UW TRAVEL TO OHIO STATE, HOST PURDUE

- No. 3 Wisconsin (18-3, 10-2 B1G) has a split week of competition, traveling to No. 22 Ohio State on Wednesday. The Badgers and Buckeyes (15-9, 5-7) serve off at 7 p.m. CT live on the Big Ten Network.
- Wisconsin returns home on Saturday, hosting Purdue (14-9, 4-8) in a 7 p.m. contest in the UW Field House. The match is already sold out.

AT THE NET

- Wisconsin has won three straight matches, after downing No. 10 Penn State, 3-1, and Rutgers, 3-0, at home last weekend. The Badgers beat the Nittany Lions for the first time since 2011.
- The Badgers are in sole possession of second place in the Big Ten standings at 10-2 after the weekend. Nebraska (11-1) leads the league while Minnesota and Penn State (9-3) are tied for third.
- Senior **Haleigh Nelson** picked up the 1,000th kill of her career in the second set against Rutgers on Sunday while senior **Lauren Carlini** earned the 5,000th assist of her career in the third set against the Scarlet Knights.
- Senior **Lauren Carlini** was named the Big Ten Setter of the Week for the 10th time of her career on Monday. She averaged 15.29 assists and 4.57 digs per set on the weekend.
- Wisconsin moved up to third in this week's AVCA Top-25 Coaches' poll and remain second in the NCAA RPI released Monday.
- The Badgers are 9-3 against AVCA Top-25 teams this season after defeating No. 10 Penn State last Friday.
- Junior **Lauryn Gillis** recorded a career-high 21 kills in leading the Badgers over No. 10 Penn State last Friday. She also added 16 kills against Rutgers on Sunday to average 5.29 kills per set on the weekend.
- Junior **Kelli Bates** showed her versatility on the weekend, playing one match at libero and one match at outside hitter. Against No. 10 Penn State, Bates played libero and had a match-high 22 digs. Against Rutgers, she started at outside hitter and had a double-double with 11 kills and 11 digs.
- Wisconsin had a school record 61 kills (for three sets under 25-point rally scoring) against Rutgers on Sunday. The Badgers also set a school record with 59 assists against the Scarlet Knights with **Lauren Carlini** putting up a record 50 helpers.

- Wisconsin has won three straight matches, after downing No. 10 Penn State, 3-1, and Rutgers, 3-0, at home last weekend.
- The Badgers beat the Nittany Lions for the first time since 2011 and for only the eighth time in program history.
- UW opened the season winning five straight before losing at then-No. 11 North Carolina on Sept. 9. The Badgers then won nine straight before losing to No. 3 Minnesota on Oct. 12.

CARLINI NAMED SOTW

- For the 10th time in her career, Lauren Carlini has been named the Big Ten Setter of the Week. It is the second most Setter of the Week awards in the conference history, trailing only Penn State's Mich Hancock who won 16 awards.
- The 6-2 setter had a career weekend surpassing 5,000 total assists. Carlini achieved the milestone in the third set against Rutgers on Sunday, becoming just the third UW setter and 21st Big Ten player over 5,000 helpers.
- The Aurora, Illinois, native put up a school record 50 assists against the Scarlet Knights, breaking her own three-set, 25-point rally scoring mark of 49 established against Purdue on Nov. 28, 2015.

Carlini also put up 57 helpers against the Nittany Lions to average an impressive 15.29 assists per set on the weekend.

- In addition to her assists, Carlini was a defensive dandy, averaging 4.57 digs per set as she recorded two double doubles. She added 15 digs against Rutgers and 17 digs against Penn State. She also led the team with five service aces over the two matches, averaging 0.71 per set, and chipped in four blocks against Penn State.
- On the year, Carlini ranks second in the Big Ten with 11.47 assists per set and is the only senior in the top 15 of the Big Ten in digs per set with 2.76..

