BADGERS CONTINUE TWO-GAME HOME STAND

- The Badgers (10-7, 1-4 B1G) wrap up their two-game homestand on Thursday, hosting No. 23 Minnesota (12-4, 1-4). Tip time is 7 p.m. from the Kohl Center.
- Wisconsin faces the Golden Gophers for the second time in less than three weeks. It is also be the third-straight game against a ranked opponent for the Badgers.
- UW takes to the road again on Sunday, playing at Northwestern (9-7, 2-3). The game starts at 2 p.m. from Welsh-Ryan Arena in Evanston, Illinois.

FROM THE COURT

- The Badgers dropped to 1-4 in the Big Ten after falling to No. 25 Indiana on Sunday. Wisconsin fell behind 37-14 after the first quarter but outscored the Hoosiers in the remaining three quarters. The comeback wasn't enough as UW lost 75-68.
- Indiana scored a season-high 75 points against the Badgers, including 37 points in the first quarter, the most points allowed in a quarter by Wisconsin. The Hoosiers also shot an opponent season-high 52 percent (26-50) from the field, including 57.1 percent (8-14) from 3-point range.
- The Badgers are 7-2 at home this season, their most home victories since 2012-13, and have won four of their last five games.
- Sophomore **Niya Beverley** scored a career-high 15 points vs. Indiana on Sunday, shooting 6-10 from the field, including a career-best 2-2 from 3-point range. The 5-foot-7 guard also added seven assists, two rebounds and one steal.
- Senior **Marsha Howard** has 10-or-more rebounds in her last three games, averaging 11.7 boards per game over the stretch. The 6-foot forward tied her career high with 15 rebounds at Penn State on Jan. 3 while adding 10 rebounds at Iowa on Jan. 7, and 10 boards against Indiana on Sunday.
- Wisconsin is the only Big Ten school with two players in the top 10 in rebounds. Senior **Marsha Howard** ranks fifth with 9.7 boards per game while freshman **Imani Lewis** ranks eighth with 8.3 rebounds per contest.
- UW ranks second nationally total rebounds, tallying 777 on the year. The Badgers also rank ninth nationally and rank second in the Big Ten with 45.7 boards per game. UW is 24th nationally with a 8.4 rebounding margin.
- Redshirt senior **Kelly Karlis** has turned up her scoring in Big Ten play, ranking third on the team with 10 points per game. Freshman **Imani Lewis** (11.8 ppg) and senior **Marsha Howard** (10.4 ppg) lead the Badgers in scoring in conference play.
- The Badgers have 15 double-doubles this season, including seven from senior **Marsha Howard** and five from freshman **Imani Lewis**. Wisconsin has the most double-doubles in a season since 2013-14 when it had 20 double-doubles.



Senior Marsha Howard picked up her seventh double-double of the season with 19 points and 10 rebounds vs. No. 25 Indiana.

- Every year since 2004-05, the athletic departments at Wisconsin and Minnesota have competed in the Border Battle, an all-sports competition.

- The 2018-19 standings are currently tied 140-140.
- Thursday night's game is the second of two contests between the women's basketball programs of the two schools with Minnesota winning the first meeting, 74-56, on Dec. 28. Thursday's winner will receive 20 points towards their school's total.

BADGERS OPEN BIG TEN SEASON 1-4

- Despite opening the Big Ten season with a 1-4 record, the Badgers are still off to their best Big Ten start since 2015-16.
- Wisconsin dropped its first seven games of the 2017-18 Big Ten season and the first 10 games in 2016-17.

