UP NEXT: UW OPENS BIG TEN PLAY AT NORTHWESTERN

- Coming off an undefeated non-conference schedule, the Badgers will look to win their 11th consecutive Big Ten opener when they travel to Evanston, III. to take on Northwestern on Jan. 2. UW owns 6 straight wins over the Wildcats.
- Wisconsin will welcome Iowa for its Big Ten home opener on Sunday, Jan. 5 at the Kohl Center. Tip off is set for 7 p.m. on the Big Ten Network.

NOTES TO KNOW

- 1 GOOD START: At 13-0, UW has posted its best start in 100 years (UW went 15-0 in 1913-14) and has done so against the nation's 7th-toughest schedule. Ranked No. 4. this is just the 2nd-ever season in which UW has climbed into the AP top 5.
- 2 STRONG RESUME: The Badgers own the top spot on ESPN's RPI, going 13-0 against teams with a combined record of 100-47 (.680) in all other games. UW owns 4 wins over the RPI top 50 and 6 wins over the RPI top 100, most in the nation (page 3).
- BO KNOWS BIG TEN: Bo Ryan's .706 (144-60) win percentage in Big Ten games is the 2nd-best mark of any coach in history behind OSU's Thad Matta (111-45, .712) and ahead of Indiana legend Bob Knight (353-151, .700).
- BY ANY MEANS NECESSARY: UW has proven it can win in any style this season, topping 80 points in 5 games and grinding out a defensive battle at Virginia. The Badgers' scoring average (75.1 ppg) is up 10.1 ppg from last season, while the 38 points allowed at UVA were UW's fewest given up in a road game since 1957.
- 5 DOUBLE-DEKKER: Sophomore Sam Dekker has posted 3 double-doubles in the last 6 games, including 16 points and 11 rebounds Saturday vs. Prairie View A&M. A preseason Top-50 candidate for both the Wooden and Naismith Player of the Year awards, Dekker leads UW averaging 14.5 points and a team-high 6.2 rebounds.
- BREAK OUT SEASON FOR KAMINSKY?: A year after averaging 4.2 points in 10.3 minutes per game, junior Frank Kaminsky is among the Big Ten's top 20 in both scoring (14.2 ppg) and rebounding (5.8 rpg). Kaminsky is the owner of the 2nd-highest single-game scoring effort in Div. I this season with 43 points vs. North Dakota.
- BALANCING ACT: All 5 starters have led UW in scoring in at least 1 game this season and are all shooting 36% or better from deep. The Badgers are one of just two teams in the Big Ten with 5 players averaging 9.0 ppg or more.

BEST RESUME IN COLLEGE BASKETBALL?

The Badgers are off to their best start in program history. See for yourself:

- UW is 13-0 for the first time in the Badgers' modern-era history (since 1946).
- UW is one of just 8 unbeaten teams in the nation.
- UW owns the nation's longest winning streak at 13 games.
- ▶ UW is ranked No. 4 in the AP poll, No. 5 in the coaches poll and No. 1 in the ESPN RPI rankings.
- UW has played the 7th-toughest schedule in the nation according to ESPN's RPI.
- UW's 13 opponents are a combined 100-46 (.680) in the games not against the Badgers.
- All but 2 of UW's first 13 opponents has a record of .500 or better and 9 have at least 8 wins.
- ► UW is 4-0 against the RPI top 50, the most of any team in the nation.
- UW also leads the nation with 6 wins over the RPI top 100.
- ▶ UW has 5 road/neutral wins, trailing only Milwaukee (6) and Harvard (6) for most in the nation.

NOTES FROM UW'S LAST GAME

#4 UW 80, PVAMU 43 - 12/28/13 - Kohl Center

- ► Wisconsin notched its most lopsided victory of the season, capping a perfect 13-0 non-conference schedule.
- ► The Badgers turned the ball over just 2 times, their fewest since having 2 against Minnesota on Dec. 28, 2010.
- ► Wisconsin committed a season-low 8 fouls and owned a dominant edge at the foul line. The Badgers went 21-for-28, while PVAMU was just 3-for-4.
- ► The Badgers out-rebounded the Panthers, 42-25, and tallied a season-high 16 offensive boards.
- ▶ Wisconsin had 4 players score in double figures for the 9th time in 13 games. Sam Dekker led UW with 16 points and 11 rebounds, his 3rd double-double of the season. Ben Brust added 11 points, Frank Kaminsky scored 10 with 7 boards and freshman Nigel Hayes posted his second straight game in double figures with 10 points, 4 rebounds and 3 blocks.

RYAN RISES TO 300 LEVEL

With the win at Virginia, Bo Ryan won his 300th game at Wisconsin, becoming just the 9th coach to reach that plateau at a Big Ten school.

