.0 fouls per game in 2012-13 and opponents shot an average of 13.9 FTs per game.

# FRANKLY, KAMINSKY SET RECORD

Junior **Frank Kaminsky** earned Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Nov. 25 after scoring a Wisconsin school-record 43 points on 16-for-19 shooting (6-for-6 from 3-point range) against North Dakota on Nov. 19. Kaminsky's total surpassed the record of 42 held by Ken Barnes (vs. Indiana, 3/8/65) and Michael Finley (at Eastern Michigan, 12/10/94).

- ► Kaminsky's 43 points are the most scored by a Division I player this season.
- ► Kaminsky's 43 points matches the 43 scored by Illinois' Brandon Paul against OSU (1/10/12) as the most by a Big Ten player since 1996-97. In fact, Kaminsky and Paul are two of only four 40-point efforts by a Big Ten player in that span, joining Minnesota's Andre Hollins (41 vs. Memphis, 11/23/12) and Ohio State's Jared Sullinger (40 vs. IUPUI, 12/9/10).
- ► Kaminsky is the first Badgers player to score at least 30+ points since Rob Wilson had 30 vs. Indiana in the 2012 Big Ten Tournament on March 9, 2012.
- ► Kaminsky set the UW single-game record in just 28 minutes. Since 1996-97, Kaminsky is one of just 4 players to have scored 43 points against a Div. 1 opponent in 28 minutes or less: Ed Gray (Cal) had 48 vs. Washington State in 1997, Brian Burke (Lafayette) had 43 vs. Lehigh in 2002 and Stephen Curry (Davidson) had 43 vs. Appalachian State in 2009.
- ► Kaminsky is one of just four Division I players since 1996-97 to score 43 points and shoot at least 84.0 percent from the field in a game.
- ► Kaminsky and Chris Kaman are the only 7-foot Division I players to score 40-plus points in a game over the last 15 seasons. Kaman had 43 points for Central Michigan in a win over Ball State (2/19/03).

#### **KOHL CENTER AMONG TOUGHEST**

Wisconsin has only lost a TOTAL of 18 home games in the Bo Ryan era.

In 13 seasons under Ryan, the Badgers are an incredible 185-18 (.911) at the Kohl Center. UW's .911 winning percentage since 2001-02 is good for 4th in the nation. Only Duke, Kansas and Gonzaga have better home records in that span (pg 10).

- ► Three of UW's 5 longest home win streaks have come under Bo Ryan, including the school-record 38 straight from 12/7/2002 to 1/25/2005.
- Over the last 12 years, 136 of the Badgers' 183 home wins have come by at least 10 points (74.5%).
- ▶ UW's win over Bowling Green on Nov. 21 marked the 250th men's basketball game at the Kohl Center. UW is 220-30 (.880) overall in the building.

#### FREE THROW IMPROVEMENT

- ► Last season, Wisconsin ranked last in the Big Ten shooting just 63.4% at the free throw line. This year, UW leads the Big Ten shooting .754 from the stripe, going 101-for-134.
- ► UW has <u>made</u> more free throws (101) than their opponents have <u>attempted</u> (84) this season.
- ▶ In the Badgers first game of the 2013-14 season, they made 25-of-30 free throws (83.3%), including each of their final 14 attempts.
- ► Since Bo Ryan joined the Badgers in 2001, UW is 95-19 (.833) when attempting 25+ free throws in a game, including 3-0 this season and 6-0 a year ago.
- ▶ **Ben Brust** is 2nd in the Big Ten shooting 93.8% at the free throw line (15-16). **Josh Gasser** is 3rd going 24-26 (.923) at the line while **Frank Kaminsky** ranks 8th at 83.3% (15-18).

### **ROAD WARRIORS**

Under Bo Ryan, Wisconsin is renowned for its incredible home record, but the Badgers have also enjoyed remarkable success on the road.

► Since Bo Ryan was hired in 2001, Wisconsin has been the Big Ten's best road team, owning the most true road wins (68) and best road win percentage (.507) in the conference.

In fact, in that era Wisconsin is the only Big Ten team with a road record of .500 or better.

- ► UW has won 94 of its last 95 games when shooting a higher FG% than its opponents, including a mark of 4-0 this season and 18-0 last season.
- ▶ UW has won 46 of its last 47 games when shooting 45% or better from the field, including wins over St. John's (46.3%), North Dakota (59.3%), Bowling Green (54.9%) and Oral Roberts (47.4%) as well as a perfect mark of 13-0 in 2012-13.

