UW HEADS TO TEMPLE LOOKING TO SWEEP PA TRIP

- Just 2 days after a 64-63 win at Penn State, the Badgers will take on Temple in Philadelphia on Dec. 6. Tip-off is at 6 p.m. (CT) on ESPN.
- Up next, UW hosts rival Marquette on Dec. 9 at the Kohl Center.

NOTES TO KNOW ABOUT WISCONSIN

- TOUGHEST STRETCH:** Wisconsin has played arguably the toughest schedule in the country so far. The Badgers are 1 of 2 teams in the country that has played 4 ranked teams already this season (more on page 3).
- GARD IN CONTROL:** With a record of 46-23 (.667), Greg Gard owns the third-highest win percentage in school history (min. 60 games) behind Hall of Famers Bo Ryan (.737) and Walter Meanwell (.712). He has gone 25-13 (.658) in Big Ten play (more on page 9).
- HOME ON THE ROAD:** Wisconsin is 59-27 (.686) away from home over the last 4 seasons. That figure ranks 5th in the NCAA for most wins away from home. Under Greg Gard, the Badgers are 11-10 in true road games and 20-17 away from home overall (more on page 7).
- THISCLOSE:** The Badgers are 0-4 against the AP top 25, but have come close to winning several. In three of them, UW was tied or within 2 points with 2:00 remaining.
- BIG TEN BEASTS:** Wisconsin has boasted a winning conference record and finished among the top 4 in each of the last 17 seasons, owning the longest run of continued success of any team in the 110-year history of Big Ten basketball (more on page 7).
- HAPP HAVING HIS WAY:** All-American **Ethan Happ** is off to an impressive start. He is the only major conference player averaging at least 15.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg and the Big Ten's only player leading his team in points, rebounds and assists (more on page 4).
- YOUTH MOVEMENT:** For the first time in 20 years, UW is relying heavily on freshmen. The Badgers freshman foursome of **Brad Davison**, **Aleem Ford**, **Kobe King** and **Nate Reuvers** is accounting for 25.5 ppg and all 4 have had a game scoring in double figures this season, including 5 such games by Davison (more on page 3).
- WHO'S GONE:** UW graduated 5 seniors off last year's team who accumulated 4,802 career points and 350 combined starts. The Badgers bring back just 38.3% of the points scored a year ago.
- WHO'S BACK:** UW returns just 1 starter from last season in junior **Ethan Happ**. Sophomore guard **D'Mitrik Trice** is the only other player on the roster that had started a game (2).



All-American **Ethan Happ** is the only major conference player averaging 15.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.

LAST TIME OUT**WISCONSIN 64, PENN STATE 63**

Dec. 4, 2017 | Bryce-Jordan Center, Univ. Park, Pa.

- ▶ Wisconsin posted its first Big Ten win of the season, 64-63, at Penn State on Monday night.
- ▶ The Badgers built a 17-point lead during the second half before holding off a furious Nittany Lion rally. Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** went 4-for-4 at the FT line in the final 34 seconds, but PSU had a shot to win the game when Tony Carr missed a 3-point with 0:02 remaining.
- ▶ UW held PSU to a season-low 35.7% shooting and season-worst 2-for-14 on 3FGs. The Badgers meanwhile finished 44.2% from the field and 5-for-11 (45.5%) from deep.
- ▶ Junior **Khalil Iverson** led UW with 16 points (14 in the first half) to go with 5 rebounds, 2 blocks and 2 steals. Those 16 points are one shy of his career-high 17 (vs. Yale).
- ▶ Wisconsin's bench out-scored PSU, 25-1, getting a career-high 11 points and 4 rebounds from freshman **Nate Reuvers**. Fellow freshman **Kobe King** also chipped in 8 points off the bench, going 2-2 from 3-point range.
- ▶ Junior **Ethan Happ** finished with 9 points, a game-high 10 boards (5 offensive) and 3 assists.

BADGERS IN BIG TEN OPENERS

- ▶ Including the win at Penn State (Dec. 4), UW has won 12 of its last 14 road Big Ten openers dating back to 2005. The only losses during that stretch came in a 69-61 defeat at Illinois in 2011 and a 59-58 loss at Indiana in 2016.
- ▶ The Badgers dropped a rare Big Ten opener on Saturday vs. Ohio State. Even with the loss, UW has won 13 of its last 15 Big Ten openers dating back to 2003-04.
- ▶ The Badgers played their earliest Big Ten games in school history. Wisconsin's earliest Big Ten opener prior to this season was a 26-21 win over Michigan State on Dec. 6, 1936.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH

Head coach Greg Gard has said on several occasions that strength of schedule won't be an issue for this year's Badgers. Judging by the early portion of the season, he appears to be right.