WISCONSIN OFF TO GREAT START

NEARLY A GREAT COMEBACK

- On Sunday, Wisconsin fell behind 37-14 after the first quarter but outscored Indiana in the remaining three quarters to nearly pull off the largest comeback in school history.
- Wisconsin cut the Indiana lead to 52-34 at the half and came out strong in the third quarter. UW cut the Hoosier lead to eight (56-48) with 2:41 to go in the third. A 10-1 Wisconsin made it a seven-point game (72-65) with 44 seconds on the clock. The Badgers' were forced to foul, sending Indiana to the line where it made 3-4 over the final 42 seconds to seal the win.
- It would have been the biggest comeback win in program history, surpassing two 20-point come-from-behind victories—one in 2008 and the other in 1985.
- Indiana scored an opponent season-high 75 points, including 37 points in the first quarter, the most points allowed in a quarter by UW. The Hoosiers also shot an opponent season-high 52 percent (26-50) from the field, including 57.1 percent (8-14) from 3-point range.

OH MY NIYA

- Sophomore **Niya Beverley** scored a career-high 15 points vs. Indiana on Sunday, shooting 6-10 from the field, including a career-best 2-2 from 3-point range.
- The 5-foot-7 guard also added seven assists, just two off her career best, while not recording any turnovers. Beverley also contributed two rebounds and one steal.

- Beverley shares the Big Ten lead with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.8, which ranks 16th nationally. She also ties for 15th with 3.8 assists per game. In Big Ten-only games, Beverley ties for seventh in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.1 while ranking eighth in assists per game at 4.6.
- On the season, Beverley ranks second on the team with 3.8 assists per game while adding 6.2 points and 2.9 rebounds per game.

DYNAMIC DUO INSIDE

- Senior **Marsha Howard** and freshman **Imani Lewis** have been the Badgers' dynamic duo inside this season, leading the Badgers in scoring and rebounding in 15 of 17 games.
- Howard has led the team in scoring in 10 games and in rebounding in nine games. Lewis has been the Badgers' leading scorer in four games and their top rebounder in six contests.
- Howard averages a team-best 12.8 points and 9.7 rebounds per game while Lewis adds 12.4 points and 8.3 rebounds per game.
- Howard has a team-best seven double-doubles, which ties for third in the Big

Ten. Lewis has five double-doubles, which ties for sixth in the conference.

MARSHA, MARSHA, MARSHA

- Senior **Marsha Howard** has 10-or-more rebounds in her last three games, averaging 11.7 boards per game over the stretch.
- The 6-foot forward tied her career high with 15 rebounds at Penn State on Jan. 3 before adding 10 rebounds at Iowa on Jan. 7, and 10 boards against Indiana on Sunday.
- Howard has led the Badgers in scoring in 10 games this season, leading the team and ranking 18th in the Big Ten with 12.8 points per game. She has scored in double figures in 12 games this season.
- She leads the Badgers with 9.7 rebounds per game, which ranks fifth in the Big Ten. Howard has led UW in rebounds in nine games, tallying 10-or-more boards in 10 games.
- Howard picked up her 500th career rebound in the first quarter against Chicago State on Dec. 12, becoming the 26th Badger to hit that milestone. The 6-foot forward has 563 boards in her fourth season, which ranks 21st at UW.

She needs two rebounds to move into 20th, a position currently held by Katie Voigt (1993-98) with 564 boards.

DOMINATING BOARDS

- UW ranks second nationally total rebounds, tallying 777 on the year. The Badgers also rank ninth nationally and rank second in the Big Ten with 45.7 boards per game. UW is 24th nationally with a 8.4 rebounding margin.
- Senior **Marsha Howard** is fifth in the Big Ten and 44th nationally with 9.7 rebounds per game. Freshman **Imani Lewis** ranks eighth in the Big Ten with 8.3 boards per game.
- Wisconsin recorded a season-high 71 rebounds vs. Winthrop on Nov. 8, which ranks second on the UW single-game record list. The Badgers also had 68 boards vs. Marshall on Dec. 4, which ranks fourth on the record list.
- The Badgers have 50-or-more rebounds in four games this season and 40-or-more boards in 11 games. UW has outrebounded 11 of 17 opponents this season, including its last two Big Ten opponents.

