BADGERS OPEN BIG TEN PLAY AT IOWA

- Wisconsin heads to Iowa City, Iowa to open Big Ten play Friday against the No. 14 Hawkeyes. The Badgers have won 3 of their last 4 games at Iowa and have won their Big Ten road opener in 6 of the last 7 years.
- Up next, the Badgers will wrap up their early Big Ten swing with a home game vs. Rutgers on Monday.

KEY NOTES TO CONSIDER

- Wisconsin has opened the season 6-1, its best start since beginning the 2014-15 season with 7 straight wins.
- The Badgers are currently No. 6 in the NCAA's NET rankings and already have 4 wins over major conference teams, tops the nation. (more on Page 3)
- According to KenPom.com, UW owns the 17th-ranked offense (113.6 adjusted efficiency) and the 11th-ranked defense (91.9 adjusted efficiency).
- In his fourth season as head coach, Greg Gard has led the Badgers to a mark of 63-37 (.630), the 3rd-highest win percentage in program history (min. 60 games).
- Since 2001-02 when Bo Ryan and Greg Gard got to Madison, Wisconsin owns the best conference win pct and most wins among Big Ten teams, posting a mark of 203-91 (.690).
- Preseason AP All-American **Ethan Happ** has opened the season like a *postseason* All-American. Leading the nation in double-doubles (7 in 7 games), Happ is averaging 18.0 ppg, while leading the Big Ten with 12.3 rpg and ranking 3rd with 5.3 apg. (more on Page 4)
- With 961 career boards, **Happ** owns UW's all-time rebounding record. He also currently ranks 7th in UW history in points (1,667), 9th in assists (307), 3rd in blocks (124) and 2nd in steals (183). (more on Page 10)
- After missing the final 23 games last season with a foot injury, **D'Mitrik Trice** is off to a sizzling start in 2018-19, leading the Big Ten with a 60.0% 3FG pct. and ranking 3rd with 3.4 3FGs per game. The sophomore guard entered the season with a career high of 16 points, but has already topped that in 4 of the first 7 games this season.
- Wisconsin leads the Big Ten and ranks 8th nationally shooting 43.8% from 3-point range. That figure is up from 33.5% a year ago. Defensively, UW is allowing opponents to shoot just 29.1% from long range.
- UW has demonstrated improved depth this season with its bench averaging 18.3 ppg. The Badgers averaged just 10.2 reserve ppg after Jan. 1 last season. A total of 4 different reserves have scored in double figures in a game this season.



D'Mitrik Trice leads the Big Ten shooting 60.0% (24-40) from 3-point range. Trice's 3FG pct. is tops in the NCAA among players with more than 20 made 3-pointers.

WISCONSIN MAKING 'NET' GAINS

- Wisconsin is ranked 6th in the latest NCAA NET rankings (NCAA tournament selection committee metric that replaced RPI) due in large part to the Badgers' record against a tough early-season schedule:
- 5 of Wisconsin's first 7 games have come against teams in NET Quadrants 1 and 2, with only 1 coming at home. The Badgers are 4-1 in those contests.
- So far, UW has faced NET rankings #3 Virginia (neutral-site loss), #26 Oklahoma (neutral-site win), #41 NC State (home win), #91 Xavier (road win) and #99 Stanford (neutral-site win).
- Wisconsin has 3 wins over Quadrant 1 and 2 teams, trailing only Duke (4) for the most in the country:

