Todd Ohrlein was named the Big Ten Co-Coach of the Year in 2011.

Now in his 13th season as head coach, Todd Ohrlein continues to mold Wisconsin women's golf into his vision of a successful program, building and growing upon each season.

The team has qualified for four NCAA regional tournaments in the past six years and in 2016, Brooke Ferrell qualified as an individual for the NCAA Bryan Regional.

The 2015 UW team finished 13th at the regional while the 2014 team just missed heading back to the national championships when it tied for ninth at the West Regional, one place out of qualifying.

The 2013 team qualified for the NCAA National championships for just the second time in school history and first under Ohrlein. The young team placed seventh at the NCAA Central Regional to advance.

It was the first regional bid since 2011. That team followed the success of the record-breaking 2010 team, but went one better with the selection to the NCAA Central Regionals.

Ohrlein was named head women's golf coach at UW in August 2003. In his first year, he led the Badgers to a fifth-place tie in the Big Ten Conference championship. He also worked with one of the most accomplished players in school history, Malinda Johnson. Johnson was a two-time All-Big Ten team member and an honorable mention All-American in 2004.

Ohrlein draws from a previous coaching experience at UW-Eau Claire where he led the Bluegolds to the 2001 NCAA Men's Division III National Golf Championship.

During his tenure at UW-Eau Claire, Ohrlein's teams qualified for the NCAA championship all six years, finishing among the top-five four times including winning the 2001 national title. He was named the 2001 Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA) National Coach of the Year and the 2001 Golfweek NCAA Division III National Coach of the Year. Ohrlein earned GCAA Central Region Coach of the Year honors three times during his six-year appointment.

At UW-Eau Claire, Ohrlein coached two first-team All-Americans including the 2003 Division III Player of the Year, Ryan Quinn of Galesville, Wis. He also coached four second-team All-Americans, four third-team All-Americans, and four honorable mention All-Americans. Before being named head coach, Ohrlein served as the assistant golf coach for two years beginning in 1995 at UW-EC.

Ohrlein graduated in 1991 from UW-Eau Claire with a degree in biology. He has plenty of athletic experience as a four-year letterwinner in basketball. He earned 1990 NAIA Academic All-America honors

and was named WSUC All-Conference and NAIA All-District in 1991.

After earning his degree, Ohrlein continued his education at the Palmer College of Chiropractic in Davenport, Iowa, graduating magna cum laude in 1995. He returned to UW-Eau Claire as an assistant men's basketball coach, a position he continued until coming to the UW. He helped guide the Bluegold program to the national basketball tournament twice, including an NCAA Division III national runner-up finish in 2000.

In October of 2009, Ohrlein was recognized by his alma mater as an inductee to the Bluegold Athletics Hall of Fame.

Lindsay Wandrey joined the Badgers as assistant coach in December of 2015.

Lindsay Wandrey was named the assistant women's golf coach at Wisconsin in November, 2015. A Pewaukee, Wisconsin, native, Wandrey played her collegiate golf at Western Illinois (2007-11), and served as the graduate assistant coach there two years while earning her master's degree. She most recently was the assistant coach for men's and women's golf the past three years at Southern Illinois-Edwardsville.

As a prep athlete at Brookfield Central, Wandrey led her team to four top-five finishes at the WIAA state championships. Wandrey placed second as a junior and was named to Wisconsin High School Golf Coaches Association All-State team as a junior and a senior. She earned All-Greater Metro Conference honors three times.

Her Pewaukee team won two WIAA regional championships, as well as two WIAA sectional championships. An all-around athlete, Wandrey also earned four letters as a basketball player, garnering All-Greater Metro Conference honors as a junior and a senior.

While with the SIEU Cougars, the women's team set the scoring record in each of the last two seasons, and also set new 36-hole and 54-hole totals records. They also had the program's first NCAA Division I medalist in Alison Gorman. The men's team turned in a pair of top-five finishes during 2014-15.