MAN, OH MAN IMANI!

- Freshman **Imani Lewis** scored a career-high 22 points and added 11 rebounds at Iowa on Jan. 7 for her fifth career double-double.
- The 6-foot-1 forward has scored in double figures in a team-best 14 games, ranking second on the team with 12.4 points per game. She also has double-figure rebounds in five games to rank second on the team with 8.3 boards per game.
- In Big Ten-only games, Lewis leads all freshmen with a field goal percentage of .446. She ranks fourth in points per game (11.8), third in rebounds per game (8.0), and fifth in minutes per game (29.0).
- In all games, Lewis ranks third among league rookies in scoring (12.4) and third in rebounding (8.3). She also ties for fourth in steals per game (1.1), ties for eighth in blocks per game (0.7) and tied for sixth in minutes played (25.9).
- Lewis was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Nov. 26, becoming the first Badger rookie honored since Nicole Bauman was named the Freshman of the Week on Dec. 2, 2012.

TOUGH DEFENSE

- UW ranks third in the Big Ten in 3-point field goal defense, allowing foes to shoot just 29 percent (98-338) from behind the arc. In Big Ten-only games, Wisconsin falls to sixth in 3-point defense at .326 (29-89).

- The Badgers have played tough defense this season, ranking 26th nationally in field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to shoot just 35.2 percent. Wisconsin also ranks 72nd nationally, allowing 58.9 points per game.

- UW has held three opponents under 50 points this season, including Chicago State scoring a season-low 38 points on Dec. 12. Seven foes have been held under 60 points.

- Nine opponents have scored more than 60 points against UW this season, including all five Big Ten foes. Wisconsin is giving up 72 points per game in conference action, which ranks 11th in the Big Ten.

- Big Ten opponents have made big improvements in shooting and points per game.

- In all games, sophomore **Niya Beverley** and junior **Kendra Van Leeuwen** tie for first and sixth, respectively, in the Big Ten in assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Beverley leads the Big Ten and ranks 16th nationally with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.8 while Van Leeuwen ranks 69th nationally with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.0.
- Beverley has 53 assists on the season while turning the ball over only 19 times. Van Leeuwen has 87 helpers this year, giving up the ball 43 times.

DISHIN' IT WITH KENDRA AND NIYA

- Junior **Kendra Van Leeuwen** ranks second in the Big Ten and ties for 23rd in the nation with 87 total assists. The 5-foot-10 guard also ranks 53rd nationally and fourth in the Big Ten with 5.1 assists per game. She has five-or-more assists in eight games this season, including 10-or-more assists in three games. She dished off a career-best 12 helpers vs. Arkansas on Nov. 25
- Her 87 assists surpasses her sophomore season total and she needs 16 assists to surpass her freshman season total of 102 dimes.
- Sophomore **Niya Beverley** ranks second on the team with a season-best 3.8 assists per game, which ties for 15th in the Big Ten. She has five-or-more assists in six contests this season.
- The duo combine for 140 of the Badgers 251 assists this season (8.2/game) while tallying only 63 turnovers (3.6/game). Wisconsin is one of only four Big Ten schools with two players in the top 15 in assists per game, joining Iowa, Michigan State and Purdue.
- Wisconsin has 10-or-more assists in 16 of 17 games this season and 20-or-more dimes in four games this year, averaging

14.8 assists per game this year, which ranks eighth in the Big Ten. The Badgers have increased their assists by 1.8 per game compared to 2017-18.

SEASON IMPROVEMENTS

- The Badgers have made overall improvements in five of eight statistical categories compared to 2017-18.
- Wisconsin's biggest improvement is in rebounds where it has an improvement of 9.9 boards per game.