Nov. 27, 2018 | Madison, Wis. | Kohl Center

- Trailing, 41-29, early in the second half, Wisconsin stormed back for a 79-75 win over NC State Tuesday night in Madison as part of the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- The Badgers tallied their first double-digit, second-half comeback since erasing a 13-point deficit in a 69-60 win over Illinois (2/21/16).
- UW improved to 10-10 all-time in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, equaling Purdue for the most wins by a Big Ten team.
- UW shot 52.4% from 3-point range (11-21), its 3rd game shooting over 50% from deep this season (63.6% vs. Oklahoma; 56.3% at Xavier).
- UW committed just 4 second-half turnovers and finished with 11 for the game. NC State entered the night forcing an average of 18.8 turnovers per game.
- Senior F **Ethan Happ** recorded his NCAA-leading 7th double-double in as many games, tallying a team-high 19 points and 11 rebounds. He also added 3 assists and 4 blocks.
- Sophomore G **D'Mitrik Trice** posted 18 points, going 4-for-5 from 3-point range. He has scored in double figures in 6 of 7 games this season and is now shooting a Big Ten-best 60.0% (24-for-40) from beyond the arc.
- Sophomore F **Aleem Ford** scored his first points of the season and finished with 12 points on 4-for-7 shooting from 3-point range.
- Sophomore G **Brad Davison** scored 12 points and drew 4 charges in the game.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE HAPP-ENING

- **Ethan Happ** authored the second triple-double in UW history with 10p, 11r, 12a vs. Coppin State. Josh Gasser is the only other Badger to record a triple-double (at Northwestern, 2011).
- It's the B1G's first triple-double since OSU's JaQuan Lyle in 2016.
- Happ's career-high 12 assists equaled the 3rd-highest total in school history and the most since Mike Kelley had 12 vs. Maryland in 2000.
- The NCAA's last player 6-10 or taller to record a triple-double with points, rebounds and assists was Northwestern's Evan Eschmeyer (27p, 14r, 10a vs. Indiana in 1999).
- Happ is the NCAA's first player to post at least 10p, 11r, 11a and 4b since Dwyane Wade in the 2003 Elite Eight vs. Kentucky (20p, 11r, 11a, 4b).

HAPP OFF TO ALL-AMERICAN START

Senior **Ethan Happ** opened the season as just the 4th pre-season AP All-American in UW history. However, early in the season, he's playing like a *postseason* All-American.

- Averaging 18.0 points, 12.3 rebounds and 5.3 assists per game, Happ is the nation's only player averaging at least 17.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg and 5.0 apg.
Over the last 20 years, no player in the nation has reached those marks for a full season.
- Happ leads the nation with 7 double-double (in 7 games) this season and tallied at least 10+ points, 10+ rebounds and 5+ assists in 5 of 7 games. No other player in the country has more than 3 such games.
- Happ ranks 3rd in the Big Ten in scoring, 1st in rebounding, 3rd in assists and 4th in blocks.
- Happ posted a triple-double in UW's opener vs. Coppin St. and followed that up with a 30-point, 13-rebound masterpiece in UW's win at Xavier.
- Happ's 30-point performance at Xavier trails only his 32-point effort in 2017 against Rutgers in MSG.
- With 22p, 15r, 6a and 4b against Virginia, Happ became first major conference player to post those numbers since Georgetown's Michael Sweetney in 2003. Overall, the last player to hit those marks was Oakland's Keith Benson (2010).
- Happ was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team, averaging 17.3 ppg, 13.0 rpg, 3.7 apg and 2.0 bpg over the 3-game series.
- With double-doubles in each of his first 7 games this season, Happ now has 38 in his career, ranking third at UW behind only Joe Franklin (47 from 1966-68) and Kim Hughes (39 from 1972-74).
- He is the 7th Badger with multiple games of 30+ points since 1995, joining Devin Harris (3), Nigel Hayes (3), Frank Kaminsky (2), Kirk Penney (2), Jordan Taylor (2) and Alando Tucker (2).

HAPP ENTERING RARE AIR

Ethan Happ is putting together one of the greatest careers in Big Ten annals (more on page 10).

- Happ needs just 39 rebounds to become the 14th player in Big Ten history to grab 1,000 rebounds. Happ can become the conference's first to accomplish this hallowed mark since MSU's Draymond Green (1,096 from 2009-12).
- Over the last 20 years, only 2 Big Ten players have totaled at least 1,500 points, 900 rebounds and 250 assists:

- Happ needs 333 points and 39 rebounds to become 4th player in Big Ten history with 2,000 points, 1,000 rebounds -- joining Greg Kelser (MSU), Joe Barry Carroll (PUR) and Herb Williams (OSU).

