WOMEN KICK OFF CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON WITH BIG TEN MEET

Championship season begins this week for the Wisconsin swimming and diving program, as the women's team competes in the 2016 Big Ten Women's Swimming and Diving Championships in Ann Arbor, Michigan, beginning Wednesday through Saturday. The University of Michigan will host the championship meet, marking the fifth time the Big Ten women's meet has been contested in Canham Natatorium (previously in 1989, 1993, 2002 and 2009).

Swimming finals will commence at 5:30 p.m. (CT) each day. Swimming preliminaries will be held Thursday through Saturday at 10 a.m. each day, while diving prelims (and consolation finals) will be held immediately after swimming prelims starting at noon. A complete schedule of events can be found above.

TOUGH TO CHASE DOWN

Junior sprinter Chase Kinney is beginning to establish herself as one of the fastest swimmers in the Big Ten.

- Kinney has yet to lose in the 50-yard freestyle this season. She has won the 50 Free on five different occasions, including at the Texas Invitational and during UW's dual meet at No. 1 Georgia.
- ► In the 100-yard freestyle, Kinney has never finished worse than second place this season and has won the event at four of the six meets she has swam this year.
- Kinney has been part of two school record relay teams. Kinney, Ivy Martin, Aja Van Hout and Annie Tamblyn set school records in the 200- and 400-yard freestyle relay during last year's championship season.
- Kinney has been named Big Ten Swimmer of the Week two times this season. She earned CollegeSwimming National Swimmer of the Week honors Feb. 3, 2016.

FRESHMAN PHENOM

Freshman Jess Unicomb has wasted no time in making an impact for the Wisconsin swimming team.

Hailing from Gold Coast, Australia, Unicomb has become a reliable contender in backstroke events for the Badgers.

She has won the 100-yard backstroke at three different meets this season and has finished third or better at five of the six meets she's swam it. In the 200-yard backstroke, Unicomb has taken the crown two times this season, including against defending Big Ten champion Minnesota and in a tridual meet at Auburn.

Unicomb has earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week recognition three times this season.

GOING THE DISTANCE WITH DANIELLE

When it comes to distance swimming events, Danielle Valley more than contributes for the Badgers.

► In only her second time swimming the event this season, Valley demolished the UW Natatorium pool record in the 1650-yard freestyle, long held by former Badger and Olympian Carly Piper.

Valley clocked in at 16:14.76, shattering the old pool record of 16:24.93 by over 10 seconds.

- The 500 freestyle is Valley's most consistent event this year, as she's won the discipline four times, including vs. Minnesota.
- ► Valley has also won the 1000 freestyle two times this season, and has claimed one 800 freestyle title and one 1650 freestyle title.
- ► Per CollegeSwimming.com, Valley ranks No. 5 in the country in the 1000 freestyle (9:43.37), No. 13 in the 500 freestyle (4:41.25), No. 17 in the 1650 freestyle (16:14.59) and No. 18 in the 800 freestyle (9:54.75).

PASSING THE HAZEL EYE TEST

On the boards, freshman Hazel Hertting has had an impact in Madison.

- ▶ Heading into the Big Ten championships coming off of her best outing yet this season, Hertting won both the 1-meter (298.58) and 3-meter (337.27) by setting career-high marks in both events vs. Green Bay.
- ► Hertting has won the 1-meter dive at three meets this season: at Northwestern, at USC and vs. Green Bay.
- A 2015 USA Nationals qualifier and USA Diving age-group qualifier on 1-meter, 3-meter and platform, Hertting is the WIAA Division I state record holder with a score of 576.45. She competed with the Fox Valley club team.
- ► Hertting was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the first time in her career on Feb. 10, 2016.

SPRINT QUEENS

A former sprint freestyle swimmer himself at Texas, it comes as no surprise that head coach Whitney Hite has coached some of the fastest female swimmers in Big Ten history.

