#### **UP NEXT: UW HOSTS FINAL IN-STATE FOE WEDNESDAY**

- ▶ Winners of 10 straight, the Badgers play the third and final game of their in-state round robin by hosting Milwaukee on Wednesday, Dec. 11. The game will be streamed live on the Big Ten Digital Network. UW is looking for its first in-state sweep since 2010.
- ► The Badgers will then play their final game before finals on campus and the holiday break by hosting Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Dec. 14, at Noon on ESPN3.

#### **NOTES TO KNOW**

- **1 GOOD START:** The Badgers are off to a 10-0 start for the first time since 1993-94 when they opened up 11-0. This is just the second-ever season in which UW has climbed into the AP top 5, checking in at No. 4. The 2006-07 team reached No. 1.
- **2 STRONG RESUME:** The Badgers are the first team in the nation to reach 10 wins and have gone 10-0 against teams with a combined record of 53-22 (.707) in all other games. UW already owns 5 wins over the ESPN.com RPI top 50 and 8 wins over the RPI top 100. No other team has won more than 2 RPI top-50 wins (page 3).
- **3 MR. 300:** With the win at Virginia, Bo Ryan became the 9th coach to win 300 games at a Big Ten school. His .727 win percentage is 2nd to only Bobby Knight (.734) among those nine.
- **4 BY ANY MEANS NECESSARY:** UW has proven it can win in any style this season, topping 80 points in three games and grinding out a defensive battle at Virginia. The Badgers' scoring average (73.2 ppg) is up 8.2 ppg from last season, while the 38 points allowed at UVA were UW's fewest given up in a road game since 1957.
- **5 DOUBLE-DEKKER:** Sophomore Sam Dekker has posted a double-double in 2 of his last 3 contests including a team-high 20 points and 10 rebounds in Saturday's win over Marquette. A preseason Top-50 candidate for both the Wooden and Naismith Player of the Year awards, Dekker is averaging 14.4 points and 5.9 rebounds.
- **6** BREAK OUT SEASON FOR KAMINSKY?: Junior Frank Kaminsky is one just 5 players ranked among the top 16 of the Big Ten's scoring and rebounding lists (Dekker is also), leading UW with 14.6 ppg and 5.9 rpg. Kaminsky is the owner of the highest single-game scoring effort in Div. I this season with 43 points in a win over North Dakota.
- **7 BALANCING ACT:** All five of UW's starters have led the team in scoring in at least one game this season and the Badgers are the only team in the Big Ten to have 5 players averaging in double figures.



#### **BEST RESUME IN COLLEGE BASKETBALL?**

The Badgers are off to one of their best starts in program history. See for yourself:

- ▶ UW is 10-0 for the first time in 20 years, its second-best start in the modern era (since 1943).
- UW is the first Div. I to reach 10 wins.
- UW owns the nation's longest winning streak at 10 games.
- ▶ UW is ranked No. 4 in the AP poll, No. 6 in the coaches poll and No. 3 in the ESPN RPI rankings.
- UW has played the 20th-toughest schedule in the nation according to ESPN's RPI.
- ▶ UW's 10 opponents are a combined 53-22 (.707) in the games not against the Badgers.
- UW is 5-0 against the RPI top 50. No other team has more than 2.
- ▶ UW owns 8 wins over the RPI top 100, most in the nation. UMass, UConn & Texas are 2nd with 5.
- ▶ UW is 8-0 against the RPI top 100. No other team even <u>played</u> more than 6 games vs. the top 100.
- ▶ UW has 5 road/neutral wins, trailing only Milwaukee (6) and Harvard (6) for most in the nation.

#### **NOTES FROM UW'S LAST GAME**

#### #8 WIS 70, MARQ 64 - 12/7/13 - Kohl Center

- ▶ With 20 points and 10 rebounds, **Sam Dekker** led the Badgers to a 70-64 win over Marquette Saturday at the Kohl Center. He was one of 5 players scoring in double figures for UW.
- ▶ UW led 28-25 at intermission, but made 7 of its first 11 shots of the second half, including two 3-pointers from **Ben Brust** to open up a 44-33 lead. **Frank Kaminsky** added 11 points, including a 3-pointer that stopped a 10-2 MU run and gave Wisconsin a 60-54 lead with 1:18 left. The Badgers would make each of their final 8 FTs to clinch the win.
- ▶ Brust finished with 13 points, **Josh Gasser** scored 10 and **Traevon Jackson** had 12 points to go with 7 assists and zero turnovers.
- ► Wisconsin went 19-for-23 at the free throw line, while MU was just 11-for-14.

#### STARTING SOMETHING

Wisconsin is off to a 10-0 start for the first time since the 1993-94 season and just the second time in the modern era (since 1943).

Led by head coach Stu Jackson, UW's 1993-94 team would open the season 11-0 and go on to play in its first NCAA tournament since 1947.

Prior to this season, Bo Ryan's best start at UW was a 6-0 record to open the 2011-12 season.