Among the 9 coaches with 300 wins, Ryan's .729 win percentage trails only Indiana's Bobby Knight (.734).

STARTING SOMETHING

Wisconsin is off to a 13-0 start, the school's best start of the modern era (since 1946).

Prior to this season, Bo Ryan's best start at UW was a 6-0 record to open the 2011-12 season.

- ► The all-time best start in school history belongs to the 1911-12 and 1913-14 Badgers teams that both finished 15-0 on the season and were later named Helms Foundation National Champions.
- ▶ Being undefeated is nothing new to Bo Ryan, who coached a pair of undefeated national championship teams at Div. III UW-Platteville, going 31-0 in 1994-95 and 30-0 in 1997-98.
- ► Wisconsin's 13-game win streak is the team's 2nd-longest win streak in the modern era.

Bo Ryan was also the coach of UW's longest modern-era win streak, 17 straight in 2006-07. In fact, Ryan-coached teams as are responsible for 4 of the 6 longest streaks in Badgers history.

SERIES VS. NORTHWESTERN

This will be the 173rd meeting between Wisconsin and Northwestern in a series that dates back to 1910. UW leads the all-time series between the schools 111-61, but trails by a 39-37 margin in games played in Evanston.

- ► The Badgers have won 6 straight over the Wildcats by an average of 18.7 points per game. Three of the last four meetings have been decided by 20+ points.
- ► The Badgers have won 11 of the last 12 match-ups overall against the Wildcats.
- ► UW and NU met only once last season with the Badgers winning, 69-41, in Evanston.
- ► Ryan is 16-4 all-time vs. Northwestern. The Badgers have won 5 of their last 6 trips to Evanston, owning a 6-4 record at Welsh-Ryan Arena under Ryan.
- ► UW has out-rebounded NU in 12 straight games, by an average of 12.8 per game.
- ► UW has 2 players from the Chicagoland area: senior **Ben Brust**, junior **Frank Kaminsky**.

Kaminsky and NU's Dave Sobolewski were high school teammates at Benet Academy in the Chicago area.

POLL CLIMBING

▶ With a perfect 13-0 start, the Badgers have climbed to No. 4 in the AP Top 25 and No. 6 in the coaches poll. Wisconsin has now spent 5 straight weeks at No. 4/6.

This marks UW's highest AP ranking since a 12-week stretch in the top 4 from Dec. 18, 2006 to March 5, 2007. That included a stop at No. 1 on Feb. 19, 2007.

► This is just the second-ever season UW has appeared in the AP top 5, doing so in back-to-back weeks. It is the 17th week in the top 5 overall, with the other 12 all coming in 2006-07.

BIG TEN OPENERS

Wisconsin has won each of its last 10 Big Ten openers, including a 60-51 win over Penn State in the conference lid lifter last season. The Badgers' 10 consecutive Big Ten-opening wins have come by an average of 17.1 points per game.

► UW is one of just 3 teams in college basketball that have won each of their last 10 conference openers, joining Kansas and Gonzaga.

- ► Overall, UW is 10-2 in Big Ten openers under Bo Ryan, with losses in each of his first two seasons as head coach.
- ► Ryan's teams have won 8 of 12 Big Ten road openers, however, the Badgers have won 8 of their last 9 road conference openers.
- ► The Badgers will be facing first-year head coaches Chris Collins (Northwestern) and Richard Pitino (Minnesota) this season. Under Bo Ryan, UW is 24-5 (.828) against Big Ten coaches in their first season.

ROAD WARRIORS

Under Bo Ryan, Wisconsin is renowned for its incredible home record, but the Badgers have also enjoyed remarkable success on the road.

► Since Bo Ryan was hired in 2001, Wisconsin has been the Big Ten's best road team, owning the most true road wins (69) and best road win percentage (.511) in the conference.

In fact, in that era Wisconsin is the only Big Ten team with a road record of .500 or better.

TAKING OFFENSE

Through 13 games, the Badgers are posting substantially better offensive numbers than last season and marks that would rank among the best in the Bo Ryan era (since 2001-02).

- ▶ UW is averaging 75.1 points per game, an increase of 10.1 ppg from last season's 65.0-point average. UW hasn't averaged 73 points in a season since the 1994-95 team scored 73.0 per game.
- ► Wisconsin leads the Big Ten and ranks 34th in the nation, shooting 39.6% from 3-point range. A year ago, the Badgers shot 33.0% from deep.

UW has shot 60.0% from 3-point range three times this season, going 12-for-20 against North Dakota and Bowling Green and shooting 9-for-15 against Eastern Kentucky.

- ► The Badgers are also shooting 46.6% from the field overall after shooting .420 a year ago.
- ► A year after finishing last in the conference, UW now ranks 4th in the Big Ten in free throw shooting, connecting at a 73.8% clip.