- ▶ In facing No. 15 Xavier, No. 22 Baylor and No. 23 UCLA, Wisconsin faced 3-straight ranked non-conference opponents for the first time in school history. Add in No. 18 Virginia and the Badgers are one of just 2 teams in the nation who have faced 4 ranked opponents already this season (Creighton is the other).
- ▶ Based on the KenPom ratings, UW's non-conference schedule includes 6 games against teams ranked in the top 60: #4 UVA, #16 Xavier, #25 Baylor, #46 Temple, #43 UCLA and #63 Marquette. Only 2 of those games are at home. Add in #59 Ohio State and #41 Penn State and the Badgers will play 8 teams in the top-70 before New Years.
- ▶ In total, UW's 2017-18 schedule features 10 games against teams in the AP preseason poll.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT

For the first time in 20 years, the Badgers are relying heavily on their freshman class – a four-man group that includes **Brad Davison**, **Aleem Ford** and **Kobe King** and **Nate Reuvers**.

- ▶ UW is starting 2 freshmen (**Davison** and **Ford**) for the first time in almost 20 years. The last time the Badgers starting lineup featured multiple freshmen was the final game of the 1997-98 season when Mike Kelley, Andy Kowske and Maurice Linton started in a 66-61 loss to Illinois.
- ▶ Wisconsin's freshman foursome of **Davison**, **Ford**, **King** and **Reuvers** have combined to average 25.5 ppg. All 4 have had a game scoring in double figures this season, including 5 such games by Davison.
- ▶ **Davison** earned Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Week (Nov. 27) after averaging 15.0 ppg and 2.0 spg in games against Baylor, UCLA and Milwaukee. Davison went 11-for-19 (57.9%) from 3-point range in those 3 games.
- ▶ **Davison** increased his scoring output in each of UW's first 6 games, going from 5 to 8 to 12 to 13 to 14 to a career-high 19 against Milwaukee.

On the year, Davison is 2nd on the team and 4th among Big Ten freshmen averaging 10.2 ppg.

He is also 2nd in the Big Ten averaging 2.1 steals per game. Among freshman nationally, Davison's 19 steals ranks 3rd behind Duke's Trevon Duval and Kentucky's Shai Gilgeous-Alexander.

Davison is shooting a team-high 42.9% (18-42) from 3-point range. Among freshman, that figure is tops in the Big Ten and 22nd in the nation.

He is averaging 2.0 3FGs per game, which leads all Big Ten freshmen and is tied for 14th in the league.

Davison is also 2nd on the Badgers in FTs and FTAs, going 20-for-25 (.800) at the charity stripe.

- ▶ **Ford** was rewarded with a starting spot after scoring a career-high 10 points (2-4 3FGs) vs. Baylor. He also tallied career highs with 7 rebounds and 5 assists vs. Milwaukee.
- ▶ On the year he is averaging 4.4 ppg and 2.7 rpg, going 8-for-23 (34.8%) from 3-point range.

- ▶ **King** has increased his production lately. Over the last 5 games, King is averaging 7.4 ppg and has gone 7-for-12 from 3-point range.
- ▶ Overall, King is averaging 5.6 ppg, including a career-high 10 points (2-5 3FGs) vs. Ohio State on Dec. 2. King has gone 7-for-18 (38.9%) from 3-point range on the season.

- ▶ **Reuvers** sat out the first 5 games of the season while contemplating a redshirt season. However, he made his debut in Game 6 vs. Milwaukee, posting 6 rebounds and 2 assists.
- ▶ Reuvers has scored in double-figures in each of the last 2 games, finishing with 10 points on 4-for-4 shooting (2-2 3FGs) against Ohio State and then 11 points with 4 rebounds at PSU.
- ▶ On the season, he is averaging 5.3 points (3-for-7 3FGs) and 3.5 rebounds per game.

HAPP HYPE

THE GAME'S BEST ALL-AROUND PLAYER

"Happ was so good a season ago that he entered Big Ten player of the year conversations even though Purdue's Caleb Swanigan was destroying everything that stood in his path on a nightly basis. He was the Adam Banks to Bronson Koenig and Nigel Hayes's Charlie Conway. With Koenig and Hayes gone now, though, Happ gets to become Adam Banks and Charlie Conway."

HAPP MAKING HISTORY

Last season, junior **Ethan Happ** established himself as one of the best players in college basketball. This season, he's looking like one of the best players of the last 20 years.

► Happ is the only major conference player averaging at least 15.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.