- ▶ Being undefeated is nothing new to Bo Ryan, who coached a pair of undefeated national championship teams at Div. III UW-Platteville, going 31-0 in 1994-95 and 30-0 in 1997-98.
- ► Wisconsin's 10-game win streak equals the team's 4th-longest win streak in the modern era.

Bo Ryan was also the coach of UW's longest modern-era win streak, 17 straight in 2006-07.

#### **POLL CLIMBING**

► With a perfect 10-0 start, the Badgers have climbed to No. 4 in the AP Top 25 and No. 6 in the coaches poll.

This marks UW's highest AP ranking since a 12-week stretch in the top 4 from Dec. 18, 2006 to March 5, 2007. That included a stop at No. 1 on Feb. 19, 2007.

► This is just the second-ever season UW has appeared in the AP top 5. It is the 13th week in the top 5, with the other 12 all coming in 2006-07.

#### **RYAN RISES TO 300 LEVEL**

With the win at Virginia, Bo Ryan won his 300th game at Wisconsin, becoming just the 9th coach to reach that plateau at a Big Ten school.

Among the 9 coaches with 300 wins, Ryan's .727 win percentage trails only Indiana's Bobby Knight (.734).

► Ryan is one of just 8 active coaches at a major conference school to earn 300 wins with his current team joining Jim Boeheim (929), Mike Krzyzewski (891), Tom Izzo (446), Billy Donovan (421), Rick Barnes (366), Rick Pitino (318) and Bill Self (306).

#### BADGERS WIN CANCUN CHALLENGE

▶ Wisconsin got a pair of wins south of the border over Saint Louis and West Virginia to claim the 2013 Cancun Challenge Championship. Sophomore **Sam Dekker** was named tournament MVP after averaging 14.5 points and 9.5 rebounds. **Traevon Jackson** also earned all-tournament honors after averaging 11.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists in the 2 games.

**Frank Kaminsky** also averaged 11.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.0 blocks during the two games. UW held SLU and WVU to a combined 37.3% shooting.

#### **ALL-TIME vs. MILWAUKEE**

- ▶ Wisconsin and Milwaukee will meet for the 31st time Wednesday. Outside the Big Ten, UW has faced only Marquette (120) more frequently than Milwaukee. The Badgers have won 20 consecutive games in this series, owning an all-time record of 29-1 against the Panthers.
- ► Under Bo Ryan, UW is 12-0 against Milwaukee, including a mark of 9-0 in Madison and three road wins. Last season, the Badgers beat the Panthers. 74-52, at the Kohl Center.
- ▶ Wisconsin and Milwaukee have played every season since the 1992-93 campaign, which coincidentally was the only time the Panthers claimed victory a 77-72 win in Madison on Dec. 12. 1992.
- ► Under Ryan, the Badgers have a 31-7 (.816) record in the in-state round-robin with Marquette (7-6), Milwaukee (12-0) and Green Bay (12-1).

Ryan's teams have never finished worse than 2-1 in the state series. UW is looking for its first in-state sweep since 2010. The Badgers have swept the round robin in 5 of the last 12 seasons.

► Prior to coming to UW, Ryan served as head coach at Milwaukee for two seasons (2000 and 2001), compiling a record of 30-27 (.526).

▶ Ryan has a long history with Panthers head coach Rob Jeter. Jeter played for Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1987-91, captaining the 1991 national championship team. Jeter also served an assistant under Ryan for 10 years at UW-Platteville, Milwaukee and Wisconsin. Most recently, Ryan and Jeter teamed up to coach Team USA to a bronze medal at the World University Games in Belgrade, Serbia in the summer of 2009.

#### **TAKING OFFENSE**

Through 10 games, the Badgers are posting substantially better offensive numbers than last season and marks that would rank among the best in the Bo Ryan era (since 2001-02).

- ▶ UW is averaging 73.2 points per game, an increase of 8.2 ppg from last season's 65.0-point average. UW hasn't averaged 73 points in a season since the 1994-95 team scored 73.0 per game.
- ► Wisconsin ranks 42nd in the nation and tops in the Big Ten, shooting 39.2% from 3-point range. A year ago, the Badgers shot 33.0% from deep.

UW shot 60.0% (12-for-20) from 3-point range in back-to-back games against North Dakota and Bowling Green, the first time pulling off that feat since at least the 1998-99 season.

- ► The Badgers are also shooting 45.3% from the field overall after shooting .420 a year ago.
- ► A year after finishing last in the conference, UW now ranks 5th in the Big Ten in free throw shooting, connecting at a 73.7% clip.

#### **UW IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY**

- ▶ Under Bo Ryan (since 2001-02), Wisconsin owns an overall record of 127-30 (.809) in nonconference games, including a mark of 95-7 (.931) at the Kohl Center.
- ► Wisconsin has now won 10 non-conference games for the 6th time in the last 8 seasons. UW has averaged 10.5 non-conference wins in Bo Ryan's first 12 seasons.

#### **FASTER AND MORE EFFICIENT**

Wisconsin is utilizing a three-guard starting lineup in 2013-14 and, perhaps not coincidentally, is playing at a faster and more efficient pace than at any time during the Bo Ryan era.