#### WRECKING THE RANKED

▶ With its 59-53 win over No. 11 Florida, Wisconsin improved to 31-11 (.738) at home under Bo Ryan against AP Top-25 teams.

That includes a sparkling 21-6 mark against teams ranked in the top 15.

Dating back to last season, the Badgers have 4 straight home games against ranked teams. Overall, UW has won 8 of its last 12 games against the top 25.

- Last season, UW posted seven wins over teams ranked in the AP Top-25 (7-6 overall), with all 7 wins coming vs. teams ranked in the top 15.
- ► UW's 7 victories against teams ranked in the top 15 was the most in the country, tied with Indiana.

### **GUARDING THE GLASS**

► After graduating three seniors in the frontcourt from a year ago, the Badgers are leaning heavily on the rebounding ability of their guards in 2013-14.

Through 6 games, Wisconsin's starting guards are 3 of the team's top 4 rebounders - **Ben Brust** 6.3, **Josh Gasser** 5.5 and **Traevon Jackson** 4.5 - have accounted for 50.5% of UW's rebounding production.

▶ Posting solid rebounding numbers is nothing new for Brust and Gasser. Despite being just 6-foot-1, Brust has 5 career double-doubles and ranked 19th in the Big Ten last year with 5.1 boards per game. He currently leads UW and ranks 20th in the conference with 6.0 boards per game.

Two years ago Gasser finished 4th on the Badgers in rebounding with 4.2 per game and posted the school's first-ever triple-double in 2011.

## **2013-14 SCHEDULE**

▶ Wisconsin's non-conference schedule features three teams in the preseason AP Top 25, including No. 10 Florida, No. 17 Marquette and No. 24 Virginia. The Badgers opening opponent St. John's and their foe in the Cancun Challenge, Saint Louis, also received votes in the preseason poll.

Including Big Ten play, the Badgers are scheduled to play 7 games against teams in the preseason AP Top 25.

▶ UW's schedule features at least 13 games vs. teams who qualified for the 2013 NCAA Tournament field. Overall, the Badgers schedule will have 23 games vs. teams who competed in the 2013 postseason.

## OH, CANADA

- ► The Badgers played a 5-game exhibition tour of Canada in August, visiting Ottawa and Toronto. UW went 4-1 on the trip with wins over Ryerson, Ottawa and two of pro team A-Game Hoops. Wisconsin's set-back came in the first game of the trip to Carleton, who has won 9 of the last 11 national championships.
- ► Sophomore **Sam Dekker** led the Badgers, averaging 19.4 points, 8.2 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game, while shooting 60.0 percent (9-for-15) from 3-point range. Junior **Frank Kaminsky** averaged 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- ► Senior **Ben Brust** and junior **Traevon Jackson** averaged 10.4 points apiece, while sophomore **George Marshall** chipped in 9.0 ppg and junior **Duje Dukan** averaged 8.8 ppg off the bench.
- ► UW shot 51.0% overall from the field and 73.7% from the free throw line (73-for-99).

#### **2013-14 TEAM INFO**

Starters Returning/Lost: 2/3 Letterwinners Returning/Lost: 11/5

- ▶ Wisconsin returns 58.0% of its minutes played from last season, 57.7% of its scoring, 40.3% of its rebounding and 65.2% of its assists.
- ▶ UW returns a pair of players that earned 2013 honorable mention accolades in senior **Ben Brust** and sophomore **Sam Dekker**. Brust, who started all 35 games a year ago, led the Badgers in scoring (11.1 ppg), finished fourth in rebounds (5.1 rpg) and second on the team with 79 assists.

Dekker led all Big Ten reserves in scoring, averaging 9.6 points per game in 22.3 minutes per game. A 2013 Big Ten All-Freshman Team selection last season, Dekker scored in double figures in 9 of UW's final 12 games, including a team-high 14 points in the team's NCAA tournament loss to Ole Miss.

- ▶ Junior **Traevon Jackson** is UW's other returning starter, having opened 29 games for the Badgers last season. A 2013 All-Big Ten Tournament selection, Jackson led the Badgers with 99 assists and 35 steals.
- ► With the graduation of 3 front court starters Jared Berggren, Mike Bruesewitz and Ryan Evans junior **Frank Kaminsky** anchors UW's front court. Kaminsky averaged 10.3 min. and 4.2 ppg a year ago.