KICKIN' IT WITH KARLIS

- Over the last nine games, **Kelly Karlis** is averaging 10.6 points per game while shooting 46.5 percent (33-71) from the field, including 53.8 percent (14-26) from 3-point range. The 6-foot-2 guard is also averaging 4.9 rebounds per game over the stretch.
- Karlis has scored 10-or-more points in six of the last nine games and has double figures in eight games this season.
- Karlis led the Badgers over Purdue on Dec. 31 with a career-high 17 points, shooting 7-10 (70 percent) from the field, including 3-4 (75 percent) from 3-point range.
- On the season, Karlis ranks third on the team with 8.2 points per game. She also adds 4.6 rebounds per game, which ranks fourth on the team, and ranks third with 14 blocks on the season. The guard has 18 3-pointers on the year, which ranks third on the Badgers.

BALANCED SCORING

- The Badgers have had balanced scoring this season with two or more players tallying 10-or-more points in 16 of 17 games.
- Against Indiana on Sunday, four Badgers scored in double figures, the seventh game this season with four or more players with 10-plus points.
- Freshman **Imani Lewis** has scored in double figures in a team-best 14 games, ranking second on the team with 12.4 ppg.
- Senior **Marsha Howard** is close behind, having scored in double figures in 12 games. She leads the team with 12.8 ppg
- Redshirt senior **Kelly Karlis** has scored in double figures in eight games this season, ranking third on the Badgers with 8.2 ppg on the season.
- Redshirt freshman **Alex Luehring** (6 games), juniors **Abby Laszewski** (4) and **Suzanne Gilreath** (3) and sophomore **Niya Beverley** (3)

and junior **Kendra Van Leeuwen** (1) have all scored 10-or-more points in at least one game.

SHOOTING STRUGGLES

- On the year, Wisconsin is shooting just 39.9 percent (427-1071) from the field, which ranks 13th in the Big Ten. The Badgers are also shooting 29.2 percent (83-284) from 3-point range, which ranks 12th in the conference.
- UW has improved in Big Ten games, hitting 41.3 percent (123-298) from the field, which ranks sixth in the conference, including 32.8 percent (22-67) from behind the arc, which ranks ninth in the Big Ten.
- UW shot a season-high 52.2 percent (36-69) from the field vs. Evansville on Dec. 21. The Badgers shot a season-low 29.6 percent (24-81) vs. Marshall on Dec. 4, taking a season-high 81 field goal attempts.
- Wisconsin is also struggling from the free-throw line, shooting just 53.5 percent (183-342), which ranks 14th in the Big Ten. In Big Ten play, the Badgers are shooting 51 percent (49-96) from the charity stripe, which ranks 14th in the conference. UW shot a season-low 25 percent (2-12) from the free-throw line at Iowa on Jan. 7.

LINE-UP BATTLES

- Wisconsin has used its depth and competition in practice this season, putting together seven different starting lineups.
- Only redshirt senior **Kelly Karlis** has started all 17 games while senior **Marsha Howard**, junior **Kendra Van Leeuwen** and freshman **Imani Lewis** have started 16 contests.
- Sophomore **Niya Beverley** has started eight games while redshirt freshman **Alex Luehring** has started four games. Junior **Suzanne Gilreath** has started the last two contests. Junior **Abby Laszewski**, redshirt sophomore **Grace Mueller**, freshman **Jasmine Hale** have all started one game.

TOP FRESHMEN IN THE BIG TEN

- Wisconsin has two of the top freshmen in the Big Ten in scoring and rebounding.
- **Imani Lewis** ranks third in scoring (12.4) and third in rebounding (8.3). The 6-foot-1 forward is also tied for fourth in steals per game (1.1), ties for eighth in blocks per game (0.7) and ties for sixth in minutes played (25.6).
- In Big Ten-only games, Lewis leads all freshmen with a field goal percentage of .446. She ranks fourth in points per game (11.8), third in rebounds per game (8.0), and fifth in minutes per game (29.0).
- **Alex Luehring** ranks 14th in scoring (6.4) and tied for 18th in rebounding (2.6). The redshirt freshman also ranks third in 3-pointers made (1.6), tied for ninth in assists per game (1.3), and tied for 12th in blocks per game (0.4).

