PACK TRACKS

- NC State improved to 6-0 with a 78-74 win over Mercer on Saturday. The Pack faced its biggest deficit of the season 7 points early in the first half on Saturday, before going on an extended 42-14 run that went for over 20 minutes of game time. Trailing by 21 with 13 minutes to go, the Bears were able to close within two points with seven seconds remaining before **Eric Lockett** sealed the win with two free throws.
- Torin Dorn led the Pack with 19 points, nine rebounds and three steals. In six games this season, the Charlotte native has led NC State in scoring five times, in rebounding three times an in steals three times. Through games of November 25, Dorn is the only player in the ACC to rank in the top-10 in the conference in scoring, rebounding and steals. He also ranks fourth in the ACC in field goal percentage.
- At 6-0, NC State is off to its best start since the 2014-15 team started 6-0. It's only the second time in the last 10 seasons, the Pack has gotten off to a 6-0 start.
- NC State is averaging 35.5 points per game from its bench this season. It has outscored the opponents bench by 135 points (213-66) this season.
- Through games of Nov. 25, NC State ranks 11th out of 351 NCAA Division I teams in scoring offense (90.8) and 15th in scoring defense (57.8). They are the only team in the country to rank in the top 15 of both categories. NC State's scoring margin of 33.0 points per game ranks second in the NCAA.

- Coached UNCW to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2016 and 2017
- Served as an assistant coach at Louisville for three seasons, helping lead the Cardinals to a 96-21 (.821) record from 2011-14
- Prior to Louisville. Keatts served as the head coach at Hargrave Military Academy for 10 seasons
- With two separate stints at Hargrave (1999-2001, 2003-2011), he compiled a 263-17 (.939) record with two national prep championships (2004, 2008), three runner-up finishes (2005, 2006, 2009) and two other appearances among the final four prep teams (2007, 2010)
- Coached 14 players that have gone on to the NBA
- Three Sweet 16 appearances, two Final Four berths and one National Championship as a coach.
- Keatts and his wife Georgette have two sons, K.J. and Kaden

NEWCOMERS TO NC STATE

■ NC State only has three returning players from last season and welcomed nine newcomers onto the roster this season. The Pack will only have 10 players in uniform this season.

- The Pack has three transfers that were with the program last season, but sat out the season to satisfy NCAA transfer requirements. Junior guard **C.J. Bryce**, sophomore guard **Devon Daniels** and sophomore guard **Blake Harris** were all with NC State last season. Bryce played for Keatts at UNCW for two seasons before transferring to NC State. Bryce was UNCW's leading scorer in the 2016-17 season, averaging 17.4 points per game for a 29-6 team. Daniels started 26 of 29 games as a freshman at Utah in the 2016-17 season. He averaged 9.9 points per game and shot 57.1 percent from the field. Harris started nine of 14 games at Missouri last season before electing to transfer at the beginning of January. The Chapel Hill native joined NC State in January and received a waiver to be immediately eligible with the Pack this season.
- Keatts brought in two grad transfers to this year's team; **Eric Lockett** and **Wyatt Walker**. Lockett averaged 14.3 points per game at Florida International last season. Walker only appeared in two games last season before being sidelined with an injury. Walker averaged 12.9 points and 9.7 rebounds per game at Samford as a sophomore. The Jacksonville, Fla., native has two years of eligibility with the Pack.
- The final four newcomers to the program this season **DJ Funderburk**, **Manny Bates**, **Jericole Hellems** and **Sacha-Killeya Jones**. Funderburk is a sophomore after playing last season at Northwest Florida State. Bates and Hellems are true freshmen. Bates will miss this season after injuring his shoulder in August. Killeya-Jones will sit this season after transfering to Kentucky.

NC STATE - WISCONSIN SERIES

- Tuesday marks the third all-time meeting between the two programs.
- Wisconsin won the two previous meetings. The Badgers defeated the Pack, 65-56, in the Sweet 16 of the 2005 NCAA Tournament. In the only meeting between the programs in the ACC-Big Ten Challenge, Wisconsin defeated NC State, 87-48, inside the Kohl Center on Dec. 1, 2010.
- The Pack has an all-time record of 7-11 in the ACC-Big Ten Challenge.

TUESDAY STORYLINES

- A win on Tuesday would give NC State a 7-0 record and be the best start for the Pack since the 2004-05 team started 8-0. A win would also be the 100th victory of head coach **Kevin Keatts** collegiate coaching
- Scoring Defense: The Pack and Badgers have both given up 347 points through six games this season. The 57.8 points per game given up to opponents ties the teams for 15th in the nation.
- Three-Point Shooting: Wisconsin is shooting 42.1 percent from three-point range this season to rank second in the Big Ten in three-point percentage. NC State has not allowed an opponent to shoot over 30% from three-point range and ranks ninth in the country in opponent three-point field goal percentage. NC State opponents are 25-107 (.234) from three-point range this season.
- Turnovers: Through six games, the most turnovers Wisconsin has committed in a single game is 13. Through six games, the fewest turnovers NC State has forced an opponent to commit in a single game is 15. The Pack ranks eighth in the country in turnover margin and 16th in the country in turnovers forced.
- Balanced scoring attack for the Pack: Torin Dorn is the only Pack player to score in double figures in all six games this season. In NC State's six games there have been 24 double-digit performances by nine different players. Only Blake Harris (scored 8 points against Mount St. Mary's and UNC Asheville) has not reached double figures yet for the Pack.

HISTORICAL START FOR NC STATE

■ NC State's 51-point victory over UNC Asheville on November 13 was historic for the Pack. With the win the Pack became the first team in ACC history to win each of its first three games of the season by 46 points or more. NC State opened the season with a 50 point win over Mount St. Mary's and had a 46 point win over Maryland Eastern Shore before defeating the Bulldogs by 51.

