OPENING TIP

• Indiana University is in its 116th season of men's basketball and will put a seven-game winning streak on the line when it hosts Wisconsin on Tuesday. IU completed a Big Ten road weep with a 79-69 win at Nebraska on Saturday. The Hoosiers will host the Badgers for the first time since January 14, 2014 when IU topped previously undefeated UW, 75-72.

1976 UNDEFEATED CHAMPS TO BE HONORED

• Members of the 1976 undefeated national championship team will be recognized at halftime in celebration of the 40th anniversary of their accomplishment which landed them the distinction of being the All-Time March Madness Team by the NCAA in 2013.

HEAD COACH TOM CREAN

• **Tom Crean** is in his eighth year of leading the Hoosiers. **Over the last four+ years, IU is 105-48 and leads the Big Ten with 19 regular season wins over ranked opponents during that time.** During that same span, the Hoosiers have appeared nationally ranked in at least one major poll during the season. He has recruited a McDonald's All-American in each of the last five years. In addition, he has seen seven of his players score 1,000 points or more in an IU uniform. **Since 2011, the Hoosiers have averaged 23 wins per season compared to 20 averaged at IU from 1995-2008.** Seven players have scored 1,000 points in their career under Tom Crean at Indiana. Christian Watford (1,730), Yogi Ferrell (1,632), Verdell Jones III (1,347), Jordan Hulls (1,318), Cody Zeller (1,157), Will Sheehey (1,120) and Victor Oladipo (1,117).

BRINGING FATIGUE TO THE GAME

• In Hoosier wins, IU is shooting 62.0% from the floor and 53.0% from three-point range in the final 10 minutes of games compared to its opponents shooting 39.7% from the floor and 27.3% from long distance during crunch time.

YOGI IS BIG TEN ACTIVE LEADER

• Senior **Kevin "Yogi" Ferrell** enters his final conference season as the active leader in scoring (1,632), assists (529), three-point field goals made (220) and is the only senior in the league to have started every game he has played (117).

Last week, he averaged 22 points, seven assists and three rebounds and averaged 15.5 points in the second half to rally IU to two road wins to start Big Ten play. He is currently sixth in the Big Ten in scoring, fourth in assists, and sixth in free throw percentage.

GOOD DEFENSE

• The Hoosiers held Nebraska's top two offensive threats, Shavon Shields and Andrew White III to just 34.7% shooting between the two (8 for 23) after they entered the game shooting 49.4% from the field.

FRESHMAN IMPACT

• Last week, IU freshmen Thomas Bryant, OG Anunoby and Juwan Morgan posted big numbers as a group in their first exposure to the Big Ten. Collectively, they contributed 45 points, 20 rebounds, shot 76.1% from the floor, made all three long distance attempts (Anunoby) and made 76.9% of their FT attempts. In addition, they combined for three assists and four blocks and steals.

IU INSIGHT

• Sophomore guard **James Blackmon, Jr.**, (15.8 ppg) did not play last week. He suffered a knee injury in practice last Monday and is under continued evaluation.

• Since the 2011-12 season, the Hoosier offense is first in the Big Ten in points scored (77.6), field goal percentage (47.8), and three-point field goal percentage (40.4).

• The Hoosiers lead the Big Ten in scoring (87.7), field goal percentage (53.4), three-point FG percentage (45.1), steals (7.7) offensive rebound percentage (40.2), and turnovers forced (14.9).

• The Hoosiers are 2nd in the country in FG percentage, 4th in scoring and three-point FG percentage, 9th in three-point field goals made, 14th in scoring margin, 18th in assists and 28th in steals.

• Since the start of the 2011-12 season, IU is 105-48 giving the Hoosiers 100 wins in a similar span for the first time since 1999 to 2004 when IU won 101 games in five full seasons (162 games).

• IU has shot 50 percent or better in 22 of its last 49 games dating back to last season. In addition, IU has shot 40 percent or better from three-point range in 29 of contests.

MORE YOGI

• **Ferrell** is one of two active players in the country to have at least 1,550 career points (1,608), 500 assists (522) and 350 rebounds (369) (other is Juan'ya Green, Hofstra). He was named second team Preseason All-American by *The Sporting News* and *USA Today*, in addition to garnering third team honors from *Athlon Sports* and fourth team mention in *Blue Ribbon Magazine*. Ferrell now has 1,632 points in his IU career, which ranks 12th on the all-time list at IU. He also has 529 career assists in his IU career, which ranks third in school history. He has made 216 3FG in his IU career, which ranks third in school history. For the season, he is averaging 16.9 points, 4.5 rebounds and 6.1 assists.

MAX SET THE TONE AT RUTGERS

• Senior graduate transfer **Max Bielfeldt** had his best day as a collegian with 18 points, 14 rebounds, two assists and two steals off the bench at Rutgers. He has exceeded his career averages at Michigan in his one season with Indiana. He is averaging 8.3 points (3.5 at UM), 5.1 rebounds (2.3 at UM), and is shooting 59.5% (5th in Big Ten) from the field (45.3 at UM) and 50.0 from three-point range (26.8 at UM).

