#### THE X FACTORS

- Xavier has won 10 of its last 12 games against seven different teams from the Big Ten Conference since the 2007-08 season. XU is 2-1 vs. Wisconsin during that time.
- Xavier is 2-0 in the Gavitt Tipoff Games. XU won at Wisconsin 80-70 last season. This is the first time Xavier has hosted a Big Ten team for the Gavitt Tipoff Games.
- Xavier has won 41 straight non-conference home games at Cintas Center with its last loss coming in the 2012-13 season.
- Xavier has sold out 20 straight home games, including IUPUI and Evansville.
- Xavier junior **Tyrique Jones** earned a spot on the weekly BIG EAST Conference Honor Roll after averaging 18.0 points, 13.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists, 2.0 blocks and 2.5 steals per game in wins over IUPUI and Evansville to open the season, while shooting 69.6 percent (16-of-23) from the field.
- Xavier's **Tyrique Jones** grabbed a career-high 20 rebounds in the Evansville win, while tying his career highs for points (19), blocks (4) and field goals made (8). This was the first 20-rebound game for a Musketeer since **David West** grabbed 21 in an overtime win vs. George Washington in the 2000-01 season (2-3-01).
- Xavier sophomore **Paul Scruggs** scored a career-high 24 points in the Evansville win, while matching his career highs for rebounds (6) and assists (5).
- Xavier junior **Quentin Goodin** returned to action vs. Evansville after missing the exhibition game and the opener vs. IUPUI. Goodin contributed 14 points.
- Xavier won its first BIG EAST Conference Regular Season Championship last season. XU, a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history, played in its fifth straight NCAA Tournament and its 12th in the last 13 years in 2018.
- Xavier has graduated 109 straight men's basketball seniors dating back to the 1985-86 school year.

#### THE XAVIER-WISCONSIN SERIES:

The series is tied 3-3, although Xavier has won three of the last four meetings. Xavier defeated Wisconsin 80-70 in Madison last season (11-16-17). Wisconsin won on a buzzer-beater in the 2016 NCAA Tournament Second Round in St. Louis, Mo., 66-63 (3-20-16). Xavier defeated Wisconsin 60-49 in the Second Round of the 2009 NCAA Tournament in Boise, Idaho (3-22-09). XU won the only meeting so far at Cintas Center, 57-48, in the 2001-02 season (12-10-01).

**XAVIER WON LAST YEAR'S MEETING AT** WISCONSIN: Xavier recorded an 80-70 win at Wisconsin on Nov. 16, 2017 as part of the annual Gavitt Tipoff Games. Xavier built a nine-point lead with under four minutes left in the first half but Wisconsin battled back to tie the score at 34-all at the half. The Badgers led 66-64 with 2:44 left when senior All-American Trevon Bluiett helped XU take over the game. Bluiett scored eight straight points, beginning with a pair of free throws to tie the score at 66-all followed by a pair of 3-pointers to give XU the lead for good at 72-66 with 1:07 left. Bluiett scored a game-high 25 points to go with a gamehigh nine rebounds. His 21-point second half effort included 12 points in the final 2:25. Fellow senior J.P. Macura hit 10-of-15 from the field on his way to 20 points, eight rebounds and four assists.

XAVIER'S RECENT HISTORY VS. THE **BIG TEN:** Xavier is hoping to continue its recent success against the Big Ten Conference, Xavier has won 10 of its last 12 games against seven different teams from the Big Ten Conference since the 2007-08 season, including 4-1 in NCAA Tournament action and 2-0 in the Gavitt Tipoff Games. Xavier's 12 games and 10-2 record vs. the Big Ten during that 11-year span have been played against Indiana (1-0), Iowa (1-1), Maryland (1-0), Michigan (1-0), Minnesota (1-0), Purdue (3-0) and Wisconsin (2-1). XU defeated Big Ten runner-up Maryland in the 2017 NCAA Tournament First Round. In addition to the last-second loss to Wisconsin in 2016. the other loss was an overtime loss to then-No. 23 Iowa in the 2013 Paradise Jam in The Bahamas.

**XAVIER IN THE GAVITT GAMES:** Xavier is 2-0 in the Gavitt Tipoff Games, the third annual challenge between the Big

Ten and the BIG EAST. Xavier defeated Wisconsin 80-70 in Madison last season (11-16-17) and then-No. 24 Michigan in Ann Arbor 86-70 in the 2015-16 season (11-20-15). This is the first time that Xavier has been the host team in the Gavitt Tipoff Games.

#### FOR THE RECORD (WISCONSIN):

Wisconsin, 1-0, defeated Coppin State 85-63 in its season opener on Nov. 6.

