OPENING TIP: Rutgers hosts the first of eight consecutive Big Ten opponents, when it welcomes Wisconsin. The Scarlet Knights and Badgers feature two of the nation's top scoring defenses, limiting opponents to 60.9 and 65.1 points-per-game, respectively. The teams also boast the two top scoring freshmen in the conference in Geo Baker (RU) and Brad Davison (UW), who share the league mark with 11.9 points-per-game. UW, which has received votes in multiple polls this season, is RU's first league foe that is not nationally-ranked. Wisconsin arrives riding a five-game winning streak, while Rutgers will be working to snap a 3-game skid.

Rutgers and Wisconsin have met seven times dating back to 1949, with the Badgers holding a 6-1 advantage. Last season, RU limited No. 15 UW to 33.3 percent shooting, including 12 percent from behind the arc, but suffered a hard-fought 61-54 overtime loss at Madison Square Garden. Rutgers is 1-1 at the RAC in the series, including a 67-62 win over the No. 4 Badgers on Jan. 11, 2015.

THE OPPONENT: Wisconsin, under the leadership of Greg Gard, has averaged 79.4 pointsper-game, while shooting 53%, during its five-game winning streak. The Badgers have played eight games against foes listed in the KenPom top-75.. All-American Ethan Happ is the only major conference player averaging at least 16.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists-per-game this season and is the Big Ten's only player leading his team in points, rebounds and assists.

- Rutgers is third nationally in offensive rebounding (15.31) and fifth in overall rebounding (43.50), while placing ninth in both scoring defense (60.9) and FG% defense (37.6). The Scarlet Knights are among the top three in the Big Ten in 12 stat categories.
- Senior Mike Williams scored 10 points vs. Stony Brook to become the 43rd RU men's basketball player to reach 1,000 career points. Junior Corey Sanders reached 1,000 against Fordham (Dec. 12). The last duo to achieve 1,000 points in the same season was Anthony Farmer and JR Inman in 2008-09. Williams will receive his 1,000-point ball pre-game on Friday.
- Geo Baker leads all Big Ten freshmen in scoring (11.9), assists (3.81) and minutes (32.2). Baker is seventh among all major conference freshmen in minutes-per-game.
- Deshawn Freeman is 5th in the Big Ten in steals (1.6) and sixth in both rebounding (8.2) and offensive rebounding (2.8).
- In the RU career record books, Corey Sanders ranks 16th in steals (117), 18th in assists (276) and 33rd in scoring (1,064). Mike Williams is 40th in scoring (1,027).
- On the heels of defeating No. 15 Seton Hall, Rutgers was honored as the NABC D-I National Team of the Week, Steve Pikiell was recognized as the HoopDirt.com National Coach of the Week, Geo Baker was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week, Corey Sanders was named Met Player of the Week and Deshawn Freeman was recognized as the Hero Sports D-I Hero of the Week on Dec. 18. The 2-0 week was capped before a capacity crowd of 8,318 at the RAC, the biggest in 15 years, and marked RU's first ranked victory since a 67-62 win over No. 4 Wisconsin on Jan. 11, 2015.
- Rutgers inked three during the early signing period, guards Montez Mathis and Ron Harper, Jr. and forward Shaq Carter (see bios).

THE WAY YOU LOOK TONIGHT

- With the 71-65 win over No. 15 Seton Hall on Dec. 16, Rutgers defeated a nationally-ranked team for the first time since topping No. 4 Wisconsin, 67-62, on Jan. 11, 2015. In each of Rutgers' last two wins over ranked opponents, they have erased double-digit point deficits 14 against Wisconsin and 13 against Seton Hall.
- Rutgers defeated a nationally-ranked Seton Hall squad for the second time, with the first coming in a 70-64 win at No. 22 SHU on Feb. 4, 2001.
- The game's attendance against Seton Hall was 8,318, signaling the largest crowd at the RAC since February 23, 2002 for a 66-60 Rutgers win over the Pirates. It was the first capacity crowd at the RAC since Ohio State on Feb. 8, 2015.
- Rutgers was honored as the NABC D-I National Team of the Week and Steve Pikiell was recognized as the HoopDirt.com National Coach of the Week on Dec. 18 after a 2-0 week consisting of wins over Fordham and No. 15 Seton Hall.
- Geo Baker was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Dec. 18. He averaged 14.5 points and four assists in wins over Fordham and No. 15 Seton Hall.
- Corey Sanders was named Met Player of the Week on Dec. 18. He averaged 17 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 steals and 2.5 assists in a 2-0 week consisting of wins over Fordham and No. 15 Seton Hall.
- Deshawn Freeman was recognized as the Hero Sports D-I Hero of the Week on Dec. 18 after a pair of double-doubles in wins over Fordham (14 points/10 rebounds) and No. 15 Seton Hall (12 points/16 rebounds).
- Rutgers has held three teams under 40 points. The last time RU limited three or more teams to under 40 points in a season was 1945-46 (Haverford, Franklin & Marshall, Panzer, Camp Kilmer).
- Geo Baker shot 7-of-11 versus FDU en route to his first career double-double (19 points, 11 assists), which was comprised of the most helpers by an RU player in a regulation game since Marquis Webb also had 11 versus Syracuse on Jan. 24, 2005.
- Rutgers limited No. 3 MSU to a season-low 62 points and 38.6 percent shooting, well below its season average of 50.2 percent.
- At No. 12 Minnesota, Rutgers had five players score in double-figures for the first time since six players at Miami on Nov. 13, 2016.
- Rutgers won by 14 vs. East Carolina with one player in double-figures. The last time RU won by double-digits with one player scoring in double-figures was a 69-55 win over Robert Morris on Nov. 11, 2008.
- Geo Baker's 29 points vs. Bryant marked the most for an RU freshman in a regulation game since Todd Billet had 31 vs. Notre Dame on Jan. 18. 2000. Baker's seven 3-pointers were the most for an RU rookie since Billet made eight triples that same game.
- RU's 16 blocks vs. Bryant were the most since issuing 18 vs. St. Peters Dec. 22, 2009.
- The 94-38 win over CCNY tied the largest margin of victory in program history, matching the 56-point (91-35) win over Trenton State on Dec. 9, 1936. The 60 rebounds were RU's most since 74 against Keene State on Dec. 7, 1992.