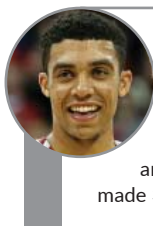

D'MITRIK THRICE

Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** missed the final 23 games of the 2017-18 season with a foot injury, but he's making up for lost time this season.

- Trice ranks 10th in the Big Ten averaging 17.0 ppg, an increase of 7.6 ppg from last year's injury-shortened average of 9.4 ppg.
- Trice leads the Big Ten, shooting 60.0% from 3-point range, hitting 24-of-40. He has the 2nd-most made triples in the conference, trailing only Purdue's Carson Edwards (25).
From 3-point range this season, Trice has already had a 5-for-5 game at Xavier, 7-for-8 vs. Oklahoma and 4-for-5 vs. NC State.
- For his career, Trice is shooting 43.3% from 3-point range, hitting 74-of-171.



TR-ICE IN HIS VEINS

D'Mitrik Trice is shooting 60.0% (24-40) from 3-point range. That figure leads the NCAA among players with more than 20 made 3-point field goals.

- Trice entered the season with a career high of 16 points against Oklahoma as a freshman in 2016-17. Through 7 games this season, he has already topped that figure 4 times.
Trice opened the season with 21 points against Coppin State and 22 points at Xavier. He then poured in 25 points in the Bahamas against Oklahoma and scored 18 vs. NC State.
- Trice has also authored 20 assists with just 8 turnovers on the year, good for a 2.5 assist-to-turnover ratio. That figure would rank 7th in the Big Ten, but he falls 1 assist shy of qualifying.

BIG TEN BEASTS

- Since 2001-02 when Bo Ryan and Greg Gard got to Madison, no team has been better than Wisconsin when it comes to Big Ten play.
The Badgers have won 69.0% of their conference games over that 17-year span.

- The Badgers have also been the Big Ten's most dominant team at home during conference play. UW owns a sparkling record of 124-23 (.844) at the Kohl Center since 2001-02.
- Since 2002, UW has won 7 Big Ten championships (4 regular season and 3 tournament).
Only OSU (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourn.) has won more titles during that era. MSU has 6 and ILL has 5, but no other school has more than 3 over that span.

WRECKING THE RANKED

- Since taking over as head coach in Dec. of 2015, Greg Gard has led the Badgers to 10 wins over teams ranked in the AP Top 25. That's tied for the 3rd-most wins among Big Ten teams.

STINGY BADGERS

- Wisconsin ranks 21st in the NCAA allowing just 60.3 ppg. The Badgers have allowed just 1 opponent to crack 70 points this season.
- KenPom.com puts the Wisconsin defense 11th in the nation with a 91.9 adjusted defensive efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions, adjusted for opponent).
- Opponents are shooting just 39.8% overall against UW and a mere 29.1% from 3-point range. Foes are making just 5.9 3FGs per game.
- The Badgers have had a better FG% than their opponents in all 7 games and haven't allowed a team to shoot 50% or better in any game.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- Wisconsin is averaging just 9.1 turnovers per game, a figure that ranks 6th in the nation.
- The Badgers also rank 23rd in the NCAA with 1.50 assist-to-turnover ratio, handing out 96 assists to just 64 turnovers.
- Individually, **D'Mitrik Trice** leads UW with a 2.5 assist-to-turnover (20 assists, 8 TOs) ratio. Taht figure would rank 6th in the Big Ten, but he falls 1 assist short of qualifying.
Ethan Happ ranks 13th in the Big Ten with a 1.61 assist-to-TO ratio (37 assists, 23 TOs).
- For his career, Trice has a 1.83 assist-to-turnover ratio (106-58), a mark that ranks 9th in school history.
- Since 2001-02, Wisconsin has averaged 10.1 turnovers per game, the nation's lowest mark. Temple is 2nd over that stretch (10.6 TOs/gm).
- The Badgers hold the NCAA record and 3 of the top 4 spots on the single-season record list for fewest turnovers per game.

