UW-MU RIVALRY CELEBRATES 100-YEAR ANNIVERSARY

(12/10/16 - Milwaukee, Wis.)

- Separated by just 75 miles, Wisconsin and Marquette will meet at the Kohl Center on Saturday to celebrate the 100-year anniversary a rivalry that began on Dec. 19, 1917. Tip-off is set for 11 a.m. (CT) on FS1.
- Up next, UW hosts Western Kentucky on Dec. 13 at 7 p.m. (CT) on FS1.

NOTES TO KNOW ABOUT WISCONSIN

- **TOUGHEST STRETCH:** Wisconsin has faced arguably the toughest schedule in the country so far. Having played 7 games against the KenPom top-70 (5 of which were away), the Badgers are also 1 of 2 teams in the country that has played 4 ranked teams already this season (more on page 3).
- BEEN HERE BEFORE: Wisconsin has a below .500 record through 10 games for the first time since 2001-02, the first year under Bo Ryan and Greg Gard. That team was 4-6 and rallied to finished 19-13, winning a share of the Big Ten championship and reaching the NCAA tournament.



All-American Ethan Happ is the only major conference player averaging 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.

- **GARD IN CONTROL:** With a record of 46-24 (.657), Greg Gard owns the third-highest win percentage in school history (min. 60 games) behind Hall of Famers Bo Ryan (.737) and Walter Meanwell (.712). He has gone 25-13 (.658) in Big Ten play (more on page 9).
- **CENTURY RIVALS:** The UW-Marquette rivalry began under controversy in 1917 and has developed into one of the best in all of college basketball. UW has won 2 of the last 3 games, including a 93-84 win last season the Badgers' highest scoring output in the series (more on page 5).
- GOOD TO BE HOME: Having already played 5 games away from home, the Badgers are glad to be back at the Kohl Center where they have won 86.6% of their games all-time. (more page 11).
- **THISCLOSE:** Wisconsin has lost 6 games this season, but has been within minutes of winning 4 of them. In each of those 4 setbacks, UW was tied or within 2 points with 2:00 remaining.
- **BIG TEN BEASTS:** UW has boasted a winning conference record in each of the last 17 seasons, the longest run of success of any team in the 110-year history of Big Ten hoops (more on page 7).
- HAPP HAVING HIS WAY: All-American Ethan Happ is off to an impressive start. He is the only major conference player averaging at least 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg and the Big Ten's only player leading his team in points, rebounds and assists (more on page 4).
- YOUTH MOVEMENT: For the first time in 20 years, UW is relying heavily on freshmen. The Badgers freshman foursome of Brad Davison, Aleem Ford, Kobe King and Nate Reuvers is accounting for 24.6 ppg and all 4 have had a game scoring in double figures this season, including 5 such games by Davison (more on page 3).

- ▶ In a game that featured 8 ties and 16 lead changes, Wisconsin couldn't close out a road win at Temple Wednesday evening.
- ► The Badgers led by 3 with 3:00 remaining, but the Owls out-scored UW, 7-0, down the stretch. Wisconsin shot just 5-for-20 (25.0%) from 3-point range and only 4-for-6 from the free throw line.
- ▶ Junior **Ethan Happ** was the only Badger in double figures, equaling a season-high with 23 points, 6 rebounds and 3 assists.
- ▶ Junior **Khalil Iverson** finished with 9 points while freshmen **Aleem Ford** and **Brad Davison** chipped in 8 points each.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH

Head coach Greg Gard has said on several occasions that strength of schedule won't be an issue for this year's Badgers. Judging by the early portion of the season, he appears to be right.

- According to KenPom's adjusted efficiency rankings, the Badgers have faced the 7th-toughest schedule. The NCAA's RPI lists Wisconsin 10th in strength of schedule.
- ▶ In facing No. 15 Xavier, No. 22 Baylor and No. 23 UCLA, Wisconsin faced 3-straight ranked non-conference opponents for the first time in school history. Add in No. 18 Virginia and the Badgers are one of just 2 teams in the nation who have faced 4 ranked opponents already this season (Creighton is the other).
- ▶ Based on the KenPom ratings, UW's nonconference schedule includes 6 games against teams ranked in the top 70: #4 UVA, #13 Xavier, #24 Baylor, #42 Temple, #43 UCLA and #63 Marquette. Only 2 of those games are at home.

