UW BACK IN ACTION VS. GREEN BAY

- After more than a week off for final exams on campus, Wisconsin returns to action to host Green Bay on Dec. 23. The Badgers are 19-0 all-time at home against the Phoenix. Tip-off is set for 4:30 p.m. (CT) on BTN.
- Up next, UW continues its 6-game homestand and rounds out non-con play by hosting Chicago State on Dec. 27 and UMass Lowell on Dec. 30.

NOTES TO KNOW ABOUT WISCONSIN

- **TOUGHEST SCHEDULE:** Wisconsin has faced arguably the toughest schedule in the country so far. The Badgers have played 8 games against the KenPom top-60, the most in the nation. UW is also 1 of 4 teams in the country that has played 4 ranked teams this season (more on page 3).
- **BEEN HERE BEFORE:** Wisconsin is .500 or below through 12 games for the first time since 2001-02, the first year under Bo Ryan and Greg Gard. That team was 6-6 and rallied to finish 19-13, winning a share of the Big Ten championship and reaching the NCAA tournament.



All-American Ethan Happ is the only major conference player averaging 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.

- **GARD IN CONTROL:** With a record of 47-25 (.653), Greg Gard owns the 3rd-highest win percentage in school history (min. 60 games) behind Hall of Famers Bo Ryan (.737) and Walter Meanwell (.712). He has gone 25-13 (.658) in Big Ten play (more on page 9).
- HAPP HAVING HIS WAY: All-American Ethan Happ is off to an impressive start. He is the only major conference player averaging at least 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg and the Big Ten's only player leading his team in points, rebounds and assists (more on page 4).
- INJURY UPDATE: UW announced last week that starting PG D'Mitrik Trice underwent foot surgery on Monday and is out indefinitely. Freshman Kobe King was also lost for the entire season after he had knee surgery on Monday. King was averaging 19.0 mpg and 5.2 ppg (more on page 3).
- GOOD TO BE HOME: Having already played 5 games away from home, the Badgers are glad to be back at the Kohl Center where they have won 86.3% of their games all-time. (more page 11).
- **THISCLOSE:** Wisconsin has lost 7 games this season, but has been within minutes of winning 4 of them. In each of those 4 setbacks, UW was tied or within 2 points with 2:00 remaining.
- **BIG TEN BEASTS:** UW has boasted a winning conference record in each of the last 17 seasons, the longest run of success of any team in the 110-year history of Big Ten hoops (more on page 7).
- YOUTH MOVEMENT: Led by guard Brad Davison (11.3 ppg) the Badgers are relying heavily on a talented freshman class that is accounting for 27.1 ppg (more on pages 3 and 6).

LAST TIME OUT

WISCONSIN 81, GREEN BAY 80

Dec. 13, 2017 | Kohl Center, Madison, Wis.

- ► Wisconsin got back on the winning track with an 81-80 win last week over Western Kentucky.
- ▶ UW rallied from a 4-point halftime deficit and led by as many as 11 points in the second half before WKU tied the game with 2.0 seconds remaining. Freshman **Brad Davison** would draw a player control foul against WKU on the ensuing inbounds pass and made a FT at the other end to win the game.
- ► The Badgers shot 54.9% from the field (their second-highest mark of the season), including 72.7% (16-for-22) during the second half.
- ▶ UW went 12-for-20 (60.0%) from 3-point range, notching season-highs for 3FGs and percentage.
- ▶ Sophomore **Brevin Pritzl** matched his career high with 17 points to lead Wisconsin, hitting a career-best four 3-point field goals (4-5 3FGs).
- ▶ Junior **Ethan Happ** also scored 17 points to go with 4 rebounds and 6 assists.
- ▶ **Davison** finished with 16 points and 5 assists, while **Aleem Ford** scored a career-high 14 points with 5 rebounds.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH

Head coach Greg Gard has said on several occasions that strength of schedule won't be an issue for this year's Badgers. Judging by the early portion of the season, he appears to be right.