Sophomore guard **George Marshall** is also back after averaging 15.8 minutes and 4.1 points per game as a redshirt freshman last season.

#### **ROSTER ADDITIONS IN 2013-14**

- ▶ UW will also return a pair of players who sat out all of last season in juniors **Josh Gasser** and **Duje Dukan**. A 2012 Big Ten All-Defensive Team honoree,
  Gasser started 66 games over his first two seasons at UW but missed all of 2012-13 with a torn ACL.
- ► The Badgers welcome a 6-man freshman class in 2013-14, highlighted by ESPN Top-100 recruits guard **Bronson Koenig** (La Crosse, Wis.) and forward **Nigel Hayes** (Toledo, Ohio).

UW's roster also features forwards Vitto Brown (Bowling Green, Ohio) and Aaron Moesch (Green Bay, Wis.) as well as guards Riley Dearring (Minnetonka, Minn.) and Jordan Hill (Pasadena, Calif.).

## **FOUR TO REDSHIRT IN 2013-14**

▶ Junior **Jordan Smith** (17 career games), sophomore **Zak Showalter** (22 career games) and a pair of freshmen, **Riley Dearring** and **Aaron Moesch** have all elected to redshirt the 2013-14 season.

# **2012-13 LOOK BACK** 23-12, 12-6 (T4th)

- ► Wisconsin advanced to the 2013 NCAA Tournament, finishing with a 23-12 record, including a 12-6 mark (fourth place) in the Big Ten.
- ► The Badgers earned a No. 5 seed in the 2013 NCAA Tournament, their 15th consecutive appearance in the Big Dance. UW lost to Ole Miss in the second round, 57-46.
- ▶ Wisconsin head coach Bo Ryan was named consensus 2013 Big Ten Coach of the Year for the third time in his career (also 2002 and 2003). Only Gene Keady (7) and Bob Knight (5) have won the honor more times than Ryan.

# **Noting the Badgers**

# BEN BRUST Sr. | G | 6-1 | 196 Hawthorn Woods, III.

► Third on the team averaging 12.5 points per game and leads the team with 6.3 rebounds per game. He is also second on the team with 15 assists.

Brust ranks 12 in the Big Ten going 16-for-35 (.457) from 3-point range and has now hit multiple treys in all 6 games this season and 22 of his last 23 games. His 2.7 triples per game is 2nd in the Big Ten.

Brust has made 15 career 3-pointers and needs 11 more to crack UW's all-time top-10 list.

- ▶ One of the most prolific 3-point shooters in UW history, Brust earned honorable mention All-Big Ten in 2012-13. Set single-season record with 79 treys last season and ranked 8th in the Big Ten shooting .389 from deep in 2012-13. Also tied single-game record with 7 made 3-pointers on two occasions.
- ▶ Developed into all-around player for UW last season, posting 5 double-doubles and ranking among the team leaders in points (11.1, 1st), rebounds (5.1, 4th), assists (79, 2nd), steals (34, 2nd), ast-to-TO ratio (1st, 2.0) and charges drawn (2nd with 10).
- ► A NASCAR enthusiast, Brust served as a spotter on Brendan Gaughan's team at Road America and was a social media correspondent at the Brickyard 400 this past summer.

# GEORGE MARSHALL R-So. | G | 5-11 | 182 Chicago, III.

► Has missed each of the last 4 games after sustaining a concussion at practice on Nov. 15. Averaged 12.5 minutes per game off the bench in UW's first 2 contests.

- ▶ Played 35 games (6 starts) in 2012-13 as a redshirt freshman. Just the second freshman to start season opener under Bo Ryan (with Devin Harris), he shot 38.% from 3-point range (11th in the Big Ten) and tallied a career-high 20 points in a loss at lowa.
- ► Used friendship with Marty Nesbitt, one of President Obama's closest friends, to facilitate a private team meeting with Obama in 2012.

# 10 NIGEL HAYES Fr. | F | 6-7 | 250 Toledo, Ohio

► Has appeared in all 6 games this season as a true freshman, averaging 14.7 minutes per game. He is 11-for-19 from the field (.579), while averaging 4.5 points and 1.3 rebounds per game.

- ► Scored 8 points and grabbed 2 rebounds in 18 minutes vs. Florida and added 6 points with 2 blocks at Green Bay.
- ► An ESPN Top-100 recruit, Hayes averaged 15.4 points, 8.7 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 2.2. blocks per game as a senior at Toledo Whitmer High School.