In fact, over the last 20 years (since 1997-98) only 3 Big Ten players have averaged those marks for an entire season and all 3 were Big Ten Player of the Year and consensus All-Americans: Ohio State's Evan Turner (2010), Michigan State's Draymond Green (2012) and Purdue's Caleb Swanigan (2017).

► Happ leads the Badgers in points (15.4), rebounds (8.9), assists (3.0) and blocks (0.8) per game. He is second in steals per game (1.3).

Happ is the only player in the Big Ten leading his team in points, rebounds and assists.

► Last season, Happ was the only player in the NCAA to average at least 13.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg, 2.5 apg, 1.5 spg and 1.0 bpg.

In fact, Happ was the first major conference player in over 20 years to reach those marks for an entire season. Vermont's Marqus Blakely (2009 & 10) is the only other D-I player to hit those marks since at least 1996-97.

► Happ was the nation's only player to lead his team in points, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals during conference play.

► Happ became just the 4th major conference player over the last 20 years to lead his team in all 5 categories during conference play. Also: Utah's Delon Wright (2014), St. John's D.J. Kennedy (2010) and Virginia Tech's Bryant Matthews (2003).

► With 1,090 points, Happ ranks 35th on Wisconsin's all-time scoring list. He is also 10th on the school's career rebounding chart with 690.

He is one of just 6 players in school history to amass 1,000 points, 650 rebounds and 150 assists.

► With 3 double-doubles this season, Happ is now tied for 7th in Wisconsin history with 23 career double-doubles.

ALL-TIME VS. TEMPLE

► Wednesday's game will mark the 11th all-time meeting between Wisconsin and Temple with the Badgers owning a 7-3 advantage in the series overall.

► Wisconsin is 4-1 all-time against Temple in Philadelphia, including wins in each of the last 4 visits. Most recently, the Badgers captured an 80-67 win at the Liacouras Center in 2003.

► The Badgers have won each of the last 2 meetings, including a 76-60 win in Madison two years ago (12/5/15). That game was the 4th-to-last game in former head coach Bo Ryan's career at Wisconsin.

► Ryan is a native of Chester, Pa., which is located approximately 20 miles south of the Temple campus.

► A total of 4 current Badgers played in the most recent Wisconsin-Temple match-up in 2015. Ethan Happ tallied 9p, 4r and 3a. Charles Thomas finished with 9p and 6r. Alex Illikainen scored 6p while Khalil Iverson had 1p and 4r.

► UW and Temple met for 8 consecutive seasons from 1995-2003, where the visiting team posted a mark of 6-2. Three of the 10 all-time meetings have gone to overtime, including a double-OT thriller in 2003 in Madison. In that game, Temple's Lynn Greer scored a Kohl Center-record 47 points.

► UW has made several trips to Philadelphia over the last 20 years, including a pair of NCAA tournament appearances in the City of Brotherly Love.

In 2016, the Badgers lost to Notre Dame, 61-56, in the Sweet 16 at the Wells Fargo Center. Wisconsin also lost to Arizona in the first round of the 2006 NCAA Tournament.

In addition to Wisconsin's 4 wins at Temple since 1996, the Badgers have also registered a 64-53 win over Penn at the Palestra in 2003.

LAST TIME VS. TEMPLE

UW 76, TEM 60 - Dec. 5, 2015 - Kohl Center, Madison, Wis.

► UW seized control with an early 19-2 run and cruised to a 76-60 win over Temple at the Kohl Center. The Badgers shot 45.8% from the field, including a mark of 54.5% (6-11) from deep. UW also held Temple to a then-season-low points and its 2nd-lowest shooting of the year (37.9%).

► Nigel Hayes tallied a double-double with a game-high 18 points and 12 rebounds.

Hayes also defended Temple's leading scorer Quenton Decosey, holding him to a season-low 3 points on 1-for-6 shooting.

► Bronson Koenig tallied 17 points (3-5 3FGs) and Zak Showalter chipped in 11 points.

► **Charlie Thomas** and **Alex Illikainen** accounted for 12 straight points during the first half, they finished with 9 and 6 points, respectively.

► The Badgers turned the ball over just 7 times and owned a 38-29 edge on the glass. UW also out-scored Temple, 30-18, in the paint.

PROS OF THE NON-CON

► UW has won 50 of its last 62 (.806) regular-season, non-conference games dating back to Dec. of 2012. That includes a mark of 15-6 (.714) under head coach Greg Gard.

► Since 2001-02, UW owns a non-conference mark of 121-12 (.910) at the Kohl Center. In the Gard era, the Badgers have gone 12-1 at home in the non-con.

