TWO-GAME PENNSYLVANIA ROAD TRIP ON TAP

The Badgers travel to the state of Pennsylvania for a pair of games in 3 days when they take on Penn State (Dec. 4) and Temple (Dec. 6). Wisconsin is looking for its 10th-straight win over the Nittany Lions.

NOTES TO KNOW ABOUT WISCONSIN

- **TOUGHEST STRETCH:** Wisconsin has played arguably the toughest schedule in the country so far. The Badgers are the only team in the country that has played 4 ranked teams already this season (more on page 3).
- THISCLOSE: The Badgers are 0-4 against the AP top 25, but have come close to winning several. In three of them, UW was tied or within 2 points with 2:00 remaining.
- GARD IN CONTROL: With a record of 45-23 (.662), Greg Gard owns the third-highest win percentage in school history (min. 60 games) behind Hall of Famers Bo Ryan (.737) and Walter Meanwell (.712). He has gone 24-13 (.649) in Big Ten play (more on page 9).



All-American Ethan Happ is the only major conference player averaging 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.

- **BIG TEN BEASTS:** Wisconsin has boasted a winning conference record and finished among the top 4 in each of the last 17 seasons, owning the longest run of continued success of any team in the 110-year history of Big Ten basketball (more on page 7).
- HAPP HAVING HIS WAY: One of just two returning All-Americans in college basketball, junior Ethan Happ is off to an impressive start. He is the only major conference player averaging at least 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg (more on page 4).
- YOUTH MOVEMENT: For the first time in 20 years, UW is relying heavily on freshmen. The Badgers freshman foursome of Brad Davison, Aleem Ford, Kobe King and Nate Reuvers is accounting for 24.5 ppg and all 4 have had a game scoring in double figures this season, including 5 such games by Davison (more on page 3).
- HOME ON THE ROAD: Wisconsin is 58-27 (.682) away from home over the last 4 seasons. That figure ranks 6th in the NCAA for most wins away from home. Under Greg Gard, the Badgers are 10-8 on the road in Big Ten play (more on page 7).
- **WHO'S GONE:** UW graduated 5 seniors off last year's team who accumulated 4,802 career points and 350 combined starts. The Badgers bring back just 38.3% of the points scored a year ago.
- WHO'S BACK: UW returns just 1 starter from last season in junior Ethan Happ. Sophomore guard D'Mitrik Trice is the only other player on the roster that had started a game (2).

LAST TIME OUT

OHIO STATE 83, WISCONSIN 58

Dec. 2, 2017 | Kohl Center, Madison, Wis.

- Wisconsin dropped a rare Big Ten opener on Saturday, falling to Ohio State, 83-58, at the Kohl Center.
- The Buckeyes shot 78.3%, including 7-of-8 from 3-point range, in the first half to build a 23-point halftime edge and never looked back. OSU shot 66.0% overall for the game.
- Wisconsin's freshman foursome led the way, accounting for 39 of the Badgers' 58 points. Brad Davison tallied team-highs with 16 points (3-6 3FGs) and 3 assists. Kobe King and Nate Reuvers each posted career highs with 10 points off the bench. Reuvers was a perfect 4-for-4 from the field overall, including 2-2 on 3FGs.
- Junior **Ethan Happ** finished with 7 points and 6 boards, his first game this season not scoring in double figures.

BADGERS IN BIG TEN OPENERS

- The Badgers dropped a rare Big Ten opener on Saturday vs. Ohio State. Even with the loss, UW has won 13 of its last 15 Big Ten openers dating back to 2003-04. UW's only other loss during that stretch came in a 61-55 home setback to No. 14 Purdue on Dec. 29, 2015.
- Wisconsin has won 11 of its last 13 road Big Ten openers dating back to 2005. The only losses during that stretch came in a 69-61 defeat at No. 25 Illinois in 2011 and a 59-58 loss at Indiana in

The Badgers have traveled to Penn State for their Big Ten road opener three times, claiming a 63-46 in 2010 and a 71-56 win in 1994 while suffering a 79-50 setback in 1996.