INDIVIDUAL NOTABLES

- Sophomore **Brad Davison** leads the Big Ten shooting 89.5% (17-19) at the free throw line. Davison shot 81.8% (90-110) last season, trailing only Ethan Happ in FTs and FTAs.
- **Davison** has scored in double figures 3 times this season and 25 times in his young career.
- Sophomore **Nate Reuvers** leads the Big Ten averaging 2.6 blocks per game. Reuvers tied the UW single-game record with 9 blocked shots against Stanford on Nov. 21. **Ethan Happ** is 4th in the Big Ten with 2.0 blocks per game.
- For his career, sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** has made 74-of-171 (.433) from 3-point range. That mark of 43.3% would rank 3rd on UW's all-time list, trailing only Tim Locum (47.2%) and Trent Jackson (44.9%).
- Happ has started all 112 games of his collegiate career. With a start at Iowa on Friday, he will move into sole possession of 4th place on UW's all-time starts list, trailing only Josh Gasser (144), Alando Tucker (126) and Mike Kelley (116).
- A total of 8 Badgers have scored in double figures in a game this season, including 4 off the bench.

BADGERS WILL BE ROAD-TESTED

- For the first time since the 2001-02 season, Wisconsin will play a total of 7 games away from home prior New Year's Day.
In addition to 3 games at the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament, the Badgers will play road games at Xavier (Nov. 13), at Iowa (Nov. 30), at Marquette (Dec. 8) and at Western Kentucky (Dec. 29).
- Over the last 16 seasons, UW has played more than 5 games away from home in Nov./Dec. just twice, playing 6 in 2014 and 2008.
- UW has not played 4 or more true road games before New Year's in any season since 2001, when the Badgers played 5 true road games.
- The Badgers will not play consecutive home games until Dec. 13/22. That's the latest in UW annals since the 2000-01 season (Dec. 30/Jan. 4).
- UW will face 8 major conference opponents by Dec. 8, the most of any Big Ten team -- Michigan State and Minnesota will play 7.

BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS REWIND

- Wisconsin earned a pair of convincing wins over Stanford and Oklahoma to advance to the championship game of the 2018 Battle 4 Atlantis. In their third game in three days, the Badgers suffered a 53-46 loss to No. 4 Virginia.
- Senior **Ethan Happ** and sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** were named to the All-Tournament Team. Happ led UW averaging 17.3 ppg and 13.0 rpg while Trice averaged 15.3 ppg, including a brilliant 25-point, 7-for-8 3FG, performance against Oklahoma.
- The Badgers held opponents to 52.3 ppg and 36.6% shooting (22.9% 3FGs) in the Bahamas.
- During the tournament, UW out-scored each of its three opponents in the second half. Overall for the tourney, the Badgers owned a +12.3 scoring edge (109-72) after halftime.

FORD RETURNS FROM LEG INJURY

- Sophomore forward **Aleem Ford** returned to the lineup during the Battle 4 Atlantis, playing 14 minutes in the 3 games. Ford had been out since suffering a leg injury on Oct. 29.
- In his 1st game back with extensive playing time Ford poured in 12 points in 21 minutes against NC State. Ford did all of his damage from downtown, going 4-for-7 from 3-point range.
 - Ford appeared in all 33 games last season, starting 20. He averaged 5.8 points and 2.8 rebounds, shooting a team-high 40.9% (45-110) from 3-point range. A native of Lawrenceville, Georgia, Ford's 45 3FGs ranked as the fifth-highest freshman total in UW history.

TOP-10 TAKEDOWNS

- Since taking over as head coach on Dec. 15, 2015, Greg Gard has guided UW to 6 wins over teams ranked in the AP top-10. The Badgers are 6-8 against top-10 teams under Gard.
Among Big Ten teams, only Michigan (7-7) has more top-10 wins and a higher win percentage against top-10 teams in that span.

■ Ethan Happ - Senior - Forward

Already one of the most-accomplished players in school history, Ethan Happ returns for his senior season looking to cement his status as one of the Big Ten's all-time greats. A two-time first-team All-Big Ten selection, two-time Big Ten All-Defensive Team pick and 2017 All-American, Happ enters the 2018-19 season with a chance to finish his career ranked in UW's top three of nearly every category. The Milan, Illinois' versatility was on display last season as he became the first Big Ten player to lead his team in points, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals since 1995-96. Known for his hard work and durability (has started all 111 games in his career), Happ earned his bachelor's degree in May of 2018 and will spend his final year of eligibility pursuing a master's degree in Educational Leadership and Policy Analysis.