Add in #58 Ohio State and #41 Penn State and the Badgers will play 8 teams in the top-70 before New Years.

► UW has lost 6 games to teams with a combined record of 41-10 (.804).

Overall, the Badgers' 10 opponents have a combined record of 61-29 (.678).

► In total, UW's 2017-18 schedule features 10 games against teams in the AP preseason poll.

BADGERS IN BIG TEN OPENERS

- ▶ Including the win at Penn State (Dec. 4), UW has won 12 of its last 14 <u>road</u> Big Ten openers dating back to 2005. The only losses during that stretch came in a 69-61 defeat at Illinois in 2011 and a 59-58 loss at Indiana in 2016.
- ▶ The Badgers dropped a rare Big Ten opener on Saturday vs. Ohio State. Even with the loss, UW has won 13 of its last 15 Big Ten openers dating back to 2003-04.
- ► The Badgers played their earliest Big Ten games in school history. Wisconsin's earliest Big Ten opener prior to this season was a 26-21 win over Michigan State on Dec. 6, 1936.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT

For the first time in 20 years, the Badgers are relying heavily on their freshman class – a fourman group that includes **Brad Davison**, **Aleem Ford** and **Kobe King** and **Nate Reuvers**.

- ▶ UW is starting 2 freshmen (**Davison** and **Ford**) for the first time in almost 20 years. The last time the Badgers starting lineup featured multiple freshmen was the final game of the 1997-98 season when Mike Kelley, Andy Kowske and Maurice Linton started in a 66-61 loss to Illinois
- ▶ Wisconsin's freshman foursome of **Davison**, **Ford**, **King** and **Reuvers** have combined to average 24.6 ppg. All 4 have had a game scoring in double figures this season, including 5 such games by Davison.
- ▶ **Davison** earned Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Week (Nov. 27) after averaging 15.0 ppg and 2.0 spg in games against Baylor, UCLA and Milwaukee. Davison went 11-for-19 (57.9%) from 3-point range in those 3 games.
- ▶ **Davison** is 2nd on the team and 5th among B1G freshmen averaging 10.0 ppg. He scored a career-high 19 points vs. Milwaukee (11/24).

Over the last 20 years (since 1999), only 3 Badgers have averaged double figures in their freshman season: Devin Harris (12.3 ppg in 2002), Alando Tucker (12.0 ppg in 2003) and Ethan Happ (12.4 ppg in 2016).

► He is also 3rd in the Big Ten averaging 1.9 steals per game. Among freshman nationally, Davison's 19 steals ranks 3rd behind Duke's Trevon Duval and Kentucky's Shai Gilgeous-Alexander.

Davison is shooting a team-high 44.4% (20-45) from 3-point range. Among freshman, that figure is tops in the Big Ten and 19th in the nation.

He is averaging 2.0 3FGs per game, which leads all Big Ten freshmen and is tied for 14th in the league.

Davison is also 2nd on the Badgers in FTs and FTAs, going 20-for-25 (.800) at the line.

► Ford was rewarded with a starting spot after scoring a career-high 10 points (2-4 3FGs) vs. Baylor. He also tallied career highs with 7 rebounds and 5 assists vs. Milwaukee.

On the year he is averaging 4.8 ppg and 2.8 rpg, going 10-for-28 (35.7%) from 3-point range.

► King has increased his production lately. Over the last 6 games, King is averaging 6.5 ppg and has gone 7-for-15 (46.7%) from 3-point range over that stretch.

Overall, King is averaging 5.2 ppg, including a career-high 10 points (2-5 3FGs) vs. Ohio State on Dec. 2. King has gone 7-for-21 (33.3%) from 3-point range on the season.

▶ Reuvers sat out the first 5 games of the season while contemplating a redshirt season. However, he made his debut in Game 6 vs. Milwaukee, posting 6 rebounds and 2 assists.

Reuvers has scored in double-figures in each of UW's 2 Big Ten games, finishing with 10 points on 4-for-4 shooting (2-2 3FGs) against OSU and then 11 points with 4 rebounds at PSU.

On the season, he is averaging 5.3 points (3-for-7 3FGs) and 3.5 rebounds per game.

HAPP HYPE

THE GAME'S BEST ALL-AROUND PLAYER

"Happ was so good a season ago that he entered Big Ten player of the year conversations even though Purdue's Caleb Swanigan was destroying everything that stood in his path on a nightly basis. He was the Adam Banks to Bronson Koenig and Nigel Hayes's Charlie Conway. With Koenig and Hayes gone now, though, Happ gets to become Adam Banks and Charlie Conway."

