YOUNG BADGERS HOST IN-STATE RIVAL MILWAUKEE

- Following a trio of battles against ranked opponents, the Badgers return home for one game against I-94 rival Milwaukee on Friday at the Kohl Center. The game is the first of 3 this season against in-state foes.
- Up next, the Badgers will travel to Virginia for the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Nov. 27. UW and UVA split a pair of Challenge games in 2012 and 2013, with each team winning on the opponent's home floor.



All-American, Ethan Happ is the only major conference player averaging 19.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 4.0 apg.

NOTES TO KNOW ABOUT WISCONSIN

- TOUGHEST STRETCH:** Wisconsin just finished playing 3 consecutive non-conference games against AP top-25 teams (Xavier, Baylor, UCLA) for the first time in school history (more on page 3).
- THISCLOSE:** The Badgers are 0-3 against the AP top 25, but were extremely close to winning all 3. UW was tied or within 2 points with 2:00 remaining in all 3 games.
- STILL STANDING TALL:** Despite a 2-3 start to the season, the Badgers are still ranked among the top teams according to Ken Pomeroy. Wisconsin is ranked No. 33 overall in the KenPom.com ratings, owning a top-50 offense (#49) and defense (#24).
- GARD IN CONTROL:** Wisconsin is in good hands with 3rd-year head coach Greg Gard. With a record of 44-21 (.677), Gard owns the third-highest win percentage in school history (min. 60 games) behind Hall of Famers Bo Ryan (.737) and Walter Meanwell (.712) (more on page 9).
- WHO'S GONE:** UW graduated 5 seniors off last year's team who accumulated 4,802 career points and 350 combined starts. The Badgers bring back just 38.3% of the points scored a year ago.
- WHO'S BACK:** UW returns just 1 starter from last season in junior **Ethan Happ**. Sophomore guard **D'Mitrik Trice** is the only other player on the roster that had started a game (2).
- HAPP HAVING HIS WAY:** One of just two returning All-Americans in college basketball, junior **Ethan Happ** is off to an impressive start. He is the only major conference player averaging at least 19.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 4.0 apg (more on page 4).
- YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Against UCLA, Wisconsin started freshmen **Brad Davison** and **Aleem Ford**. The last time UW had 2 or more freshmen in the starting lineup was the final game of the 1997-98 season. Overall, freshmen are accounting for 26.4% pct of the Badgers' points (more on page 5).
- LONG EXHIBITION SEASON:** The Badgers enjoyed an 8-game exhibition schedule, including a 5-game foreign tour of New Zealand and Australia. UW went 7-1, boasting wins over Missouri and Northern Iowa as well as 4 wins over pro teams down under (more on page 6).

ALL-TIME VS. MILWAUKEE

▶ Wisconsin and Milwaukee will meet for the 34th time on Friday in a series that began in 1901. Outside the Big Ten, UW has faced only Marquette (123) more frequently than UWM.

▶ UW owns a 31-2 lead in the all-time series, but the Panthers won the most recent meeting, 68-67, in 2015 in Madison. That UWM win came in the third-to-last game of Bo Ryan's coaching career and snapped a streak of 22 consecutive wins by the Badgers in the series.

▶ Wisconsin and Milwaukee did not play each other last season, snapping a string of meeting every season from 1992 through 2015.

▶ Prior to coming to Madison, UW head coach Greg Gard served as an assistant coach under Bo Ryan at Milwaukee for two seasons (2000 and 2001), compiling a record of 30-27 (.526).

LAST TIME OUT

#23 UCLA 72, WISCONSIN 70

Nov. 21, 2017 | Sprint Center, Kansas City, Mo.

▶ In a game that featured 15 ties and 5 lead changes, Wisconsin came up just short in the consolation finals of the 2017 Hall of Fame Classic in Kansas City, Missouri. UCLA's Aaron Holiday scored a lay-up with 0.9 seconds remaining to give the Bruins a 72-70 win.

▶ UW led by as many as 12 in the first half and UCLA led by as many as 9 in the second half, but the contest was a two-possession game or less for the final 12:45 of the game.