- ▶ A Badger has won the women's 50-yard freestyle Big Ten title every year Hite has been at the helm of Wisconsin. Beckie Thompson won the crown in 2012 and Ivy Martin won three-straight from 2013-15.
- ► Hite and the Badgers have also won titles in the 100-yard freestyle and 200-yard freestyle relays at three of the four Big Ten championships that Hite has led Wisconsin at.
- At last year's Big Ten championships, Ivy Martin won seven Big Ten titles (every event she swam in) and was named Big Ten Swimmer of the Championships for the second-straight season.

HUTCHINS CLAIMS SCHOOL RECORDS

It's safe to say that Matt Hutchins is readying himself for championship season.

► The distance swimmer from Christchurch, New Zealand, has already set two school records in the 1650-yard freestyle record (14:38.14) at the Texas Invitational in December and the 1000-yard freestyle record (8:58.45) during a dual meet at USC.

BORDER BATTLE FOR THE AGES

The Wisconsin swimming and diving program got its 2015-16 season off to an electric start with a dual-meet sweep of rival Minnesota at the UW Natatorium

- ► The UW women knocked off the defending Big Ten champions and the Badger men topped Minnesota for the second straight year.
- ► The men set three pool records: 200 Medley Relay (Pinfold, Mandli, Tran, Clifton 1:29.88);
 400 Freestyle Relay (Pinfold, Stack, Hutchins, Clifton 2:57.97); 50
 Freestyle (Cannon Clifton 20.16)
- ▶ Jess Unicomb and Chase Kinney each won two titles. In her collegiate debut, Unicomb claimed both the 100- and 200-yard backstroke. Kinney took both the 50- and 100-yard freestyle.

WISCONSIN SIGNS ONE OF NATION'S TOP RECRUITING CLASSES FOR 2016

If it wasn't already evident that Whitney Hite has constructed a swimming and diving program that is on the rise in Madison, the 2016 recruiting class for UW helped send a message.

- ► Hite and Wisconsin announced the signing of 12 high school seniors and the addition of transfer Cierra Runge for 2016-17.
- Included in the high school seniors was female swimmer Beata Nelson, a 12-time Wisconsin high school state champion and arguably the top recruit in the nation for 2016.

Nelson holds three Wisconsin high school state records (100 back, 100 fly, 200 free relay). Her time of 51.62 seconds in the 100-yard butterfly at this year's Wisconsin high school state meet also reset her previous USA public high school national record.

A five-event Olympic trials qualifier, Nelson also owns the National Age Group record in the 100-yard butterfly at 51.08 seconds. Nelson is a member of the USA Junior National Team and swims under Shane Ryan at the Madison Aquatic Club.

Cierra Runge is an NCAA record holder in the 500yard freestyle and was an NCAA runner-up in 2015 in both the 500- and 1650-yard freestyle while swimming at California.

A native of Cochranville, Pennsylvania, she is a member of the USA National Team and competed at the 2015 World Championships. Runge also earned a silver medal in the 400-meter freestyle at the 2014 Pan Pacific Championships. She is currently training with North Baltimore Aquatic Club.

BIG TEN'S BEST:

A handful of Badgers have already garnered praise and recognition for their performances so far this season.

- Oct. 21, 2015: Chase Kinney was named Big Ten Swimmer of the Week and Jess Unicomb was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week.
- ▶ Dec. 9, 2015: Jess Unicomb was named Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Week and Matt Hutchins was named Big Ten Swimmer of the Week.
- ▶ Jan. 13, 2016: Danielle Valley and Matt Hutchins swept Big Ten Swimmer of the Week honors for Wisconsin. Jess Unicomb was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week. Clark Carter earned both the Big Ten Freshman and Diver of the Week awards.
- ► Feb. 3, 2016: Chase Kinney and Matt Hutchins swept the CollegeSwimming National Swimmer of the Week honors. Jess Unicomb was named CollegeSwimming Big Ten Swimmer of the Week. Kinney was also named Co-Big Ten Swimmer of the Week.
- ▶ Feb. 10, 2016: Danielle Valley and Cannon Clifton swept Big Ten Swimmer of the Week honors. Hazel Hertting earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week. Clark Carter was chosen as Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Week.

BTN TO AIR CHAMPIONSHIPS:
