UW GOES FOR 6 IN A ROW WEDNESDAY

- On the heels of a victory over I-94 rival Marquette, Wisconsin hosts another in-state rival when Green Bay comes to the Kohl Center on Wednesday, Dec. 14. Tip off is at 8 p.m. (CT) on the Big Ten Network.
- Up next, the Badgers will take a 9-day break for final exams on campus before hosting Florida A&M on Dec. 23 at 8 p.m. on BTN.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT WISCONSIN

- **GARD IN CHARGE:** Since the Dec. 15, 2015 retirement of Bo Ryan, Greg Gard and Wisconsin haven't missed a step. The 2016 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year, Gard is 14-2 (.875) as head coach at the Kohl Center.
- **GANG'S ALL HERE:** UW returns each of the top 9 scorers from last season, bringing back all but 20 minutes (99.8%) and 6 points (99.7%).
- **BIG WINS:** Wisconsin already owns wins over 2 of the 2016 Final Four participants (Syracuse and Oklahoma) and has beaten teams from the ACC, Big East (2x), Big 12 and SEC this season.
- **PRAISE FOR HAYES:** Last week's Big Ten Player of the Week, senior **Nigel Hayes** has been the catalyst for UW's 5-game win streak. Including a season-high 28 points vs. Oklahoma (12/3), Hayes is shooting 58.7% from the field, 3-for-4 on 3FGs and averaging 8.0 FTAs during the 5-game stretch.
- **HAYES CLIMBING:** Enters Saturday's game at Marquette, Hayes ranks 9th on UW's all-time scoring list with 1,486 career points. The versatile forward is also the nation's only active player with at least 1,400 points, 600 rebounds and 200 assists.
- **LOOKING TO SCORE:** Sporting one of the most efficient offenses in the nation (10th according to KenPom.com), the Badgers are averaging 86.6 ppg and shooting 53.4% over the last 5 outings.
- **GETTING DEFENSIVE:** Wisconsin has held 8 of its 11 opponents to season-low point totals. According to KenPom.com, the Badgers rank 20th in the NCAA in adjusted defensive efficiency.
- **OWNING THE GLASS:** The Badgers are 3rd in the nation with a +13.7 rebounding margin. UW also leads the NCAA in defensive rebounding pct. (80.3%) and is 12th in off. (39.8%) rebounding pct.
- **MAKING IT HAPP-EN:** **Ethan Happ** has scored in double figures in 8 straight and is near the top of several B1G categories: 2nd in rpg (9.5), 3rd in O-rpg (3.3), 2nd in FG% (.700) and 4th in spg (1.5).
- **KOENIG HEATING UP:** Wisconsin's leading scorer (16.0 ppg), **Bronson Koenig** is 18-for-32 (.563) from 3-point range over the last 4 games. He ranks 3rd in the Big Ten with 2.9 3FGs per game.
- **PROTECT THIS HOUSE:** The Badgers have won 12 in a row at home. UW's .872 all-time win percentage (265-39) at the Kohl Center ranks 5th among all active arenas in the NCAA.



Nigel Hayes has averaged 16.4 ppg, 6.0 rpg and 4.6 apg over UW's 5-game win streak.

ALL-TIME VS. GREEN BAY

▶ Wisconsin and Green Bay have played every year since 1999 and Wednesday's contest will mark the 23rd meeting all-time. The Badgers own a 21-1 record against Green Bay, going 18-0 in Madison.

▶ Greg Gard's first game as head coach was against Green Bay (Dec. 23, 2015), an 84-79 win, nearly one year ago.

▶ Wisconsin has won each of the last 6 meetings with Green Bay by an average of 14.2 points per game.

▶ Since the regular meetings began in 1999, Green Bay is averaging 56.7 ppg against UW and has scored more than 62 points just 3 times (2009, 2013 and 2015).

LAST TIME OUT

#17 UW 93, MARQUETTE 84

Dec. 10, 2016 | Bradley Center, Milwaukee, Wis.

▶ Wisconsin grabbed bragging rights for the year with a 93-84 win over I-94 rival Marquette last Saturday at the BMO Harris Bradley Center. The Badgers trailed 40-35 at intermission, but erupted for 58 second-half points, as six players scored in double figures.