- Freshman **Jasmine Hale** missed the first four games with a finger injury. She has played in 12 games, including her first start vs. Marshall, averaging 12.3 minutes per game. She averages 3.1 points, 2.3 rebounds, 0.5 assists and 0.8 steals per game.
- Freshman **Diamond Bragg** has played in 14 games, averaging 7.3 minutes per game and contributing 0.8 points, 1.1 rebounds and 0.9 assists per game.

IN THE NATIONAL STATS

- UW ranks second nationally total rebounds, tallying 777 on the year. The Badgers also rank ninth nationally and rank second in the Big Ten with 45.7 boards per game. UW is 24th nationally with a 8.4 rebounding margin.
- On defense, the Badgers rank 26th nationally in field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to shoot just 35.2 percent.
- The Badgers rank 12th with 91 total blocks while ranking 16th nationally with 5.4 blocks per game.
- Junior **Kendra Van Leeuwen** ranks 23rd nationally with 87 total assists this season. She also ranks 53rd with 5.1 assists per game.
- Senior **Marsha Howard** ranks 30th with 165 total rebounds and 44th with 9.7 rebounds per game. She also ties for 30th with seven double-doubles this year.

COUNTING DOWN

- Two Badgers are counting down to career milestones.
- Redshirt senior **Kelly Karlis** is four blocks away from 100 stops. She is also 16 points away from 500 career tallies and 28 rebounds away from 400 career boards.
- Junior **Kendra Van Leeuwen** is two steals away from 100 takeaways.

SCORING WELL INSIDE

- UW is scoring well in the paint, averaging 32.8 points per game while opponents are averaging 23.0 points per game.
- Only four teams have outscored the Badgers in the paint this season.
- Wisconsin's bench has outscored or tied 15 of 17 opponents this season, averaging 22.6 points per game compared to just 11.6 points per game from foes' reserves.
- UW is also scoring 12.9 points per game on second-chance baskets while foes average just 7.8 points per game on second chances.

IRON BADGER

- Junior **Kendra Van Leeuwen** has played in all 78 games as a Badger. The 5-foot-10 guard has also started 76 games in the Cardinal and White.
- She is averaging 3.46 assists per game for her career, which ranks seventh on the UW career record list.

MOST IMPROVED REBOUNDERS

- The Badgers have one of the most improved rebounders in the Big Ten this season.
- Senior **Marsha Howard** ranks fifth, improving her boards by 2.8 per game compared to her junior season.

HAVING CAREER SEASONS

- Several returnees are having the best seasons of their careers in 2018-19.
- Sophomore **Niya Beverley** is averaging a career best 6.2 points per game while shooting a season-best .379 (33-87) from the field, including a best .444 (8-18) from 3-point range. She is also averaging a season-best 3.8 assists per game.
- Sophomore **Kara Crowley** puts up a season-best 2.1 points and 0.9 rebounds per game.

She also made her first two 3-pointers this season while adding her first two assists.

- Junior **Suzanne Gilreath** is shooting a season-best 37.7 percent (20-53) from 3-point range. She is averaging a season-best 1.4 rebounds per game and also has just the second block of her career.
- Senior **Marsha Howard** is averaging a season-best 12.8 points and 9.7 rebounds per game. The forward made the first 3-pointer of her career. Howard surpassed her sophomore season total of 16 blocks with 18 stuffs.
- Redshirt senior **Kelly Karlis** puts up a season-best 8.2 points per game while averaging a season-best 1.8 assists per set, tallying a season best 30 dimes.
- Junior **Abby Laszewski** tallies a season-best 6.4 points and 4.6 rebounds per game. She is shooting a season-best 55.7 percent (49-88) and already has 27 blocks this season, needing just two to equal her sophomore year total.
- Junior **Kendra Van Leeuwen** is averaging a season-best 4.6 points, 4.0 rebounds and 5.1 assists per game. She is shooting a season-best 71.4 percent (15-21) from the free-throw line. Van Leeuwen already has 87 assists this season, which surpasses her sophomore year total. She needs just 15 helpers to equal her freshman season total.