▶ The Badgers held a 34-28 scoring edge in the paint and forced 19 turnovers, but UCLA shot 54.0% from the field and shot 9-for-17 (52.9%) from 3-point range. UW was just 5-for-22 (22.7%) from deep.

▶ Junior **Ethan Happ** led UW with 19 points, 9 rebounds, 5 assists and 3 steals. Junior **Khalil Iverson**, sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** and freshman **Brad Davison** each scored 14 points, while fellow freshman **Kobe King** tallied a career-high 9 points.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH

Head coach Greg Gard has said on several occasions that strength of schedule won't be an issue for this year's Badgers. Judging by the early portion of the season, he appears to be right.

▶ In facing No. 15 Xavier, No. 22 Baylor and No. 23 UCLA, Wisconsin faced 3-straight ranked non-conference opponents for the first time in school history.

▶ Based on the KenPom ratings, UW's non-conference schedule includes 6 games against teams ranked in the top 60: #7 UVA, #17 Xavier, #20 Baylor, #41 UCLA, #47 Temple #56 Marquette. Only 2 of those games are at home. Add in #67 Ohio State (Dec. 2) and #40 Penn State (Dec. 4) and the Badgers will play 8 teams in the top-70 before New Years.

▶ In total, Wisconsin's 2017-18 schedule features 10 games against teams in the AP preseason poll and another 3 against teams receiving votes.

HAPP MAKING HISTORY

Last season, junior **Ethan Happ** established himself as one of the best players in college basketball. This season, he's looking like one of the best players of the last 20 years.

► Happ is the only major conference player averaging at least 19.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 4.0 apg.

In fact, over the last 20 years (since 1997-98) only 2 players in college basketball have averaged those marks: Ohio State's Evan Turner (2010) and LSU's Ben Simmons (2016).

► Happ leads the Badgers in points (19.0), rebounds (9.6), assists (4.0) and blocks (1.2), while ranking second in steals (1.4).

Happ is the only player in the Big Ten leading his team in points, rebounds and assists.

► Last season, Happ was the only player in the NCAA to average at least 13.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg, 2.5 apg, 1.5 spg and 1.0 bpg.

In fact, Happ was the first major conference player in over 20 years to reach those marks for an entire season. Vermont's Marqus Blakely (2009 & 10) is the only other D-I player to hit those marks since at least 1996-97.

► Happ was the nation's only player to lead his team in points, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals during conference play.

► Happ became just the 4th major conference player over the last 20 years to lead his team in all 5 categories during conference play. Also: Utah's Delon Wright (2014), St. John's D.J. Kennedy (2010) and Virginia Tech's Bryant Matthews (2003).

► With 1,046 points, Happ ranks 42nd on Wisconsin's all-time scoring list. He is also 14th on the school's career rebounding chart with 658.

He is one of just 6 players in school history to amass 1,000 points, 650 rebounds and 150 assists.

► With 3 double-doubles already this season, Happ is now tied for 7th in Wisconsin history with 23 career double-doubles.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT

For the first time in 20 years, the Badgers are relying heavily on their freshman class.

► Against No. 23 UCLA, UW started 2 freshmen (**Brad Davison** and **Aleem Ford**) for the first time in almost 20 years.

The last time the Badgers starting lineup featured 2+ freshmen was the final game of the 1997-98 season when Mike Kelley, Andy Kowske and Maurice Linton started in a 66-61 loss to Illinois in the Big Ten tournament. The following year, Wisconsin would start its run of 19 consecutive NCAA tournaments.

► Wisconsin's freshman trio of **Davison**, **Ford** and **Kobe King** have combined to average exactly 20.0 ppg in a combined 58.2 minutes per game.

► **Davison** in particular is playing like a savvy veteran, increasing his scoring output in each of UW's 5 games this season from 5 to 8 to 12 to 13 and then 14 against UCLA.

On the year, **Davison** ranks 3rd on the team averaging 10.4 ppg, while ranking 2nd in the Big Ten with 13 steals (2.6 spg). He is also 2nd on the Badgers in FTs and FTAs, going 15-18 (.833) at the charity stripe.