▶ UW used a 16-0 run midway through the second half to turn a 46-47 deficit into a 62-47 lead. Six different Badgers scored during that stretch and Wisconsin held the Golden Eagles scoreless for a span of 5:39 to take control.

▶ The Badgers shot a season-high 58.2% and 44.4% (8-18) from 3-point range. UW assisted on 20 of its 32 baskets.

▶ UW's 93 points are the school's most-ever scored in the series with Marquette. The Badgers also equaled their highest scoring output in a road game over the last 20 years (also scored 93 in a win at Milwaukee in 2013).

▶ The 93 points are UW's most in road game vs. a major conference team since a 104-98 loss at Minnesota in 1971.

▶ The Badgers tallied their most points in a half since scoring 58 in the second half of a 99-55 win over Prairie View A&M in the 2010-11 opener.

▶ **Bronson Koenig** led UW with 18 points (4-6 3FGs) and a season-high 6 assists. **Nigel Hayes** filled out his stat line with 17 points, 9 rebounds, 4 assists, 1 block and 3 steals.

▶ **Khalil Iverson** scored a career-high 16 points (5-6 FGs), including 12 in the second half. He also added 5 boards.

▶ **Ethan Happ** picked up 2 fouls in first 101 seconds and sat the rest of the half. Happ scored all 11 points and grabbed all 5 of his rebounds in 15 minutes of action in the second half.

▶ **Vitto Brown** (15) and **Zak Showalter** (11) rounded out UW's 6 double-digit scorers.

▶ In Greg Gard's first game as head coach, UW posted an 84-79 win over Green Bay. The Badgers built a 30-point lead (68-38) with 13:01 remaining, before hanging on in the closing minutes.

▶ UW used a 17-0 first-half run to seize control. The Badgers held GB scoreless for a span of 9:17 and forced 16 straight misses over that stretch.

▶ UW overcame a season-high 26 turnovers. The Badgers hadn't turned the ball over 25+ times since 1997.

▶ **Nigel Hayes** led UW with 24 points, scoring his 1,000th-career point. Hayes was 6-for-7 from the field (9-9 FTs) with 5 reb., 4 assists and 3 steals.

▶ **Ethan Happ** had 16 points, 8 rebounds while **Vitto Brown** finished with 15 points, a game-high 9 boards. **Jordan Hill** posted 10 points and 4 assists off the bench.

► UW is 9-0 when shooting at least 42.0% from the field this season. The Badgers are 21-2 under Gard when shooting at least 42.0%.

Conversely, the Badgers are 7-0 when limiting opponents below 45.0% shooting this season. The Badgers are 19-2 under Gard when keeping foes below 45.0% from the field.

► UW is averaging 19.7 ppg from its bench, with 4 reserves averaging double-digit minutes and another at 8.9 mpg. In fact, the Badgers' roster features 10 different players who have recorded a double-digit scoring game.

► Wisconsin is averaging 18.7 free throw attempts per game. Last season, the Badgers led the Big Ten with 20.8 FTAs per game. **Nigel Hayes** led the Big Ten in FTAs (258) and was second in made FTs (190).

► The Badgers are committing an average of 15.4 fouls per game, 10th-fewest in the NCAA.

► UW is 9-0 this season when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining, continuing a Mariano Rivera-like string of closing games. Dating back to February of 2011, UW is 146-5 (.967) when leading or tied with 5:00 left.

Under Greg Gard, the Badgers are 24-0 when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining.

► Over the current 5-game win streak, Wisconsin has found another gear offensively. The Badgers have greatly increased their production and decreased their turnovers.

► Wisconsin is getting it done at both ends of the floor, leading the NCAA in defensive rebounding percentage and ranking 12th in offensive rebounding percentage.

• DEF. REBOUNDING: UW is rebounding 80.3% of opponent missed shots

• OFF REBOUNDING: UW is rebounding 39.2% of its missed shots

► UW has had a commanding advantage on the offensive glass, grabbing 138 offensive boards compared to just 74 for its opponents. UW's 12.5 offensive reb. per game ranks 4th in the Big Ten.

► The Badgers have out-scored opponents 146 to 72 on second-chance points this season. UW is averaging 13.3 second-chance points per game while surrendering just 6.5 per game.