▶ UW has played 8 games against teams ranked in the KenPom top-60, the most of any team in the nation. In fact, Purdue (7) is the nation's only other team that has faced more than 5 top-60 foes.

- ► The NCAA's RPI lists Wisconsin 7th in strength of schedule.
- ▶ In facing No. 15 Xavier, No. 22 Baylor and No. 23 UCLA, Wisconsin faced 3-straight ranked non-conference opponents for the first time in school history. Add in No. 18 Virginia and the Badgers are one of just 4 teams in the nation who have faced 4 ranked opponents already this season (Savannah State 5, Creighton 4, Texas Southern 4).
- ▶ UW has lost 7 games to teams with a combined record of 63-16 (.797).

Overall, the Badgers' 10 opponents have a combined record of 97-46 (.678).

► In total, UW's 2017-18 schedule features 10 games against teams in the AP preseason poll.

INJURY UPDATES

Wisconsin suffered a pair of injuries to its backcourt recently with the news that starting point guard D'Mitrik Trice and reserve Kobe King would miss significant time.

- Trice had surgery on his right foot on Dec. 11 and will begin rehab in approximately 2-3 weeks. He was averaging a team-high 31.5 minutes per game, ranking third on the Badgers in scoring (9.4 ppg) and second in assists (2.3 apg).
- ▶ King underwent season-ending surgery to his left knee on Dec. 11. The freshman, who appeared in each of the first 10 games this season, will be eligible to apply for a medical hardship waiver after the season. If granted, the La Crosse native will return as a redshirt freshman for the 2018-19 season.

King was averaging 19.0 minutes and 5.2 points per game, including a career-high 10 points (2-5 3FGs) against Ohio State on Dec. 2.

DAVISON TAKES THE LEAD

Guard **Brad Davison** is putting together one of the better freshman seasons in recent Wisconsin history.

▶ **Davison** is 2nd on the team averaging 11.3 ppg, including a career-high 20 points vs. Marquette (12/9). He has scored in double figures 7 times this season.

Over the last 30 years (since 1988), only 6 Badgers have averaged double figures in their freshman season.

▶ Davison ranks 3rd among Big Ten freshman with 11.3 ppg, trailing only OSU's Kaleb Wesson (12.2 ppg) and Rutgers' Geo Baker (12.1 ppg).

Baker (30.8 mpg) is the BIG's only freshman playing more minutes than Davison (28.6 mpg).

Davison is shooting a team-high 43.4% (23-53) from 3-point range, ranking 12th in the B1G.
 Among freshmen, Davison's 3FG Pct. is tops

in the Big Ten and 22nd in the nation.

Tim Locum holds the UW freshman 3FG

Pct. record, going 41-for-93 (44.1%) in 1988.

Davison is averaging 1.9 3FGs per game, which leads all Big Ten freshmen and is tied for 14th in the league.

- ▶ Davison also leads the Badgers in made free throws and ranks 2nd in FTAs, going 35-for-47 (.745) at the line. He set a UW season-high going 11-for-16 at the charity stripe vs. Marquette.
- ► Davison is also 3rd in the Big Ten averaging 1.8 steals per game. Among freshmen nationally, Davison's 22 steals ranks 6th.
- ▶ **Davison** earned Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Week (Nov. 27) after averaging 15.0 ppg and 2.0 spg in games against Baylor, UCLA and Milwaukee. Davison went 11-for-19 (57.9%) from 3-point range in those 3 games.

HAPP HYPE

THE GAME'S BEST ALL-AROUND PLAYER

"Happ was so good a season ago that he entered Big Ten player of the year conversations even though Purdue's Caleb Swanigan was destroying everything that stood in his path on a nightly basis. He was the Adam Banks to Bronson Koenig and Nigel Hayes's Charlie Conway. With Koenig and Hayes gone now, though, Happ gets to become Adam Banks and Charlie Conway."

HAPP MAKING HISTORY

Last season, junior **Ethan Happ** established himself as one of the best players in college basketball. This season, he's looking like one of the best players of the last 20 years.

► Happ is the <u>only major conference player</u> averaging at least 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.

