### UW TO PLAY FOR BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS CHAMPIONSHIP

- Wisconsin has advanced to the championship game of the Battle 4 Atlantis after back-to-back wins over Stanford and Oklahoma. The Badgers will take on Virginia on Friday at 1 p.m. (CT).
- The Badgers are off to a 5-0 start for the 4th time in the last 8 seasons.

### **TOP-10 TAKEDOWNS**

- The Badgers will be facing their first ranked opponent of the season on Friday when they face No. 4 Virginia.
- Since taking over as head coach in 2015, Greg Gard has guided UW to 6 wins over teams ranked in the AP top-10. The Badgers are 6-7 against top-10 teams under Gard.

Among Big Ten teams, only Michigan (7-7) has more top-10 wins and a higher win percentage against top-10 teams in that span.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

### **WISCONSIN 78, OKLAHOMA 58**

Nov. 22, 2018 | Battle 4 Atlantis Semifinals

- Wisconsin led by just 3 at the half, but went 8-for-9 from 3-point range after intermission and surged to a 20-point win.
- Overall, UW shot 63.5% from long range, going 14-for-22. That was the Badgers' best outside shooting display since hitting 12-of-18 (66.7%) against Arizona in the 2015 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight.
- Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** scored a career-high 25 points, going 7-for-8 from 3-point range. His 7 made triples equal the second-highest total in UW history, one shy of the school record. He has now reset his career high in 3 of the season's 5 games, also scoring 21 vs. Coppin State, 22 vs. Xavier.
- Senior Ethan Happ tallied his 5th double-double in as many games this season, finishing with 14 points, 12 rebounds and 5 assists. This marks the 4th game this year Happ has had at least 10+ points, 10+ rebounds and 5+ assists. No other player in the country has done it more than 3 times.
- Sophomore **Nate Reuvers** hit a career-high 3 3-pointers en route to 12 points. Redshirt freshman **Kobe King** scored a career-high 14 points off the bench, going 3-for-5 from deep.
- UW turned it over just 8 times while forcing OU into 15 TOs.

### LAST MEETING: #18 UVA 49, UW 37

Nov. 27, 2017 | Charlottesville, Va.

- Trailing by 4 at the half, Wisconsin was unable to muster enough offense in the second half, falling 49-37 at No. 18 Virginia in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge last season.
- Despite holding UVA to then-season lows of 38.3% FG shooting and 21.4% (3-14) 3FG shooting, the Badgers also posted then-season low marks, shooting 31.3% overall and 15.0% from 3-point range (3-for-20).
- Wisconsin also did not allow a single free throw attempt, the first time in school history that Virginia has not had an FTA in a game.
- Junior Ethan Happ led UW with 14 points and 8 rebounds. Sophomore
   D'Mitrik Trice was the only other
   Badger in double figures, scoring 10 points.
- Devon Hall scored 16 to lead the Cavaliers, who out-scored Wisconsin 34-18 in the paint. UVA owned a 39-30 rebounding advantage, grabbing 14 offensive boards.

### **ALL-TIME VS. VIRGINIA**

Wisconsin and Virginia will meet for the sixth time Friday at the Battle 4 Atlantis. The Cavaliers lead the all-time series, 3-2, including a 49-39 win in Charlottesville. Va. last season.

The two teams have met three times in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, with UW winning in 2013 and UVA winning in 2012 and 2017.