► Individually, **Ethan Happ** is 2nd in the Big Ten with 9.5 rebounds per game and is 3rd in the B1G with 3.3 offensive boards per game.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

► The Badgers have held 8 of their 11 opponents to their (at the time) lowest point total of the season.

► UW's scoring defense (61.4 ppg) ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 22nd in the NCAA.

► UW ranks 20th in Ken Pomeroy's Adjusted Defensive Efficiency, averaging 92.6 points per 100 possessions.

The Badgers also rank 10th in Offensive Efficiency, becoming one of just 11 teams to rank among the top 20 in both offense and defense.

► Wisconsin has been closing out defensive possessions with the best in the country. UW leads the NCAA in defensive rebounding percentage, grabbing 80.3% of opponent missed shots. The Badgers are allowing an average of just 6.5 second-chance points per game.

► UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 10 of the past 14 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in 9 of the past 14 years. Last year, the Badgers allowed 63.9 points per game, the top mark in the Big Ten and 18th nationally.

► **Ethan Happ** had 19 points and 15 rebounds, **Bronson Koenig** scored 20 points.

► UW out-rebounded the Hoyas, 50-21 (20-1 on the offensive glass). The +29 rebounding edge was the Badgers' largest since 2010.

► UW owned a 19-1 edge in second-chance points and a dominant 38-16 advantage scoring in the paint. Both were season highs.

#4 UNC 56, #16 UW 56 | Nov. 23 | Championship

► Wisconsin missed its first 11 shots and never recovered. Senior **Vitto Brown** led UW with 15 points (4-5 3FGs). **Ethan Happ** added 13 points.

► UW shot just 38.2% and was out-rebounded for the first time this season, 38-26. The Tar Heels also dominated the paint, scoring 36 points compared to just 16 for the Badgers.

WRECKING THE RANKED

► Since Greg Gard joined the UW staff in 2001 under Bo Ryan, the Badgers are 38-15 (.717) against the AP Top-25 at the Kohl Center.

► The Badgers are 1-2 against the AP Top-25 overall this season and have gone 21-12 against the AP Top-25 over the last 4 seasons.

► Since 2001-02, UW is 160-38 (.808) in non-conference games, including a mark of 116-11 (.913) at the Kohl Center.

► Over the last 15 seasons, the Badgers have gone 22-19 (.537) in non-conference road games. That includes wins in 7 of last 9 true road games.

► Since 2003-04, Wisconsin is 99-5 (.952) at home vs. unranked non-con opponents.

STRONGER IN SECOND HALF

UW is renowned for its incredible home success, but it has been almost as good on the road lately.

► Wisconsin is 49-18 (.731) away from home over the last 4 seasons. This season, the Badgers are 3-2 from the Kohl Center, going 1-1 in true road games and 2-1 in neutral settings.

► In 2015-16, Wisconsin posted 3 road wins over ranked opponents for the first time in school history. UW and Kansas (3) were the nation's only schools with at least 3 ranked road wins.

Last season also marked the first time the Badgers had multiple top-10 road wins since 1955.

► Over the last 4 seasons, UW ranks 3rd in the NCAA in most wins away from home. The Badgers also own the 4th-best win percentage away from home over that span.

KLUTCH KOENIG

A preseason All-Big Ten pick, senior **Bronson Koenig** earned the nickname "Klutch Koenig" a year ago with his late-game heroics and has been a steady force in the Wisconsin backcourt his entire career.

► Koenig leads Wisconsin and ranks 6th in the Big Ten with 16.0 ppg. He has scored at least 20 points 5 times this season. He entered the year with 4 career games with 20+ points. He ranks 3rd in the Big Ten averaging 2.9 3-pointers per game.

► Against Syracuse (11/29), Koenig matched his career high with six 3-pointers, finishing with 20 points (6-9 3FGs) in 27 minutes. His recent hot streak includes at least 4 triples in each of the last 4 games.

► With 21 points against Tennessee (11/21), the La Crosse, Wis., native surpassed the 1,000-point milestone, becoming Wisconsin's 43rd member of the century club. He currently ranks 34th on UW's all-time scoring chart with 1,113 points.