# TRAEVON JACKSON Jr. | G | 6-2 | 208 Westerville, Ohio

- ► Ranks 4th on the team averaging 11.7 points, leads the team with 4.7 assists per game and is 4th with 4.5 rebounds per game.
- ▶ Jackson has led the Badgers in assists in 5 of 6 games this season, ranking 5th in the Big Ten with 4.7 per game. His 2.2 assist-to-turnover ratio (28 to 13) is 11th in the conference.
- ► Jackson made the game-clinching shot in the win over Florida with an elbow jumper with 9.8 seconds left.
- ► A converted 2-guard, Jackson took over the point guard role after Gasser was lost last season. Led the Badgers with 99 assists and 35 steals, earning 2013 All-Big Ten Tournament Team after averaging 11.0 ppg and 3.0 apg during the three games.
- ► Connected on three game-winning or game-tying shots in the final minute last season: game-tying 3-pointer with 29 seconds left to force overtime in a win over Iowa, made game-winning jumper with 2.1 seconds left in win over Minnesota and drained a 25-foot 3-pointer as time expired to win at Penn St.
- ► The son of Ohio State and NBA All-Star Jimmy Jackson, Traevon has trained in each of the last few summers in Ohio with Trey Burke among others.

# 13 DUJE DUKAN R-Jr. | F | 6-9 | 220 Deerfield, III.

- ► Has appeared in all 6 games averaging 9.3 minutes off the bench. Dukan is averaging 4.5 points and 2.2 rebounds per game. He is shooting 40.0% from 3-point range on the season, connecting on 4-of-10 from deep and 5-for-6 at the free throw line.
- ▶ Dukan set career highs in points (15), rebounds (5) and minutes played (21) against St. John's in the season opener. Dukan went 2-for-3 from 3-point range and 5-for-6 at the line that night.
- ► Redshirted in 2012-13 after suffering from mono in the fall. He has appeared in 22 total games and had scored 11 career points entering 2013-14.
- ▶ Born in Split, Croatia and raised in the Chicago area, Dukan grew up in the Bulls locker room as his father, Ivica Dukan, has worked in the team's scouting department since 1992.

- ▶ With UW trailing 16-4 vs. Florida, Dekker hit back-to-back 3-pointers and scored 10 points over the next 6 minutes to fuel the Badgers' comeback.

- ► Coming off a missed season due to a torn ACL, Gasser is 2nd on the team averaging 32.0 minutes per game. He ranks 5th on the team in scoring (10.7 ppg) and is 2nd with 5.5 rpg.
- ► Gasser ranks 3rd in the Big Ten and 2nd on the team at the free throw line, shooting 92.3% (24-26). His 24 made FTs is tied with Ben Brust for the team lead. He is also shooting 37.5% (6-for-16) from 3-point range.
- ► Led the Badgers with 19 points and 8 rebounds in 35 minutes of action during the season opener vs. St. John's. Gasser made his first shot attempt in 2 years (a 3-pointer) and finished 3-for-5 from behind the arc and a perfect 8-for-8 at the free throw line.
- ► Returns after missing all of last season with a torn left ACL suffered during practice on Oct. 27, 2012. A 2012 Big Ten All-Defensive Team selection, he started 66 games in his first two seasons, including 30 as a true freshman.
- ▶ Owns the only triple-double in school history and first Big Ten freshman to do it since Magic Johnson in 1977 with 10 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists at Northwestern (1/23/11). Shot .452 from 3-point range in 2011-12, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten.
- ► A former high school quarterback, Gasser has earned a reputation as one of the toughest players on the team. During the 2012 NCAA Tournament, Gasser held SEC leading scorer, John Jenkins, to 3-of-13 shooting while battling a flu that kept him out of practice and awake the night before.

- ► Has appeared in 5 games as a true freshman, averaging 17.8 minutes per game, the most among UW reserves.
- ► Is averaging 4.4 points, 1.0 rebound and 1.2 assists per game, while shooting 69.2% from the field (9-13) and 66.7% (4-6) from 3-point range.
- ► Saw first extended time in the 3rd game of the season posting 7 points and 2 assists in 23 minutes at Green Bay.
- ► Enjoyed a career-high 10 points vs. Bowling Green, going 4-for-6 from the field and 2-for-3 from outside the arc. Also added 3 rebounds and 2 assists in 27 minutes.