► According to STATS, Inc., Wisconsin is also enjoying its most efficient team in the last 13 seasons (Ryan era), averaging 1.17 points per possession - good for 4th in the Big Ten (Iowa 1.23, Michigan 1.21 and Penn State 1.21).

▶ UW is averaging 64.5 possessions per game, an increase of 2.2 possessions over last season (62.3) and the team's fastest pace since 2005-06.

#### TRIPLE THREAT

▶ UW has cooled from the outside, but still ranks 42nd in the nation and tops in the Big Ten shooting 39.2% from 3-point range (83-for-212). Among Big Ten teams, Michigan is 2nd from long range, shooting 38.6%.

UW shot 33.0% from 3-point range a year ago, good for 7th in the Big Ten.

- ► The Badgers have shot 60.0% from long range twice this season and connected on at least 45% or better in 4 games: vs. St. John's (47.8%, 11-23); vs. Florida (45.0%, 9-20); vs. UND (60.0%, 12-20) and vs. Bowling Green (60.0% 12-20).
- ► Wisconsin is also 2nd in the Big Ten and 27th nationally, averaging 8.3 made 3-pointers per game, trailing only Michigan in the Big Ten (9.4 per game).
- ▶ Individually, UW has 4 players shooting 40.0% or better from behind the arc and 7 shooting 35% or better. The Badgers have 3 players on the Big Ten leaderboard.

#### **KOHL CENTER AMONG TOUGHEST**

Wisconsin has only lost a TOTAL of 18 home games in the Bo Ryan era.

In 13 seasons under Ryan, the Badgers are an incredible 186-18 (.912) at the Kohl Center. UW's .912 winning percentage since 2001-02 is good for 4th in the nation. Only Duke, Kansas and Gonzaga have better home records in that span (pg 11).

- Three of UW's 5 longest home win streaks have come under Bo Ryan, including the school-record 38 straight from 12/7/2002 to 1/25/2005.
- Over the last 12 years, 137 of the Badgers' 186 home wins have come by at least 10 points (73.7%).

#### **ROAD WARRIORS**

Under Bo Ryan, Wisconsin is renowned for its incredible home record, but the Badgers have also enjoyed remarkable success on the road.

► Since Bo Ryan was hired in 2001, Wisconsin has been the Big Ten's best road team, owning the most true road wins (69) and best road win percentage (.511) in the conference.

In fact, in that era Wisconsin is the only Big Ten team with a road record of .500 or better.

#### **DEFENSE WITHOUT FOULING**

- ► Even with the new defensive emphasis from officials, the Badgers are again among the nation's best at defending without fouling. UW is averaging just 15.3 fouls per game, which ranks 5th in the nation.
- ► UW's opponents are averaging just 14.8 free throw attempts this season, the lowest per game average in the Big Ten.
- ▶ By comparison, UW finished 3rd in the nation averaging 14.0 fouls per game in 2012-13 and opponents shot an average of 13.9 FTs per game.

#### FREE THROW IMPROVEMENT

- ► Last season, Wisconsin ranked last in the Big Ten shooting just 63.4% at the free throw line. This year, UW has improved to 73.7% from the stripe (165-for-224), good for 5th in the conference.
- ▶ UW has <u>made</u> more free throws (165) than their opponents have <u>attempted</u> (148) this season.
- ► In the final minute of games, Wisconsin is shooting 83.3% (40-of-48) at the free throw line.
- ► In the opener vs. St. John's, UW made 25-of-30 FTs (83.3%), including their final 14 attempts.
- ► Since Bo Ryan joined the Badgers in 2001, UW is 96-19 (.835) when attempting 25+ free throws in a game, including 4-0 this season and 6-0 a year ago.
- ▶ **Ben Brust** leads the Big Ten shooting 95.5% at the free throw line (21-22). **Josh Gasser** is 4th going 39-45 (.867).

#### **DEPENDING ON DEFENSE**

- ► In last week's 48-38 win over Virginia, the Badgers relied on their trademark defense to pull out a rare road win in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
  - UW limited UVA to just 38 points and 23.4% shooting. The 38 points were the fewest allowed by the Badgers in a road game since a 44-34 win over Washington Univ. (St. Louis) in 1957.
  - The Cavaliers' 38 points were their second fewest in the shot clock era (since 1986) and the .234 FG% (11-47) was 4th-lowest in UVA history.
  - The Badgers held the Cavaliers without field goal for stretches of 8:43 and 9:03 in the second half. In fact, UVA had just 3 total field goals in the second half. Virginia also went scoreless for a period of 6:50 spanning the two halves.
- ► This season UW is allowing 63.2 points per game which ranks third in the Big Ten and 33rd nationally. But the Badgers' numbers are dropping. Over the last 4 games, UW is allowing 55.5 ppg.
- ► UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 8 of the past 11 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in scoring D in 9 of the past 11 years.