HAPP MAKING HISTORY

Last season, junior **Ethan Happ** established himself as one of the best players in college basketball. This season, he's looking like one of the best players of the last 20 years.

► Happ is the only major conference player averaging at least 16.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.

In fact, over the last 20 years (since 1997-98) only 3 Big Ten players have averaged those marks for an entire season and all 3 were Big Ten Player of the Year and consensus All-Americans: Ohio State's Evan Turner (2010), Michigan State's Draymond Green (2012) and Purdue's Caleb Swanigan (2017).

▶ Happ leads the Badgers in points (16.2), rebounds (8.6), assists (3.0) and blocks (0.7) per game. He is second in steals per game (1.2).

Happ is the <u>only player in the Big Ten</u> leading his team in points, rebounds and assists.

► Last season, Happ was the only player in the NCAA to average at least 13.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg, 2.5 apg, 1.5 spg and 1.0 bpg.

In fact, Happ was the first major conference player in over 20 years to reach those marks for an entire season. Vermont's Marqus Blakely (2009 & 10) is the only other D-I player to hit those marks since at least 1996-97.

► Happ was the <u>nation's only player</u> to lead his team in points, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals during conference play.

▶ Happ became just the 4th major conference player over the last 20 years to lead his team in all 5 categories during conference play. Also: Utah's Delon Wright (2014), St. John's D.J. Kennedy (2010) and Virginia Tech's Bryant Matthews (2003).

▶ With 1,113 points, Happ ranks 35th on Wisconsin's all-time scoring list. He is also 10th on the school's career rebounding chart with 696.

He is one of just 6 players in school history to amass 1,000 points, 650 rebounds and 150 assists.

▶ With 3 double-doubles this season, Happ is now tied for 7th in Wisconsin history with 23 career double-doubles.

ALL-TIME VS. MARQUETTE

- ▶ Wisconsin and Marquette will celebrate the 100-year anniversary of one of the best rivalries in college basketball on Saturday. Separated by just 75 miles, the Badgers and Golden Eagles meet for the 124th time in a series that began on Dec. 19, 1917. UW and MU have played every year but one since the 1958-59 season (did not play in 1984-85).
- ▶ UW won the first-ever meeting in 1917, 15-14, on a controversial free throw from All-American William Chandler in the final seconds. MU protested that the corresponding foul had occurred after time expired. Ironically, Chandler would later serve as the head coach at Marquette from 1930-51.
- Overall, Wisconsin owns a 67-56 advantage in the series, making Marquette the Badgers' most played non-conference rival.

In games played in Madison, the Badgers are 38-17 all-time against the Golden Eagles.

- ▶ Wisconsin has won 2 of the last 3 vs. MU, including a 93-84 win in Milwaukee last season (details below). The road team has actually won 5 of the last 7 meetings.
- Five current Badgers have seen action against Marquette.

▶ Ethan Happ has scored in double figures in each of his 2 games vs. Marquette, finishing with 12 points and 7 rebounds in 2015 and tallying 11 points and 5 boards in 2016.

Khalil Iverson scored 16 points (one shy of his current career high) and grabbed 5 rebounds in UW's 2016 win over Marquette.

- Neither team being nationally ranked for this rivalry game is a rarity, as at least one of the two teams has been ranked in 13 of the last 17 meetings.
- ► The father of UW junior **T.J. Schlundt**, Terrell, played at MU (1980-83) and was team co-captain with Doc Rivers in 1983. UW sophomore transfer **Trevor Anderson** was prep teammates with MU's Sam Hauser at SPASH. UW freshman **Brad Davison** (Maple Grove, Minn.) is childhood friends and prep rivals with MU's Theo John (Minneapolis).
- ► Saturday vs. MU serves as game 2 of Wisconsin's 3-game in-state circuit. The Badgers already defeated Milwaukee, 71-49, and will host Green Bay on Dec. 23.

- **Bronson Koenig** led UW with 18 points (4-6 3FGs) and 6 assists. Nigel Hayes tallied 17 pts, 9 rebs and 4 assists.
- Khalil Iverson scored a then-career-high 16 points (5-6 FGs), including 12 in the second half, with 5 boards.
- Ethan Happ picked up 2 fouls in the first 101 seconds and sat the rest of the half. He posted all 11 points and 5 of his rebounds in 15 minutes of action in the second half.