WILLIAMS IMPACT

• Junior forward **Troy Williams** is averaging 13.7 points and 7.2 rebounds in his last 10 games and is shooting 59.3 from the field. His seven three-point field goals in 15 games eclipses his season-totals of six in each of the last two seasons. Williams is seventh in the league in rebounding and in field goal percentage and is second in the Big Ten in steals.

ODDS AND TRENDS

• The Hoosiers have notched 50 percent or better shooting in 22 out of 30 halves played so far this season.

• Freshman **Thomas Bryant** is third among the league's first-year players averaging 12.0 points. He leads the Big Ten in field goal shooting making 73.1% of his shot attempts. He had 19 points, four rebounds and three blocked shots at Nebraska.

• Sophomore **Robert Johnson** is second in the Big Ten in three-point field goal percentage making 52.2% of his shots. Team is 9-0 when he starts. He had 16 point against the Badgers in Madison last season.

• Sophomore **James Blackmon, Jr.**, is 10th in the league in scoring (15.8), third in three-point field goals made per game (2.8) and seventh in three-point field goal percentage (46.3). He had a season-high 33 points against Alcorn State earlier this year.

• Senior **Nick Zeisloft** is 5th in the Big Ten shooting 48.3% from three-point range. Last year, he had 19 points against the Badgers hitting seven of 12 from the field and five of nine from three-point range.

• Junior **Collin Hartman** made his 18th career start and sixth this season at Nebraska. He tied a season-high with nine points and made all three of his long distance attempts at Rutgers. He is averaging 5.6 points and 3.0 rebounds while shooting 58.8% from the field and 60.0% from long distance in the last five games.

• Freshman **OG Anunoby** is averaging 9.5 points and 5.0 rebounds in his first two Big Ten games. He is coming off a career-high 11-point effort at Nebraska and also added three rebounds and two steals. In his first Big Ten game at Rutgers he had eight points, seven rebounds and two steals to help the Hoosiers. He also has made all three of his three-point shots.

• Freshman **Juwan Morgan** hit two big free throws, grabbed two boards and had an assist and a turnover at Nebraska. At Rutgers, he had two points and three rebounds in six minutes off the bench against Rutgers. Prior to the break, he had two points, two rebounds, a block and a steal against Kennesaw State.

• Junior walk-on **Ryan Burton** played 10 minutes against Rutgers and scored a career-high six points when he drained both of his long distance attempts.

• For the third time under Tom Crean, the Hoosiers have put together a seven-game winning streak. IU won 12 to start the 2011-12 season and nine to begin the 2012-13 campaign.

The team includes 13 members of the 1991 Indiana All-Star squad. Five other all-state players are included to recognize the top of Indiana's high school class of 1991.

1991 Indiana All-Stars include Mr. Basketball Glenn Robinson, **Alan Henderson**, Daimon Beathea, Brandon Brantley, **Brian Evans**, Andy Elkins, Marlon Fleming, Jeff Massey, LaMar Morton, Steve Nicodemus, Andre Owens, LaSalle Thompson and Chris Wilburn.

The remaining five, named to various all-state teams are: Lance Barker, Tony Etchison, Jerry Freshwater, Chad Gilbert and Jason Williams.

Evans played at Indiana from 1992-1996 and was named Big Ten MVP in 1996 after averaging 21.2 points, 7.1 rebounds and shooting 39.2 percent from the 3-point line his senior year. He was also a Third Team All-American and went on to be named Male Athlete of the Year at Indiana and earned the Balfour Award. He finished his career with 1,701 points and 730 rebounds and shot 40.8 percent from behind the 3-point line.

Henderson was an All-American at Indiana in 1995 as he averaged 23.5 points and 9.7 rebounds per game - including a 41-point performance against Michigan State. For his career, he posted 1,979 points and 1,091 rebounds and shot 54.0 percent from the floor.

All Mens Silver Anniversary Team members will be honored at the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame's Annual Men's Banquet on Wednesday, March 23, 2016.

A midday reception, free and open to the public, will be held at the Hall of Fame museum in New Castle. The evening banquet will take place at the Primo Banquet Hall, which is located on the south side of Indianapolis.

40TH ANNIVERSARY OF 1976 CHAMPS

Indiana University Vice President and Director of Intercollegiate Athletics **Fred Glass** today announced initial plans for a season long recognition to honor the 40th anniversary of the undefeated 1976 men's basketball team. Indiana's 1976 team remains the last undefeated NCAA men's basketball champion and was selected as the greatest college basketball team of all-time on the 75th anniversary of the NCAA Tournament in 2013.

The season-long honoring of the 40th anniversary is being highlighted by: season tickets being mailed to fans in a folded keepsake replica of the 1976 championship banner; a commemorative patch placed on the back of IU's home and away jerseys throughout the year; a public recognition of that perfect championship season during IU's home game against Wisconsin on January 5, 2016; and the induction of **Bobby Wilkerson** and **Tom Abernethy** into the IU Athletics Hall of Fame. With Wilkerson and Abernethy being inducted tonight, all five starters from the 1976 undefeated team will now be in the IU Athletics Hall of Fame along with head coach Bob Knight.