► Over the last 15 seasons, the Badgers have gone 22-20 (.524) in non-conference road games, including wins in 7 of its last 10 true road games.

► UW is 14-0 under Gard against unranked non-conference opponents. Since 2003-04, UW is 105-5 (.955) vs. unranked non-con opponents.

WHAT'S TRENDING WITH UW

► UW is 29-3 under Gard when shooting at least 45.0% from the field.

Additionally, the Badgers are 38-6 under Gard when keeping foes' FG percentage below 45.0%.

► Wisconsin is 4-0 this season and 35-6 under Gard when out-rebounding opponents.

► UW ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 11th in the NCAA with 10.3 turnovers per game (Mich 9.2).

Since 2001-02, Wisconsin has averaged 10.1 TOs per game, the nation's lowest mark. Temple is a distant 2nd over that stretch (10.6 TOs / game).

► Wisconsin is allowing 64.1 points per game this season, which ranks 4th in the Big Ten and 44th in the NCAA.

Last season the Badgers led the Big Ten and ranked 13th nationally allowing 62.4 ppg.

UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 11 of the past 15 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in 9 of the past 15 years.

► The Badgers committed an average of 16.3 fouls per game last season, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten and 30th-fewest in the NCAA. This year UW is averaging 16.9 fouls per game, a number that ranks 5th in the Big Ten.

UW opponents are averaging just 16.0 FTAs per game.

► UW went 23-1 last season when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining, continuing an impressive string of closing games. Under Greg Gard, UW is 42-2 when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining.

Dating back to February of 2011, UW is 163-7 (.959) when leading or tied with 5:00 left.

► UW has won 8 of its last 9 overtime games, with the only loss coming in an 84-83 buzzer-beater loss to Florida in the 2017 Sweet 16.

TRICE IS NICE

Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** made an immediate impact off the bench during his first year in Madison. Now the Huber Heights, Ohio, native is Wisconsin's starting point guard and resident sharp shooter.

► Playing at team-high 31.7 minutes per game, Trice ranks 3rd in scoring (10.1 ppg) and 2nd in assists (2.1 apg). His 19-to-11 assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7) leads the team (min. 2.0 apg).

► Trice is shooting just 29.7% from 3-point range on the year, going 11-for-37.

However, last season Trice led UW and ranked 9th in the Big Ten shooting 41.8% (38-91) from 3-point range.

Trice's 41.8% 3-point mark was the second-highest 3FG percentage by a freshman in school history, trailing only Tim Locum's mark of 44.1% (41-93) in 1988.

► He was UW's top reserve in terms of points (5.6), assists (1.7) and minutes (18.3) per game.

The point guard also owned a 1.7 assist-to-turnover ratio, dishing 63 assists to 37 TOs.

WRECKING THE RANKED

► The Badgers are 0-4 against teams ranked in the AP top 25 this season, but that hasn't been trend with UW lately. Over the last 4 seasons, Wisconsin has gone 24-16 (.600) against the AP Top-25 over the last 4 seasons.

► Under Greg Gard, UW is 9-12 against ranked teams. Here are a look at Gard's "Big Wins":

► The NCB HOF Class of 2017 also included Tim Duncan, Cleo Hill, Scott May, Rick Mount, Paul Silas, John Stockton and Jay Williams.

► Ryan spent 32 seasons as a collegiate head coach, finishing 26th on the NCAA's all-time wins list with a record of 747-233 (.762)

In 14-plus seasons at Wisconsin, Ryan led the Badgers to a mark of 364-130 (.737) and five Big Ten championships and back-to-back Final Fours, including an appearance in the 2015 National Championship Game.

► The Badgers bring back just 38.3% of the points scored a year ago and 39.4% of the minutes played.

► Wisconsin heads into the 2017-18 season needing to replace 4 starters off of last year's Sweet 16 qualifier. UW returns third-team AP All-American **Ethan Happ**, who was the nation's only player to lead his team in points (14.6), rebounds (8.6), assists (3.0), blocks (1.6) and steals (2.3) during conference play last season.

► The Badgers will surround Happ with a host of young talent, including sophomore point guard **D'Mitrik Trice** and junior forward **Khalil Iverson** among others. Trice averaged 18.3 minutes and 5.6 points per game as a freshman, shooting a team-high 41.8% from 3-point range. Iverson averaged 15.3 points per game off the bench a year ago, shooting over 50% from the field. UW's rotation should also feature returning juniors **Alex Illikainen**, **Charles Thomas, IV** and **Andy Van Vliet**, as well as sophomore **Brevin Pritzl**.