In fact, over the last 20 years (since 1997-98) only 3 Big Ten players have averaged those marks for an entire season and all 3 were Big Ten Player of the Year and consensus All-Americans: Ohio State's Evan Turner (2010), Michigan State's Draymond Green (2012) and Purdue's Caleb Swanigan (2017).

► Happ leads the Badgers in points (16.3), rebounds (8.3), assists (3.3) and blocks (0.8) per game. He is second in steals per game (1.2).

Happ is the <u>only player in the Big Ten</u> leading his team in points, rebounds and assists.

► Last season, Happ was the only player in the NCAA to average at least 13.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg, 2.5 apg, 1.5 spg and 1.0 bpg.

In fact, Happ was the first major conference player in over 20 years to reach those marks for an entire season. Vermont's Marqus Blakely (2009 & 10) is the only other D-I player to hit those marks since at least 1996-97.

► Happ was the <u>nation's only player</u> to lead his team in points, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals during conference play.

▶ Happ became just the 4th major conference player over the last 20 years to lead his team in all 5 categories during conference play. Also: Utah's Delon Wright (2014), St. John's D.J. Kennedy (2010) and Virginia Tech's Bryant Matthews (2003).

▶ With 1,147 points, Happ is tied for 32nd on Wisconsin's all-time scoring list. He is also 10th on the school's career rebounding chart with 709.

He is one of just 5 players in school history to amass 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 150 assists.

▶ With 3 double-doubles this season, Happ is now tied for 7th in Wisconsin history with 23 career double-doubles.

ALL-TIME VS. GREEN BAY

- ► Wisconsin and Green Bay have played every year since 1999 and Saturday's contest will mark the 24th meeting all-time. The Badgers own a 22-1 record against Green Bay, going 19-0 in Madison.
- ► Greg Gard's first game as head coach was against Green Bay, an 84-79 win on Dec. 23, 2015.
- ► Wisconsin has won each of the last 7 meetings with Green Bay by an average of 14.1 points per game.
- ► Since the regular meetings began in 1999, Green Bay is averaging 58.1 ppg against UW and has scored more than 62 points just 3 times (2009, 2013 and 2015).
- ► The match-up with Green Bay completes Wisconsin's three-game series with the other in-state foes. The Badgers defeated Milwaukee, 71-49, on Nov. 24 and lost to Marquette, 82-63, on Dec. 9.

UW is 3-1 against in-state opponents under Greg Gard and has gone 42-10 (.808) in such games dating back to 2000.

► The Badgers, who always take an extended break during final exams on campus, have won their last 20 games immediately after finals. UW's last post-finals defeat came in a 59-57 loss to Providence in 1996.

- ▶ Wisconsin led by as many as 24 before coasting to a 73-59 win over Green Bay last season. The Badgers used a 12-0 run in the second half to pull away, holding the Phoenix scoreless for a stretch of 4:14.
- ► A year after turning the ball over 26 times against Green Bay in 2015, the Badgers had just 9 turnovers in the 2016 meeting. UW also forced a season-high 19 turnovers, including 13 steals.
- ► The Badgers assisted on 18 of their 27 field goals.
- ▶ **Nigel Hayes** led Wisconsin with 24 points. He also grabbed 5 boards and equaled his seasonhigh with 13 FTAs.
- ► Zak Showalter tallied 16 points (4-6 3FGs), 5 rebounds and a career-high 6 steals.
- ► Ethan Happ picked up a double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds. He also dished 6 assists with only 1 turnover and ripped 2 steals.

FRESHMAN FOURSOME

For the first time in 20 years, the Badgers are relying heavily on their freshman class – a 5-man group that includes **Brad Davison**, **Aleem Ford**, **Kobe King**, **Walt McGrory** and **Nate Reuvers**.