In Wandrey's first season on staff with the Cougars, the men's team to a sixth-place finish at the Ohio Valley Conference championships. Freshman Jordan Peters receive recognition as a member of the Ohio Valley Conference All-Newcomer team.

As an assistant at Western Illinois, the Leathernecks earned five top-five finishes during the 2012-13 season and finished sixth in the Summit League

Championships. Their opening round score of 300 was a season-low for the program.

Prior to joining the coaching staff at WIU, Wandrey earned four letters for the Leathernecks competing in 75 rounds throughout her career. She was the medalist at the 2010 Loyola Invitational with rounds of 74-76, the runner-up at the 2008 Western Illinois Fall Invitational, and earned three other top-five finishes in her career.

The 2010-11 Leathernecks had their best season in school history earning three tournament victories and three runner-up finishes during the season. Wandrey shot her career best-round of 72 at the Jackrabbit Invitational in 2011. Wandrey's top-five placing at the Summit League Championship helped the team to a runner-up finish her senior year.

Wandrey earned her bachelor's degree in business management in 2011, and earned a master's in sport management in 2013, both from Western Illinois.

2015-16 NOTES

- The Badgers set a new school record with 8597 strokes in 29 rounds for 296.45. The old season record set in 2014-15 was 298.97.
- UW averaged 297.43 through 14 rounds in the fall and a 295.53 average in the spring.
- The team has its best Big Ten Conference finish since 2011, tying for fourth with a 54-hole conference meet best 289-290-283-862 ; the second best 54-hole score in school history. The 283 in the last round also tied for second-best 18-hole team score all-time.
- The Cardinal Cup tied Wisconsin's best tournament finish of the season, as the Badgers (302-295-299=896) placed fourth.
- Hosting the fifth-annual Westbrook Invitational, the Badgers (293-291-290=874) placed 10th, as Brooke Ferrell tied for first on the player leaderboard. UW's third round score tied a season-best and the 874 was fifth best 54-hole in school history.

2015-16 Individual Notes:

- Junior Brooke Ferrell qualified for her third NCAA Regional where she placed 59th with a 78-71-78--221. She led UW in four tournaments and tied for the second best finish at the Big Ten championship placing third with a school record 65-72-72=209. The 65 and 137 tied school marks.
- Ferrell tied for medalist honors in two events: Oct. 19-20, at the Cardinal Cup she matched the then-school record for 54 holes (213), in addition to tying the second- and third-best scores for 18- (66) and 36-holes (140), respectively. Ferrell finished the tournament knotted in first at 3-under. Ferrell (71-71-69) bettered her previous 54-hole best at the Westbrook Invitational, Feb. 21-22, by shooting a new 54-hole school record 5-under 211 and earning her second first-place finish of the year, as she tied with San Diego State's Emma Henrikson (69-73-79=211). Ferrell led the

Badgers for the second-straight season this year with a career-best 73.25 strokes per round.

- Sophomore Gabby Curtis was the Badgers' top finisher in four tournaments including a season 54-hole best tying for 18th at the Alamo Invitational with a 3-over 73-72-74--219. She was second on the team in scoring with 74.83 strokes per round.
- Junior Michelle Cheung (71-72-73) netted the best 36- (143) and 54-hole (216) scores of her career at the Westbrook Spring Invitational, as she placed tied for 18th at even par. She was third on the team in scoring averaging 74.97.
- Freshman Nat Zeng was Wisconsin's top rookie golfer. She was the second UW finisher at the Briar's Creek Invitational placing tied for 32nd with a personal 54-hole best 75-73-73--221. Her frosh season average of 75.91 ranks second all-time behind Ferrell.
- Freshman Jessica Reinecke netted the best 18-, (72) and 36- (150) scores of her career at the UCF Challenge. Her even par 72 in the first round was tied for the second-best scorecard on the team. Reinecke (78-78-74) bested her previous 54-hole low of 234 with a 14-over 230 at the Westbrook Spring Invitational.
- Sophomore Becky Klongland played in 26 rounds and averaged a career-best 76.50 per round. She was the second best finisher at the conference meet tying for ninth with a career best 74-71-68--213, which ties the third best 54-hole round in school history. Her 76.5 average was a career best by 2.2 strokes.