The Badgers are playing their earliest Big Ten games in school history. Wisconsin's earliest Big Ten opener prior to this season was a 26-21 win over Michigan State on Dec. 6, 1936.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH

Head coach Greg Gard has said on several occasions that strength of schedule won't be an issue for this year's Badgers. Judging by the early portion of the season, he appears to be right.

- In facing No. 15 Xavier, No. 22 Baylor and No. 23 UCLA, Wisconsin faced 3-straight ranked non-conference opponents for the first time in school history. Add in No. 18 Virginia and the Badgers are the nation's only team that has faced 4 ranked opponents already this season.
- Based on the KenPom ratings, UW's nonconference schedule includes 6 games against teams ranked in the top 60: #4 UVA, #17 Xavier, #29 Baylor, #39 Temple, #47 UCLA and #63 Marquette. Only 2 of those games are at home.

Add in #60 Ohio State (Dec. 2) and #32 Penn State (Dec. 4) and the Badgers will play 8 teams in the top-70 before New Years.

In total, UW's 2017-18 schedule features 10 games against teams in the AP preseason poll and another 3 vs. teams receiving votes.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT

For the first time in 20 years, the Badgers are relying heavily on their freshman class - a fourman group that includes Brad Davison, Aleem Ford and Kobe King and Nate Reuvers.

- Against No. 23 UCLA, UW started 2 freshmen (Davison and Ford) for the first time in almost 20 years. The last time the Badgers starting lineup featured multiple freshmen was the final game of the 1997-98 season when Mike Kelley, Andy Kowske and Maurice Linton started in a 66-61 loss to Illinois.
- Wisconsin's freshman foursome of Davison, Ford, King and Reuvers have combined to average 24.5 ppg. All 4 have had a game scoring in double figures this season, including 5 such games by Davison.
- Last week's Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Week, **Davison** in particular is playing like a savvy veteran. Last week in games against Baylor, UCLA and Milwaukee, Davison averaged 15 points and two steals per game, while going 11-for-19 (57.9%) from 3-point range.
- **Davison** increased his scoring output in each of UW's first 6 games, going from 5 to 8 to 12 to 13 to 14 to a career-high 19 against Milwaukee.

On the year, Davison is 2nd on the team and 2nd among Big Ten freshmen averaging 11.5 ppg (Kaleb Wesson, OSU, 12.1 ppg).

He is also 2nd in the Big Ten averaging 2.1 steals per game.

Davison is shooting a team-high 45.0% (18-40) from 3-point range. Among freshman, that figure ranks 2nd in the Big Ten (Michigan's Jordan Poole, 45.8%) and 16th in the nation.

He is averaging 2.3 3FGs per game, which leads all Big Ten freshmen and is tied for 9th in the league.

Davison is also 2nd on the Badgers in FTs and FTAs, going 20-for-25 (.800) at the charity stripe.

- Ford was rewarded with a starting spot vs. UCLA after scoring a career-high 10 points (2-4 3FGs) vs. Baylor. He also tallied career highs with 7 rebounds and 5 assists vs. Milwaukee.
- King is averaging 5.3 ppg, including a career-high 10 points (2-5 3FGs) vs. Ohio State. Over the last 4 games, King is averaging 7.3 ppg and has gone 5-for-10 from 3-point range.
- Reuvers sat out the first 5 games of the season while contemplating a redshirt season. However, he made his debut in Game 6 vs. Milwaukee, posting 6 rebounds and 2 assists.

Reuvers scored his first collegiate points against Ohio State, finishing with 10 points on 4-for-4 shooting (2-2 3FGs). He is also averaging 3.3 rebounds per game, including 1.7 offensive boards per game.

HAPP HYPE

THE GAME'S BEST ALL-AROUND PLAYER

"Happ was so good a season ago that he entered Big Ten player of the year conversations even though Purdue's Caleb Swanigan was destroying everything that stood in his path on a nightly basis. He was the Adam Banks to Bronson Koenig and Nigel Hayes's Charlie Conway. With Koenig and Hayes gone now, though, Happ gets to become Adam Banks and Charlie Conway."