- ▶ UW is starting 2 freshmen (**Davison** and **Ford**) for the first time in almost 20 years. The last time the Badgers starting lineup featured multiple freshmen was the final game of the 1997-98 season when Mike Kelley, Andy Kowske and Maurice Linton started in a 66-61 loss to Illinois.
- ▶ Wisconsin's freshman fivesome of **Davison**, **Ford**, **King**, **McGrory** and **Reuvers** have combined to average 27.1 ppg. All 4 scholarship freshman have had a game scoring in double figures this season, including 7 such games by Davison.
- ► Ford moved into the starting lineup in the season's 5th game and is averaging 5.3 ppg and 2.9 rpg. He is 2nd on the team shooting 41.2% from 3-point range, going 14-for-34 from deep.

Ford scored a career-high 14 points (4-5 3FGs) with 5 rebounds and 3 assists vs. WKU.

► Reuvers sat out the first 5 games of the season while contemplating a redshirt season. However, he made his debut in Game 6 vs. Milwaukee, posting 6 rebounds and 2 assists.

Reuvers scored in double-figures in each of UW's 2 Big Ten games, finishing with 10 points on 4-for-4 shooting (2-2 3FGs) against OSU and then 11 points with 4 rebounds at PSU.

On the season, he is averaging 4.3 points (3-for-12 3FGs) and 3.3 rebounds per game.

► King's production had been increasing before a left knee injury ended his season. King averaged 19.0 mpg and 5.2 ppg over the first 10 games.

Over the last 6 games, King's scoring average climbed to 6.5 ppg and he had gone 7-for-15 (46.7%) from 3-point range over that stretch.

King scored a career-high 10 points (2-5 3FGs) vs. Ohio State on Dec. 2.

INCREASING IVERSON

A starter for the first time in his career, junior **Khalil Iverson** has responded with his best season.

- ▶ Iverson is averaging 7.4 ppg, ranking 2nd on the team with 4.3 rpg. He is also shooting a teamhigh 55.4% from the field.
- ▶ Iverson has scored in double figures 3 times this season, including a career-high 17p (8-9 FGs) vs. Yale and a 16-point effort (7-8 FGs) at PSU.

WHAT'S TRENDING WITH UW

► UW is 30-3 under Gard when shooting at least 45.0% from the field.

The Badgers are 38-6 under Gard when keeping foes' FG percentage below 45.0%.

- ► Wisconsin is 4-2 this season and 35-8 under Gard when out-rebounding opponents.
- ▶ UW ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 17th in the NCAA with 10.9 turnovers per game (Mich 9.4).

Since 2001-02, Wisconsin has averaged 10.1 TOs per game, the nation's lowest mark. Temple is a distant 2nd over that stretch (10.6 TOs / game).

▶ Wisconsin is allowing 66.5 points per game this season, which ranks 8th in the Big Ten. The Badgers have allowed more than 64.0 ppg for an entire season just twice in the last 20 years (65.7 in 2001-02 and 65.6 ppg in 2005-06).

Last season the Badgers led the Big Ten and ranked 13th nationally allowing 62.4 ppg.

UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 11 of the past 15 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in 9 of the past 15 years.

► The Badgers committed an average of 16.3 fouls per game last season, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten and 30th-fewest in the NCAA.

This year UW is averaging 15.8 fouls per game, a number that ranks 2nd in the Big Ten. UW opponents are averaging 15.0 FTAs per game.

▶ Under Greg Gard, UW is an impressive 43-3 when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining. Last season, the Badgers went 23-1 when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining.

Dating back to February of 2011, UW is 164-7 (.959) when leading or tied with 5:00 left.

▶ UW has won 8 of its last 9 overtime games, with the only loss coming in an 84-83 buzzer-beater loss to Florida in the 2017 Sweet 16.

NON-CON SUCCESS

- ▶ UW is 51-14 (.785) in regular-season, nonconference games dating back to 2012. That includes a mark of 16-8 (.667) under Greg Gard.
- ► Since 2001-02, UW owns a non-conference mark of 122-13 (.904) at the Kohl Center. In the Gard era, the Badgers are 13-2 (.867).
- ▶ Over the last 15 seasons, the Badgers have gone 22-21 (.512) in non-conference road games, including wins in 7 of its last 11 true road games.
- ▶ UW is 15-2 under Gard against unranked noncon opponents, with the only 2 losses coming at Temple and vs. Marquette this season. Since 2003-04, UW is 105-7 (.938) vs. unranked non-con foes.