#### **GASSER 'AFFECTS WINNING'**

"You want to talk about a guy who can affect winning in multiple ways, you are talking about Josh Gasser. He has drawn the assignment of guarding the best guy and I said it earlier, when they need a basket, a moment, a guy to deliver, this is one of the guys you can turn to. He knows how to do it."

As a sophomore in 2012, **Josh Gasser** was named to the Big Ten All-Defensive Team and ranked second in the Big Ten shooting 45.2% from 3-point range. After missing last season with a knee injury, he has picked up right where he left off -- at both ends of the floor.

► In Wisconsin's win at Virginia, Gasser guarded Preseason All-ACC pick and leading scorer Joe Harris all night and limited him to 2 points on 1-for-10 shooting in 33 minutes. Harris scored 22 against UW last year while Gasser was redshirting.

Gasser then guarded Marquette's Jake Thomas and held him without a shot <u>attempt</u> in the 25 minutes he was on him. Thomas entered averaging 7.2 shot attempts per game.

- ► Gasser leads the Badgers and ranks 9th in the Big Ten shooting 42.3% from 3-point range on the year, making 11-of-26 from downtown.
- ► Gasser is also among the Big Ten's best free throw shooters, ranking 4th in the league shooting 86.7% at the stripe (39-for-45).

#### **DYNAMIC DEKKER**

A Big Ten All-Freshman Team pick last season, sophomore Sam Dekker has been named to the preseason watch list for both the 2013-14 Naismith Trophy and the Wooden Award Watch List.

► Dekker has put together 2 of his best games as a Badger in the last few weeks, posting first two career double-doubles against West Virgnia and Marquette.

Dekker posted 20 points and 10 rebounds against Marquettes on the heels of tallying career highs with 21 points and 12 rebounds in the championship game of the Cancun Challenge, earning tournament MVP honors in the process.

- ► The Sheboygan, Wis., native has scored in double figures in all but two games this season, and ranks 2nd on the team averaging 14.4 points. He is also tied for the team lead with 5.9 rebounds per game. He is 14th in the Big Ten in scoring and 16th in rebounding.
- ▶ Dekker is also improving on the glass, averaging 8.5 rebounds over his last 4 outings (34 rebounds). Over the first 6 games, Dekker pulled in a total of 25 boards, averaging 4.2 per game.

#### **KAMINSKY AMONG MOST IMPROVED**

Last season, junior **Frank Kaminsky** averaged just 4.2 points per game in 10.3 minutes of action. This season, he has stepped into a starting role and just might be the most improved player in the Big Ten.

- ► Kaminsky is averaging a team-high 14.6 points per game, increasing his scoring by 10.4 points per game, the 2nd-biggest jump in the Big Ten (Michigan's Caris Lavert is up 11.6 ppg).
- ► Just the 5th 7-footer in UW history, Kaminsky ranks among the conference leaders in a variety of categories.

#### FRANKLY, KAMINSKY SET RECORD

**Frank Kaminsky** earned Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Nov. 25 after scoring a Wisconsin school-record 43 points on 16-for-19 shooting (6-for-6 from 3-point range) against North Dakota on Nov. 19. Kaminsky's total surpassed the record of 42 held by Ken Barnes (vs. Indiana, 3/8/65) and Michael Finley (at Eastern Michigan, 12/10/94).

- ► Kaminsky's 43 points are the most scored by a Division I player this season.
- ► Kaminsky's 43 points matches the 43 scored by Illinois' Brandon Paul against OSU (1/10/12) as the most by a Big Ten player since 1996-97. In fact, Kaminsky and Paul are two of only four 40-point efforts by a Big Ten player in that span, joining Minnesota's Andre Hollins (41 vs. Memphis, 11/23/12) and Ohio State's Jared Sullinger (40 vs. IUPUI, 12/9/10).
- ► Kaminsky is the first Badgers player to score at least 30+ points since Rob Wilson had 30 vs. Indiana in the 2012 Big Ten Tournament on March 9, 2012.
- ► Kaminsky set the UW single-game record in just 28 minutes. Since 1996-97, Kaminsky is one of just 4 players to have scored 43 points against a Div. 1 opponent in 28 minutes or less: Ed Gray (Cal) had 48 vs. Washington State in 1997, Brian Burke (Lafayette) had 43 vs. Lehigh in 2002 and Stephen Curry (Davidson) had 43 vs. Appalachian State in 2009.
- ► Kaminsky is one of just four Division I players since 1996-97 to score 43 points and shoot at least 84.0 percent from the field in a game.
- ► Kaminsky and Chris Kaman are the only 7-foot Division I players to score 40-plus points in a game over the last 15 seasons. Kaman had 43 points for Central Michigan in a win over Ball State (2/19/03).

#### TRENDS TO TRACK

- ▶ Dating back to Feb. of 2011, UW has won 66 of its last 67 games when leading or tied with 5:00 left, including a perfect 10-0 mark this season.
- ▶ UW has won 97 of its last 98 games when shooting a higher FG% than its opponents, including a mark of 6-0 this season and 18-0 last season.

▶ UW has won 47 of its last 48 games when shooting 45% or better from the field, including a 5-0 mark this season and 13-0 in 2012-13.