Rutgers, RWJBarnabas Health, state and community officials broke ground on the 295,000-square-foot, four-story sports facility and parking deck in a ceremony on Nov. 1, 2016.

THE LAST DANCE

Rutgers dropped an 82-51 decision at No. 13/12 Purdue Wednesday night. Facing their third ranked league foe in as many games, the Scarlet Knights forced 16 turnovers, but were undone by the Boilermakers' 10 three-pointers. Geo Baker and Mike Williams scored in double figures for RU, posting 11 and 10 points, respectively. Purdue shot 49 percent (26-of-53), while Rutgers made 33 percent (20-of-60) of its field goal attempts. The home squad also benefited from a 45-27 advantage on the glass.

COME FLY WITH ME

Rutgers began this season the same way it concluded the last, with an emphasis on community service and giving back. Rutgers and St. John's raised \$15,000 for American Red Cross Disaster Relief via a charity exhibition at the RAC on Nov. 5. The day prior (Nov. 4), the team hosted a clinic with the Special Olympics New Jersey unified basketball team that will represent the Garden State at the 2018 Special Olympics USA games. On Nov. 7, players volunteered at Elijah's Promise Soup Kitchen in New Brunswick as part of RLA's Annual Week of Service. The kitchen serves almost 300 meals a day and over 100,000 meals a year to individuals who would otherwise go hungry. On Sept. 24, the team participated in the Tunnel to Towers 5K Run. The event symbolizes Stephen Siller's final footsteps from the foot of the Battery Tunnel to the Twin Towers, and pays homage to the 343 FDNY firefighters, 71 law enforcement officers, and thousands of civilians who lost their lives on Sept. 11, 2001. Last season, men's basketball

had 100% team participation in Rutgers Leadership Academy community service initiatives. Joey Downes was one of nine student-athletes to travel to Honduras with the RLA in June to benefit Soles4Souls, a global not-for-profit dedicated to fighting poverty.

The 2018 Big Ten Men's Basketball Tournament will take place at Madison Square Garden, Feb. 28-March 4. The league held its annual media day from the World's Most Famous Arena on Oct. 19. Rutgers is 45-55 at the current (since Feb. 1968) Madison Square Garden. Overall at MSG since 1949, Rutgers is 51-57.

NIGHT AND DAY

- Last season, Rutgers more than doubled its overall win total and tripled its conference victory total from 2015-16.
- Achieved a plus-117 rank improvement in RPI, as well as major NCAA ranking improvements in rebound margin (+299), scoring defense (+272), three point FG defense (+247), offensive rebounds (+244), rebounds (+232), field goal percentage defense (+226) and blocks (+114).
- Ranked among the top 100 in 10 NCAA statistical categories, including among the top 50 in seven, after ranking among the top 150 in just two statistical categories in 2015-16.
- Earned the program's first Big Ten Conference road and tournament wins.
- 9-1 start marked the best head-coaching debut in Rutgers men's basketball history.
- 6-0 signaled the sixth-best undefeated start in the 110-year history of the program.
- Posted an undefeated home record in non-conference play.
- Out-rebounded opponents in 11 of 18 conference games, after winning the boards in just three league contests in 2015-16.
- Ten Big Ten games were decided in single digits after suffering 15 league losses by double digits in 2015-16.
- Played the second-toughest conference schedule in the Big Ten according to Ken Pom analysis.
- Played 17 games, 52 percent of its schedule, against programs that earned NCAA (13) or NIT (4) bids.

SOMETHING WONDERFUL

Quincy Douby was officially inducted into the Rutgers Athletics Hall of Fame on Oct. 20, 2017. He scored 1,690 points, the sixth-highest total in Rutgers men's basketball history, in three seasons. The Brooklyn native averaged 25.4 points per-game as a junior in 2005-06, setting the school record for points in a season (839), to lead the league in scoring en route to becoming RU's only First Team All-Big East Conference selection. The Haggerty Award winner as the Metropolitan Player of the Year and an All-American in 2005-06, Douby is among the Rutgers career leaders in every offensive category.