Big Ten Conference Honors

Brooke Ferrell was named first team All-Big Ten in 2016, becoming the first Badgers to earn the honor since Malinda Johnson in 2004. She earned second-team honors in 2015.

Ferrell earned her second Big Ten Player of the Week honor this year with her second medalist title Feb. 22 at the Westbrook Spring Invitational

in Peoria, Arizona. Ferrell set the then-school 54-hole record with a 71-71-69--211.

She earned her first weekly honor on Oct. 23 with a 3-under 66-74-73=213 to tie for first at the Cardinal Cup in Louisville, Kentucky. The 213 was the old school mark she had tied several times.. It was the first time a Badger won an event since Kimberly Dinh took the crown at the BYU Entrada Classic in 2013.

Michelle Cheung was named the Sportsmanship Award winner from Wisconsin in 2016.

Earning Academic All-Big Conference honors were Ferrell and Aya Johnson for a second year, and Becky Klongland and Ali Nageotte for the first time.

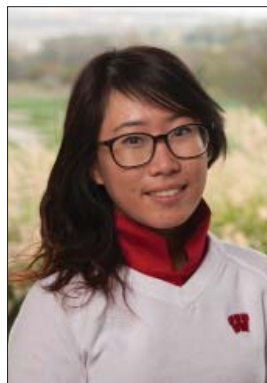

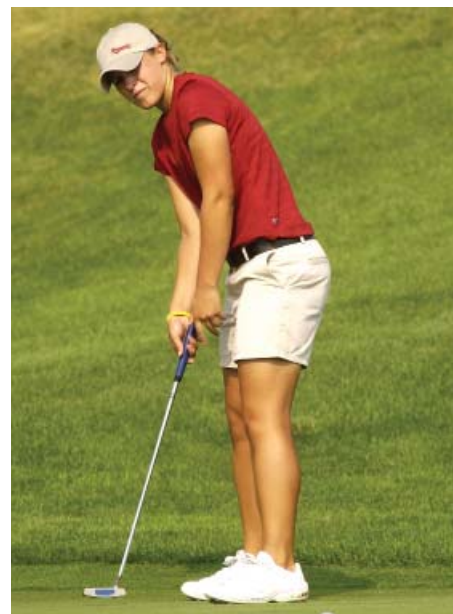

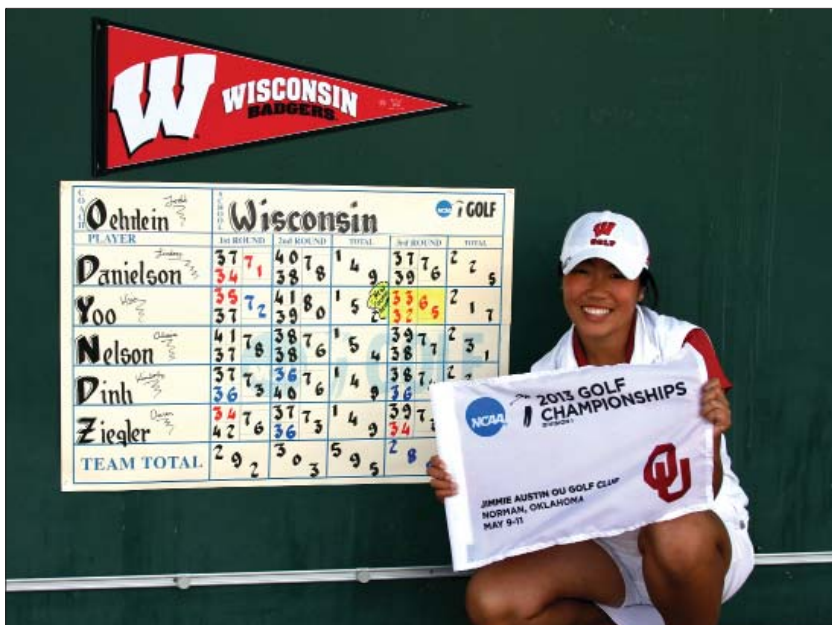

Important Dates in History

The first women's golf team teed it up in September of 1974 and was coached by Janie Eastham, a faculty member in the division of physical education. Jackie Hayes took over the program in 1976 and coached until 1983 when former UW golfer Chris Regenberg took over. Dennis Tiziani, who also coached the UW men's team, took on the women's coaching duties in 1990 and coached until 2003 when Todd Ohrlein became the head coach.