► **Ford** was rewarded with a starting spot vs. UCLA after scoring a career-high 10 points (2-4 3FGs) vs. Baylor on Nov. 20.

► **King** played 17 minutes off the bench against UCLA and finished with a career-high 9 points (3-4 FGs).

WHAT'S TRENDING WITH UW

► UW is 28-3 under Gard when shooting at least 45.0% from the field.

Additionally, the Badgers are 37-5 under Gard when keeping foes' FG percentage below 45.0%.

► The Badgers have out-scored opponents by 54 points in the paint this season, an average of 10.8 ppg. Last year, UW scored 296 more points in the paint that its opponents (margin of +8.0 ppg).

► UW ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 12th in the NCAA with just 9.4 turnovers per game (Mich 8.6).

Since 2001-02, Wisconsin has averaged 10.1 TOs per game, the nation's lowest mark. Temple is a distant 2nd over that stretch (10.6 TOs / game).

► Wisconsin allowed 62.4 ppg last season, which led the Big Ten and ranked 13th nationally. This season, UW is surrendering 66.6 ppg.

UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 11 of the past 15 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in 9 of the past 15 years.

► The Badgers committed an average of 16.3 fouls per game last season, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten and 30th-fewest in the NCAA. This year UW is averaging 17.4 fouls per game.

► UW is averaging 21.0 FTAs per game. The Badgers are 22-7 under all-time Greg Gard when attempting at least 20 FTs in a game.

► UW went 23-1 last season when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining, continuing an impressive string of closing games. Under Greg Gard, UW is 40-2 when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining.

Dating back to February of 2011, UW is 162-7 (.959) when leading or tied with 5:00 left.

► UW has won 8 of its last 9 overtime games, with the only loss coming in an 84-83 buzzer-beater loss to Florida in the 2017 Sweet 16.

PROS OF THE NON-CON

► UW has won 49 of its last 60 (.817) regular-season, non-conference games dating back to Dec. of 2012. That includes a mark of 14-5 (.737) under head coach Greg Gard.

► Since 2001-02, UW owns a mark of 120-12 (.909) at the Kohl Center. In the Gard era, the Badgers have gone 11-1 at home in the non-con.

► Over the last 15 seasons, the Badgers have gone 22-19 (.537) in non-conference road games, including wins in 7 of its last 9 true road games.

► UW is 13-0 under Gard against unranked non-conference opponents. Since 2003-04, UW is 104-5 (.954) vs. unranked non-con opponents.

EXHIBITION RECAP

► Wisconsin participated in a total of 8 exhibition games prior to the 2017-18 season, including a 5-game foreign tour of New Zealand and Australia, a closed scrimmage with Missouri, and home contests with Northern Iowa and Div. 3 UW-Stout.

► In the 8 total games, UW shot 48.8% from the field, including 39.7% from 3-point range (75-183). UW was also 73.2% at the free throw line.

▷ UW beat Missouri, 74-66, at Augustana College in Rock Island, Illinois. **Ethan Happ** led UW with 17 points and 8 rebounds, while **Brad Davison** (14), **Khalil Iverson** (12) and **D'Mitrik Trice** (11) also scored in double figures. The Badgers held Mizzou to 29.8% shooting, including 18.2% (4-22) from 3-point range.

▷ UW routed Northern Iowa, 69-38, at the Kohl Center in a game to benefit Team Rubicon. **Kobe King** was the only Badger to score in double figures with 15 points. Eight different players combined to hit 10 3FGs, going 10-24 (41.7%) as a team.

UNI shot just 32.6% overall and 22.2% from deep (4-18). The Badgers held the Panthers without a FG for over 14:00 during the second half.

▷ UW topped Div. 3 UW-Stout, 85-56, as 4 players scored in double figures: **King** 17, **Davison** 13, **Iverson** 11 and **Andy Van Vliet** 11.

BADGERS DOWN UNDER

In August, Wisconsin took a 12-day, 5-game tour of Australia and New Zealand, making stops in Auckland, Rotorua, Melbourne and Sydney.