HAPP MAKING HISTORY

Last season, junior Ethan Happ established himself as one of the best players in college basketball. This season, he's looking like one of the best players of the last 20 years.

► Happ is the only major conference player averaging at least 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.

In fact, over the last 20 years (since 1997-98) only 3 Big Ten players have averaged those marks for an entire season and all 3 were Big Ten Player of the Year and consensus All-Americans: Ohio State's Evan Turner (2010), Michigan State's Draymond Green (2012) and Purdue's Caleb Swanigan (2017).

► Happ leads the Badgers in points (16.3), rebounds (8.8), assists (3.0) and blocks (0.8) per game. He is second in steals per game (1.4).

Happ is the only player in the Big Ten leading his team in points, rebounds and assists.

▶ Last season, Happ was the only player in the NCAA to average at least 13.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg, 2.5 apg, 1.5 spg and 1.0 bpg.

In fact, Happ was the first major conference player in over 20 years to reach those marks for an entire season. Vermont's Margus Blakely (2009 & 10) is the only other D-I player to hit those marks since at least 1996-97.

▶ Happ was the nation's only player to lead his team in points, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals during conference play.

► Happ became just the 4th major conference player over the last 20 years to lead his team in all 5 categories during conference play. Also: Utah's Delon Wright (2014), St. John's D.J. Kennedy (2010) and Virginia Tech's Bryant Matthews (2003).

▶ With 1,081 points, Happ ranks 36th on Wisconsin's all-time scoring list. He is also tied for 10th on the school's career rebounding chart with 680.

He is one of just 6 players in school history to amass 1,000 points, 650 rebounds and 150 assists.

▶ With 3 double-doubles this season, Happ is now tied for 7th in Wisconsin history with 23 career double-doubles.

This marks the only regular-season meeting between UW and PSU.

The Badgers have won the last 9 meetings with the Nittany Lions, including an 82-55 win in Madison last season. Wisconsin has won 22 of the last 24 against PSU overall.

UW has won 5 straight in University Park, Pa., including a 66-60 win in 2016, the team's most recent visit.

► The Badgers' 5 straight wins at PSU equals their longest active road winning streak against a Big Ten opponent.

PROS OF THE NON-CON

- ▶ UW has won 50 of its last 62 (.806) regularseason, non-conference games dating back to Dec. of 2012. That includes a mark of 15-6 (.714) under head coach Greg Gard.
- ► Since 2001-02, UW owns a non-conference mark of 121-12 (.910) at the Kohl Center. In the Gard era, the Badgers have gone 12-1 at home in the non-con.
- ▶ Over the last 15 seasons, the Badgers have gone 22-20 (.524) in non-conference road games, including wins in 7 of its last 10 true road games.
- ▶ UW is 14-0 under Gard against unranked non-conference opponents. Since 2003-04, UW is 105-5 (.955) vs. unranked non-con opponents.

WHAT'S TRENDING WITH UW

▶ UW is 29-3 under Gard when shooting at least 45.0% from the field.

Additionally, the Badgers are 37-6 under Gard when keeping foes' FG percentage below 45.0%.

- ► Wisconsin is 3-0 this season and 34-6 under Gard when out-rebounding opponents.
- ▶ UW ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 12th in the NCAA with 10.4 turnovers per game (Mich 9.3).

Since 2001-02, Wisconsin has averaged 10.1 TOs per game, the nation's lowest mark. Temple is a distant 2nd over that stretch (10.6 TOs / game).

▶ Wisconsin is allowing 64.2 points per game this season, which ranks 5th in the Big Ten and 49th in the NCAA.

Last season the Badgers led the Big Ten and ranked 13th nationally allowing 62.4 ppg.

UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 11 of the past 15 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in 9 of the past 15 years.

► The Badgers committed an average of 16.3 fouls per game last season, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten and 30th-fewest in the NCAA. This year UW is averaging 16.1 fouls per game, a number that ranks 4th in the Big Ten and 35th overall.