The following are some significant moments in UW women's golf history.

April 22-24, 2016 - Brooke Ferrell represents Wisconsin at the NCAA Bryan Regional in Bryan, Texas. The junior, appearing in her third-straight regional, finishes tied for 59th with 78-71-78--221. Ferrell concludes her season with scoring average of 73.25 strokes per round which ranks first all-time.

April 22-24, 2016 - Wisconsin picks up its best Big Ten Championship finish since 2010-11, tying for fourth. The Badgers finish at a 2-under 862 marking their best 54-hole scorecard of the season. Brooke Ferrell ends in third which ties the second-best conference placement in UW history. She tied 18- (65) and 36-hole (137) school records, while setting a new 54-hole mark with a 209 at the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin also set a new record for season scoring average at 296.45 strokes per round.

Feb. 21-22, 2016 - Junior Brooke Ferrell ties for first at the Westbrook Spring Invitational for her second title of the year with a new school 54-hole mark of 211.

Oct. 19-20, 2015 - Junior Brooke Ferrell ties for first at the Cardinal Cup, as the Badgers finish fourth on the team leaderboard. At the tournament she tied the second-best 18-hole score (66) and tied the third-best 36- (140) and 54-hole scores (213) all-time. Ferrell's tied-for-first placing is her career-best.

Oct. 5-6, 2015 - Junior Michelle Cheung's 54-hole scorecard of 216 at the Windy City Collegiate Championship ties for fourth in

UW history. Fellow third-year golfer Brooke Ferrell matches the fifth-lowest 54-hole output with a 217.

June, 2015 - Senior Kimberly Dinh becomes the third UW women's golfer to earn the prestigious Big Ten Medal of Honor. She also is named a CoSIDA District and first team Academic All-American. She was also the Big Ten Conference choice to advance to the NCAA Woman of the Year honors program.

May 9, 2015 - The Badgers set the school season team record for best 18-hole average with 298.97 strokes per round.

April 27, 2015 - The Badgers qualify for their third-straight NCAA Regional, a program first, and fourth in the past five years but fail to advance to the NCAA Championships.

April 26, 2015 - UW places sixth at the Big Ten Championship and freshman Gabby Curtis leads the team tying for 13th with a 4-over 72-73-75--220,

Feb. 8, 2015 - Freshman Gabby Curtis ties the all-time lowest individual total for 54-holes with her 213 (69-70-74) at the UCF Challenge in Orlando, Fla. Five others own the record including Brooke Ferrell (2014), Kris Yoo (2013) Lindsay Danielson (2012), Alexis Nelson (2012), and Carly Werwie (2010).

2013-2014 - The Badgers set the school 18-hole season scoring average in 2013-14 with 299.25 (9,576/32 rounds). Brooke Ferrell set the freshman scoring record with 75.34 strokes per round.

May 10, 2014 The Badgers qualify for their second-straight NCAA Regional and finish tied for ninth with 301-305-315-921, just missing a second-straight appearance at the NCAA Championships.

April 27, 2014 UW places sixth at the Big Ten Championship and freshman Brooke Ferrell has the best individual performance since 2004 placing fourth with 78-75-68--221,

Feb. 24, 2014 Freshman Brooke Ferrell tied the all-time lowest individual total for 54-holes with her 213 (74-70-69) at the Westbrook Spring Invitational in Peoria, Ariz. Four others own the record including Kris Yoo (2013) Lindsay Danielson (2012), Alexis Nelson (2012), and Carly Werwie (2010).