► Wisconsin went 4-1 on the trip, playing 4 games against teams from the top professional league (National Basketball League) and another against professional team Hawthorn Magic.

► In the 5 games, 5 different players led the team in scoring and none was named **Ethan Happ**.

► The Badgers had 4 players finish with double-digit scoring averages: **D'Mitrik Trice** (12.6), **Ethan Happ** (12.0), **Brevin Pritzl** (11.4) and **Brad Davison** (11.2). As team, Wisconsin shot 48.9% on the trip, including 41.7% (48-115) from behind the international 3-point line (22 ft, 2 in. = 17 inches longer than NCAA distance).

► In addition to basketball, the team also enjoyed some sightseeing, including a jet boat tour, gondola ride overlooking Rotorua, a traditional Māori dinner and performance, an Australian Rules Football game, as well as a cruise of Sydney harbor cruise and a climb to the top of the Sydney Bridge.

► Wisconsin heads into the 2017-18 season needing to replace 4 starters off of last year's Sweet 16 qualifier. UW returns third-team AP All-American **Ethan Happ**, who was the nation's only player to lead his team in points (14.6), rebounds (8.6), assists (3.0), blocks (1.6) and steals (2.3) during conference play last season.



BO RYAN GETS CALL TO THE HALL

Former Wisconsin head coach Bo Ryan was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2017 on Nov. 19 in Kansas City, Missouri.

► The NCB HOF Class of 2017 also included Tim Duncan, Cleo Hill, Scott May, Rick Mount, Paul Silas, John Stockton and Jay Williams.

► Ryan is the third Wisconsin inductee in the Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame, joining former head coach Walter Meanwell (1912-17, '21-34) and player Chris Steinmetz, Jr. (1902-05), who were both inducted in 2006.

► The Badgers will surround Happ with a host of young talent, including sophomore point guard **D'Mitrik Trice** and junior forward **Khalil Iverson** among others. Trice averaged 18.3 minutes and 5.6 points per game as a freshman, shooting a team-high 41.8% from 3-point range. Iverson averaged 15.3 points per game off the bench a year ago, shooting over 50% from the field. UW's rotation should also feature returning juniors **Alex Illikainen**, **Charles Thomas, IV** and **Andy Van Vliet**, as well as sophomore **Brevin Pritzl**.

► Wisconsin welcomes 4 scholarship freshmen to the roster in 2017-18: guard **Brad Davison**, forward **Aleem Ford** (redshirted in 2016-17), guard **Kobe King** and forward **Nate Reuvers**.

TRICE IS NICE

Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** made an immediate impact off the bench during his first year in Madison. Now the Huber Heights, Ohio, native is Wisconsin's starting point guard and resident sharp shooter.

► Playing at team-high 32.6 minutes per game, Trice ranks 2nd in scoring (10.6 ppg) and assists 2.6 apg. His 13-to-4 assist-to-turnover ratio (3.3) would rank 7th in the Big Ten but he falls 2 assists short of qualifying.

► Last season, Trice led UW and ranked 9th in the Big Ten shooting 41.8% (38-91) from 3-point range.

Trice's 41.8% 3-point mark was the second-highest 3FG percentage by a freshman in school history, trailing only Tim Locum's mark of 44.1% (41-93) in 1988.

► He was UW's top reserve in terms of points (5.6), assists (1.7) and minutes (18.3) per game.

The point guard also owned a 1.7 assist-to-turnover ratio, dishing 63 assists to 37 TOs.

2016-17 LOOK BACK**Record:** 27-10 | **Big Ten:** 12-6 (T-2nd)

► The Badgers finished last season with a mark of 27-10, tallying the 5th-highest single-season win total in school history.

► Wisconsin reached the NCAA tournament for the 19th-consecutive season in 2016-17, the 5th-longest streak in NCAA history.

► The Badgers advanced to their 4th-consecutive Sweet 16 and the team's 6th trip in the last 7 years. UW is the only school to accomplish either feat. The Badgers have won 13 NCAA tournament games over the last 4 years, the highest mark in all of college basketball.

► Greg Gard is just the 3rd coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first 2 years as a head coach, joining Mark Few (Gonzaga) and Steve Lavin (UCLA).

