THIS WEEK'S GAMES

The Idaho State men's basketball team plays at No. 17 Wisconsin on Wednesday, Dec. 7, at 6 p.m. mountain time. Jerry Miller will call the game live on 102.5 KMGI. Live audio, stats and video will be available through isubengals.com. The game will also be broadcasted on ESPN 3. Following Wednesday's games, ISU returns home to host Bristol on Dec. 10 at 7 p.m. in Holt Arena and Montana Tech on Dec. 16 at 6 p.m. in Reed Gym.

SERIES VS. WISCONSIN

Wisconsin leads the series 1-0. The Badgers won the first meeting 60-58 on Dec. 9, 2008 in Madison.

SCOUTING WISCONSIN

Wisconsin is 7-2 and 5-0 at home. Bronson Koenig leads the scoring attack with a 15.2 points per game average. Ethan Happ is scoring 13.7 and Nigel Hayes is netting 13.1. Wisconsin averages 75.6 points a game and holds opponents to 60.8 points. The Badgers are shooting .474 percent, .348 percent from the three-point line and .677 percent from the free throw line. Wisconsin is averaging 39.9 rebounds and holding opponents to 26.7.

DID YOU KNOW

- Ethan Telfair had a streak of 26 straight games scoring in double figures snapped vs. Lamar.
- Ethan Telfair scored in double figures in 29 of 31 games last year and in four of five this season. He has 18 games of 20 points or more in his career.
- Last year Ethan Telfair had 20 games with five assists or more and this year he has five assists or more in four of the five games he has appeared in.
- Ethan Telfair had 13 games with five rebounds or more last year and this year he has reached that feat twice
- Geno Luzcando has scored in double figures in five of eight games and in 32 games dating back to the start of last season.
- Last year Geno Luzcando had 22 games with two steals or more and this year he has five games with two steals or more.
- Gary Chivichyan has made a 3-pointer in the last five games he has appeared in.

Bill Evans FILE

Bill Evans was named the head coach of the Idaho State men's basketball program on March 8, 2012 and he quickly has put his stamp on the program on the court and academically. The 2015-16 Big Sky Conference and NABC All-District Coach of the Year guided the Bengals to a 16-15 record and a fourth place finish in the Big Sky.

The 16-15 record was the sixth best start since the 1976-77 season and the 11-7 conference record was the best winning percentage since the 2000-01 team finished 10-6.

Evans is only the fourth ISU coach to be named Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year. Evans coached a Bengal offense in 2015-16 that set a school record for 3-pointers made in a season and ISU had its first first-team all-conference player since 2008-09 in Ethan Telfair.

Evans has been one of the top defensive coaches in the game. Since being head coach in Pocatello, The Bengal defense has ranked in the top half of the league in scoring defense and over the last three seasons the ISU defense has ranked in the top half in field goal percentage defense.

In the 2012-13 season, the Bengals finished the year second overall in scoring defense, giving up only 64.3 points a game. That mark was the best by a Bengal team since before the shot clock era.

A year later, the Bengals held opponents to 69.4 points a game in Big Sky Conference games.

In the classroom, the Bengals recorded a perfect 1,000 APR for the 2012-13 school year along with a team GPA of 3.0 for 2014 spring semester. The Bengals boasted over a 3.0 GPA for the 2014-15 academic year.

In the last two years Evans has had eight student-athletes recognized by the NABC for academic excellence and the 2015-16 season saw a record six players earn Big Sky All-Academic honors. The team also received the team academic excellence award by the NABC for the 2014-15 season.

During Evans four years in Pocatello he has coached four all-conference players in Ethan Telfair, Chris Hansen, Geno Luzcando and Jeffrey Solarin. Hansen left ISU as the school's all-time leader for 3-pointers made and attempted. He also left ISU as the ninth leading scorer in program history. Solarin finished his career ranked in the Top 10 for total career rebounds.

Telfair put together one of the best single-seasons in Bengal history in 2015-16. He averaged 20.2 points overall and 23.9 in conference play. He also tallied 5.7 assists and 4.5 rebounds in league. For the year he made 205 free throws.

Evans is a seasoned veteran of 36 years in the coaching

SEEING THE FLOOR

This year 10 of the 11 eligible players to see the floor are averaging 10.3 minutes or more. Ethan Telfair leads the team in minutes played at 33.

BOYD HOT IN CANCUN

In Brandon Boyd's first career starts, the Bengal redshirt freshman scored a career-high 26 vs. NJIT in Cancun and had 25 vs. Eastern Kentucky. Boyd had a career-high four steals, vs. Eastern Kentucky while playing 43 minutes in the overtime loss. He also made four 3-pointers on 6 attempts vs. ECU and made a career-best seven free throws on eight attempts vs. NJIT. Boyd is averaging 14.3 points in 30.7 minutes of play. He is 15-34 from the three-point line. Since the Eastern Kentucky game Boyd is averaging 18.2 points a game and shooting .481 percent from the three-point line. He is also 22-28 from the free throw line during this stretch.

TOPALOVIC OFF TO CAREER START

Novak Topalovic is off to a career-start to the 2016-17 season. He had a career-game with 15 points and 16 rebounds at Utah Valley on Nov. 16. In the season opener at New Mexico he had 12 points and nine rebounds. Topalovic is averaging 9.8 points and 7.1 rebounds a game.

GARRITY SEES FIRST ACTION AS A BENGAL

UVU transfer Hayes Garrity saw his first action at ISU in Cancun. He played 12 minutes against ECU and played 28 against NJIT. Against NJIT he had five points, three steals and five rebounds. He is averaging four points in 18 minutes of play in five games.

ISU AGAINST POWER 5 SCHOOLS

Since the 2005-06 season, ISU has played the following schools from Power-5 Conferences. Washington State (6 times), Utah (3 times), Arizona State (2 times), Washington (2 times), Oregon (3 times), Oklahoma, Colorado, Arizona, Iowa (2 times), Iowa State, Notre Dame, USC, Wisconsin (2nd time this year on Dec. 7), Oregon State, UCLA, Texas A&M, Illinois, Texas Tech and Kanas. Idaho State's last win over a team from a Power-5 conference was a 62-57 win at Oregon on Dec. 3, 1986.

TELFAIR TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Ethan Telfair had his first career triple-double at New Mexico with 25 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists. He also had six steals. The Big Sky Conference had three players with triple-doubles last year and Telfair is the first in the league this season. Telfair is the third Bengal in school history to have a triple-double. Steve Hayes had 24 points, 16 rebounds and 10 blocks vs. Weber State on January 30, 1976 and Lawrence Butler had 41 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists vs. UNLV on Feb. 10, 1979.

THE WEEK THAT WAS

In the Bengals only game this week, ISU beat Lamar 77-60. Robert Jones III led ISU with 18 points. The Bengals never trailed in the game and only turned the ball over 10 times. Novak Topalovic had a career-high six blocks in the win. ISU had four players finish in double figures. Later in the week ISU lost at 79-76 at the buzzer to CSUN.

SCORING THREATS

This year's Bengal basketball team returns 75.6 percent of its scoring from the 2015-16 season. The team scored 2,297 points and 1,738 of those points return. Four starters return to the Bengal lineup. All four combined to average 48.2 points. Geno Luzcando scored 14.4 points, Gary Chivichyan scored 7.6 and Kyle Ingram six a game.

This year ISU will play nonconference games against Division I schools from nine different conferences.