TRIPLE THREAT

► A big part of Wisconsin's success has been it's 3-point accuracy by many players. As a team, the Badgers rank 34th in the nation and tops in the Big Ten shooting 39.6% from 3-point range.

UW shot 33.0% from 3-point range a year ago, good for 7th in the Big Ten.

- ► The Badgers have shot 60.0% from long range three times this season and connected on at least 45% or better in 5 games.
- ► Wisconsin is also 2nd in the Big Ten and 26th nationally, averaging 8.5 made 3-pointers per game, trailing only Michigan in the Big Ten (9.1 per game).
- ► Individually, all 5 of UW's starters are shooting better than 36% and all have hit double-digit triples.

- ▶ Ben Brust has hit multiple triples in 12 of 13 games this season, including a season-high 6 against Bowling Green and 5 against Eastern Kentucky. His 37 made 3-pointers are the most in the Big Ten and he also leads the conference averaging 2.8 3-pointers per game.
- ► Brust has made 176 career 3-pointers, ranking 8th in UW history. He needs 5 more triples to pass Jordan Taylor (180) for 7th place.

- ▶ Dating back to Feb. of 2011, UW has won 69 of its last 70 games when leading or tied with 5:00 left, including a perfect 13-0 mark this season.

- ► The Badgers committed a season-low 2 turnovers against Prairie View A&M on Dec. 28. That was the team's fewest turnovers in exactly three years. UW last turned it over 2 or fewer times against Minnesota (2) on Dec. 28, 2010.
- ► Wisconsin also owns an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.51 this season (168 assists, 111 turnovers), which ranks 4th in the Big Ten and 20th in the nation.

FREE THROW IMPROVEMENT

- Last season, Wisconsin ranked last in the Big Ten shooting just 63.4% at the free throw line. This year, UW has improved to 73.8% from the stripe (217-for-294), good for 4th in the conference.
- ▶ UW has <u>made</u> more free throws (217) than their opponents have <u>attempted</u> (170) this season.
- ► The Badgers are averaging 8.0 more free throw attempts per game than a year ago. Last season UW had 16.6 FTAs per game, and it has increased that number to 22.6 per game in 2013-14.
- ► In the final minute of games, Wisconsin is shooting 83.3% (40-of-48) at the free throw line.
- ► In the opener vs. St. John's, UW made 25-of-30 FTs (83.3%), including their final 14 attempts. UW connected on 25-of-33 FTs (75.8%) vs. Eastern Kentucky.
- ► Since Bo Ryan joined the Badgers in 2001, UW is 98-19 (.838) when attempting 25+ free throws in a game, including 6-0 this season and 6-0 a year ago.
- ▶ **Josh Gasser** is 3rd in the Big Ten shooting 86.3% (44-51) from the stripe. **Ben Brust** would lead the Big Ten shooting 92.3% at the free throw line (24-26), but he is two made free throws shy of qualifying.

Gasser is also a 82.5% career free throw shooter, making 156 of 189, which places him 4th in UW history.

- ► This season UW is allowing 60.6 points per game which ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 14th nationally and the Badgers' numbers are dropping. Over the last 7 games, UW is allowing 54.0 ppg.
- ► UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 8 of the past 11 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in scoring D in 9 of the past 11 years.

- ► In UW's 48-38 win over Virginia, the Badgers relied on their trademark defense to pull out a rare road win in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
 - UW limited UVA to just 38 points and 23.4% shooting. The 38 points were the fewest allowed by the Badgers in a road game since a 44-34 win over Washington Univ. (St. Louis) in 1957.
 - The Cavaliers' 38 points were their second fewest in the shot clock era (since 1986) and the .234 FG% (11-47) was 4th-lowest in UVA history.
 - The Badgers held the Cavaliers without field goal for stretches of 8:43 and 9:03 in the second half. In fact, UVA had just 3 total field goals in the second half. Virginia also went scoreless for a period of 6:50 spanning the two halves.

DEFENSE WITHOUT FOULING

- ► Even with the new defensive emphasis from officials, the Badgers are again among the nation's best at defending without fouling. UW leads the nation, averaging just 14.4 fouls per game.
- ► UW's opponents are averaging just 13.1 free throw attempts this season, which is the fewest in the NCAA.
- ▶ By comparison, UW finished 3rd in the nation averaging 14.0 fouls per game in 2012-13 and opponents shot an average of 13.9 FTs per game.

GASSER 'AFFECTS WINNING'

"You want to talk about a guy who can affect winning in multiple ways, you are talking about Josh Gasser. He has drawn the assignment of guarding the best guy and I said it earlier, when they need a basket, a moment, a guy to deliver, this is one of the guys you can turn to. He knows how to do it."