Feb. 24, 2014 The women's golf team set its all-time lowest team total on 54-holes with a total of 859 (286-288-285) in placing third at the Westbrook Spring Invitational in Peoria, Ariz.

Sept. 22, 2013 Women's golf set a program record for lowest 18-hole round with a 281 in the third round of the Lady Paladin Invitational in Greenville, S.C.

Sept. 22, 2013 Kris Yoo tied the all-time lowest individual total for 54-holes with her 213 (73-70-70) at the Lady Paladin Invitational in Greenville, S.C. Three others own the record including Lindsay Danielson (2012), Alexis Nelson (2012), and Carly Werwie (2010).

May 24, 2013 The team won two tournaments in the same season for only the third time in school history. UW won the Hoosier's Fall Invitational October 14, 2012, and the BYU Entrada Classic March 29, 2013. The only other times UW won two tournaments in one year was in 2010-11 and in 1999-2000

May 24, 2013 The women's golf team set a new single season record for rounds with 40. The scoring average was second all-time with 303.75 (12,150/40).

May 24, 2013 Senior Lindsay Danielson concludes her career with the all-time scoring record at Wisconsin. Danielson averaged 75.60 strokes per round while playing from 2009-13.

May 24, 2013 UW women's golf has its highest NCAA Championship finish placing 23rd with 301-309-297-311--1218 at the university course in Athens, Ga.

May 19, 2013 Kimberly Dinh, a redshirt-sophomore and chemical engineering major with a 4.0 GPA at the University of Wisconsin, is the recipient of the Elite 89 award for the 2013 NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championship. The Elite 89 is presented to the student-athlete with the highest cumulative grade-point average participating at the finals site for each of the NCAA's championships.

May 11, 2013 Women's golf places seventh in the NCAA Central Regional in Norman, Okla., with a 292-303-288--883 to advance to its second NCAA Championships.

May 11, 2013 Kris Yoo set the school 18-hole record with a 65 in the third round of the NCAA Central Regional in Norman, Okla.

April 30, 2013 Kris Yoo earns second team All-Big Ten honors. She is the first UW player to earn the recognition since Katie Elliott in 2007.

Sept. 13, 2011 Women's golf team wins team championship at the Badger Invitational in Madison for the second year in a row.

Apr. 26, 2011 Women's golf coach Todd Oehrlein is named Big Ten Co-Coach of the Year after the Badgers finished fourth at the conference meet and were selected for the NCAA Central Regional

April 24, 2011 Kris Yoo ties the school 72-hole record finishing seventh with a 296 at the Big Ten Championships in Glencoe, Ill.

Mar. 22, 2011 Women's golf team wins the team championship at the BYU Entrada Classic with a score of 313-302-299=914.

Sept. 27, 2010 Women's golf team wins team the Badger Invitational in Madison with a score of 282-300-297=879. Senior Carly Werwie wins the individual championship at the tournament with a school 54-hole record 213.

Oct. 6, 2010 Women's golf team wins the team championship at the Johnie Imes Invitational in Columbia, Mo. (309-299-301=908)

Apr. 25, 2010 Women's golf finished the season with a new school 18-hole scoring average record, finishing at 302.93.

April 23, 2010 Women's golf team sets school 72-hole record low at 1,194 at the Big Ten Championships in Madison. Junior Carly Werwie ties the school 72-hole record with a 296.

Sept. 28, 2008 Women's golfer, freshman Jessica Gerry wins individual championship at Badger Invitational (71-66-78=215). Team finishes second.

Sept 11, 2006 Women's golfer, Junior Katie Elliott wins the individual championship at the Badger Invitational in Madison (74-77-74=225). The Badgers finish second as a team at the event.

April 25, 2004 Malinda Johnson sets the school season scoring record with 74.33 strokes per round during the 2003-04 season.

May 10, 2003 Women's golf advanced to its first-ever NCAA Championship with with a sixth-place finish at the Central Regional. Katie Connelly won the regional with a 217. At nationals, the team finished in 24th place at the Kampen Course in West Lafayette, Ind., on May 20-23.