BO RYAN GETS CALL TO THE HALL

Former Wisconsin head coach Bo Ryan was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2017 on Nov. 19 in Kansas City, Missouri.

► The NCB HOF Class of 2017 also included Tim Duncan, Cleo Hill, Scott May, Rick Mount, Paul Silas, John Stockton and Jay Williams. ▶ Ryan spent 32 seasons as a collegiate head coach, finishing 26th on the NCAA's all-time wins list with a record of 747-233 (.762)

In 14-plus seasons at Wisconsin, Ryan led the Badgers to a mark of 364-130 (.737) and five Big Ten championships and back-to-back Final Fours, including an appearance in the 2015 National Championship Game.

ACTIVE WIN/LOSS STREAKS

FORMER WALK-ONS IN ROTATION

The Badgers' recent rotation has featured a trio of players who came to Wisconsin as walk-ons in senior **Aaron Moesch**, junior **T.J. Schlundt** and **Walt McGrory**.

- ▶ **Schlundt** came to Madison as a walk-on and earned a scholarship prior to this season for the first time. Over the last 2 games, Schlundt has averaged 17.0 minutes per game, including a career-high 21 minutes vs. Western Kentucky. He has gone 3-for-5 from 3-point range in those 2 games.
- ► Moesch, who also earned a scholarship in August has appeared in 6 total games this season. Recently, he played 5 minutes at Temple and 4 minutes vs. Marquette.
- ► Freshman guard **Walt McGrory** did not appear in UW's first 11 games and was contemplating redshirting until making his debut vs. Western Kentucky. He played 2 minutes, going 1-for-2 from the free throw line.

BADGERS IN BIG TEN OPENERS

- ▶ Including the win at Penn State (Dec. 4), UW has won 12 of its last 14 <u>road</u> Big Ten openers dating back to 2005. The only losses during that stretch came in a 69-61 defeat at Illinois in 2011 and a 59-58 loss at Indiana in 2016.
- ► The Badgers dropped a rare Big Ten opener on Saturday vs. Ohio State. Even with the loss, UW has won 13 of its last 15 Big Ten openers dating back to 2003-04.
- ► The Badgers played their earliest Big Ten games in school history. Wisconsin's earliest Big Ten opener prior to this season was a 26-21 win over Michigan State on Dec. 6, 1936.

TRICE IS NICE

Before undergoing foot surgery on Dec. 11, sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** had started each of UW's first 10 games at point guard and established himself as one of the team's better shooters.

- ▶ Playing at team-high 31.5 minutes per game, Trice ranks 3rd in scoring (9.4 ppg) and 2nd in assists (2.3 apg). His 23-to-13 assist-to-turnover ratio (1.8) leads the team (min. 2.0 apg).
- ► Trice is shooting just 30.0% from 3-point range on the year, going 12-for-40.

However, last season Trice led UW and ranked 9th in the Big Ten shooting 41.8% (38-91) from 3-point range.

Trice's 41.8% 3-point mark was the second-highest 3FG percentage by a freshman in school history, trailing only Tim Locum's mark of 44.1% (41-93) in 1988.

► He was UW's top reserve in terms of points (5.6), assists (1.7) and minutes (18.3) per game.

The point guard also owned a 1.7 assist-toturnover ratio, dishing 63 assists to 37 TOs.

CONFERENCE CONSISTENCY

▶ With 12 Big Ten wins last season, Wisconsin posted a winning conference record for the 17th-consecutive season, the longest run of success in the 109-year history of Big Ten hoops.