#### WRECKING THE RANKED

▶ With its 59-53 win over No. 11 Florida, Wisconsin improved to 31-11 (.738) at home under Bo Ryan against AP Top-25 teams.

That includes a sparkling 21-6 mark against teams ranked in the top 15.

Dating back to last season, the Badgers have 4 straight home games against ranked teams. Overall, UW has won 8 of its last 12 games against the top 25.

Last season, UW posted seven wins over teams ranked in the AP Top-25 (7-6 overall), with all 7 wins coming vs. teams ranked in the top 15.

UW's 7 victories against teams ranked in the top 15 was the most in the country, tied with Indiana.

#### **CONTROL FREAKS**

► Over the last 4 seasons, no one in the country has taken care of the ball better than Wisconsin... and it's not even close.

For the 5th-straight season, Wisconsin ranks among the nation's top teams in taking care of the ball. Wisconsin is tied for 2nd in the NCAA averaging just 9.0 turnovers per game.

#### OH, CANADA

- ► The Badgers played a 5-game exhibition tour of Canada in August, visiting Ottawa and Toronto. UW went 4-1 on the trip with wins over Ryerson, Ottawa and two of pro team A-Game Hoops. Wisconsin's set-back came in the first game of the trip to Carleton, who has won 9 of the last 11 national championships.
- ► Sophomore **Sam Dekker** led the Badgers, averaging 19.4 points, 8.2 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game, while shooting 60.0 percent (9-for-15) from 3-point range. Junior **Frank Kaminsky** averaged 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- ► Senior **Ben Brust** and junior **Traevon Jackson** averaged 10.4 points apiece, while sophomore **George Marshall** chipped in 9.0 ppg and junior **Duje Dukan** averaged 8.8 ppg off the bench.
- ► UW shot 51.0% overall from the field and 73.7% from the free throw line (73-for-99).

#### **FOUR TO REDSHIRT IN 2013-14**

▶ Junior **Jordan Smith** (17 career games), sophomore **Zak Showalter** (22 career games) and a pair of freshmen, **Riley Dearring** and **Aaron Moesch** have all elected to redshirt the 2013-14 season.

#### BEN BRUST Sr. | G | 6-1 | 196 Hawthorn Woods, III.

► Third on the team in points (11.4) and rebounds (6.0) per game and second in assists with 18.

Brust leads the Big Ten in free throw percentage, making 21-of-22 (.955) and is tied for 13th in the conference going 25-for-60 (.417) from 3-point range.

► Brust is averaging a turnover every 44.1 minutes per game (8 TOs in 353 min.), the best mark in the nation (minimum 300 min. played).

► Brust has now hit multiple treys in 9 of 10 games this season and 25 of his last 27 games. His 25 triples leads the Big Ten and his average of 2.5 treys per game is 3rd.

Brust has made 164 career 3-pointers and needs 3 more to crack UW's all-time top-10 list.

► Brust has hit multiple 3-pointers in 37 games dating back to last season, the 3rd-highest total in Div I

- ▶ One of the most prolific 3-point shooters in UW history, Brust earned honorable mention All-Big Ten in 2012-13. Set single-season record with 79 treys last season and ranked 8th in the Big Ten shooting .389 from deep in 2012-13. Also tied single-game record with 7 made 3-pointers on two occasions.
- ▶ Developed into all-around player for UW last season, posting 5 double-doubles and ranking among the team leaders in points (11.1, 1st), rebounds (5.1, 4th), assists (79, 2nd), steals (34, 2nd), ast-to-TO ratio (1st, 2.0) and charges drawn (2nd with 10).
- ► A NASCAR enthusiast, Brust served as a spotter on Brendan Gaughan's team at Road America and was a social media correspondent at the Brickyard 400 this past summer.

# NIGEL HAYES Fr. | F | 6-7 | 250 Toledo, Ohio

► Has appeared in all 10 games this season as a true freshman, averaging 14.3 minutes per contest. He is 15-for-34 from the field (.441), while averaging 4.0 points and 1.6 rebounds per game.

- ► Tallied career highs in rebounds (5), blocks (2) and minutes played (25) vs. Saint Louis (11/26) in the semifinals of the Cancun Challenge.
- ► Scored 8 points and grabbed 2 rebounds in 18 minutes vs. Florida and added 6 points with 2 blocks at Green Bay.
- ► An ESPN Top-100 recruit, Hayes averaged 15.4 points, 8.7 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 2.2. blocks per game as a senior at Toledo Whitmer High School.

# TRAEVON JACKSON Jr. | G | 6-2 | 208 Westerville, Ohio

- ► Ranks 4th on the team averaging 11.2 points, leads the team with 4.8 assists per game and is 4th with 5.2 rebounds per game.
- ► Jackson has led the Badgers in assists in 9 of 10 games this season, ranking 5th in the Big Ten.

His 2.2 assist-to-turnover ratio (48 to 19) is 9th in the conference. In his last two games, Jackson has dished out 11 assists and just 2 turnovers.