As a sophomore in 2012, **Josh Gasser** was named to the Big Ten All-Defensive Team and ranked second in the Big Ten shooting 45.2% from 3-point range. After missing last season with a knee injury, he has picked up right where he left off -- at both ends of the floor.

► In Wisconsin's win at Virginia, Gasser guarded Preseason All-ACC pick and leading scorer Joe Harris all night and limited him to 2 points on 1-for-10 shooting in 33 minutes. Harris scored 22 against UW last year while Gasser was redshirting.

Gasser then guarded Marquette's Jake Thomas and held him without a shot <u>attempt</u> in the 25 minutes he was on him. Thomas entered averaging 7.2 shot attempts per game.

- ► Gasser ranks 12th in the Big Ten shooting 40.6% from 3-point range on the year, making 13-of-32 from downtown.
- ► Gasser is also among the Big Ten's best free throw shooters, ranking 3rd in the league shooting 86.3% at the stripe (44-for-51).

He also ranks among UW's all-time 3-point and free throw shooters, ranking 11th all-time behind the arc (39.4%) and 4th all-time at the stripe (.825).

DYNAMIC DEKKER

A Big Ten All-Freshman Team pick last season, sophomore Sam Dekker has been named to the preseason watch list for both the 2013-14 Naismith Trophy and the Wooden Award Watch List.

► Dekker has put together 3 of his best games as a Badger in the last few weeks, posting three doubledoubles in the last 6 games - against West Virginia, Marquette and Prairie View A&M.

Dekker posted 20 points and 10 rebounds against Marquette on the heels of tallying career highs with 21 points and 12 rebounds in the championship game of the Cancun Challenge, earning tournament MVP honors in the process. He also scored 16 points with 11 rebounds against Prairie View A&M on Dec. 28.

- ► The Sheboygan, Wis., native has scored in double figures in all but two games this season, and leads the team averaging 14.5 points. He also leads the team with 6.2 rebounds per game. He is 13th in the Big Ten in scoring and 12th in rebounding.
- ▶ Dekker is one of just 3 players to rank among the Big Ten's top 13 in both scoring and rebounding (MSU's Adreian Payne and NU's Drew Crawford are the other two).
- ▶ Dekker is becoming more and more active on the glass, averaging 8.0 rebounds over his last 7 outings (56 rebounds). Over the first 6 games, Dekker pulled in a total of 25 boards, averaging 4.2 per game.

Last season, junior **Frank Kaminsky** averaged just 4.2 points per game in 10.3 minutes of action. This season, he has stepped into a starting role and just might be the most improved player in the Big Ten.

- ► Kaminsky is averaging 14.2 points per game, increasing his scoring by 10.0 points per game, the 2nd-biggest jump in the Big Ten (Michigan's Caris Lavert is up 10.8 ppg).
- ► Just the 5th 7-footer in UW history, Kaminsky ranks among the conference leaders in a variety of categories.

FRANKLY, KAMINSKY SET RECORD

Frank Kaminsky earned Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Nov. 25 after scoring a Wisconsin school-record 43 points on 16-for-19 shooting (6-for-6 from 3-point range) against North Dakota on Nov. 19. Kaminsky's total surpassed the record of 42 held by Ken Barnes (vs. Indiana, 3/8/65) and Michael Finley (at Eastern Michigan, 12/10/94).

- At the time, Kaminsky's 43 points were the most scored by a Division I player this season. His effort is now the 2nd-highest of the year.
- ► Kaminsky's 43 points matches the 43 scored by Illinois' Brandon Paul against OSU (1/10/12) as the most by a Big Ten player since 1996-97. In fact, Kaminsky and Paul are two of only four 40-point efforts by a Big Ten player in that span, joining Minnesota's Andre Hollins (41 vs. Memphis, 11/23/12) and Ohio State's Jared Sullinger (40 vs. IUPUI, 12/9/10).
- ► Kaminsky is the first Badgers player to score at least 30+ points since Rob Wilson had 30 vs. Indiana in the 2012 Big Ten Tournament on March 9, 2012.
- ► Kaminsky set the UW single-game record in just 28 minutes. Since 1996-97, Kaminsky is one of just 4 players to have scored 43 points against a Div.

1 opponent in 28 minutes or less: Ed Gray (Cal) had 48 vs. Washington State in 1997, Brian Burke (Lafayette) had 43 vs. Lehigh in 2002 and Stephen Curry (Davidson) had 43 vs. Appalachian State in 2009.

- ► Kaminsky is one of just four Division I players since 1996-97 to score 43 points and shoot at least 84.0 percent from the field in a game.
- ► Kaminsky and Chris Kaman are the only 7-foot Division I players to score 40-plus points in a game over the last 15 seasons. Kaman had 43 points for Central Michigan in a win over Ball State (2/19/03).