UW opponents are averaging just 14.9 FTAs per game, the 32nd-lowest mark in the NCAA.

▶ UW went 23-1 last season when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining, continuing an impressive string of closing games. Under Greg Gard, UW is 41-2 when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining.

Dating back to February of 2011, UW is 163-7 (.959) when leading or tied with 5:00 left.

▶ UW has won 8 of its last 9 overtime games, with the only loss coming in an 84-83 buzzer-beater loss to Florida in the 2017 Sweet 16.

TRICE IS NICE

Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** made an immediate impact off the bench during his first year in Madison. Now the Huber Heights, Ohio, native is Wisconsin's starting point guard and resident sharp shooter.

- ▶ Playing at team-high 31.4 minutes per game, Trice ranks 3rd in scoring (10.3 ppg) and assists 2.0 apg. His 16-to-9 assist-to-turnover ratio (1.8) leads the team (min. 2.0 apg).
- ► Trice is shooting 31.4% from 3-point range on the year, going 11-for-35.

Last season, Trice led UW and ranked 9th in the Big Ten shooting 41.8% (38-91) from 3-point range.

Trice's 41.8% 3-point mark was the secondhighest 3FG percentage by a freshman in school history, trailing only Tim Locum's mark of 44.1% (41-93) in 1988.

► He was UW's top reserve in terms of points (5.6), assists (1.7) and minutes (18.3) per game.

The point guard also owned a 1.7 assist-to-turnover ratio, dishing 63 assists to 37 TOs.

WRECKING THE RANKED

- ► The Badgers are 0-4 against teams ranked in the AP top 25 this season, but that hasn't been trend with UW lately. Over the last 4 seasons, Wisconsin has gone 24-16 (.600) against the AP Top-25 over the last 4 seasons.
- ▶ Under Greg Gard, UW is 9-12 against ranked teams. Here are a look at Gard's "Big Wins":

In 14-plus seasons at Wisconsin, Ryan led the Badgers to a mark of 364-130 (.737) and five Big Ten championships and back-to-back Final Fours, including an appearance in the 2015 National Championship Game.

- ▶ Wisconsin participated in a total of 8 exhibition games prior to the 2017-18 season, including a 5-game foreign tour of New Zealand and Australia, a closed scrimmage with Missouri, and home contests with Northern Iowa and Div. 3 UW-Stout.
- ► In the 8 total games, UW shot 48.8% from the field, including 39.7% from 3-point range (75-183). UW was also 73.2% at the free throw line.
 - ▷ UW beat Missouri, 74-66, at Augustana College in Rock Island, Illinois. Ethan Happ led UW with 17 points and 8 rebounds, while Brad Davison (14), Khalil Iverson (12) and D'Mitrik Trice (11) also scored in double figures. The Badgers held Mizzou to 29.8% shooting, including 18.2% (4-22) from 3-point range.
 - D UW routed Northern Iowa, 69-38, at the Kohl Center in a game to benefit Team Rubicon. **Kobe King** was the only Badger to score in double figures with 15 points. Eight different players combined to hit 10 3FGs, going 10-24 (41.7%) as a team.

UNI shot just 32.6% overall and 22.2% from deep (4-18). The Badgers held the Panthers without a FG for over 14:00 during the second half.

> UW topped Div. 3 UW-Stout, 85-56, as 4 players scored in double figures: King 17, Davison 13, Iverson 11 and Andy Van Vliet 11.

- ► The Badgers bring back just 38.3% of the points scored a year ago and 39.4% of the minutes played.
- ▶ Wisconsin heads into the 2017-18 season needing to replace 4 starters off of last year's Sweet 16 qualifier. UW returns third-team AP All-American **Ethan Happ**, who was the nation's only player to lead his team in points (14.6), rebounds (8.6), assists (3.0), blocks (1.6) and steals (2.3) during conference play last season.
- ▶ The Badgers will surround Happ with a host of young talent, including sophomore point guard **D'Mitrik Trice** and junior forward **Khalil Iverson** among others. Trice averaged 18.3 minutes and 5.6 points per game as a freshman, shooting a team-high 41.8% from 3-point range. Iverson averaged 15.3 points per game off the bench a year ago, shooting over 50% from the field. 2016-17 LOOK BACK