- In the Badgers' 2013 win, UW's Josh Gasser was the only player from either team to score in double figures, finishing with 11 points. Frank Kaminsky posted 9 points and 12 rebounds.
- In that game, the Badgers limited Virginia to just 38 points and 23.4% shooting. The 38 points were the fewest allowed by the Badgers in a road game since a 44-34 win over Washington University (St. Louis) in 1957. At the time, the Cavaliers' 38 points were their fewest during the Tony Bennett era.
- The Badgers held the Cavaliers without field goal for stretches of 8:43 and 9:03 in the second half. In fact, UVA had just 3 total field goals in the second half. Virginia also went scoreless for a period of 6:50 spanning the two halves.
- Prior to the home-and-home series in 2012 and 2013, the last time Wisconsin and UVA met (1998), Dick Bennett, Tony Bennett's father, was the head coach at UW. The Badgers claimed a 66-56 win at the 1998 Top of the World Classic in Fairbanks, Alaska.
- UW head coach Greg Gard and UVA head coach Tony Bennett served together for 2 seasons (2002 and 2003) as assistant coaches at Wisconsin. The Badgers won back-to-back Big Ten championships with Gard and Bennett on the staff.
- Dick Bennett served as the head coach at UW for five-plus seasons from 1996 to 2000, while Tony served as an assistant coach on the Badgers' staff for three seasons (2001-03). Dick Bennett owned a 94-68 (.580) record at Wisconsin, taking the Badgers to 3 NCAA tournaments, including a trip to the 2000 Final Four.
- UVA assistant coach Brad Soderberg coached at Wisconsin for 6 years from 1995-2001. He spent the first 5 seasons as an assistant under Dick Bennett, before taking over as the interim head coach during the 2000-01 season upon Dick Bennett's retirement. Soderberg led the the Badgers to an 18-11 overall record and an appearance in the 2001 NCAA Tournament.
- Wisconsin is 43-43 all-time against members of the ACC. The Badgers will play another ACC opponent on Tuesday when they host NC State as part of the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.

UW is 9-10 all-time in the Challenge, owning the 2nd most wins of any Big Ten team.

### **OTHER WISCONSIN NOTABLES**

With 5 assists vs. Oklahoma, senior Ethan Happ moved into 10th place on UW's all-time assists list with 298 dimes.

Happ is now in Wisconsin's all-time top 10 in each of the 5 major stat categories: points (7th), rebounds (1st), assists (10th), blocks (6th) and steals (2nd).

■ Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** ranks 3rd in the Big Ten in scoring, averaging 19.2 ppg. That's nearly a 10-point increase from last year's scoring average of 9.4 ppg. Trice is also 2nd in the Big Ten with 20 made 3-point field goals and ranks 3rd in the conference shooting 60.6% from downtown.

Trice also has a 2.6 assist-to-turnover ratio on the season (13 assists, 5 turnovers). For his career, Trice would have the 9th best assist-to-turnover ratio in UW history, but needs 1 more dime to qualify. His career mark is 1.80 (99 ast, 55 TOs).

Senior Ethan Happ ranks 8th in the Big Ten averaging 17.0 ppg and 2nd with 12.0 rebounds per game. He is also 4th with 5.6 assists per game.

Happ is the NCAA's only player averaging at least 17.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg and 5.0 apg.

- Happ is tied for the NCAA lead with 5 double-doubles in UW's 5 games. He is 1 of 4 players with 5, along with Yoeli Childs (BYU), Mike Daum (South Dakota State) and Demajeo Wiggins (Bowling Green).
- Happ has a streak of 29 consecutive games scoring in double figures dating back to last season.
- Wisconsin is averaging 79.6 ppg and surrendering just 58.8 ppg. Last season, the Badgers averaged 66.8 ppg and allowed 66.0 ppg.
- Opponents are shooting just 38.6% overall and 28.3% from 3-point range against Wisconsin. Last season, UW foes shot 45.9% overall and 35.0% from deep.
- UW has held a better shooting percentage than its opponents in each of the 5 games this season. On the year, UW is shooting 48.3% while allowing just 38.6%.
- Wisconsin leads the Big Ten and ranks 10th in the NCAA shooting 44.8% from 3-point range. For perspective, the Badgers have not shot over 40.0% from long range over a full season since 1991-92 (42.6%).
- The Badgers are second in the Big Ten in free throw shooting at 75.5%. Last season, UW was 10th in the conference at 69.9%. A total of 6 different players have attempted double-digit FTs this season.
- Wisconsin has out-rebounded each of its 5 opponents this season and owns a +5.0 rebounding margin on the year. The Badgers are 44-12 under Greg Gard when out-rebounding their foes.
- UW leads the Big Ten with just 8.2 turnovers per game and rank 2nd with a 1.6 assist-to-turnover ratio. The Badgers have not had more than 11 turnovers in any game this season.
- Seven different players have scored in double figures this season for Wisconsin: Trice (5x), Happ (5x), Davison (2x), Pritzl (2x), Reuvers (2x), King (1x) and Thomas (1x).