■ Trevor Anderson - Sophomore - Guard

Trevor Anderson is set to make his Wisconsin debut in 2018-19 after sitting out last season as a transfer from Green Bay. In one year with the Phoenix, Anderson started the first 20 games as a true freshman before suffering a back injury that cost him the remainder of the season. A physical point guard who led Stevens Point Area Senior High to back-to-back state championships, Anderson averaged 9.8 points and 2.7 assists per game for Green Bay in 2016-17.

■ Brad Davison - Sophomore - Guard

A relentless competitor and natural-born leader, Brad Davison put together one of the best freshman seasons in recent UW history in 2017-18. A Big Ten All-Freshman Team selection, Davison started the final 29 games of the season and flourished after taking over the point guard reins when D'Mitrik Trice was lost to a season-ending injury. The physical, combo guard scored in double figures 20 times in his debut season, demonstrating the ability to attack the rim and get to the foul line while setting UW's freshman 3-point field goal record (.60). A two-sport prep standout on the hardwood and gridiron in Maple Grove, Minnesota, Davison enters his sophomore season healthy after playing 2017-18 with a left shoulder injury that included 8 dislocations during the season.

■ Aleem Ford - Sophomore - Forward

Aleem Ford turned heads last season, appearing in all 33 games (20 starts) and playing 24.4 minutes in his first season of action at Wisconsin. Now a redshirt sophomore, Ford has added 15 pounds and looks to build on a season in which he led the Badgers shooting 40.9% from 3-point range. Ford sustained a leg injury on Oct. 29 and is out indefinitely, but is expected to return later this season. A native of Lawrenceville, Georgia, Ford spent a season at IMG Academy before joining the Badgers. A lengthy wing, Ford combines a soft-shooting touch with a slashing ability to get to the rim.

■ Kobe King - Freshman - Guard

An athletic combo guard, Kobe King returns from an injury-shortened freshman season. King averaged 19.0 minutes and 5.2 points per game during the first 10 games of last season before suffering a season-ending knee injury. King was granted a medical hardship and will retain his freshman eligibility in 2018-19. Even in the short sample size, the former Wisconsin Mr. Basketball showed off a versatile skill set equally adept at attacking the rim and stretching the floor.

■ Khalil Iverson - Senior - Forward

One of the most explosive athletes in the Big Ten, Khalil Iverson broke into Wisconsin's starting lineup last year as a junior and enjoyed the best season of his career. Now entering his senior season in 2018-19, Iverson has expanded his game from above-the-rim athlete to all-around player. In addition to highlight-reel dunks, Iverson has shown a knack for scoring in the lane and getting to the free throw line and embraced the role of defensive stopper last season. The Delaware, Ohio, native has scored 541 career points in 109 games at UW, including 40 starts.

■ Brevin Pritzl - Junior - Guard

After emerging as a starter in 2017-18, junior Brevin Pritzl returns for his fourth year at Wisconsin. The hot-shooting guard began his career with a medical hardship when a broken left foot cost him nearly the entire 2015-16 season. He bounced back to appear in 24 games as a redshirt freshman in 2016-17 before averaging over 29 minutes per game last season. Lethal from long range, Pritzl hit multiple 3-pointers in 13 games last season, including a career-high six triples and 20 points vs. Minnesota. The all-time leading scorer in De Pere High School history, Pritzl has rounded out his game since arriving in Madison, ranking third on the team in rebounds and tops in assist-to-turnover in 2017-18.

■ Nate Reuvers - Sophomore - Forward

Nate Reuvers enters year number two after a season of growth both on and off the court as a freshman. At 6-foot-11, Reuvers brings size to the UW frontcourt and now he has added 25 pounds to that frame. An inside-outside threat, Reuvers started 15 of the final 18 games as a true freshman in 2017-18 and finished the season averaging 5.3 ppg and 2.0 rpg in 16.6 mpg.