WHAT'S TRENDING WITH UW

▶ UW is 29-3 under Gard when shooting at least 45.0% from the field.

Additionally, the Badgers are 38-6 under Gard when keeping foes' FG percentage below 45.0%.

- Wisconsin is 4-1 this season and 35-7 under Gard when out-rebounding opponents.
- UW ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 10th in the NCAA with 10.4 turnovers per game (Mich 9.2).

Since 2001-02, Wisconsin has averaged 10.1 TOs per game, the nation's lowest mark. Temple is a distant 2nd over that stretch (10.6 TOs / game).

Wisconsin is allowing 63.6 points per game this season, which ranks 4th in the Big Ten and 39th in the NCAA.

Last season the Badgers led the Big Ten and ranked 13th nationally allowing 62.4 ppg.

UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 11 of the past 15 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in 9 of the past 15 years.

- ▶ The Badgers are defending the 3-point line well, allowing opponents to hit just 31.8% from deep (3rd in the Big Ten). Last year, foes shot 37.6% from behind the arc.
- ► The Badgers committed an average of 16.3 fouls per game last season, which ranked 3rd in the Big Ten and 30th-fewest in the NCAA.

This year UW is averaging 16.6 fouls per game, a number that ranks 4th in the Big Ten. UW opponents are averaging 15.9 FTAs per game.

▶ Under Greg Gard, UW is an impressive 42-3 when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining. Last season, the Badgers went 23-1 when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining.

Dating back to February of 2011, UW is 163-7 (.959) when leading or tied with 5:00 left.

▶ UW has won 8 of its last 9 overtime games, with the only loss coming in an 84-83 buzzerbeater loss to Florida in the 2017 Sweet 16.

BO RYAN GETS CALL TO THE HALL

Former Wisconsin head coach Bo Rvan was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2017 on Nov. 19 in Kansas City, Missouri.

The NCB HOF Class of 2017 also included Tim Duncan, Cleo Hill, Scott May, Rick Mount, Paul Silas, John Stockton and Jay Williams.

▶ Ryan spent 32 seasons as a collegiate head coach, finishing 26th on the NCAA's alltime wins list with a record of 747-233 (.762)

In 14-plus seasons at Wisconsin, Ryan led the Badgers to a mark of 364-130 (.737) and five Big Ten championships and back-to-back Final Fours, including an appearance in the 2015 National Championship Game.

NON-CON SUCCESS

- ▶ UW has won 50 of its last 63 (.794) regularseason, non-conference games dating back to Dec. of 2012. That includes a mark of 15-7 (.682) under head coach Greg Gard.
- ► Since 2001-02, UW owns a non-conference mark of 121-12 (.910) at the Kohl Center. In the Gard era, the Badgers have gone 12-1 at home in the non-con
- ▶ Over the last 15 seasons, the Badgers have gone 22-21 (.512) in non-conference road games, including wins in 7 of its last 11 true road games.
- ▶ UW is 14-1 under Gard against unranked non-conference opponents, with the only loss coming at Temple (12/6/17). Since 2003-04, UW is 105-6 (.946) vs. unranked non-con opponents.

TRICE IS NICE

Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** made an immediate impact off the bench during his first year in Madison. Now the Huber Heights, Ohio, native is Wisconsin's starting point guard and resident sharp shooter.

- ▶ Playing at team-high 31.5 minutes per game, Trice ranks 3rd in scoring (9.4 ppg) and 2nd in assists (2.3 apg). His 23-to-13 assist-to-turnover ratio (1.8) leads the team (min. 2.0 apg).
- ► Trice is shooting just 30.0% from 3-point range on the year, going 12-for-40.

However, last season Trice led UW and ranked 9th in the Big Ten shooting 41.8% (38-91) from 3-point range.

Trice's 41.8% 3-point mark was the secondhighest 3FG percentage by a freshman in school history, trailing only Tim Locum's mark of 44.1% (41-93) in 1988.

► He was UW's top reserve in terms of points (5.6), assists (1.7) and minutes (18.3) per game.

The point guard also owned a 1.7 assist-to-turnover ratio, dishing 63 assists to 37 TOs.