INJURIES HURT

- Wisconsin has struggled with injuries this season.
- The Badgers lost junior starter **Courtney Fredrickson** for the season to a knee injury at Milwaukee on Nov. 13.
- Redshirt senior **Lexy Richardson** will miss the season due to a knee injury suffered vs. Winthrop on Nov. 8.
- Freshman **Carmen Backes** will also miss the year due to a knee injury she suffered in high school.
- Junior **Suzanne Gilreath** and freshman **Jasmine Hale** missed the first four games of the season due to a foot and hand injury, respectively, but have come off the bench since then.
- Redshirt sophomore **Grace Mueller** injured her ankle on Dec. 27 in practice and will be out indefinitely.

WELCOME SYDNEY DOWN UNDER

- With all of the injuries, the Badgers added freshman **Sydney Mathiason** to their roster. The 6-foot-1 forward served as a team manager before joining Cardinal and White.
- Mathiason was a two-time first-team all-conference pick at Monroe High School, averaging 10.8 points and 7.9 rebounds per game as a senior. She aided the Cheesemakers to state tournament appearances as a junior and senior, and two conference championships.

BADGERS SIGN FOUR

Four of the nation's top 150 players in the 2019 class have signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Badgers.

The signees are **Sydney Hilliard**, a 5-foot-11 guard from Monroe, Wisconsin; **Julie Pospisilova**, a 6-foot-1 guard from Prague, Czech Republic; **Sara Stapleton**, a 6-foot-3 post from Blaine, Minnesota; and **Tara Stauffacher**, a 5-foot-11 wing from Beaver Dam, Wisconsin.

All four athletes are ranked among the top 150 players in the country for 2019 by Blue Star Index – Pospisilova (39th), Stauffacher (90th), Stapleton (135th) and Hilliard (146th) and collectively the recruiting class is ranked 18th in the country.

Hilliard is a two-time all-state performer for Monroe High School. As a junior, she set Monroe High School's single-season scoring record with 558 points and also broke the school's career scoring record. Hilliard led the Cheesemakers to back-to-back Wisconsin State tournament appearances in 2017 and 2018. She averaged 22.3 points, 6.3 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game in the 2017-18 season, which led to a 2018 All-Area Player of the Year award and a USA Today First-Team Wisconsin selection.

Hilliard played with Wisconsin Academy during AAU season. She impresses in the classroom as well, as she's a member of the high honor roll.

Pospisilova plays with two club teams in Prague – ZVVZ USK Praha and USK Praha – and has plenty of international experience as she also competes on the Czech National Team.

In 2017-18, she led the Extra League with 16.1 points per game while adding 6.6 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.0 steals per game, leading her team to the Czech Championship. In the First League, Pospisilova averaged 14.2 points, 6.6 rebounds, 2.9 assists and 2.1 steals per game.

She has played on the Czech Republic National Team since 2014, competing in five European Championships, winning

gold medals in 2015 and 2018. In 2016-17, Pospisilova was part of a student exchange program at Downers Grove North High School in Illinois, where she averaged 13.4 points and 6.1 rebounds per game. Pospisilova joins a long list of former Badgers who played for the nationally recognized Chicago Hoops Express Nike Blue Star Travel team.

Stapleton's impact in the paint has led to a Prospect Nation post player ranking of No. 24 in the country. She is a two-time first-team all-conference selection at Centennial High School in Circle Pines, Minnesota. She averaged 11.7 points, 7.0 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game as a junior and is currently just 19 points shy of 1,000 points for her career. She also holds school records for blocks in a single game (9) and career (91).