- ► Ranks among the Big Ten's top 10 in several categories: 7th in points (17.3), 5th in FG% (.582), 4th in 3FG% (.550), 9th in FT% (.833) and 7th in blocks per game (1.7).
- ► Scored UW school-record 43 points vs. North Dakota, going 16-for-19 from the field and a perfect 6-for-6 from 3-point range in just 28 minutes. His 43 points is the most in Div. 1 this season and equals the most by a Big Ten player since at least 1996-97.

- ► Has scored in double figures in 4 straight games, including a team-high 21 points and 6 boards in UW's win over Oral Roberts (Nov. 23).
- ► Has raised his scoring average 13.1 point per game this season after averaging just 4.2 ppg a year ago. That is the biggest scoring increase of any player in the Big Ten.

▶ Ryan's teams have won at least 20 games in 10 of his 12 seasons at UW. Illinois (10) is the only other Big Ten team with 10 20-win seasons since 2001-02. Prior to Ryan's arrival, the Badgers had just four 20-win seasons in 103 years of basketball.

#### **BIG TEN, BIG RESULTS**

- ▶ Since Bo Ryan took over in 2001, Wisconsin has been arguably the best team in the Big Ten. Ryan's clubs have won five Big Ten championships (3 regular season and 2 tournament). Only Ohio State (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourney) has won more titles during Ryan's tenure. Illinois also has 5 titles, but no other Big Ten school has more than 3 rings over that span.
- ► Ryan's teams have posted a 144-60 (.706) Big Ten record, the best mark in the conference over the last 12 seasons. Michigan St. is second at 137-67 (.672) and Ohio St. is third at 135-69 (.662).
- ► Last season, Wisconsin posted a 12-6 record in the Big Ten, finishing in fourth place. The Badgers have notched double-digit conference wins in 11 of 12 years under Bo Ryan and have never finished lower than fourth place in the Big Ten standings.

▶ UW has posted a winning conference record in each of the last 13 seasons. Among the 6 major conferences, only Kansas (23 seasons) has a longer active streak of finishing above .500 in league play.

#### ALL WE DO IS WIN, WIN, WIN

Over the last seven seasons (since 2006-07), Wisconsin has accumulated an overall record of 179-64 (.737). That win total and percentage puts the Badgers in pretty exclusive company.

Wisconsin's .737 win percentage ranks 15th among all NCAA Div. I teams in that span.

#### **NCAA TOURNEY REGULARS**

- ▶ UW has qualified for the NCAA tournament in each of Bo Ryan's 12 seasons in Madison, posting a 16-12 record over that span. Under Ryan, UW has won at least one game in 10 of the 12 NCAA appearances. Among Big Ten teams, only MSU (23) has won more NCAA tourney games than UW since 2001-02.
- ▶ UW has made 15 consecutive NCAA tourneys one of just six schools with an active streak of at least 14 years: Kansas (24), Duke (18), Michigan State (16) and Gonzaga (15).
- ► Wisconsin has advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2 of the last 3 seasons and 3 of the last 6.

▶ Only Kansas (5), Michigan State (5), Duke (4), Louisville (4), North Carolina (4), Ohio State (4) and Syracuse (4) have been to more Sweet 16s in the last 6 years than UW (3).

#### ATTENDANCE IS B1G

- ► In 2012-13, the Badgers ranked second in the Big Ten and finished 7th nationally by averaging 16.843 per game.
- ▶ Wisconsin has led the Big Ten in attendance in 9 of the last 11 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 13 years.

- ◆ In Bo Ryan's 13 seasons as Wisconsin's head coach, the Badgers have compiled a 185-18 (.911) record at the Kohl Center, including an 91-11 (.892) record in Big Ten home games.
- ◆ In Ryan's first 10 seasons, the Badgers lost at TOTAL of 11 home games. UW has lost 7 in the last two seasons.
- ◆ Four of the 8 longest home winning streaks in UW history have happened with Bo Ryan on the sidelines, including the school-record 38-game winning streak from 2002 to 2005.

◆ With 297 wins, Bo Ryan has surpassed Hall of Famer Harold "Bud" Foster (265) to become UW's all-time career wins leader. Ryan needs 15 Big Ten wins to supplant Meanwell (158 wins) as the school's leader in conference wins.