- ► Jackson has displayed a far better shot from 3-point range this season, jumping from 29.3% from the beyond the arc in 2012-13 to 36.0% this year.
- ► Earned Cancun Challenge All-Tournament Team honors after leading the Badgers to title averaging 11.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists in the 2 games.
- ► Jackson made the game-clinching shot in the 59-53 win over Florida with an elbow jumper with 9.8 seconds left.
- ► A converted 2-guard, Jackson took over the point guard role last season after Josh Gasser was lost for the year with a knee injury.
- ▶ In 2012-13, led the Badgers with 99 assists and 35 steals. Earned 2013 All-Big Ten Tournament Team after averaging 11.0 ppg and 3.0 apg during the three games.
- ► Connected on three game-winning or game-tying shots in the final minute last season: game-tying 3-pointer with 29 seconds left to force overtime in a win over Iowa, made game-winning jumper with 2.1 seconds left in win over Minnesota and drained a 25-foot 3-pointer as time expired to win at Penn St.
- ► The son of Ohio State and NBA All-Star Jimmy Jackson, Traevon has trained in each of the last few summers in Ohio with Trey Burke among others.

#### 13 DUJE DUKAN R-Jr. | F | 6-9 | 220 Deerfield, III.

- ► Has appeared in all 10 games averaging 9.6 minutes off the bench. Dukan is averaging 3.9 points and 2.1 rebounds per game. He is shooting 35.3% from 3-point range on the season, connecting on 6-of-17 from deep and 5-for-6 at the free throw line.
- ▶ Dukan set career highs in points (15), rebounds (5) and minutes played (21) against St. John's in the season opener. Dukan went 2-for-3 from 3-point range and 5-for-6 at the line that night.
- ► Redshirted in 2012-13 after suffering from mono in the fall. He has appeared in 22 total games and had scored 11 career points entering 2013-14.
- ▶ Born in Split, Croatia and raised in the Chicago area, Dukan grew up in the Bulls locker room as his father, Ivica Dukan, has worked in the team's scouting department since 1992.

- ► Tallied 2nd career double-double, and 2nd in 3 games, with 20 points and 10 rebounds against Marquette on Dec. 7, 2013.
- ► Ranks 2nd on the Badgers in points (14.4) and is tied for team-lead in rebounds per game (5.9). Has scored in double figures in 8 of 10 games and 17 of his last 22 dating back to last season.

- ► Pulled down 25 rebounds in UW's first 6 games, but has grabbed 34 rebounds in the Badgers' last 4 games (8.5 rpg).
- Joins teammate Frank Kaminsky as one of 5 players to rank top 16 in Big Ten points and rebounds per game.
- ► Shooting 48.6% (53-for-109) from the field overall, including 36.8% (14-for-28) from 3-point range.

# JOSH GASSER R-Jr. | G | 6-3 | 190 Port Washington, Wis.

- ► Coming off a missed season due to a torn ACL, Gasser is 2nd on the team averaging 33.1 minutes per game. He ranks 5th on the team in scoring (10.4 ppg) and rebounds per game (4.6).
- ► Gasser ranks 4th in the Big Ten and 2nd on the team at the free throw line, shooting 86.7% (39-45). His 39 made FTs is second-most among all Badgers. He is also shooting 43.2% (11-for-26) from 3-point range, tied for 9th-best in the conference.
- ► Ranks 4th all-time in UW anals in career FT percentage (.825), owns the 10th-best 3-point FG percentage (.396) in school history and is 8th in UW's career assist-to-turnover category (1.85).

- ► Held 2013 first-team All-ACC performer Joe Harris to 1-of-10 shooting (2 points) in UW's 48-38 win at Virginia during the 2013 Big Ten/ACC Challenge. Then held Marquette's Jake Thomas without a single shot <u>attempt</u> in 25 minutes.
- ► Led the Badgers with 19 points and 8 rebounds in 35 minutes of action during the season opener vs. St. John's. Gasser made his first shot attempt in 2 years (a 3-pointer) and finished 3-for-5 from behind the arc and a perfect 8-for-8 at the free throw line.
- ► Returns after missing all of last season with a torn left ACL suffered during practice on Oct. 27, 2012. A 2012 Big Ten All-Defensive Team selection, he started 66 games in his first two seasons, including 30 as a true freshman.
- ▶ Owns the only triple-double in school history and first Big Ten freshman to do it since Magic Johnson in 1977 with 10 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists at Northwestern (1/23/11). Shot .452 from 3-point range in 2011-12, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten.
- ► A former high school quarterback, Gasser has earned a reputation as one of the toughest players on the team. During the 2012 NCAA Tournament, Gasser held SEC leading scorer, John Jenkins, to 3-of-13 shooting while battling a flu that kept him out of practice and awake the night before.