■ Tai Strickland - Freshman - Guard

A true freshman from Tampa, Florida, Tai Strickland brings quickness and athleticism to the UW backcourt. The son of Rod Strickland, a 17-year NBA veteran and former All-American at DePaul (1985-88), Tai Strickland is equally adept at distributing and penetrating on offense as he is locking up as an on-ball defender.

■ Charles Thomas - Senior - Forward

Charles Thomas IV begins his senior season in 2018-19 looking to provide valuable depth to the Badgers' frontcourt. In his first three seasons at UW, Thomas has appeared in 81 games, including 38 Big Ten contests and three NCAA tournament games. A sturdy, low-post presence, Thomas has shown the ability to score both inside and outside, scoring 160 career points and grabbing 134 rebounds while playing 7.3 minutes per game.

■ D'Mitrik Trice - Sophomore - Guard

D'Mitrik Trice returns as a third-year sophomore in 2018-19 after missing the final 23 games and receiving a medical hardship last season with a foot injury. Trice, who debuted with a strong freshman campaign in a sixth-man role in 2016-17, took over the starting point guard reins a year ago for Wisconsin. Starting the first 10 games of the season, Trice averaged a team-high 31.5 minutes per game and responded by ranking third on the team with 9.4 points per game and second with 2.3 assists per game before the injury. A sturdy ball handler and sharp-shooter, Trice shot a team-high 41.8 percent from 3-point range in 37 games as a freshman in 2016-17. The Huber Heights, Ohio, native has earned a reputation as a natural leader after a successful prep career in basketball and quarterbacking his high school football team to a state championship.

► UW has reached the Sweet 16 or better in 4 of the last 5 seasons. No team in the nation has gone more frequently over that span. Kentucky is the only other team with 4 appearances in the last 5 seasons.

The Badgers have also advanced to the Sweet 16 or better in 6 of the last 8 years. No team in the nation has gone more frequently over that span either.

► Wisconsin advanced to the Final Four in both 2014 and 2015, becoming one of 8 Big Ten teams to reach back-to-back Final Fours. The Badgers have advanced to the Final Four a total of 4 times, winning the national championship in 1941 and reaching the national semifinals in 2000.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

2016 JIM PHELAN NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR

A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard promptly led the team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons at the helm and will begin his fourth season as the head coach of the Badgers in 2018-19.

Initially an interim head coach, Gard proved quickly he was worthy of the head coaching position and was officially named as such on March 7, 2016. In three seasons, he owns the third-highest winning percentage in UW history, piloting the Badgers to a record of 57-36 (.613).

In his first two seasons with the head coaching title, Gard maintained a level of success that has become synonymous with Wisconsin Basketball. In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

Wisconsin maintained its place among the top of the Big Ten during the transition to Gard as well. In his first season, the Badgers finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

Gard's first two seasons as head coach at Wisconsin continued a trend of lofty academic success, placing 15 players on the Academic All-Big Ten list. Over his 17 years in Madison, UW has boasted a total of 63 Academic All-Big Ten honors, trailing only Purdue and Northwestern over that span.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. In 2015, Gard was ranked as the fourth-best "X&O" assistant coach in college basketball by coachstat.net. In 2012, Gard was named No. 3 on the list of top assistant coaches in college basketball according to Bleacher Report. FOX Sports also listed Gard No. 10 on its list of the nation's top 25 assistant coaches.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at UW-Milwaukee and served as an assistant coach at UW-Platteville from 1993-99.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School and one at Platteville High School, where he served in junior high and assistant varsity coaching capacities.

In 2016, Gard and his wife, Michelle, partnered with the University of the Wisconsin and Wisconsin Foundation and Alumni Association, to launch Garding Against Cancer. This fundraising initiative raises funds and awareness for cancer research and care within the state of Wisconsin. In its first two years of hosting fundraising events across the state, GAC raised more than \$2 million dollars in the fight against cancer.

Gard is a 1995 graduate of UW-Platteville with a degree in physical and health education. He received a master's degree in counselor education from Platteville in 2007. Gard and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters, Mackenzie and Peyton, and a son, Isaac.