NELSON GETS 1,000 KILLS

- Senior **Haleigh Nelson** picked up the 1,000th kill of her career in the second set against Rutgers on Sunday. The 6-4 middle blocker became the 20th UW player and seventh middle blocker to record 1,000 kills.
- Nelson became the 41st Big Ten athlete and seventh UW player to record 500 blocks at Texas on Sept. 18. She is just the fifth Wisconsin player to record more than 1,000 career kills and 500 career blocks.
- She has 539 stuffs in her fourth season, which ranks sixth on the Badger record list. She needs 16 blocks to move into fifth, a position currently held by Kelly Kennedy (1996-99) with 555 blocks.
- Nelson also ranks fourth in block assists (490) and seventh in blocks per set (1.20).
- Nelson continues to rank first for UW career hitting percentage at .369, which moves her ahead of Sherisa Livingston (1998-01), who hit .366 as a Badger.

CARLINI PICKS UP 5,000 ASSISTS

- Senior **Lauren Carlini** earned the 5,000th assist of her career in the third set against the Scarlet Knights on Sunday. She is just the third Badger and the 21st Big Ten setter to record 5,000 career assists.

- The 6-2 setter ranks third at UW with 5,007 assists. She needs 228 assists to move into second at Wisconsin, a position currently held by Jackie Simpson (2004-07) with 5,235 assists. The UW career record is 5,833 helpers by Laura Abbinante (1993-96).
- Carlini also ranks eighth on the UW career record list with 1,251 digs. She is just the second Badger setter to record more than 5,000 assists and more than 1,200 digs, following in the footsteps of Abbinante, who had 5,833 assists and 1,246 digs in her career.
- Carlini needs just 38 digs to pass Marisa Mackey (1995-98), who had 1,289 digs, for seventh on the UW record list. Carlini also ranks fifth in assists per set (11.43) and 10th in digs per set (2.86).

TOUGH SCHEDULE

- The Badgers are 9-3 against AVCA Top-25 teams this season after defeating No. 10 Penn State last Friday. The nine wins are the fourth most over ranked opponents in a season in program history.

- UW has also defeated then-No. 6 Hawaii, then-No. 18 San Diego, then-No. 16 Texas A&M, then-No. 2 Texas, then-No. 17 Ohio State, then-No. 14 Purdue, then-No. 24 Illinois and then-No. 18 Michigan.
- Wisconsin's losses have come to then-No. 11 North Carolina, No. 3 Minnesota and No. 1 Nebraska.

- The Badgers have played the third-toughest schedule in the country, according to the NCAA RPI released Oct. 31. Texas ranks first with TCU second. Purdue and Minnesota rank fourth and fifth, respectively.

WISCONSIN MOVES UP TO THIRD

- The Badgers moved up one spot to third in the AVCA Top 25 Coaches' poll released Oct. 31. Wisconsin has been among the top-six teams nationally all season long.
- The Big Ten continues to dominate the poll with the top three teams, four teams in the top 11, and seven teams in the top 25.
- Nebraska (20-1) remains first while Minnesota (17-4) moves up to second. Following Wisconsin in third, Kansas (20-2) jumps up two spots to fourth after downing Texas last week. The Longhorns (17-3) fall to fifth.
- Penn State (17-6) drops one spot to 11th while Michigan State (19-5) falls one place to 16th. Michigan (18-6) moves back four places to 17th and Ohio State (15-9) moves back three spots to 22nd. Purdue and Illinois are receiving votes.

BADGERS REMAIN SECOND IN RPI

- In the fifth NCAA RPI of the season, released Oct. 31, Wisconsin remains second behind Big Ten foe Nebraska.
- The RPI is one of the tools used by the NCAA committee to select tournament teams. It is also used to select host teams for the tournament, including regionals.
- The Badgers have played 18 of 21 matches against teams in the top 100 of the RPI, including 10 matches against top-25 teams.
- The Big Ten has eight teams in the top 30, including five in the top 12. In addition to the

Huskers and Badgers, Minnesota is fourth, Michigan is 11th, and Michigan State ranks 12th.