► With a Big Ten record of 12-6 and second-place showing, the Badgers secured a top-4 conference finish for the 17th-consecutive season, the longest such streak in Big Ten history.

► The 2017 senior class of Vitto Brown, Nigel Hayes, Bronson Koenig and Zak Showalter equaled UW's highest 4-year win total with 115.

► Ethan Happ earned third-team AP All-America honors, becoming just the 6th Badger ever to be named to an All-America team. He was also first-team All-Big Ten and was named the AP's Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year.

► The Badgers tallied a total of 4 wins over teams in the AP top-25, including No. 1 Villanova in the second round of the NCAA tournament. The Badgers have now posted 5 wins over No. 1 or No. 2 seeds in the last 4 NCAA tournaments. Wisconsin owns a total of 4 wins over No. 1 seeds since 2000, the most of any team.

► A Senior CLASS Award finalist, Nigel Hayes was one of the most versatile players in Big Ten history. Ranking 3rd on UW's all-time scoring list, Hayes is 1 of just 2 players in Big Ten history to tally 1,800 pts, 700 rebs and 300 asts, joining MSU's Steve Smith.

► Wisconsin's career 3-point king with 267 triples, Bronson Koenig was at his best when the game was on the line. Over the last 2 seasons, he went 37-for-75 (.493) from 3-point range in the final 5:00 and overtime.

► UW also had 6 players earn 2017 Academic All-Big Ten honors: **Vitto Brown** (3x honoree), **Matt Ferris** (2x honoree), **Nigel Hayes** (3x honoree), **Aaron Moesch** (2x honoree), **Brevin Pritzl** and **Zak Showalter** (2x honoree).

► Wisconsin led the Big Ten and ranked 13th in the NCAA in scoring defense (62.4 ppg). UW has led the conference in scoring D in 11 of the last 15 seasons.

► Including last year's run to the Sweet 16 and the football team's win in the Cotton Bowl, Wisconsin has earned an NCAA men's basketball tournament invite and qualified for a bowl game in each of the last 15 years. That is college athletic's longest all-time streak of dual success.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard will begin his third season as the head coach of the Badgers in 2017-18 on the heels of leading the team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

After initially taking over on an interim basis, Gard was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. In two seasons, he has piloted the Badgers to a record of 42-18 (.700), owning the second-best 60-game start in program history.

In his first two seasons with the head coaching title, Gard has maintained a level of success that has become synonymous with Wisconsin Basketball. In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

The transition to Gard's leadership began with a 1-4 start to the Big Ten Conference, but Wisconsin proceeded on a run that saw it win 11 of its final 13 regular-season games.

A 77-76 victory over fourth-ranked Michigan State was the beginning of a seven-game win streak that also featured a win over No. 19 Indiana and an impressive road triumph at No. 2 Maryland. The Badgers later added another road win over No. 8 Iowa on Feb. 24.

UW finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 16 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has never seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings, amassing a combined mark of 196-80 (.710) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes earned the nod in 2016 and



third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in 2017.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. During that time, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 12 winningest seasons at Wisconsin. He has helped pilot the Badgers to four Big Ten regular season titles and three Big Ten tournament championships, most recently winning both crowns in 2015. UW has made the NCAA tournament in each of Gard's first 14 seasons, advancing to seven Sweet 16s, three Elite Eights and two Final Fours.

During Gard's first two seasons as head coach, Wisconsin has placed 11 players on the Academic All-Big Ten list. Over his 16 years in Madison, UW has boasted a total of 59 Academic All-Big Ten honors, trailing only Purdue and Northwestern over that span.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. He also served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School

► Since 2002, UW has won 7 Big Ten championships (4 regular season and 3 tourn.). Only OSU (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourn.) has won more titles during Ryan's tenure. MSU has 6 and ILL has 5, but no other school has more than 3 over that span.

► Bo Ryan's teams posted a 172-68 (.717) Big Ten record, the best mark in the conference over his 14 seasons. Michigan St. was second at 161-79 (.671) and Ohio St. was third at 156-84 (.650).