BOMBS AWAY BRUST

- ▶ **Ben Brust** has had a hot start to the season from outside. The senior guard leads the Big Ten in 3-pointers made (37) and 3-pointers per game, averaging 2.8 per outing.
- ► Brust is also 5th in the conference, shooting 44.0% from behind the arc. He has hit 37 of 84 attempts on the year.
- ► Brust has hit multiple triples in 12 of 13 games this season, including a season-high 6 against Bowling Green and 5 against Eastern Kentucky. His 37 made 3-pointers are the most in the Big Ten and he also leads the conference averaging 2.8 3-pointers per game.
- ► Brust has made 176 career 3-pointers, ranking 8th in UW history. He needs 5 more triples to pass Jordan Taylor (180) for 7th place.
- ► The 6-foot-1 guard also ranks 3rd on the team with 5.2 rebounds per game. This hasn't come as a surprise after Brust ranked 19th in the Big Ten in rebounding last season, pulling in 5.1 per game. He was the only player shorter than 6-foot-4 to rank among the leagues top-20 rebounders.

JACKSON NOTES

Junior **Traevon Jackson** entered last season as the team's third-string point guard, but worked his way into the starting lineup by the season's 7th game a year ago. Now with 42 starts under his belt, Jackson has solidified himself as one of the better lead guards in the Big Ten.

Last season Jackson owned a 1.36 assist-toturnover ratio (99 assists, 73 turnovers). He has increased that to a 2.46 ratio in 2013-14, dishing 59 assists with just 24 turnovers. That ratio ranks 7th in the Big Ten.

Over his last 6 games, Jackson has 29 assists to just 8 turnovers, good for a 3.63 assist-to-TO ratio.

- ► Jackson is averaging a team-high 4.5 assists per game, the 5th-best mark in the Big Ten.
- ▶ Jackson has also increased his offensive efficiency this season. His scoring average is up from 6.9 ppg to 10.7 this season, while his 3-point shooting has gone up to 36.4% from 29.3% a year ago.

HAYES HAVOK

The Big Ten Freshman of the Week, Nigel Hayes has looked like a different player over Wisconsin's last 2 games.

► Hayes averaged 4.0 points per game and went 10-for-21 (.476) at the foul line over UW's first 11 games.

In the last 2, Hayes has posted back-to-back double-digit scoring games including a career-high 17 points against Eastern Kentucky (Dec. 14). Over those 2 contests, the Toledo, Ohio native is averaging 13.5 points, while shooting 19-for-26 (.731) at the free throw line.

WRECKING THE RANKED

▶ With its 59-53 win over No. 11 Florida, Wisconsin improved to 31-11 (.738) at home under Bo Ryan against AP Top-25 teams.

That includes a sparkling 21-6 mark against teams ranked in the top 15.

Dating back to last season, the Badgers have 4 straight home games against ranked teams. Overall, UW has won 8 of its last 12 games against the top 25.

Last season, UW posted seven wins over teams ranked in the AP Top-25 (7-6 overall), with all 7 wins coming vs. teams ranked in the top 15.

UW's 7 victories against teams ranked in the top 15 was the most in the country, tied with Indiana.

OH, CANADA

- ► The Badgers played a 5-game exhibition tour of Canada in August, visiting Ottawa and Toronto. UW went 4-1 on the trip with wins over Ryerson, Ottawa and two of pro team A-Game Hoops. Wisconsin's set-back came in the first game of the trip to Carleton, who has won 9 of the last 11 national championships.
- ► Sophomore **Sam Dekker** led the Badgers, averaging 19.4 points, 8.2 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game, while shooting 60.0 percent (9-for-15) from 3-point range. Junior **Frank Kaminsky** averaged 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- ► Senior **Ben Brust** and junior **Traevon Jackson** averaged 10.4 points apiece, while sophomore **George Marshall** chipped in 9.0 ppg and junior **Duje Dukan** averaged 8.8 ppg off the bench.
- ► UW shot 51.0% overall from the field and 73.7% from the free throw line (73-for-99).

FOUR TO REDSHIRT IN 2013-14

▶ Junior **Jordan Smith** (17 career games), sophomore **Zak Showalter** (22 career games) and a pair of freshmen, **Riley Dearring** and **Aaron Moesch** have all elected to redshirt the 2013-14 season.

Brust has made 176 career 3-pointers, moving into 8th place in UW history with his 3-for-8 (.375) effort against Prairie View A&M. He needs 5 more treys to pass Jordan Taylor (175) for 7th place.