#### **24** BRONSON KOENIG Fr. | F | 6-3 | 190 La Crosse, Wis.

- ► Has appeared in 9 games as a true freshman, averaging 15.3 minutes per game, the most among UW reserves.
- ► Is averaging 3.2 points, 1.2 rebounds and 1.0 assist per game, while shooting 52.2% from the field (12-23) and 41.7% (5-12) from 3-point range.
- ► Shooting 41.7% from 3-point range, the top mark among Big Ten freshmen (minimum 10 attempts).
- ► Saw first extended time in the 3rd game of the season posting 7 points and 2 assists in 23 minutes at Green Bay.
- ► Enjoyed a career-high 10 points vs. Bowling Green, going 4-for-6 from the field and 2-for-3 from outside the arc. Also added 3 rebounds and 2 assists in 27 minutes.
- ► The 2013 Wisconsin High School Player of the Year, Koenig led Aquinas H.S. to state championships in both 2011 and 2013. Ranked No. 73 in the nation by Rivals.com, Koenig averaged 17.0 points and 4.4 assists per game while shooting 45.5% from 3-point range as a senior.

# FRANK KAMINSKY Jr. | F/C | 7-0 | 234 Lisle, III.

- ► Leads the Badgers with 14.6 points per game and is tied for team-lead with 5.9 rebounds per game.
- ► Ranks among the Big Ten's top 15 in several categories: 13th in points, 4th in FG% (.554), tied for 11th in 3FG% (.419) and 6th in blocks per game (2.1).
- ► Joins teammate Sam Dekker as one of 5 players to rank top 16 in Big Ten points and rebounds per game.
- ► Scored UW school-record 43 points vs. North Dakota, going 16-for-19 from the field and a perfect 6-for-6 from 3-point range in just 28 minutes. His 43 points is the most in Div. 1 this season and equals the most by a Big Ten player since at least 1996-97.
- ► Has scored in double figures in 7 of last 8 games, including a team-high 21 points and 6 boards in UW's win over Oral Roberts (Nov. 23).
- ► Has raised his scoring average 10.4 points per game this season after averaging just 4.2 ppg a year ago. That is second to Michigan's Caris LeVert for the biggest scoring increase of any player in the Big Ten.

#### **BIG TEN, BIG RESULTS**

- Since Bo Ryan took over in 2001, Wisconsin has been arguably the best team in the Big Ten. Ryan's clubs have won five Big Ten championships (3 regular season and 2 tournament). Only Ohio State (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourney) has won more titles during Ryan's tenure. Illinois also has 5 titles, but no other Big Ten school has more than 3 rings over that span.
- Ryan's teams have posted a 144-60 (.706) Big Ten record, the best mark in the conference over the last 12 seasons. Michigan St. is second at 137-67 (.672) and Ohio St. is third at 135-69 (.662).
- ► Last season, Wisconsin posted a 12-6 record in the Big Ten, finishing in fourth place. The Badgers have notched double-digit conference wins in 11 of 12 years under Bo Ryan and have never finished lower than fourth place in the Big Ten standings.

UW has posted a winning conference record in each of the last 13 seasons. Among the 6 major conferences, only Kansas (23 seasons) has a longer active streak of finishing above .500 in league play.

#### ALL WE DO IS WIN, WIN, WIN

Over the last seven seasons (since 2006-07), Wisconsin has accumulated an overall record of 187-64 (.745). That win total and percentage puts the Badgers in pretty exclusive company.

Wisconsin's .745 win percentage ranks 14th among all NCAA Div. I teams in that span.

- ▶ UW has qualified for the NCAA tournament in each of Bo Ryan's 12 seasons in Madison, posting a 16-12 record over that span. Under Ryan, UW has won at least one game in 10 of the 12 NCAA appearances. Among Big Ten teams, only MSU (23) has won more NCAA tourney games than UW since 2001-02.
- ► UW has made 15 consecutive NCAA tourneys one of just six schools with an active streak of at least 14 years: Kansas (24), Duke (18), Michigan State (16) and Gonzaga (15).
- ▶ Wisconsin has advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2 of the last 3 seasons and 3 of the last 6.

► Only Kansas (5), Michigan State (5), Duke (4), Louisville (4), North Carolina (4), Ohio State (4) and Syracuse (4) have been to more Sweet 16s in the last 6 years than UW (3).

- ◆ In Bo Ryan's 13 seasons as Wisconsin's head coach, the Badgers have compiled a 186-18 (.912) record at the Kohl Center, including an 91-11 (.892) record in Big Ten home games.
- ◆ In Ryan's first 10 seasons, the Badgers lost at TOTAL of 11 home games. UW lost 7 in the last two seasons combined.
- ◆ Four of the 8 longest home winning streaks in UW history have happened with Bo Ryan on the sidelines, including the school-record 38-game winning streak from 2002 to 2005.
- ◆ Over the last 13 seasons, 137 of the Badgers' 186 home wins have come by at least 10 points (73.7 percent).
- ◆ Wisconsin has trailed at halftime in only 37 of 204 home games under Ryan. UW has come back to win 24 of those 37 games.
- ◆ UW had a streak of 143 consecutive sellouts at the Kohl Center snapped in 2011 (vs. Green Bay). Wisconsin sold out every game from 2003 until midway through the 2011-12 season.