FOR THE RECORD (XAVIER): Xavier, 2-0, is coming off a 91-85 win over Evansville on Saturday. Xavier got career performances from junior Tyrique Jones and sophomore Paul Scruggs to help overcome 17 3-point field goals by the Aces, the most ever hit by a Xavier opponent. Jones grabbed a career-high 20 rebounds, while tying his career highs for points (19), blocks (4) and field goals made (8). Scruggs scored a career-high 24 points, while tying his career highs for rebounds (6) and assists (5). Xavier led by 15 points, 35-20. with seven minutes left in the first half but managed just a 49-45 advantage at halftime. Evansville took a 65-64 lead on a 3-pointer with 13:46 left but it proved to be UE's last lead of the game.

**XAVIER WON ITS OPENER AGAIN: Xavier** defeated IUPUI 82-69 on Opening Night at Cintas Center on Nov. 6, XU's 29th straight season-opening win. Graduate transfer Ryan Welage led XU with 24 points on the strength of six 3-pointers, while junior Tyrique Jones added 17 points on 8-of-11 shooting to go with six rebounds a career-high four steals. Welage scored 21 of his 24 points in the final 17:14 of the game. XU trailed by two points, 42-40, with 18:26 left but Welage helped fuel a rally to help XU take control of the game. Sophomore Naji Marshall, battling illness that kept him out of practice for multiple days before the game, contributed 13 points and a career-high seven assists.

#### HOME COOKING TO OPEN THE SEASON:

Xavier is playing the final game of a threegame season-opening homestand. Xavier leaves for the Maui Jim Maui Invitational later this week.

NON-CONFERENCE WIN STREAK AT CINTAS CENTER: Xavier has won 41 straight non-conference home games with its last loss coming in the 2012-13 season to Wofford (56-55 on 12-22-12).



XAVIER TRAVELS TO MAUI AFTER THE WISCONSIN GAME: Xavier opens play against a stacked field in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational on Monday, Nov. 19 vs. Auburn, which was ranked No. 11 in the preseason AP Poll. XU's second game on Nov. 20 will be against either No. 4 Duke or San Diego State (receiving AP votes). The third game on Nov. 21 could pit XU against No. 3 Gonzaga, Arizona (receiving AP votes), Iowa State or Illinois.

**SUCCESSFUL DEBUT:** Xavier first-year head coach **Travis Steele** made a successful official debut with the win over IUPUI on Nov. 6 and followed that up with a win vs. Evansville on Nov. 10. Steele is the 18th head coach in Xavier history.

**OH CAPTAIN MY CAPTAIN:** Xavier's tricaptains (as voted by the players) are juniors **Tyrique Jones** and **Quentin Goodin** and graduate transfer **Kyle Castlin**.

**GOODIN RETURNS TO ACTION:** Junior point guard **Quentin Goodin** saw his first game action of the season vs. Evansville, contributing 14 points. Goodin missed the preseason action and the season opener vs. IUPUI on Nov. 6 with a shoulder injury.

**GREAT START FOR JONES EARNS HIM BIG EAST HONOR:** Junior Tyrique Jones earned a spot on the weekly BIG EAST Conference Honor Roll after averaging 18.0 points, 13.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists, 2.0 blocks and 2.5 steals per game in seasonopening wins over IUPUI and Evansville, while shooting 69.6 percent (16-of-23) from the field. Jones grabbed a careerhigh 20 rebounds in the Evansville win, while tying his career highs for points (19), blocks (4) and field goals made (8). This was the first 20-rebound game for a Musketeer since David West grabbed 21 in an overtime win vs. George Washington in the 2000-01 season (2-3-01).





SCRUGGS STARTING WELL: Sophomore Paul Scruggs has started each of the first two games, averaging 14.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game. Scruggs scored a career-high 24 points in the Evansville win, while seting new career highs for 3-pointers (4) and field goals (8) and tying his career highs for rebounds (6) and assists (5).

MARSHALL READY FOR A BIG SOPHO-MORE YEAR: Sophomore Naji Marshall, who was selected 2018-19 preseason All-BIG EAST Conference Honorable Mention, was a unanimous selection to the 2017-18 BIG EAST All-Freshman Team. Marshall dished off a career-high seven assists in the opener vs. IUPUI on Nov. 6.

**GRADUATE STARTERS:** Two of Xavier's three graduate transfers, **Ryan Welage** and **Kyle Castlin**, have started each of the first two games. Welage has averaged 14.5 ppg., while Castlin has contributed 7.5 ppg. and is second on the team in rebounding at 7.0 rpg. Welage hit six 3-pointers on his way to a team-high 24 points in the opener vs. IUPUI on Nov. 6. **Zach Hankins** has contributed 10.0 ppg. in a reserve role.