Set single-season record with 79 treys last season and ranked 8th in the Big Ten shooting .389 from deep in 2012-13. Also tied single-game record with 7 made 3-pointers on two occasions.
- ▶ Developed into all-around player for UW last season, posting 5 double-doubles and ranking among the team leaders in points (11.1, 1st), rebounds (5.1, 4th), assists (79, 2nd), steals (34, 2nd), ast-to-TO ratio (1st, 2.0) and charges drawn (2nd with 10).
- ► A NASCAR enthusiast, Brust served as a spotter on Brendan Gaughan's team at Road America and was a social media correspondent at the Brickyard 400 this past summer.

NIGEL HAYES Fr. | F | 6-7 | 250 Toledo, Ohio

- ► Named Big Ten Freshman of the Week (Dec. 30) after scoring 10 points and adding 4 rebounds in win over Prairie View A&M (Dec. 28).
- ► Has appeared in all 13 games this season as a true freshman, averaging 14.6 minutes per contest. He is 21-for-43 from the field (.488), while averaging 5.5 points and 1.8 rebounds per game.
- ► Scored a career-high 17 points on 13-for-17 (.764) shooting from the free throw stripe vs. Eastern Kentucky (Dec. 14).
- ► Averaging 13.5 points per game and shooting 19-for-26 (.731) from the free throw stripe during last two games.
- ► Tallied career highs in rebounds (5), blocks (2) and minutes played (25) vs. Saint Louis (11/26) in the semifinals of the Cancun Challenge.

- ▶ Jackson has led the Badgers in assists in 10 of 13 games this season, ranking 5th in the Big Ten.

His 2.5 assist-to-turnover ratio (59 to 24) is 7th in the conference. In his last 4 games, Jackson has dished out 22 assists and just 7 turnovers.

- ► Jackson has displayed a far better shot from 3-point range this season, jumping from 29.3% from the beyond the arc in 2012-13 to 36.4% this year.
- ► Earned Cancun Challenge All-Tournament Team honors after leading the Badgers to title averaging 11.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists in the 2 games.
- ► Jackson made the game-clinching shot in the 59-53 win over Florida with an elbow jumper with 9.8 seconds left.
- ► A converted 2-guard, Jackson took over the point guard role last season after Josh Gasser was lost for the year with a knee injury.
- ▶ In 2012-13, led the Badgers with 99 assists and 35 steals. Earned 2013 All-Big Ten Tournament Team after averaging 11.0 ppg and 3.0 apg during the three games.
- ► Connected on three game-winning or game-tying shots in the final minute last season: game-tying 3-pointer with 29 seconds left to force overtime in a win over lowa, made game-winning jumper with 2.1 seconds left in win over Minnesota and drained a 25-foot 3-pointer as time expired to win at Penn St.
- ► The son of Ohio State and NBA All-Star Jimmy Jackson, Traevon has trained in each of the last few summers in Ohio with Trey Burke among others.

13 DUJE DUKAN R-Jr. | F | 6-9 | 220 Deerfield, III.

- ► Has appeared in all 13 games averaging 10.0 minutes off the bench. Dukan is averaging 3.8 points and 1.9 rebounds per game. He is shooting 34.8% from 3-point range on the season, connecting on 8-of-23 from deep and 5-for-6 at the free throw line.
- ▶ Dukan set career highs in points (15), rebounds (5) and minutes played (21) against St. John's (Nov. 8) in the season opener. Dukan went 2-for-3 from 3-point range and 5-for-6 at the line that night.
- ► Redshirted in 2012-13 after suffering from mono in the fall. He has appeared in 22 total games and had scored 11 career points entering 2013-14.
- ▶ Born in Split, Croatia and raised in the Chicago area, Dukan grew up in the Bulls locker room as his father, Ivica Dukan, has worked in the team's scouting department since 1992.

- ► Coming off a missed season due to a torn ACL, Gasser is 2nd on the team averaging 32.2 minutes per game. He ranks 5th on the team in scoring (9.0 ppg) and rebounds per game (4.34.
- ► Gasser is 3rd in the Big Ten and 2nd on the team at the free throw line, shooting 86.3% (44-51). His 44 made FTs is second-most among all Badgers. He is also shooting 40.6% (13-for-32) from 3-point range, tied for 12th-best in the conference.
- ► Ranks 4th all-time in UW anals in career FT percentage (.825), owns the 10th-best 3-point FG percentage (.396) in school history and is 5th in UW's career assist-to-turnover category (1.94).