► Wisconsin welcomes 4 scholarship freshmen to the roster in 2017-18: guard **Brad Davison**, forward **Aleem Ford** (redshirted in 2016-17), guard **Kobe King** and forward **Nate Reuvers**.

2016-17 LOOK BACK

Record: 27-10 | **Big Ten:** 12-6 (T-2nd)

► The Badgers finished last season with a mark of 27-10, tallying the 5th-highest single-season win total in school history.

► Wisconsin reached the NCAA tournament for the 19th-consecutive season in 2016-17, the 5th-longest streak in NCAA history.

► The Badgers advanced to their 4th-consecutive Sweet 16 and the team's 6th trip in the last 7 years. UW is the only school to accomplish either feat. The Badgers have won 13 NCAA tournament games over the last 4 years, the highest mark in all of college basketball.

► Greg Gard is just the 3rd coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first 2 years as a head coach, joining Mark Few (Gonzaga) and Steve Lavin (UCLA).

► With a Big Ten record of 12-6 and second-place showing, the Badgers secured a top-4 conference finish for the 17th-consecutive season, the longest such streak in Big Ten history.

► The 2017 senior class of Vitto Brown, Nigel Hayes, Bronson Koenig and Zak Showalter equaled UW's highest 4-year win total with 115.

► Ethan Happ earned third-team AP All-America honors, becoming just the 6th Badger ever to be named to an All-America team. He was also first-team All-Big Ten and was named the AP's Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year.

► The Badgers tallied a total of 4 wins over teams in the AP top-25, including No. 1 Villanova in the second round of the NCAA tournament. The Badgers have now posted 5 wins over No. 1 or No. 2 seeds in the last 4 NCAA tournaments. Wisconsin owns a total of 4 wins over No. 1 seeds since 2000, the most of any team.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard will begin his third season as the head coach of the Badgers in 2017-18 on the heels of leading the team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

After initially taking over on an interim basis, Gard was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. In two seasons, he has piloted the Badgers to a record of 42-18 (.700), owning the second-best 60-game start in program history.

In his first two seasons with the head coaching title, Gard has maintained a level of success that has become synonymous with Wisconsin Basketball. In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

The transition to Gard's leadership began with a 1-4 start to the Big Ten Conference, but Wisconsin proceeded on a run that saw it win 11 of its final 13 regular-season games.

A 77-76 victory over fourth-ranked Michigan State was the beginning of a seven-game win streak that also featured a win over No. 19 Indiana and an impressive road triumph at No. 2 Maryland. The Badgers later added another road win over No. 8 Iowa on Feb. 24.

UW finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 16 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has never seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings, amassing a combined mark of 196-80 (.710) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes earned the nod in 2016 and



third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in 2017.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. During that time, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 12 winningest seasons at Wisconsin. He has helped pilot the Badgers to four Big Ten regular season titles and three Big Ten tournament championships, most recently winning both crowns in 2015. UW has made the NCAA tournament in each of Gard's first 14 seasons, advancing to seven Sweet 16s, three Elite Eights and two Final Fours.

During Gard's first two seasons as head coach, Wisconsin has placed 11 players on the Academic All-Big Ten list. Over his 16 years in Madison, UW has boasted a total of 59 Academic All-Big Ten honors, trailing only Purdue and Northwestern over that span.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. He also served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School

► Bo Ryan's teams posted a 172-68 (.717) Big Ten record, the best mark in the conference over his 14 seasons. Michigan St. was second at 161-79 (.671) and Ohio St. was third at 156-84 (.650).

► This season, Wisconsin finished 2nd in the Big Ten with a record of 12-6. The Badgers have notched double-digit conference wins in 15 of the last 16 years and have never finished lower than 4th place in the Big Ten standings over that span.

► Over the last 15 seasons, 181 of the Badgers' 241 home wins have come by at least 10 points (75.1 percent).

► Wisconsin has trailed at halftime in only 52 of 272 home games since the 2001-02 season. UW has come back to win 32 of those 52 games (61.5 percent).

► In 2016-17, the Badgers led the Big Ten and ranked 6th nationally in attendance, selling out every game (17,287 per game). UW has led the Big Ten in attendance in 11 of the last 15 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 17 years.

► This season, the Badgers sold out the 2,100-person Grateful Red (3rd-largest student section in the Big Ten) in under 15 minutes.

► Including the most recent game vs. Ohio State, Wisconsin has sold out the last 62 consecutive games at the Kohl Center dating back to Jan. of 2014.

► UW had a streak of 143 consecutive sellouts at the Kohl Center, selling out every game from 2003 until midway through the 2011-12 season.