PACK DANGEROUS FROM THREE-POINT RANGE

■ The Pack has been hitting its three-pointers to start the season. NC State has had double-digit three-pointers in four of the six games this season. NC State ranks second in the ACC in three-pointers made per game (9.5) and fourth in three-point field goa percentage (39.6%).

- Nine of the 10 NC State players on the roster have hit at least one three-pointer this season. Only Wyatt Walker (0-1) has not hit a three-pointer. Six of the 10 players (Braxton Beverly, CJ Bryce, Torin Dorn, Jericole Hellems, Markell Johnson and Eric Lockett) have made two or more three-pointers in a game this season.
- Last season, NC State only had 10 or more three-pointers in two of the first 16 games of the season. The Pack has done it in four of six games to start this season.

JOHNSON A THREAT FROM THREE-POINT RANGE

- Junior guard **Markell Johnson** is currently leading the ACC in three-point field goal percentage at 56.5% [13-of-23]
- The reigning ACC assist champion (7.3 assists per game last season) is averaging to hit 2.2 three-pointers per game this season and has hit three or more three-pointers in three games this season.
- The Cleveland, Ohio native has worked on his shot and has developed into a player defenses have to respect from long range. In 30 games as a freshman, he shot 25% (12-of-48) from three-point range. Last season in 26 games, he hit 27 three-pointers, shooting 40.9% from three-point range.

PERFECT START FOR FUNDERBURK

- Sophomore forward **DJ Funderburk** hit the first 10 field goal attempts of his collegiate career before finally missing a shot late in the first half against UNC Asheville. For the season, Funderburk is averaging 7.7 points on 68.0 percent shooting, 5.0 rebounds and 1.2 blocks per game.
- The Cleveland, Ohio, native went 4-of-4 from the field and finished with 9 points in the season-opener against Mount St. Mary's. He added 6 rebounds and a team-best 2 blocks. Against Maryland Eastern Shore, Funderburk scored 13 points on a perfect 5-of-5 shooting in the win over Maryland Eastern Shore. After hitting his first shot against UNC Asheville, Funderburk missed his second attempt. He finished the game with 11 points on 4-of-6 shooting and added six rebounds and three blocks.
- The stats from the exhibition game don't count for season totals, but Funderburk was a perfect 7-of-7 in the exhibition game against Chowan to finish with 20 points.

PACK LEADING THE ACC IN REBOUNDING MARGIN

■ With the departure of **Abdul-Malik Abu**, **Lennard Freeman** and **Omer Yurtseven**, the Pack only returned 31.5 percent of its rebounding total from last season. Despite the loss of players that combined to average over 15 rebounds per game, NC State had its three best rebounding performances of the **Kevin Keatts** era to open the season.

- NC State has outrebounded three of its six opponents by more than 20 to open the season. The Pack was +22 against Mount St. Mary's, +23 against Maryland Eastern Shore and + 27 against UNC Asheville.
- \blacksquare The Pack leads the ACC and is sixth out of all 351 NCAA Division I teams with a +14.3 rebounding margin.
- NC State has a 41.8 percent offensive rebounding percentage meaning when the Pack has missed a shot this season (its hitting 51.3% of its field goal attempts this season which ties for the lead in the ACC), 41.8% of the time NC State has come down with the rebound.
- Seven of the 10 players on NC State's team have had at least one game with five or more rebounds.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- Through six games, NC State's bench has scored 213 points and is averaging 35.5 points per game.
- The bench scored 50 points in the win over Maryland Eastern Shore on 11/10. The 50 bench points are the most for the Pack since the 1999-2000 season when NC State began playing at PNC Arena.
- NC State has outscored the opponents bench by 147 (213-66) points through six games this season.
- Last season, NC State's bench averaged 21.8 points per game and outscored the opponents, 720-523.

NC STATE ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- Five of the 12 players on the NC State roster hail from North Carolina. Two players are from Ohio. Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Michigan and Missouri all have one.
- Nine of the 12 players on NC State's roster are listed at 6'5" or taller.
- The Pack's roster features nine players that have been enrolled at another college. Only junior **Markell Johnson** and freshmen **Manny Bates** and **Jericole Hellems** have spent their entire career at NC State.
- Seven of the 12 players on the roster have two or more years left in college. Only **Torin Dorn** and **Eric Lockett** will exhaust their collegiate eligibility this season. **Wyatt Walker** is a grad transfer, but he was granted a medical redshirt season for the 2017-18 season when he only played two games for Samford and has two years of eligibility to play at NC State.

JAMES T. VALVANO ARENA

- Historic William Neal Reynolds Coliseum will now share its name with another icon of NC State Athletics, as former men's basketball head coach Jim Valvano will join Hall of Fame women's basketball coach Kay Yow in being recognized at the famed venue. At a ceremony on December 5 prior to NC State's Heritage Game, James. T. Valvano Arena will be formally dedicated to the legendary coach who guided the Wolfpack to the 1983 national championship.
- As part of NC State's \$1.6 billion Think and Do the Extraordinary campaign, a group of generous supporters of NC State Athletics joined together to honor the life and contributions of the late Valvano by making a \$5 million pledge to name the arena in Reynolds Coliseum. This gift will go towards the Capital campaign goals of Wolfpack Club and support the \$35 million Reynolds Coliseum renovation project.
- In 10 seasons leading the NC State program he guided the Wolfpack to seven NCAA Tournaments, including a pair of trips to the Elite Eight and a Sweet Sixteen appearance in addition to the 1983 national title. His squads won the 1983 and 1987 ACC titles. In his 10 years, his squads went 121-37 (.766) at Reynolds Coliseum.