WRECKING THE RANKED

- ► The Badgers are 0-4 against teams ranked in the AP top 25 this season, but that hasn't been trend with UW lately. Over the last 4 seasons, Wisconsin has gone 24-16 (.600) against the AP Top-25 over the last 4 seasons.
- ▶ Under Greg Gard, UW is 9-12 against ranked teams. Here are a look at Gard's "Big Wins":

- Among the major conferences, only Kansas (27, including this season) has a longer active streak of above .500 seasons.
- ▶ Wisconsin has also clinched no worse than a 4th-place finish in the Big Ten standings for the 17th-consecutive season. That is also the longest such streak in Big Ten history.
- ▶ The Badgers have now tallied at least 12 Big Ten wins in each of the last 7 seasons, the longest active streak in the conference (Purdue is 2nd at 3 straight seasons with 12+ wins).
- ▶ Since Gard entered the Big Ten head coaching ranks, Wisconsin is 25-13 (.658) in conference play tied for the 2nd-best mark in the Big Ten.

- ▶ Wisconsin is replacing 4 starters off of last year's Sweet 16 qualifier. UW returns third-team AP All-American **Ethan Happ**, who was the nation's only player to lead his team in points (14.6), rebounds (8.6), assists (3.0), blocks (1.6) and steals (2.3) during conference play last season.
- ► The Badgers will surround Happ with a host of young talent, including sophomore point guard **D'Mitrik Trice** and junior forward **Khalil Iverson** among others. Trice averaged 18.3 minutes and 5.6 points per game as a freshman, shooting a team-high 41.8% from 3-point range. Iverson averaged 15.3 points per game off the bench a year ago, shooting over 50% from the field.

 4th-consecutive Sweet 16 and the team's 6th
 trip in the last 7 years. UW is the only school to
 accomplish either feat. The Badgers have won 13
 NCAA tournament games over the last 4 years,
 the highest mark in all of college basketball.
- ► Greg Gard is just the 3rd coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first 2 years as a head coach, joining Mark Few (Gonzaga) and Steve Lavin (UCLA).
- ▶ With a Big Ten record of 12-6 and secondplace showing, the Badgers secured a top-4 conference finish for the 17th-consecutive season, the longest such streak in Big Ten history.
- ► The 2017 senior class of Vitto Brown, Nigel Hayes, Bronson Koenig and Zak Showalter equaled UW's highest 4-year win total with 115.
- ► Ethan Happ earned third-team AP All-America honors. He was also first-team All-Big Ten and was named the AP's Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard will begin his third season as the head coach of the Badgers in 2017-18 on the heels of leading the team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

After initially taking over on an interim basis, Gard was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. In two seasons, he has piloted the Badgers to a record of 42-18 (.700), owning the second-best 60-game start in program history.

In his first two seasons with the head coaching title, Gard has maintained a level of success that has become synonymous with Wisconsin Basketball. In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

The transition to Gard's leadership began with a 1-4 start to the Big Ten Conference, but Wisconsin proceeded on a run that saw it win 11 of its final 13 regular-season games.

A 77-76 victory over fourth-ranked Michigan State was the beginning of a seven-game win streak that also featured a win over No. 19 Indiana and an impressive road triumph at No. 2 Maryland. The Badgers later added another road win over No. 8 Iowa on Feb. 24.

UW finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 16 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has never seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings, amassing a combined mark of 196-80 (.710) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes earned the nod in 2016 and



third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in 2017.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. During that time, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 12 winningest seasons at Wisconsin. He has helped pilot the Badgers to four Big Ten regular season titles and three Big Ten tournament championships, most recently winning both crowns in 2015. UW has made the NCAA tournament in each of Gard's first 14 seasons, advancing to seven Sweet 16s, three Elite Eights and two Final Fours

During Gard's first two seasons as head coach, Wisconsin has placed 11 players on the Academic All-Big Ten list. Over his 16 years in Madison, UW has boasted a total of 59 Academic All-Big Ten honors, trailing only Purdue and Northwestern over that span.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. He also served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School

- ▶ Over the last 15 seasons, 181 of the Badgers' 241 home wins have come by at least 10 points (75.1 percent).
- ▶ Wisconsin has trailed at halftime in only 52 of 272 home games since the 2001-02 season. UW has come back to win 32 of those 52 games (61.5 percent).
- ▶ In 2016-17, the Badgers led the Big Ten and ranked 6th nationally in attendance, selling out every game (17,287 per game). UW has led the Big Ten in attendance in 11 of the last 15 seasons and has finished among the nation's top 7 in each of the last 17 years.