► Koenig hit the game-winning 3-pointer to beat Xavier and advance to the Sweet 16 of the 2016 NCAA Tournament (3/20/16). He also made the game-winning shot on a spinning, left-handed lay-in with 5.9 seconds remaining in UW's 74-73 win over VCU (11/22/16) at Madison Square Garden.

► An the final 5:00 (and OT) of games last season, Koenig shot 54.8% (17-31) from 3-point range.

► Koenig went 83-for-213 from 3-point range last season, tallying the second-most triples in school history. For his career, Koenig's 199 3-pointers rank 6th in UW annals. Ben Brust holds the school record with 235 treys.

► Last season, Koenig set a Wisconsin record by hitting at least one 3-pointer in 43 straight games. It was snapped with an 0-for-2 effort vs. Pitt in the 2016 NCAA Tournament.

3TTO BROWN

In his first 2 years on campus, senior **Vitto Brown** did not attempt a single 3-point field goal. Since then, he has turned into one of the Badgers' most reliable 3-point marksmen.

► On the season, Brown is shooting 36.4% from 3-point range, hitting 16-of-44 from downtown. During the 3-game Maui Invitational, Brown went 7-for-10 from outside the arc. In the championship game against North Carolina, Brown led the Badgers with 15 points, matching his career high with 4 triples (4-for-5).

► Last season, Brown led the Badgers in 3-point FG percentage, hitting 38-of-95 (.400) from long range.

► For his career, Brown is shooting 39.6% from 3-point range (54-for-139).

PRAISE FOR HAYES

Last week, senior **Nigel Hayes** earned his first Big Ten Player of the Week after averaging 18.5 points, 8.0 assists and 6.5 rebounds per game in wins over No. 22 Syracuse and Oklahoma.

► Against Syracuse, Hayes tallied 9 points, 13 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists, coming one point short of authoring just the 2nd triple-double in UW history (Josh Gasser had 10 pts, 12 reb, 10 ast at Northwestern in 2011).

Hayes did become the first Badger to post a double-figure assist total since Jordan Taylor had 10 vs. Green Bay on Dec. 7, 2011. Hayes recorded the second rebounds/assists double-double in Badgers history (Gasser's triple-double).

► Hayes followed up later in the week with a season-high 28 points and a game-high 6 assists in a 90-70 win over Oklahoma.

► UW's 5-game win streak has coincided with Hayes' increased production.

► On the year, Hayes is 1 of only 3 players in the Big Ten averaging 13.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg and 3.0 apg per game this season - Caleb Swanigan (PUR) and Tai Webster (NEB).

► Hayes leads the Badgers averaging 3.5 assists per game and ranks 8th in the Big Ten with a 2.1 assist-to-turnover ratio (39 assists, 19 turnovers).

HAYES BUILDING LEGACY AT UW

The preseason Big Ten Player of the Year, **Nigel Hayes** returned for his senior season after testing the NBA Draft waters and is poised to leave a legacy as one of the best in Wisconsin history.

► With 1,486 career points, Hayes now ranks 9th on Wisconsin's all-time scoring list. He is 47 points away from passing Mike Wilkinson (2002-05) for 8th in UW annals.

► Hayes also owns 621 career rebounds and 258 career assists, becoming just the 2nd player in UW history to accumulate 1,300 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists.

► Last season, Hayes set UW single-season records for free throws (190) and free throw attempts (258). He led the Big Ten in FTAs and ranked second to Illinois' Malcolm Hill in FTs (193).

For his career, Hayes ranks 3rd in school history for made FTs (449) and 2nd in FTAs (651).

Hayes also equaled UW's single-game record with 17 made FTs when he went 17-for-22 against Indiana (1/26/16).

► A 2016 First-Team All-Big Ten selection, Hayes leads all active Big Ten players in career points and rebounds, while ranking 8th in assists, 2nd in steals and 8th in blocks.

ETHAN HAPP 2.0

Coming off a breakout freshman campaign, preseason All-Big Ten pick **Ethan Happ** has his sights set on even bigger things in 2016-17.

► Second on the team in scoring, Happ has reached double digits in 8 straight games and has posted a double-double in 4 of the last 7 games.