- Ryan set the UW wins record in just 365 games and 11 seasons.
   Foster reached the milestone in 532 games and 25 seasons.
- ◆ Bo Ryan became the 56th NCAA coach to reach the 600-win plateau and is 1 of just 9 active Division I coaches to reach that hallowed ground. Ryan's career winning percentage of .759 is 3rd only to North Carolina's Roy Williams (.797) and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (.763) among active coaches with 600 wins. Among all-time coaches with 600 career wins (regardless of NCAA classification), Ryan's winning percentage ranks 10th.
- Ryan tied legendary Indiana coach Branch McCracken as the 2nd-fastest coach in conference history to record 100 Big Ten wins, doing so in 140 games. Only Bob Knight did it faster (131 games).
- Ryan's .706 (144-60) win percentage in conference games is the 2nd-best mark in Big Ten history, trailing only OSU's Thad Matta (111-45, .712) and surpassing legend Indiana coach Bob Knight (353-151, .700).
- ◆ Indiana's Bob Knight (327) and Purdue's Ward Lambert (331) are the only coaches in Big Ten history to reach 250 wins faster than Bo Ryan, who did it in 343 games.
- ◆ Ryan won his third Big Ten Coach of the Year honor in 2013. Only Purdue's Gene Keady (7) and Indiana's Bob Knight (5) have won the honor more times than Ryan.

With 297 wins, Ryan is the all-time wins leader in Wisconsin history, surpassing Hall of Famer Bud Foster (265). Prior to Ryan's hire at UW in 2001-02, the Badgers had four 19-win seasons (high of 22) in 103 years.

Including last season, Ryan has now led the UW to at least 19 wins in each of his 12 seasons at UW and owns 10 seasons of 20+ wins. In fact, Ryan's teams have accounted for the 9 winningest seasons in school annals.

Wisconsin has averaged 24.3 wins per season during the Ryan era, including a school-record 31 wins in 2007-08.

# **Big Ten Record**

UW pre-Bo Ryan: 607-757 (.445) UW with Bo Ryan: 144-61 (.706)

In the first 96 years of Big Ten play, Wisconsin won at least 11 Big Ten games 9 times (including just once since 1941). Including this season, Ryan has led the Badgers to at least 11 conference wins in 10 of his 12 seasons. He was the first Big Ten coach to win at least 11 league games in each of his first four years.

Ryan has led Wisconsin to a 144-60 (.706) record in Big Ten play, owning the 2nd-highest winning percentage of any coach in Big Ten history.

Ryan is the fastest coach in UW history to reach 100 Big Ten wins, doing so in 140 games. That also ties Branch McCracken as the 2nd-fastest in conference history. Only Bob Knight (131 games) did it faster.

UW has finished among the top 4 in the Big Ten in each of Ryan's 11 seasons. That 11-year stretch of top-4 finishes is the 2nd-longest in Big Ten history, trailing only Purdue's run of 13 in a row from 1920-32.

## **NCAA Tournament Record**

UW pre-Bo Ryan: 7 appearances / 9-6 UW with Ryan: 12 appearances / 16-12

Wisconsin made seven appearances in the first 63 years of the NCAA tournament. Since Bo Ryan took over as head coach, the Badgers have earned 12 consecutive tournament bids and advanced to the Sweet 16 five times.

UW has won 16 NCAA tournament games under Ryan, surpassing the Badgers' total of 9 in the 63 years prior to Ryan.

# **BO RYAN**HEAD COACH

When Bo Ryan took over as head coach at Wisconsin in 2002, he was promptly dubbed Big Ten Coach of the Year in each of his first two seasons. Last year, his 12th at UW, Ryan proved he is still



thought of in the same light, collecting the third Big Ten Coach of the Year award of his career.

Now as Ryan enters his 30th season as a head coach in 2013-14 - his 13th atop the Wisconsin program - it's difficult to decide which is more impressive, his incredible longevity or his unparalleled success. It is, however, safe to say that the combination of the two is what elevates Ryan among college basketball's elite.

Owning the most wins in UW annals (291 entering 2013-14), Ryan is also one of just 40 coaches in NCAA history to reach the 650-career win plateau. Ryan's career winning percentage of .757 (674-216) is seventh all-time among coaches with 600 career wins.

A member of five Halls of Fame, Ryan has been enshrined into the Wilkes College Athletic HOF (2003), the Delaware County Chapter of the Pennsylvania Sports HOF (2008), the Pennsylvania Sports HOF (2011), the Wis. Basketball Coaches Assoc. HOF (2011) and the Wis. Intercollegiate Athletic Conference HOF (2012).