April 27, 2003 Women's golfer Malinda Johnson placed third in the Big Ten Championship in Iowa City, Iowa.

April 26, 2002 Malinda Johnson ties for second with a 305, the best finish by a Badger in the Big Ten Championships. Rachel Wiese also tied for second in 1994.

May 25, 2001 Women's golfer Allie Blomquist finished tied for 18th place at the NCAA

Championship in Howie-in-the-Hills, Fla. It is the best finish at the national championship by a Badger.

May 25, 2000 Junior golfer Allie Blomquist of Afton, Minn., became the first Badger woman golfer to be selected a first team GTE/CoSIDA Academic All-American.

May 9, 1994 Dennis Tiziani is named Big Ten women's golf coach of the year- the first honor for a women's golf coach in program history.

May 8, 1994 Rachel Wiese finished second with a 309, the best finish by a Badger in the Big Ten Championships.

May 8, 1994 The women's golf team won its first and only Big Ten Championship in Columbus, Ohio. The team won with a then-school 72-hole record 1,254 (313-312-313-316).

May 9, 1993 The 1992-93 Badgers established themselves as the best Badger team to-date in program history. The squad averaged 318.88 strokes per round breaking the old record of 321.64 set in 1982-83. Wisconsin had its first-ever national ranking (as high as 12th) and lowest 18-hole team score of 303 (twice).

April 18, 1993 The Badgers won their first team championship and individual championship since 1990, when junior Laura Bleyhl (Elk River, Minn.) led the Badgers to a win in the Boilermaker Invitational on April 18.

May 5, 1991 The Badger women's golf team turned in its finest performance in UW history placing third at the 1991 Big Ten Championship held at Cherokee Golf Course in Madison. Wisconsin bettered its previous best effort of fourth in 1990, scoring a 72-hole total 1259 (317-312-316-314) for third place behind champion Iowa (1238) and second place Indiana (1247). Senior Nicki Tiziani (Madison, Wis.) recorded the best individual Badger finish in conference history with a fourth place score of 307 (71-76-78-82). Tiziani's one under par 71 tied a then-Big Ten first round championship record.

April 8, 1990 The Badgers capped off a fine spring by finishing in a school-record fourth place at the Big Ten Championship in St. Paul, Minn., with a 72-hole total of 1283. Senior Julie DeWulf (Mequon, Wis.) came in fifth place individually with a 313 total, at the time it was the highest individual finish by a Badger at a Big Ten Championship in the history of the program.

1983-84 The Badgers won the Lady Badger Invitational and the Notre Dame Invitational. Jeanne Hackbarth (Watertown, Wis.) was individual medalist in the Notre Dame Invitational. Monica Tamayo (Colombia, South America) was the Badger's top golfer with a 82.4 average.

1982-83 The Badgers completed the season with their lowest 18-hole season average ever-321.64. Wisconsin also record its lowest round ever, 305, at the Ohio State Invitational. Cathy White (Hayward, Wis.) finished the season with the best average of 79.67. Wisconsin placed third in the Lady Badger Invitational, fifth in the Lady Boilermaker Classic and fifth in the Lady Northern Tournament.

1981-82 Wisconsin had its best season since becoming a varsity program by placing fifth in the Midwest Regional and Big Ten Championships. Connie Rudnicki (West Bend, Wis.) and Barb Casper (Fond du Lac, Wis.) were both named to the All-Big Ten team. Rudnicki placed eighth at Big Ten meet and Casper placed 10th in the tournament. Casper was also the tournament medalist in the Purdue Invitational.

1977-78 Chris Tallard (Madison, Wis.) was the Badger leader with a 88.76 average for the year. Wisconsin placed sixth in the

Lady Badger Invitational; seventh in the Purdue Invitational, the MAIAW Regional championships and Big Ten Championships.

1976-77 Karen Julson (Madison, Wis.) shot a 342 for 129th place at the 1977 AIAW National Championship. Julson averaged 83.5 for the year.