► Through 11 games, Happ is filling up the box score, averaging 13.3 ppg, 9.5 rpg, 2.5 apg, 0.9 bpg and 1.5 spg in 24.4 minutes per game.

His 9.5 rebounds per game rank 2nd in the Big Ten (PUR's Caleb Swanigan - 11.2). Wisconsin hasn't had a player average at least 9.0 rpg since Rashard Griffith had 10.8 per game in 1995.

► Happ and Caleb Swanigan (Purdue) are the only players in the NCAA averaging at least 13.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 2.5 apg.

► Ranking No. 6 on Ken Pomeroy's Player of the Year list, Happ is shooting 70.0% from the field, the 7th in the NCAA.

► Happ ranks 3rd in the Big Ten in offensive rebounds per game (3.3) and 4th in steals (1.5 per game).

► Happ enjoyed one of the best games of his young career vs. Syracuse (11/29). Happ posted his 13th career double-double with 24 points (10-12 FGs) and 13 rebounds (6 offensive). He also added 4 assists, 1 block and 1 steal.

Happ also did not commit a foul in the game for the first time in his career.

► Happ enjoyed a fine 3-game stretch at the Maui Invitational, earning All-Tournament honors after averaging 16.0 points and 9.0 rebounds.

He scored in double figures in all 3 games on the islands, highlighted by a 19-point, 15-rebound effort in the semifinals against Georgetown. That matched his career high for rebounds and marked the 11th double-double of his career (first this season).

► Happ was named consensus 2016 Big Ten Freshman of the Year. He is Wisconsin's first FOY winner since Sam Okey in 1996. Happ was also named to the Big Ten's All-Defensive Team and third-team All-Conference.

► An all-around talent, Happ was the only player in the Big Ten to average at least 11.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 1.0 apg, 1.0 spg and 0.5 bpg.

► Over the last 15 years, Happ is just the 3rd NCAA freshman to score 400 points, have 60 steals and 30 blocks, joining Texas' Kevin Durant and Pitt's DuJuan Blair.

► The Milan ("MY-lin"), Ill. native ranked 4th in the Big Ten with 9 double-doubles last season.

► A 2016 Big Ten All-Defensive Team selection, Happ led the Big Ten averaging 1.8 steals per game, and raised that during conference play averaging a league-best 2.4 per game in Big Ten affairs. He was the first freshman to lead the conference in steals since Ohio State's Aaron Craft did it in 2011.

SHOW(ALTER) TIME

► A former walk-on, senior guard **Zak Showalter** has made his way into a valuable piece of the Badgers' rotation. In his 5th year in the program, Showalter is averaging 6.8 ppg, 2.7 rpg with a team-best 2.5 assist-to-turnover ratio (25 assists to 10 turnovers).

► After a career-high 4 steals vs. Idaho State, Showalter is averaging 1.1 per game.

► Showalter made just four 3-pointers in his first two seasons at UW, but knocked down 35 percent (37-107) from long range as a junior.

► Showalter averaged 7.5 ppg and 3.8 rpg while ranking third on UW with 36 steals.

TRICE IS NICE

Freshman **D'Mitrik Trice** has made an immediate impact during his first year in Madison. The Huber Heights, Ohio, native has been a steadying force off the UW bench, playing valuable minutes at the point guard position.

► Trice scored a career-high 16 points against Oklahoma, going a perfect 4-for-4 from 3-point range.

► Trice's 16 points vs. OU were the most by a UW freshman guard since George Marshall scored 20 points at Iowa (Jan. 19, 2013).

► Trice ranks 2nd in the Big Ten in 3-point FG percentage, shooting 60.9% (14-23) from deep.

► He is UW's top reserve in terms of points (6.1 ppg), assists (1.6 apg) and minutes (17.7) per game.

► The younger brother of former Michigan State marksman, Travis Trice, D'Mitrik is a pretty decent shot in his own right. Owning the highest 3-point FG percentage on the team, Trice has hit 9-of-16 (.563) from deep, a number that ranks 4th in the Big Ten.

Travis Trice finished 6th on Michigan State's all-time 3-point field goal list with 202 career triples.

PRESEASON NOTES

Starters Returning/Lost: 5/0

Letterwinners Returning/Lost: 13/4

► UW returns all 5 starters for the first time since 1988-89. In fact, the Badgers return each of the top 9 scorers from last season.

► Overall, Wisconsin brings back all but 20 minutes played (99.8%) and all but 6 points (99.7%).

► UW finished last season in a tie for third place in the 2016 Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

► The Badgers are currently enjoying a streak of 18 consecutive NCAA tournament appearances, tied for the fifth-longest streak in tournament history. Last season, Wisconsin reached the Sweet 16, becoming the nation's only team to reach the Sweet 16 in five of the last six years.

Gard became the first coach to take his team to the Sweet 16 in his inaugural head coaching season since Chris Mack led Xavier in 2010.

► Wisconsin is enjoying a streak of at least 20 wins for 10 consecutive seasons and has tallied at least 12 Big Ten wins in 7 straight (longest in conference).

► Including **Nigel Hayes** last season, a total of 9 different Badgers have been named first-team All-Big Ten over the last 15 years, combining for 13 first-team all-conference honors. No other Big Ten program has more during that era.

► The Badgers have recorded at least 30 wins in four of the last 10 seasons, the most of any team in the Big Ten. In fact, Ohio State (3), Michigan State (1) and Michigan (1) are the only other Big Ten schools to win 30 games in a season over that span.

Nationally, only Kansas (7), Duke (5) and North Carolina (5) have more 30-win seasons than Wisconsin over the last 10 years.

► Wisconsin will play 12 regular season games vs. teams in the 2016 NCAA Tournament field, with 7 of those coming at home and 5 on the road. During the non-conference schedule, the Badgers host 2016 Final Four participants Oklahoma and Syracuse, as well as Green Bay. UW also faced national runner-up North Carolina at the Maui Invitational.

► The Badgers return key reserves **Jordan Hill** (junior guard - 15.6 mpg), **Khalil Iverson** (soph. guard - 13.0 mpg), **Alex Illikainen** (soph. forward - 9.8 mpg) and **Charles Thomas, IV** (soph. forward - 9.1 mpg). Wisconsin will also regain the services of redshirt freshman guard **Brevin Pritzl**, who missed all but one game of his freshman year with a foot injury and sophomore forward **Andy Van Vliet**, who was forced to sit out the 2015-16 season after the NCAA ruled him ineligible for not enrolling in college within a year of high school graduation.

► Wisconsin also welcome a three-man freshman class that features guard **D'Mitrik Trice** (6-0, Huber Heights, Ohio) as well as forward **Aleem Ford** (6-8, Lawrenceville, Ga.) and walk-on guard **Michael Ballard** (6-4, Oak Park, Ill.) who have both chosen to redshirt the 2016-17 season.

2015-16 LOOK BACK

Record: 22-13, **Big Ten:** 12-6 (T-3rd)

► Wisconsin reached the NCAA tournament for the 18th-consecutive season in 2015-16, the 5th-longest streak in NCAA history. The Badgers have won 15 NCAA tournament games since 2011. Only Kentucky (20) has won more games in the Big Dance over that time frame.

► On Jan. 13, 2016, Wisconsin was 9-9 overall and 1-4 in the Big Ten with an RPI of 110. Since then, the Badgers won 13 of their final 17 games, climbed to 3rd place in the league, into the RPI top 40 and reached the Sweet 16 for the 5th time in the last 6 seasons.

► With wins over Maryland (2), Michigan St. (4), Iowa (8) and Xavier (9), the Badgers were 1 of 4 teams to own 4 top-10 wins last season (with Texas, Kansas and Villanova). UW and Villanova were the only teams to tally 3 of those away from home.

► With a Big Ten record of 12-6, the Badgers secured a top-4 conference finish for the 16th-consecutive season, the longest such streak in Big Ten history. Wisconsin won at least 12 Big Ten games for the 7th-consecutive season (the longest active streak in the league).

► **Ethan Happ** became the second Big Ten Freshman of the Year in UW history, joining Sam Okey (1996). Happ was also named to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team and All-Defensive team, as well as taking home third-team All-Big Ten honors.

► With **Nigel Hayes** earning first-team All-Big Ten honors, a total of nine different UW players have been named first-team All-Big Ten over the past 15 seasons, combining for 13 first-team all-conference honors. No other Big Ten program has more during that era.

Junior **Bronson Koenig** was named to the All-Big Ten third team.

► UW also had 5 players earn 2016 Academic All-Big Ten honors: **Vitto Brown** (2x honoree), **Matt Ferris**, **Nigel Hayes** (2x honoree), **Aaron Moesch** (2x honoree) and **Zak Showalter**.

► Wisconsin led the Big Ten in scoring defense (63.8 ppg) and TO percentage (forcing more than one TO per every 5 possessions), having held a total of 10 teams to their season-low point total.

► UW led the Big Ten, averaging 20.8 FTAs per game last season. That mark ranked as the Badgers' 2nd-highest average in the last 9 years.

► No team in the nation had more freshmen than Wisconsin (8) last season and that group played 29.0% of UW's minutes. The quartet of **Ethan Happ**, **Alex Illikainen**, **Khalil Iverson** and **Charles Thomas, IV** averaged 19.5 ppg and 13.3 mpg.

WINNING AT WISCONSIN

► The Badgers won a school-record 36 games in 2014-15, reaching 30 wins for the 4th time in school history. All 4 have come in the last 10 years. Each of the top 11 spots in the UW record book for single-season wins have come in the last 15 years.

BIG TEN, BIG RESULTS

► Since 2002, UW has won 7 Big Ten championships (4 regular season and 3 tourn.). Only OSU (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourn.) has won more titles during Ryan's tenure. MSU has 6 and ILL has 5, but no other school has more than 3 over that span.

► Bo Ryan's teams posted a 172-68 (.717) Big Ten record, the best mark in the conference over his 14 seasons. Michigan St. was second at 161-79 (.671) and Ohio St. was third at 156-84 (.650).

► Last season, Wisconsin finished 3rd in the Big Ten with a record of 12-6. The Badgers have notched double-digit conference wins in 14 of the last 15 years and have never finished lower than 4th place in the Big Ten standings over that span.

► UW has posted a winning conference record in each of the last 15 seasons. Among the 6 major conferences, only Kansas (23 seasons) has a longer active streak of finishing above .500 in league play.

ALL WE DO IS WIN, WIN, WIN

During the Bo Ryan/Greg Gard era, Wisconsin has accumulated an overall record of 379-138 (.733) heading into 2016-17. That win total and percentage put the Badgers in pretty exclusive company.

► UW has made 18 consecutive NCAA tourneys - the 5th-longest streak in NCAA history.

► UW has reached the Sweet 16 or better in 4 of the last 5 years. No team in the nation has gone more frequently over that span.

► Since 2002, Wisconsin has won 27 NCAA tournament games. Among Big Ten teams, only MSU (28) has won more NCAA tourney games than UW since 2001-02.

► Wisconsin advanced to the Final Four in both 2014 and 2015, becoming one of 8 Big Ten teams to reach back-to-back Final Fours. The Badgers have advanced to the Final Four a total of 4 times, winning the national championship in 1941 and reaching the national semifinals in 2000.

BADGERS' ATTENDANCE IS BIG

► In 2015-16, the Badgers ranked 2nd in the Big Ten and finished 6th nationally by averaging a sellout capacity of 17,287 per game.

► Since the 2001-02 season when Greg Gard first joined the staff, the Badgers have compiled a 229-27 (.895) record at the Kohl Center, the 4th-highest mark in the nation over that span.

► Over the last 15 seasons, UW is 113-16 (.876) in Big Ten home games, the best mark in the conference.

► Four of the 8 longest home winning streaks in UW history have happened in the last 15 years, including the school-record 38-game winning streak from 2002 to 2005.

► Over the last 15 seasons, 170 of the Badgers' 229 home wins have come by at least 10 points (74.2 percent).

► Wisconsin has trailed at halftime in only 47 of 256 home games since the 2001-02 season. UW has come back to win 30 of those 47 games.

► In 2015-16, the Badgers ranked 2nd in the Big Ten and 7th nationally in attendance, selling out every game (17,287 per game). UW has led the Big Ten in attendance in 10 of the last 14 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 16 years.

