STARTING FIVE

• Big Ten play resumes for the remainder of the season as the Minnesota men's basketball team crosses the border to face Wisconsin on Thursday night. The Gophers are looking for their first win in Madison since 2009.

• Redshirt sophomore forward Eric Curry made his return to the lineup on Dec. 30 in the win over Mount St. Mary's. Curry, who missed all of last season and the first 12 games of this year with a knee injury, scored six rebounds, four points and an assist in 17 minutes of action against the Mountaineers.

• On Dec. 21 with the win over N.C. A&T, head coach Richard Pitino earned his 100th victory at the helm of Gopher basketball. He became just the ninth coach in program history to reach the mark. Pitino is the youngest Power Five coach with 100+ wins at one school, and the third youngest in the nation with 100 wins at one school.

• Senior forward Jordan Murphy became the 11th player in Big Ten history with 1,400+ points and 1,000+ career rebounds. Additionally, Murphy broke Jim Brewer's 45-year old school record when he scored 18 points and 13 rebounds against Nebraska for his 52nd career double-double. Murphy leads the nation in rebounding (12.6) and is fourth in double-doubles (nine) this season, as of Jan. 2. He is also fourth in free throw attempts (111) and 18th in free throws made (77). Murphy needs just 14 points to become the ninth Gopher with 1,500+ career points.

• Freshman Daniel Oturu has posted four straight double-doubles, including a career-high 20 points to go with 11 rebounds vs. the Aggies on Dec. 21. Oturu has nine games this season with eight or more rebounds, and seven games in double-figure scoring. Oturu is leading the team and ranks second in the Big Ten blocking 2.1 shots per contest. For his efforts vs. N.C. A&T, Oturu was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Dec. 24.

SCOUTING THE BADGERS

- Wisconsin has split its last four games, most recently being tripped up at Western Kentucky, 83-76, on Dec. 29.
- In their two December conference contests, the Badgers won at Iowa and held off Rutgers at home.
- Preseason All-America honoree Ethan Happ leads the Badgers and ranks in the Big Ten's top four in scoring (19.2), rebounding (10.6 rpg) and assists (4.8 apg), one of a trio of UW players averaging double-digit scoring (D'Mitrik Trice - 15.5 ppg, Brad Davison (10.5 ppg).

CHARITABLE WORK

- Minnesota is fourth in the nation in getting to the charity stripe, tallying 371 free throw attempts through 13 games this season. Of those shots, the Gophers made 251, a figure which ranks 10th nationally.
- The Gophers are second in the Big Ten in both of those categories, trailing Iowa.
- Senior Jordan Murphy is fourth nationally getting to the line, with 111 free throw attempts (8.5 FTA/game).
- In single game averages, the Gophers are getting to the free throw line nearly 12 more times per contest than their opponents.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- Minnesota wrapped up non-conference play in December with a 10-1 record, including a perfect 5-0 mark in home games.
- Included in the 10 wins were four over Power Five opponents in Utah (Pac-12), Texas A&M (SEC), Washington (Pac-12) and Oklahoma State (Big XII).
- The four non-conference wins against those conferences (and their historical predecessors) is the most since the 1959-60 season (Vanderbilt, Oklahoma, Missouri, at Oklahoma).

GAME TIME CHANGE AT MARYLAND

- Minnesota's game at Maryland, the regular-season finale on Friday, March 8, has been changed to a 7 p.m. ET/6 p.m. CT tip-off. That is 30 minutes later than originally scheduled.
- Fox Sports 1 and KTLK 1130 AM/103.5 FM will broadcast the game.

THE JORDAN MURPHY SUPERLATIVE NOTE

- Senior Jordan Murphy continues his march through the Gopher record books and continues to make his mark among the nation's leaders as well.
- So far this season, Murphy has set new school records for career rebounds and career double-doubles.
- He leads the country and the Big Ten Conference, averaging 12.6 rebounds per game and fourth with nine double-doubles to date.
- Murphy has moved into the top-15 for career Gopher shot blockers, as he has 115 to his name in Maroon & Gold. He is also rapidly moving up the free throw chart, currently sitting tied for first and fourth in attempts and made, respectively.

REMEMBERING TAYRA

- In early December, the Gopher basketball family suffered a tremendous loss with the passing of Tayra McFarlane, mother of senior guard Dupree McBrayer.
- McFarlane lost her battle with cancer and passed away on December 3 at the age of 58.
- In remembrance, Gopher players will wear "TM" patches while coaches and staff will wear "TM" pins for the remainder of the season.
- The Gophers were able to raise more than \$15,000 in less than 24 hours through a GoFundMe campaign to pay for McFarlane's funeral and other final expenses. Included in that total was a \$5,000 contribution from head coach Richard Pitino and his wife Jill.

GOPHERS SIGN TRE' WILLIAMS TO NLI

- Minnesota head coach Richard Pitino announced Wednesday the addition of Marvin "Tre" Williams III to the Gophers. Williams, a 6-5 guard from Dallas, Texas who is currently enrolled at Wasatch Academy (Utah),

signed his National Letter of Intent to join the team beginning in 2019.

- "We are excited to announce the signing of Tre' Williams," said Pitino. "He is a terrific basketball player and an exceptional athlete. He's versatile, multipositional, and fits in our system perfectly. In addition to all that, he is a terrific student. He will be a valuable member of our program from day one."
- Williams, who is rated a three-star prospect, is in his second season at Wasatch after two years of high school in Texas. Last season, Williams averaged 12.5 points per game, third highest on the Tigers' roster, after appearing in 26 games and also totaling 36 3-pointers. He was invited to the 2017 Nike Top 100 Camp as well as attending the 2018 Pangos All-American Camp in Norwalk, Calif. During his freshman season at Prestonwood Christian Academy, he was part of the TAPPS 5A Boys Basketball State Championship squad.

NEARLY \$125K RAISED AT COACHES VS. CANCER DINNER

- For the fourth time, the Minnesota men's basketball team traded in their jerseys for suits to help raise money for cancer at the Coaches vs. Cancer Tipoff Dinner, held Sunday night at Interlachen Country Club.
- More than \$124,000 was raised on the evening for the fight against cancer, with the proceeds benefiting the Richard M. Schulze Hope Lodge adjacent to the U's campus in Minneapolis. In the four years of the event, which started in head coach Richard Pitino's second season, more than \$380,000 has been raised for the American Cancer Society.
- "Each year, we've been fortunate to see this event grow and raise more money for this important mission, and last night was by far our biggest and best," said Pitino. "It's such a tremendous opportunity for me and our team to step away from basketball for one night and connect with our community for a great cause. I am thankful for our generous donors, and am excited to see what we can do in the future."

WATCH LISTS

- Jordan Murphy's name can be found on a trio of prestigious watch lists as he enters his final season with the Gophers.
- In October, Murphy was selected among the Karl Malone Award Preseason Watch List, which identifies the top power forward in Division I college basketball.
- This month, the Atlanta Tipoff Club selected Murphy among its 50 members of the Citizen Naismith Trophy Watch List, awarded to the top player in college basketball. Additionally, the John Wooden Award and Lute Olson Awards all recognized Murphy among their players to watch as they select the top collegian in the country.
- All of the awards will trim down their candidate list after the first of the year.

DRESS REHEARSALS

- The Gophers played a pair of preseason games as they readied for the 2018-19 season.
- On October 20, Minnesota edged Creighton in a closed scrimmage in Omaha, 83-81.
- Four different Gophers reached double figures in the game, led by freshman Gabe Kalscheur who scored a game-high 15 points.
- 12 days later, Minnesota welcomed in-state foe Minnesota Duluth for an exhibition at the Barn, with the Gopher offense firing on all cylinders in a 109-53 victory. Seven different Gophers scored in double figures in that contest, with freshman Daniel Oturu registering a double-double with 17 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. Sophomore Isaiah Washington led all scorers with 18 points.

UP NEXT

- Minnesota is idle over the weekend before opening the first of three two-game Big Ten homestands next week. It begins with a 6:00 p.m. tilt against Maryland on Tuesday, January 8 at the Barn.

Please contact the Athletic Communications office for more information regarding the on-line credentialing system. Delivery of credentials will be handled according to individual situations, but in most cases will not be mailed. Credentials can be picked up starting two and a half hours before game time at the Williams Arena media will call gate at the west end of the south lobby of the building.

MEDIA CREDENTIAL CRITERIA

Due to severe space limitations for media seating in Williams Arena, media requesting credentials for Golden Gopher basketball will have to meet certain criteria to gain access to press seating. **Beginning with the 2018-19 season, media seating will be located in section 203 (SE corner of the arena).**

- The originating television entity of the game will be seated courtside at center court.
- Flagship radio for the visiting team will be seated in the first row of section 203. Any non-originating radio stations doing game updates will be seated in the upper press row. Student radio stations will be subject to space restrictions and will only be granted credentials if space allows.
- Any national publication will be granted a minimum of one credential for working press and one photography credential if needed courtside.
- The Associated Press and the primary daily newspapers of the Minneapolis/St. Paul market that provide daily coverage for Golden Gopher basketball will be granted three seats. (1-photo, 2-working press). Any other requested credentials will be seated as space dictates.
- Any visiting team's primary newspapers from its largest media market that provide daily coverage of the visiting team will be granted credentials. The location of other credentialed media of the visiting team will be determined by circulation size or the visiting SID.
- Minneapolis/St. Paul local television stations with network affiliation will be granted one seat in the press seating area. additional seats will be granted if space allows.
- Only on-line entities that are affiliated with an accredited news agency can qualify for credentials. No additional credentials will be given to any print, radio or television agency for their on-line websites that are already credentialed for Gopher Basketball.
- If there is no space available within the arena, media can request credentials and have access during the game to the media work room located on the second level of the east addition and postgame interview areas.

PHOTO AND FILM CREDENTIALS

All photo and game film credentials should be requested as early as possible because of severe space limitations. Photographers and film crews may work only in the designated areas. Photographers are not allowed on the court during play, but can photograph pregame and postgame activities, if they have requested such access from the media relations staff. Failure to comply will result in expulsion from the arena.

MEDIA PASS GATE

The media pass gate is located at the south end of the University Ave. lobby. If you need to pick up credentials, the media will call table is located at the Media Pass Gate. You must have proper identification to receive your credentials. The media pass gate opens two and a half hours before game time.

WEEKLY PRACTICE ACCESS/INTERVIEW AVAILABILITY

Coach Pitino and select Golden Gopher players will be made available for interviews the day before each game prior to practice. Requests for individual players should be submitted to Dan Reisig no less than 24 hours before scheduled availability, but are not guaranteed for availability.

POST-GAME INTERVIEWS

Minnesota complies with an equal-access policy. Following a 10-minute cooling-off period, postgame coaches' interviews are conducted in the Media Room, located on the second level of the east addition. Selected Minnesota student-athletes will be made available for post-game interviews in the Media Room. The Minnesota locker room is not open to the media. Generally, visiting team player interviews are conducted in the lower level hallway outside the visitor locker room.

Richard Pitino is in his sixth season as the 17th head coach of the University of Minnesota's Golden Gopher men's basketball team.

In his fifth season, Pitino saw the Gophers achieve several notable achievements. The Gophers were ranked nationally to begin the season and as high as 12th, while two individuals picked up All-Big Ten honors. Jordan Murphy earned his third straight All-Big Ten nod after a year in which he led the conference in rebounding and tied for the nation's lead in double-doubles (24). Nate Mason received All-Big Ten honorable mention after capping a career in which he ranked among the all-time Gophers.

The 2017 Big Ten Coach of the Year as voted by the league's media and head coaches, Pitino led the Gophers to a school-record 23 regular season wins and an NCAA appearance for the first time since 2013. Earning a No. 5 seed in the tournament - the Gophers' highest since 1982 - Pitino guided the Gophers to an 11-win Big Ten season, the most since the 1990 campaign. Four Gophers received All-Big Ten honors, including First Team selection Nate Mason and Defensive Player of the Year Reggie Lynch along with third teamer Jordan Murphy and All-Freshman selection Amir Coffey.

The 2016-17 season saw several accomplishments, including the selection of freshman Jordan Murphy to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. He was the Gophers' first honoree since 2005 and only the third ever. The Gophers also picked up signature victories over No. 6 Maryland at home, along with improving to 3-0 under Pitino in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge after a home victory over Clemson in November.

In 2015-16, the Gophers set a new school single-season record with 313 steals, passing the previous mark of 297 set in 2007-08. The team averaged 74.2 points per game, the highest since the 2001-02 season and the second straight season under head coach Richard Pitino that the Gophers have averaged more than 71 points per game. Two of his players garnered All-Big Ten honorable mentions in guard Andre Hollins (coaches & media) and Maurice Walker (media). In February, the Gophers defeated then-#25 and eventual Final Four team Michigan State in East Lansing for the first time since 1997 (later vacated) - the team's first road win over a top-25 team since 2012.

Pitino came to Gold Country after spending one season at the helm of the Florida International University (FIU) basketball program. Prior to his arrival in South Florida, FIU had not had a winning season since 1999-2000 and in the three seasons before his hiring posted a combined record of 26-65. In just one season, Pitino led the program to 18 wins, the fourth-most in program history, and its first appearance in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament championship game. FIU finished with 11 conference wins on the season, the most by a Panther team since joining the Sun Belt Conference.

Prior to leading FIU, Pitino served as the Associate Head Coach for one season and an assistant for two other seasons under his father, Rick, at Louisville. In three years overall with the Cardinals, he helped the program to a combined 88-25 record, a pair of NCAA Elite Eight berths (2008 and 2009) and one NCAA Final Four appearance (2012). His efforts also helped the Cards land two of top 15 recruiting classes in his three years (2007-08 and 2008-09). Pitino also spent time as an assistant for two seasons under Billy Donovan at Florida. In his time with the Gators, the club was a combined 50-20 with back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances, including reaching the 2011 NCAA Southeast Regional finals before falling to NCAA runner-up Butler.