- ◆ In 2012-13, the Badgers ranked 2nd in the Big Ten and 7th nationally in attendance (16,843 per game). UW has led the Big Ten in attendance in 9 of the last 11 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 13 years.

#### Ryan has taken UW to new heights

With 301 wins, Bo Ryan has surpassed Hall of Famer Harold "Bud" Foster (265) to become UW's all-time career wins leader. Ryan needs 15 Big Ten wins to supplant Meanwell (158 wins) as the school's leader in conference wins.

- Ryan set the UW wins record in just 365 games and 11 seasons. Foster reached the milestone in 532 games and 25 seasons.
- Bo Ryan became the 56th NCAA coach to reach the 600-win plateau and is 1 of just 9 active Division I coaches to reach that hallowed ground. Ryan's career winning percentage of .760 is 3rd only to North Carolina's Roy Williams (.797) and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (.763) among active coaches with 600 wins. Among all-time coaches with 600 career wins (regardless of NCAA classification), Ryan's winning percentage ranks 10th.
- Ryan tied legendary Indiana coach Branch McCracken as the 2nd-fastest coach in conference history to record 100 Big Ten wins, doing so in 140 games. Only Bob Knight did it faster (131 games).
- Ryan's .706 (144-60) win percentage in conference games is the 2nd-best mark in Big Ten history, trailing only OSU's Thad Matta (111-45, .712) and surpassing legend Indiana coach Bob Knight (353-151, .700).
- Indiana's Bob Knight (327) and Purdue's Ward Lambert (331) are the only coaches in Big Ten history to reach 250 wins faster than Bo Ryan, who did it in 343 games.
- Ryan won his third Big Ten Coach of the Year honor in 2013. Only Purdue's Gene Keady (7) and Indiana's Bob Knight (5) have won the honor more times than Ryan.

With 301 wins, Ryan is the all-time wins leader in Wisconsin history, surpassing Hall of Famer Bud Foster (265). Prior to Ryan's hire at UW in 2001-02, the Badgers had four 19-win seasons (high of 22) in 103 years.

Including last season, Ryan has now led the UW to at least 19 wins in each of his 12 seasons at UW and owns 10 seasons of 20+ wins. In fact, Ryan's teams have accounted for the 9 winningest seasons in school annals.

Wisconsin has averaged 24.3 wins per season during the Ryan era, including a school-record 31 wins in 2007-08.

#### **Big Ten Record**

UW pre-Bo Ryan: 607-757 (.445) UW with Bo Ryan: 144-61 (.706)

In the first 96 years of Big Ten play, Wisconsin won at least 11 Big Ten games 9 times (including just once since 1941). Including this season, Ryan has led the Badgers to at least 11 conference wins in 10 of his 12 seasons. He was the first Big Ten coach to win at least 11 league games in each of his first four years.

Ryan has led Wisconsin to a 144-60 (.706) record in Big Ten play, owning the 2nd-highest winning percentage of any coach in Big Ten history.

Ryan is the fastest coach in UW history to reach 100 Big Ten wins, doing so in 140 games. That also ties Branch McCracken as the 2nd-fastest in conference history. Only Bob Knight (131 games) did it faster.

UW has finished among the top 4 in the Big Ten in each of Ryan's 11 seasons. That 11-year stretch of top-4 finishes is the 2nd-longest in Big Ten history, trailing only Purdue's run of 13 in a row from 1920-32.

#### **NCAA Tournament Record**

UW pre-Bo Ryan: 7 appearances / 9-6 UW with Ryan: 12 appearances / 16-12

Wisconsin made seven appearances in the first 63 years of the NCAA tournament. Since Bo Ryan took over as head coach, the Badgers have earned 12 consecutive tournament bids and advanced to the Sweet 16 five times.

UW has won 16 NCAA tournament games under Ryan, surpassing the Badgers' total of 9 in the 63 years prior to Ryan.

### Wisconsin Coaching Staff

#### BO RYAN HEAD COACH

When Bo Ryan took over as head coach at Wisconsin in 2002, he was promptly dubbed Big Ten Coach of the Year in each of his first two seasons. Last year, his 12th at UW, Ryan proved he is still



thought of in the same light, collecting the third Big Ten Coach of the Year award of his career.

Now as Ryan enters his 30th season as a head coach in 2013-14 - his 13th atop the Wisconsin program - it's difficult to decide which is more impressive, his incredible longevity or his unparalleled success. It is, however, safe to say that the combination of the two is what elevates Ryan among college basketball's elite.

Owning the most wins in UW annals (291 entering 2013-14), Ryan is also one of just 40 coaches in NCAA history to reach the 650-career win plateau. Ryan's career winning percentage of .757 (674-216) is seventh all-time among coaches with 600 career wins.

A member of five Halls of Fame, Ryan has been enshrined into the Wilkes College Athletic HOF (2003), the Delaware County Chapter of the Pennsylvania Sports HOF (2008), the Pennsylvania Sports HOF (2011), the Wis. Basketball Coaches Assoc. HOF (2011) and the Wis. Intercollegiate Athletic Conference HOF (2012).