► This season, the Badgers sold out the 2,100-person Grateful Red (third-largest student section in the Big Ten) in exactly 3 minutes.

► Including the win over Idaho State on Wednesday, the Badgers are currently enjoying a streak of 46 consecutive sellouts dating back to Jan. of 2014.

► UW had a streak of 143 consecutive sellouts at the Kohl Center snapped in 2011 (vs. Green Bay). Wisconsin sold out every game from 2003 until midway through the 2011-12 season.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

Long considered one of the best assistant coaches in all of college basketball, Greg Gard was named head coach at the University of Wisconsin on March 7, 2016. A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Gard is in his 15th season on the Badgers basketball staff, having served as the team's associate head coach since July of 2008.

"It's an honor and a privilege to be named the head coach at the University of Wisconsin," Gard said. "I'm extremely thankful for this incredible opportunity to lead my home-state program into the future. It's a role and a responsibility that I cherish and take extremely seriously.

"I'm looking forward to building on the great tradition at Wisconsin and representing my home state in a manner that can make Badger fans proud."

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award.

Gard, 45, took over as the Badgers' interim head coach following the retirement of longtime head coach Bo Ryan on Dec. 15. A week later, having begun installation of the Swing offense that had brought UW much success in the past, Gard led the Badgers to an 84-79 win over Green Bay in his head coaching debut.

The transition to Gard's leadership began with a 1-4 start to the Big Ten Conference season, leaving UW at 9-9 overall, but it didn't take long for the Badgers to adjust. Wisconsin proceeded on a run that saw them become one of the nation's hottest teams down the stretch of the regular season, winning 11 of their final 13 games.

A 77-76 victory over fourth-ranked Michigan State at the Kohl Center on Jan. 17 was the beginning of a seven-game win streak that also featured a home win over No. 19 Indiana and an impressive road triumph at No. 2 Maryland. The Badgers later added another road win over No. 8 Iowa on Feb. 24.

Over the season's final seven weeks, Wisconsin lost just twice — on the road at the hands of No. 8 Michigan State and No. 15 Purdue.

"It became clear to me as the season wore on and I was able to observe Greg both on and off the court that he was the right person to lead our men's basketball team," UW Director of Athletics Barry Alvarez said. "I was extremely excited to be able to offer him the job and fully believe that the program is in good hands for years to come."

UW finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).



In 15 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has never seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth while amassing a mark of 184-74 (.713) in Big Ten play.

As associate head coach, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

In November of 2015, Gard was ranked as the fourth-best "X&O" assistant coach in college basketball by coachstat.net. The rankings were made upon receipt of votes from a panel of national college basketball media, scouts and coaches.

In 2012, Gard was named No. 3 on the list of top assistant coaches in college basketball according to Bleacher Report. Fox Sports also listed Gard No. 10 on its list of the nation's top 25 assistant coaches.

Gard's 13th and 14th seasons in Madison were some of the program's most memorable. He helped guide the Badgers to back-to-back Final Four appearances in 2014 and 2015, and in 2015 UW reached its first national championship game since 1941. Wisconsin shattered the school's single-season wins record (36) in 2015 and became one of just 10 teams with at least 36 wins in Division I history. In 2014, UW finished 30-8 and won at least 30 games for just the third time in school history.

In fact, Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 11 winningest seasons at Wisconsin.

Gard helped pilot the Badgers to four Big Ten regular season titles and three Big Ten tournament championships, most recently winning both crowns in 2015. UW has made the NCAA tournament in each of Gard's first 14 seasons, advancing to seven Sweet 16s three Elite Eights and two Final Fours.

Gard came to the Badgers after spending

the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee, where he had responsibilities in scouting, summer basketball camp operations and on-floor coaching, as well as involvement with recruiting.

Previously, Gard served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments. In his final year at UW-Platteville, Gard served as Ryan's top assistant in charge of recruiting, camp operations and scouting. He also worked as an advisor in the university's admissions office.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School and one at Platteville High School, where he served in junior high and assistant varsity coaching capacities.

Gard is a 1995 graduate of UW-Platteville with a degree in physical and health education. He received a master's degree in counselor education from Platteville in 2007. Gard and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters Mackenzie and Peyton and a son, Isaac.