- ► Held 2013 first-team All-ACC performer Joe Harris to 1-of-10 shooting (2 points) in UW's 48-38 win at Virginia during the 2013 Big Ten/ACC Challenge. Then held Marquette's Jake Thomas without a single shot attempt in 25 minutes.
- ► Led the Badgers with 19 points and 8 rebounds in 35 minutes of action during the season opener vs. St. John's. Gasser made his first shot attempt in 2 years (a 3-pointer) and finished 3-for-5 from behind the arc and a perfect 8-for-8 at the free throw line.
- ► Returns after missing all of last season with a torn left ACL suffered during practice on Oct. 27, 2012. A 2012 Big Ten All-Defensive Team selection, he started 66 games in his first two seasons, including 30 as a true freshman.
- ► Owns the only triple-double in school history and first Big Ten freshman to do it since Magic Johnson in 1977 with 10 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists at Northwestern (1/23/11). Shot .452 from 3-point range in 2011-12, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten.
- ► A former high school quarterback, Gasser has earned a reputation as one of the toughest players on the team. During the 2012 NCAA Tournament, Gasser held SEC leading scorer, John Jenkins, to 3-of-13 shooting while battling a flu that kept him out of practice and awake the night before.

BRONSON KOENIG Fr. | F | 6-3 | 190 La Crosse, Wis.

- ► Has appeared in 12 games as a true freshman, averaging 16.6 minutes per game, the most among UW reserves.
- ► Is averaging 3.8 points, 1.6 rebounds and 1.1 assist per game, while shooting 50.0% from the field (19-38) and 36.8% (7-19) from 3-point range.
- ► Shooting 36.8% from 3-point range, the 2nd-best mark among Big Ten freshmen (minimum 10 attempts).
- ► Saw first extended time in the 3rd game of the season posting 7 points and 2 assists in 23 minutes at Green Bay.
- ► Enjoyed a career-high 10 points vs. Bowling Green, going 4-for-6 from the field and 2-for-3 from outside the arc.

Also added 3 rebounds and 2 assists in 27 minutes.

BIG TEN, BIG RESULTS

- ► Since Bo Ryan took over in 2001, Wisconsin has been arguably the best team in the Big Ten. Ryan's clubs have won five Big Ten championships (3 regular season and 2 tournament). Only Ohio State (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourney) has won more titles during Ryan's tenure. Illinois also has 5 titles, but no other Big Ten school has more than 3 rings over that span.
- Ryan's teams have posted a 144-60 (.706) Big Ten record, the best mark in the conference over the last 12 seasons. Michigan St. is second at 137-67 (.672) and Ohio St. is third at 135-69 (.662).
- ► Last season, Wisconsin posted a 12-6 record in the Big Ten, finishing in fourth place. The Badgers have notched double-digit conference wins in 11 of 12 years under Bo Ryan and have never finished lower than fourth place in the Big Ten standings.

► UW has posted a winning conference record in each of the last 13 seasons. Among the 6 major conferences, only Kansas (23 seasons) has a longer active streak of finishing above .500 in league play.

ALL WE DO IS WIN, WIN, WIN

Over the last seven seasons (since 2006-07), Wisconsin has accumulated an overall record of 187-64 (.745). That win total and percentage puts the Badgers in pretty exclusive company.

- ▶ UW has qualified for the NCAA tournament in each of Bo Ryan's 12 seasons in Madison, posting a 16-12 record over that span. Under Ryan, UW has won at least one game in 10 of the 12 NCAA appearances. Among Big Ten teams, only MSU (23) has won more NCAA tourney games than UW since 2001-02.
- ► UW has made 15 consecutive NCAA tourneys one of just six schools with an active streak of at least 14 years: Kansas (24), Duke (18), Michigan State (16) and Gonzaga (15).
- ▶ Wisconsin has advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2 of the last 3 seasons and 3 of the last 6.

- ◆ In Bo Ryan's 13 seasons as Wisconsin's head coach, the Badgers have compiled a 189-18 (.913) record at the Kohl Center, including an 91-11 (.892) record in Big Ten home games.
- ◆ In Ryan's first 10 seasons, the Badgers lost at TOTAL of 11 home games. UW lost 7 in the last two seasons combined.
- ◆ Four of the 8 longest home winning streaks in UW history have happened with Bo Ryan on the sidelines, including the school-record 38-game winning streak from 2002 to 2005.
- Over the last 13 seasons, 140 of the Badgers' 189 home wins have come by at least 10 points (74.1 percent).
- ◆ Wisconsin has trailed at halftime in only 37 of 207 home games under Ryan. UW has come back to win 24 of those 37 games.
- ◆ UW had a streak of 143 consecutive sellouts at the Kohl Center snapped in 2011 (vs. Green Bay). Wisconsin sold out every game from 2003 until midway through the 2011-12 season.

- ◆ In 2012-13, the Badgers ranked 2nd in the Big Ten and 7th nationally in attendance (16,843 per game). UW has led the Big Ten in attendance in 9 of the last 11 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 13 years.