This season-long recognition continues IU Athletics efforts in recent years to honor the accomplishments the players and coaches from the back-to-back undefeated regular seasons which, among other things, established Knight as a legendary coach and produced four All-Americans, three Big Ten MVP's, and a National Player of the Year. Last season, IU honored the seniors from the 1975 team that won the Big Ten Championship and finished the regular season undefeated with an on-court public recognition.

In 2013, Scott May (represented by his son Scott Jr.), Kent Benson, Isiah Thomas, Steve Alford (represented by his father), and Keith Smart (represented by Todd Meier) were also recognized in a half-time ceremony for being named as some of the greatest players in the 75 year history of the NCAA Tournament. In addition to the induction of Abernethy and Wilkerson in the IU Athletics Hall of Fame this year, Coach Knight was inducted in 2009.

**BUCKNER INDUCTED TO COLLEGE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME**

KANSAS CITY -- Former Indiana University men's basketball All-American **Quinn Buckner**, who helped lead the Hoosiers to a perfect season and the 1976 NCAA Championship, is one of five former college basketball standouts in the 2015 induction class of the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame. The National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame was established in 2006 and Buckner is the fourth former IU player to be inducted, joining Branch McCracken, Walt Bellamy and Isiah Thomas, who were honored in 2006. IU Coaches Bob Knight and Everett Dean also were inducted in 2006.

Buckner joins Kansas State's **Rolando Blackman**, Ohio State's **John Havlicek**, Long Beach State's **Ed Ratleff** and North Carolina's **Charlie Scott** as the headline players in the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame's induction class of 2015. Joining them for the 10th enshrinement ceremony are legendary coaches **Don Donoher** of Dayton, **C. Felton "Zip" Gayles** of Langston and **Lou Henson**, who coached at Hardin-Simmons, New Mexico State and Illinois.

The Class of 2015 was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame on Friday, November 20, 2015, at the Arvest Bank Theatre at the Midland in Kansas City as part of a three-day celebration of college basketball.

The National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame is located in the College Basketball Experience (CBE), a world-class entertainment facility adjacent to Kansas City's Sprint Center, which will serve as the venue of the annual CBE Hall of Fame Classic.

A three-year captain at Indiana for Coach Bob Knight, Quinn Buckner was a key member of IU's 1975-76 NCAA Championship team, which is the last team to go unbeaten throughout an entire season and post-season. He is one of only three players to win a title at the high school, college, NBA and Olympic level, joining Jerry Lucas and Magic Johnson.

In 2006, the first class was inducted into the newly formed National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame. That class included the game's inventor, James Naismith, and possibly its greatest coach, John Wooden. Since that time, eight more classes have been inducted and have included the likes of Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, Danny Manning, Larry Bird, Earvin "Magic" Johnson and Shaquille O'Neal.

BAILEY, CHEANEY PART OF 55TH INDUCTION CLASS TO INDIANA BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

NEW CASTLE, Indiana -- Including the all-time leading scorer in Indiana high school basketball history, the all-time leading scorer in Indiana University and Big Ten Conference history, men who once held the all-time scoring records at Butler University and Indiana State University, a pair of Indiana high school state champion players, the record holder for state finals rebounding, a collegiate national champion player and a coach of two Indiana Mr. Basketballs, the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame announces their 55th mens' induction class.

Damon Bailey remains the all-time leading scorer in Indiana high school basketball history 26 years after he graduated from Bedford North Lawrence High School with 3,134 points. The 1990 Indiana Mr. Basketball, he led the Stars to three state finals appearances, including the 1990 state championship. A 1994 All-American as a senior at Indiana University, he graduated having won more games in an IU jersey than any other player (108) including a school-record 11 NCAA Tournament wins, tied for 2nd in games played (132), the all-time leader in three-point field goals made (166), 5th in three-point % (.437), tied for 2nd in assists (474), and 5th in career scoring (1,741).

Bailey is inducted in his first year eligible (26 years after high school graduation), and becomes just the 9th player inducted into the Hall in their first year of eligibility (joining Steve Alford, Kent Benson, Larry Bird, Dave Colescott, Kyle Macy, George McGinnis, Rick Mount and Oscar Robertson).

Calbert Cheaney set records at Evansville Harrison High School before a remarkable college and pro career. The only player in Harrison history to have his jersey retired, Cheaney holds the single-game school scoring record (47) amongst his 1,064 points. A three-time college All-American and the consensus 1993 National Player of the Year, he re-wrote the Indiana University record book, remaining today the all-time leading scorer (2,613 points) in school and Big Ten Conference history.

Setting the IU record for career starts (130) and graduating 2nd in career games played (132), he left with the school record in field goals made (1,018), 2nd in career FG % (.559), 4th in three-point % (.438) and having led the team in scoring all four years, he held three of the top 13 single-season scoring totals in IU history upon graduation.