BADGERS SET SCHOOL RECORDS

- Wisconsin had a school record 61 kills (for three sets under 25-point rally scoring) against Rutgers on Sunday. That broke the previous mark of 53 kills, set three other times, including most recently at Colorado State on Sept. 6, 2014.
- The Badgers also set a school record with 59 assists against the Scarlet Knights with **Lauren Carlini** putting up a record 50 helpers. The previous best team mark for assists was 52 against California on Dec. 7, 2013, while Carlini broke her own record of 49 assists against Purdue on Nov. 28, 2015.
- The Badgers also had 67 kills against Penn State on Friday to average an impressive 18.29 kills per set through two matches.

IMPRESSIVE WEEKEND NUMBERS

- The Badgers put up some impressive hitting and dig numbers last weekend against No. 10 Penn State and Rutgers.
- Individually, **Lauryn Gillis** averaged 5.29 kills per set while **Romana Kříšková** and **Molly Haggerty** both chipped in 4.00 kills per set.
- **Lauren Carlini** averaged 15.29 assists per set while **Kelli Bates** led the team with 4.71 digs per set. Carlini added 4.57 digs per set.

GILLIS IS BACK!

- Junior **Lauryn Gillis** recorded a career-high 21 kills in leading the Badgers over No. 10 Penn State last Friday. She also added 16 kills against Rutgers on Sunday to average 5.29 kills per set on the weekend.
- The 6-1 outside hitter missed six matches from Sept. 9-24 with an ankle injury and is getting back to her non-conference form.
- Gillis ranks second on the team with 2.96 kills per set while leading the Badgers with 2.74 kills per set in Big Ten play.

KRIŠKOVÁ ON THE ATTACK

- Senior **Romana Krišková** has found her rhythm attacking over the last five matches. The 6-2 right-side hitter has double figures in four matches to average 3.11 kills per set over the stretch.
- Krišková led the Badgers with a UW career best 18 kills against Rutgers on Sunday. She also added 10 kills against Penn State on Friday.
- A native of Slovakia, Krišková has double-figure kills in five matches this season. She ranks fifth on the team with 2.15 kills per set while hitting .261.

IT'S ALL ABOUT THE BATES!

- Junior **Kelli Bates** showed her versatility on the weekend, playing one match at libero and one match at outside hitter.
- Against No. 10 Penn State, Bates played libero and had a match-high 22 digs, her fifth match this season with 20-plus digs.
- Against Rutgers, the 5-11 Bates started at outside hitter and had a double-double with 11 kills and 11 digs. On the weekend, she averaged 4.71 digs per set while adding 1.57 kills per set.
- For the season, Bates leads the Badgers with 3.86 digs per set. She has started 11 matches at outside hitter and 10 matches at libero.

THANK YOU FANS!

- Wisconsin has sold out the UW Field House six times this season and is averaging a school record attendance.
- The Badgers are averaging 5,960 fans per match this season, which ranks third nationally. Nebraska leads the nation with 8,206 per match while Hawaii ranks second at 6,536 per match.
- UW's mark would set a school record for attendance average, shattering the current mark of 5,050 fans per match set in 2007.
- For the first time in program history, the Badgers sold more than 3,000 season tickets. UW sold 3,279 season tickets for 2016, an increase of 1,170 from 2015.

SHEFFIELD PICKS UP 100 WINS

- Head coach **Kelly Sheffield** picked up his 100th win at Wisconsin on Oct. 15 with a 3-2 win at No. 18 Michigan.
- In his fourth year on the Badger bench, Sheffield is 103-23 (.817), the 13th best winning percentage nationally over the last four seasons.

- He became the fastest coach to reach 100 wins at Wisconsin. Former head coach Pete Waite won 100 matches 24 contests into his fourth season while Sheffield did it 17 matches into his fourth year.
- Sheffield is also 374-135 (.735) in his 16th year as a head coach.