- Among the major conferences, only Kansas (27, including this season) has a longer active streak of above .500 seasons.
- ▶ Wisconsin has also clinched no worse than a 4th-place finish in the Big Ten standings for the 17th-consecutive season. That is also the longest such streak in Big Ten history.
- ▶ The Badgers have now tallied at least 12 Big Ten wins in each of the last 7 seasons, the longest active streak in the conference (Purdue is 2nd at 3 straight seasons with 12+ wins).
- ▶ Since Gard entered the Big Ten head coaching ranks, Wisconsin is 25-13 (.658) in conference play tied for the 2nd-best mark in the Big Ten.

- The Badgers had 4 players finish with double-digit scoring averages: D'Mitrik Trice (12.6), Ethan Happ (12.0), Brevin Pritzl (11.4) and Brad Davison (11.2). As team, Wisconsin shot 48.9% on the trip, including 41.7% (48-115) from behind the international 3-point line (22 ft, 2 in. = 17 inches longer than NCAA distance).
- In addition to basketball, the team also enjoyed some sightseeing, including a jet boat tour, gondola ride overlooking Rotorua, a traditional Māori dinner and performance, an Australian Rules Football game, as well as a cruise of Sydney harbor cruise and a climb to the top of the Sydney Bridge.

- UW returns just 38.3% of the points scored a year ago and 39.4% of the minutes played.
- Wisconsin is replacing 4 starters off of last year's Sweet 16 qualifier. UW returns third-team AP All-American Ethan Happ, who was the nation's only player to lead his team in points (14.6), rebounds (8.6), assists (3.0), blocks (1.6) and steals (2.3) during conference play last
- The Badgers will surround Happ with a host of young talent, including sophomore point guard D'Mitrik Trice and junior forward Khalil Iverson among others. Trice averaged 18.3 minutes and 5.6 points per game as a freshman, shooting a team-high 41.8% from 3-point range. Iverson averaged 15.3 points per game off the bench a year ago, shooting over 50% from the field.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard will begin his third season as the head coach of the Badgers in 2017-18 on the heels of leading the team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

After initially taking over on an interim basis, Gard was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. In two seasons, he has piloted the Badgers to a record of 42-18 (.700), owning the second-best 60-game start in program history.

In his first two seasons with the head coaching title, Gard has maintained a level of success that has become synonymous with Wisconsin Basketball. In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

The transition to Gard's leadership began with a 1-4 start to the Big Ten Conference, but Wisconsin proceeded on a run that saw it win 11 of its final 13 regular-season games.

A 77-76 victory over fourth-ranked Michigan State was the beginning of a seven-game win streak that also featured a win over No. 19 Indiana and an impressive road triumph at No. 2 Maryland. The Badgers later added another road win over No. 8 Iowa on Feb. 24.

UW finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 16 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has never seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings, amassing a combined mark of 196-80 (.710) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes earned the nod in 2016 and



third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in 2017.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. During that time, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 12 winningest seasons at Wisconsin. He has helped pilot the Badgers to four Big Ten regular season titles and three Big Ten tournament championships, most recently winning both crowns in 2015. UW has made the NCAA tournament in each of Gard's first 14 seasons, advancing to seven Sweet 16s, three Elite Eights and two Final Fours.

During Gard's first two seasons as head coach, Wisconsin has placed 11 players on the Academic All-Big Ten list. Over his 16 years in Madison, UW has boasted a total of 59 Academic All-Big Ten honors, trailing only Purdue and Northwestern over that span.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. He also served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School

- ▶ Over the last 15 seasons, 181 of the Badgers' 242 home wins have come by at least 10 points (75.1 percent).
- ▶ Wisconsin has trailed at halftime in only 54 of 274 home games since the 2001-02 season. UW has come back to win 33 of those 54 games (61.1 percent).
- ▶ In 2016-17, the Badgers led the Big Ten and ranked 6th nationally in attendance, selling out every game (17,287 per game). UW has led the Big Ten in attendance in 11 of the last 15 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 17 years.
- ► This season, the Badgers sold out the 2,100-person Grateful Red (3rd-largest student section in the Big Ten) in under 15 minutes.
- ► Including the most recent game vs. Western Kentucky, Wisconsin has sold out the last 64 consecutive games at the Kohl Center dating back to Jan. of 2014.