- ► The Badgers finished last season with a mark of 27-10, tallying the 5th-highest single-season win total in school history.
- ▶ Wisconsin reached the NCAA tournament for the 19th-consecutive season in 2016-17, the 5th-longest streak in NCAA history.
- The Badgers advanced to their
 4th-consecutive Sweet 16 and the team's 6th
 trip in the last 7 years. UW is the only school to
 accomplish either feat. The Badgers have won 13
 NCAA tournament games over the last 4 years,
 the highest mark in all of college basketball.
- ► Greg Gard is just the 3rd coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first 2 years as a head coach, joining Mark Few (Gonzaga) and Steve Lavin (UCLA).
- ▶ With a Big Ten record of 12-6 and secondplace showing, the Badgers secured a top-4 conference finish for the 17th-consecutive season, the longest such streak in Big Ten history.
- ► The 2017 senior class of Vitto Brown, Nigel Hayes, Bronson Koenig and Zak Showalter equaled UW's highest 4-year win total with 115.
- ► Ethan Happ earned third-team AP All-America honors, becoming just the 6th Badger ever to be named to an All-America team. He was also first-team All-Big Ten and was named the AP's Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year.
- ▶ The Badgers tallied a total of 4 wins over teams in the AP top-25, including No. 1 Villanova in the second round of the NCAA tournament. The Badgers have now posted 5 wins over No. 1 or No. 2 seeds in the last 4 NCAA tournaments. Wisconsin owns a total of 4 wins over No. 1 seeds since 2000, the most of any team.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard will begin his third season as the head coach of the Badgers in 2017-18 on the heels of leading the team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

After initially taking over on an interim basis, Gard was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. In two seasons, he has piloted the Badgers to a record of 42-18 (.700), owning the second-best 60-game start in program history.

In his first two seasons with the head coaching title, Gard has maintained a level of success that has become synonymous with Wisconsin Basketball. In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

The transition to Gard's leadership began with a 1-4 start to the Big Ten Conference, but Wisconsin proceeded on a run that saw it win 11 of its final 13 regular-season games.

A 77-76 victory over fourth-ranked Michigan State was the beginning of a seven-game win streak that also featured a win over No. 19 Indiana and an impressive road triumph at No. 2 Maryland. The Badgers later added another road win over No. 8 Iowa on Feb. 24.

UW finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 16 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has never seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings, amassing a combined mark of 196-80 (.710) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes earned the nod in 2016 and



third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in 2017.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. During that time, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 12 winningest seasons at Wisconsin. He has helped pilot the Badgers to four Big Ten regular season titles and three Big Ten tournament championships, most recently winning both crowns in 2015. UW has made the NCAA tournament in each of Gard's first 14 seasons, advancing to seven Sweet 16s, three Elite Eights and two Final Fours.

During Gard's first two seasons as head coach, Wisconsin has placed 11 players on the Academic All-Big Ten list. Over his 16 years in Madison, UW has boasted a total of 59 Academic All-Big Ten honors, trailing only Purdue and Northwestern over that span.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. He also served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School

- ▶ Over the last 15 seasons, 181 of the Badgers' 241 home wins have come by at least 10 points (75.1 percent).
- ▶ Wisconsin has trailed at halftime in only 52 of 272 home games since the 2001-02 season. UW has come back to win 32 of those 52 games (61.5 percent).
- ▶ In 2016-17, the Badgers led the Big Ten and ranked 6th nationally in attendance, selling out every game (17,287 per game). UW has led the Big Ten in attendance in 11 of the last 15 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 17 years.
- ► This season, the Badgers sold out the 2,100-person Grateful Red (3rd-largest student section in the Big Ten) in under 15 minutes.
- ▶ Including the most recent game vs. Ohio State, Wisconsin has sold out the last 62 consecutive games at the Kohl Center dating back to Jan. of 2014.