Ryan has taken UW to new heights

◆ With 304 wins, Bo Ryan has surpassed Hall of Famer Harold "Bud" Foster (265) to become UW's all-time career wins leader. Ryan needs 15 Big Ten wins to supplant Meanwell (158 wins) as the school's leader in conference wins.

- Ryan set the UW wins record in just 365 games and 11 seasons.
 Foster reached the milestone in 532 games and 25 seasons.
- ◆ Bo Ryan became the 56th NCAA coach to reach the 600-win plateau and is 1 of just 9 active Division I coaches to reach that hallowed ground. Ryan's career winning percentage of .761 is 3rd only to North Carolina's Roy Williams (.797) and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (.763) among active coaches with 600 wins. Among all-time coaches with 600 career wins (regardless of NCAA classification), Ryan's winning percentage ranks 10th.
- Ryan tied legendary Indiana coach Branch McCracken as the 2nd-fastest coach in conference history to record 100 Big Ten wins, doing so in 140 games. Only Bob Knight did it faster (131 games).
- ◆ Ryan's .706 (144-60) win percentage in conference games is the 2nd-best mark in Big Ten history, trailing only OSU's Thad Matta (111-45, .712) and surpassing legend Indiana coach Bob Knight (353-151, .700).
- ◆ Indiana's Bob Knight (327) and Purdue's Ward Lambert (331) are the only coaches in Big Ten history to reach 250 wins faster than Bo Ryan, who did it in 343 games.
- ◆ Ryan won his third Big Ten Coach of the Year honor in 2013. Only Purdue's Gene Keady (7) and Indiana's Bob Knight (5) have won the honor more times than Ryan.

With 304 wins, Ryan is the all-time wins leader in Wisconsin history, surpassing Hall of Famer Bud Foster (265). Prior to Ryan's hire at UW in 2001-02, the Badgers had four 19-win seasons (high of 22) in 103 years.

Including last season, Ryan has now led the UW to at least 19 wins in each of his 12 seasons at UW and owns 10 seasons of 20+ wins. In fact, Ryan's teams have accounted for the 9 winningest seasons in school annals.

Wisconsin has averaged 24.3 wins per season during the Ryan era, including a school-record 31 wins in 2007-08.

Big Ten Record

UW pre-Bo Ryan: 607-757 (.445) UW with Bo Ryan: 144-61 (.706)

In the first 96 years of Big Ten play, Wisconsin won at least 11 Big Ten games 9 times (including just once since 1941). Including this season, Ryan has led the Badgers to at least 11 conference wins in 10 of his 12 seasons. He was the first Big Ten coach to win at least 11 league games in each of his first four years.

Ryan has led Wisconsin to a 144-60 (.706) record in Big Ten play, owning the 2nd-highest winning percentage of any coach in Big Ten history.

Ryan is the fastest coach in UW history to reach 100 Big Ten wins, doing so in 140 games. That also ties Branch McCracken as the 2nd-fastest in conference history. Only Bob Knight (131 games) did it faster.

UW has finished among the top 4 in the Big Ten in each of Ryan's 11 seasons. That 11-year stretch of top-4 finishes is the 2nd-longest in Big Ten history, trailing only Purdue's run of 13 in a row from 1920-32.

NCAA Tournament Record

Wisconsin made seven appearances in the first 63 years of the NCAA tournament. Since Bo Ryan took over as head coach, the Badgers have earned 12 consecutive tournament bids and advanced to the Sweet 16 five times

UW has won 16 NCAA tournament games under Ryan, surpassing the Badgers' total of 9 in the 63 years prior to Ryan.

Wisconsin Coaching Staff

BO RYANHEAD COACH

When Bo Ryan took over as head coach at Wisconsin in 2002, he was promptly dubbed Big Ten Coach of the Year in each of his first two seasons. Last year, his 12th at UW, Ryan proved he is still



thought of in the same light, collecting the third Big Ten Coach of the Year award of his career.

Now as Ryan enters his 30th season as a head coach in 2013-14 - his 13th atop the Wisconsin program - it's difficult to decide which is more impressive, his incredible longevity or his unparalleled success. It is, however, safe to say that the combination of the two is what elevates Ryan among college basketball's elite.

Owning the most wins in UW annals (291 entering 2013-14), Ryan is also one of just 40 coaches in NCAA history to reach the 650-career win plateau. Ryan's career winning percentage of .757 (674-216) is seventh all-time among coaches with 600 career wins.

A member of five Halls of Fame, Ryan has been enshrined into the Wilkes College Athletic HOF (2003), the Delaware County Chapter of the Pennsylvania Sports HOF (2008), the Pennsylvania Sports HOF (2011), the Wis. Basketball Coaches Assoc. HOF (2011) and the Wis. Intercollegiate Athletic Conference HOF (2012).