Stapleton was recently named to the 2018-19 Minnesota Miss Basketball Watch List by Breakdown Sports. She is also a three-year member of the honor roll and has received the Conference Athletic Academic Award for three seasons. Stapleton competed for the nationally recognized Minnesota Stars AAU team.

Stauffacher is a versatile wing who was a three-time first-team all-conference selection and three-time offensive player of the year at Beaver Dam High School, after scoring the most 3-pointers in school history. She was also named Division 2 All-State after helping her Beaver Dam High School team to back-to-back Wisconsin State Championships for coach Tim Chase. Stauffacher is a talented three-sport athlete, as she's a four-year letterwinner in volleyball, even earning first-team all-conference honors. Plus, she was a three-year letterwinner in track and field. She has been named to the high honor roll every semester of her high school career and is a member of the National Honor Society.

Stauffacher starred for the Wisconsin Lakers on the AAU circuit, which culminated last summer as their team won the 2018 BlueStar National Championship.

TRIPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- Three Badgers recorded double-doubles against Winthrop on Nov. 8, the first time since 1996 that three UW players tallied double-doubles in the same game.
- Howard had 18 points and 14 rebounds; junior **Courtney Fredrickson** had 14 points and 11 rebounds; and Lewis had 10 points and 11 rebounds.
- The last time UW had three players with double-doubles was vs. Purdue on Jan. 26, 1996. Barb Franke (38 pts/13 reb), Ann Klapperich (23 pts/12 reb) and Keisha Anderson (14 pts/11 asst) set the mark.

TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

- Wisconsin won its first regular-season tournament title since 2009-10 when it was crowned champions of the Challenge in the Music City—Music Row Bracket on Nov. 23-25.
- The Badgers defeated Pittsburgh 57-42 and Tennessee State 58-53 before falling to Arkansas 69-68. All four teams finished with identical 2-1 records but Wisconsin won the tournament based on fewest points given up.

Last time vs. Minnesota:

Wisconsin dropped its Big Ten opener, falling at No. 12 Minnesota, 74-56, Dec. 28, 2018, at Williams Arena

It was a slow start for both teams, going scoreless for the first minute and a half of the game until a Minnesota jumper connected with the basket at the 8:22 mark of the first period. Wisconsin (9-4 overall, 0-1 Big Ten) was held to two points until sophomore Niya Beverley sank both free throws (4-11) with 1:58 left in the first quarter.

The Badgers used a 7-0 run early in the second quarter to cut the Gopher lead to six (20-14) with 7:03 on the clock. Wisconsin kept the score within 10 points at the half (32-22) but four turnovers in the third quarter helped Minnesota take a 55-34 lead after three periods. UW cut the lead to 13 (61-48) off a Kelly Karlis 3-pointer but that was as close as the Badgers would get.

UW shot 35 percent (21-60) from the field and outshot the Gophers from beyond the arc hitting 5-15 (33.3 percent) while Minnesota hit 39.7 percent (27-68) from the field and 25 percent from deep (4-16).

UW struggled from the free-throw line, shooting just 42.9 percent (9-21) while the Gophers hit 61.5 percent (16-26) from the charity stripe.

Wisconsin dominated off the bench with 24-9 points and out blocked the Gophers 6-3. Minnesota edged the Badgers 46-45 in rebounds.

The Badgers tallied 20 turnovers in the game as Minnesota had eight steals. The Golden Gophers had 13 giveaways as UW also had eight steals.

Gilreath led UW with nine points, all from beyond the arc. Freshman Imani Lewis had team-high seven rebounds while junior Kendra Van Leeuwen led the team with five assists.

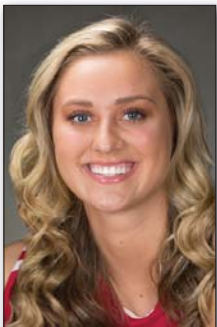