SERVICE PLEASE

- In conference-only matches, UW ranks second in the Big Ten with 1.67 service aces per set (70 total) while giving up only 0.67 aces per set (28 total), which leads the league.
- In all matches, Wisconsin has given up 44 service aces, allowing only 0.59 per set for all matches, which also leads the Big Ten.
- Wisconsin recorded a school three-set record 11 service aces at Rutgers on Oct. 5, including a career-high and school record six aces by senior **Lauren Carlini**. Freshman **Sarah Dodd** tied her career best with two aces against the Scarlet Knights.
- The Badgers followed that up with 10 aces against Illinois on Oct. 8. Senior **Haleigh Nelson** and sophomore **Amber MacDonald** both had three service aces against the Illini. MacDonald tied her career best, previously set against Illinois on Sept. 30, 2015.
- UW scored eight service aces at Iowa on Oct. 22, including four from Nelson, which tied her career high. She had three straight in the first set to put Wisconsin up 8-3.
- In conference play, Carlini ranks second in the Big Ten with 0.48 service aces per set (20 total) while Nelson ranks fourth with 0.38 aces per set (16 total).
- In all matches, Wisconsin is averaging 1.36 aces per set (101 total), which ranks fourth in the Big Ten, while giving up only 0.59 aces per set (44 total).
- UW has recorded more service aces than 16 of 21 opponents, while tying the last five foes.
- On the season, Carlini leads the Badgers with 26 aces (0.35/set) while Nelson adds 24 service aces (0.32/set). Three other Badgers are in double figures with Bates (13), **Molly Haggerty** (13) and MacDonald (11) scoring well from the line.

STRUGGLING ON THE BLOCK

- Wisconsin has struggled with its blocking in the last six matches, getting outblocked by five opponents
- Over the stretch, UW is averaging just 1.6 blocks per set while opponents are averaging 2.9 blocks per set.
- The Badgers were also out dug by four straight opponents until outdigging Penn State 73-53 and Rutgers 68-35.
- On the season, UW is averaging 2.56 blocks per set while foes average 2.32 blocks per set. The Badgers average 15.14 digs per set while opponents average 13.26 digs per set.

- Only seniors **Lauren Carlini** (setter) and **Haleigh Nelson** as well as sophomore **Tionna Williams** (middle blockers) have started all 19 matches.

- Seniors **Lauren Carlini** and **Haleigh Nelson** were named to the 14-player Preseason All-Big Ten team. Carlini, who was one of four unanimous selections, earns her third-straight preseason honor while Nelson picks up her first honor.

STRONG TEAM RETURNS

- UW lost only one letterwinner to graduation, starting libero Taylor Morey. Wisconsin returned 11 letterwinners and six starters.

#22 Ohio State

The Buckeyes enter the week with a 15-9 season record, notching wins over No. 1 Nebraska and No. 11 Michigan State in October. With a 5-7 record in Big Ten play, OSU fell to Maryland in five sets on Wednesday before sweeping the Terrapins in Columbus on Friday.

Ohio State ranks second among Big Ten teams in kills, averaging 14.15 kills per set.

Taylor Sandbothe leads all Buckeyes with 337 kills (3.92/set), ranking fourth in the conference, and averages a .329 attack percentage (337K - 102E - 714TA). A 6-2 senior middle blocker, Sandbothe adds a team-high 1.10 blocks per set, as well as 25 service aces. Audra Appold, a 6-1 sophomore outside hitter, averages 3.33 kills per set, while 6-1 junior outside hitter Luisa Schirmer contributes 2.86 kills per set and 6-1 sophomore setter Taylor Hughes chips in 1.45 per set.

Hughes averages 10.50 assists per set, playing a major part in the Buckeyes No. 1 rank in assists in the conference, adding 57 blocks (0.66/set) and 158 digs (1.84/set). Hughes' team-high 30 aces (0.35/set) ranks sixth in the conference.

The Buckeyes trail only Wisconsin in team digs, averaging 14.66 saves per set. Valeria Leon, a 5-6 senior defensive specialist, averages 4.15 digs per set, ranking sixth in the Big Ten, while Schirmer adds 2.59 saves per set and Appold contributes 2.29 per set.