**EXPERIENCE RETURNING:** Despite losing its top three scorers from last year's team, Xavier has experience returning. Junior **Quentin Goodin** started all 35 games as a sophomore. Junior **Tyrique Jones** started 32 games in his first two seasons, including 19 as a sophomore. Sophomore **Naji Marshall** started 18 games in his first season, including each of the final 11 games. Sophomore **Paul Scruggs** played in 34 games as a freshman, averaging 16.8 minutes a game. XU welcomes five newcomers, including three graduate transfers.

#### NCAA TOURNAMENT ELITE COMPANY:

Xavier, a No. 1 seed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, has made five straight NCAA Tournaments and 12 of the last 13 NCAA Tournaments. Only eight schools have been to at least 12 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years: Duke, Kansas, Gonzaga and Michigan State are at 13, while Xavier, North Carolina, Villanova and Wisconsin are at 12.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS: Xavier, 2-0 so far in the non-conference portion of the schedule, finished 12-1 in the non-conference portion of its regular season schedule for the 2017-18 season, including an 89-76 win over then-No. 11 Cincinnati on Dec. 2.

#### CONSISTENT CONFERENCE SUCCESS:

Xavier, 15-3 and winner of the BIG EAST Conference Regular Season Championship, has recorded 36 straight seasons at .500 or better in conference play (MCC, Atlantic 10 and BIG EAST). No other school in NCAA Division I has an active streak of more than 31 years. Xavier's last conference regular season title prior to last year was in 2011 when XU finished 15-1 in the Atlantic 10 Conference.

BIG EAST PREDICTIONS: Xavier, picked to finish sixth in the BIG EAST Conference preseason coaches poll, finished 29-6 overall last season and won its first BIG EAST Conference Regular Season Championship at 15-3. Sophomore Naji Marshall was the only preseason BIG EAST honoree for the Musketeers, earning honorable mention honors.

TRAVIS STEELE RADIO SHOW: The second Travis Steele Radio Show will air live from Delicio Coal Fired Pizza at University Station on Wednesday, Nov. 14. The show airs from 7-8 p.m. on 55KRC. The popular radio tandem of Joe Sunderman and Byron Larkin host the show along with head coach Travis Steele.



Travis Steele, who was named the Sedler Family Men's Head Basketball Coach at Xavier on Saturday, March 31, picked up his first career win on Nov. 6 vs. IUPUI. Steele celebrated his 37th birthday on Nov. 12.

Steele spent the past 10 seasons at Xavier, including nine on the staff of his predecessor, Chris Mack. Steele is the 18th head coach in Xavier basketball history.

"As we completed our national search process, it became clear that the best head coach for our program was the person we knew the best, Travis Steele," said Xavier University Vice President

and Director of Athletics Greg Christopher. "Travis brings passion, personality and organizational leadership skills to our head coaching position, which is really the CEO of our basketball program. He has earned a reputation as one of the brightest young offensive minds in the game and one of the future stars in this profession."

Steele has been a part of nine NCAA Tournament teams in his 10 years at Xavier, including five teams that reached at least the Sweet 16. Last year's team won XU's first BIG EAST Regular Season Championship, a school-record final AP ranking of No. 3 and the first NCAA Tournament No. 1 seed in school history.

Steele, who was named over the last two years as one of the top two recruiters in the BIG EAST Conference by *Sporting News* basket-ball magazine, is a big part of the reason Xavier's recent recruiting classes have earned national attention. He has played a key role in multiple nationally-ranked recruiting classes in recent years, including three straight classes ranked among the top 20 in the country.

Steele has participated in the Nike-produced Villa 7 consortium, which annually brings together the country's elite assistant basket-ball coaches to build the next generation of great basketball leaders.

Former Xavier head coach Sean Miller hired Steele prior to the 2008-09 season as Xavier's Director of Basketball Operations. Mack promoted Steele to assistant coach after he took over the program prior to the 2009-10 season. Steele was promoted to Associate Head Coach following the 2015-16 season.

Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of the video coordinator. After serving as the video coordinator for a season and a half while at IU, he was promoted to the position of assistant coach in February, 2008.

Prior to his time with the Hoosiers, Steele served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under former XU head coach Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University from 2001-04.

Steele, the brother of former XU assistant and current Akron head coach John Groce, graduated cum laude from Butler in May 2004, earning a bachelor of science degree in marketing. Steele was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their five-year-old son, Winston.
