THE GAME: The University of Wisconsin-La Crosse travels to the University of Wisconsin Friday, November 1. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m. in the Kohl Center.

ON THE AIR: The game will be streamed on BTN+ and broadcast on the Badger Sports Network on iHeartRadio.

THE SERIES VS. THE BADGERS: Wisconsin leads the all-time regular-season series, 3-0, with UWL. The teams played in 1912-13, 1920-21, and 1921-22.

Wisconsin and UWL will be meeting for the second exhibition game. The Badgers earned a 84-59 win over the Eagles on November 6, 2010. Tony Mane led UWL with 24 points while Michael Hanson added 17.

EXHIBITION: Wisconsin is hosting an exhibition game with a member of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) for the 15th time in the last 16 seasons. Wisconsin earned a 78-44 victory over UW-Platteville in the first contest in 2004.

This year's game also marks the fourth annual Cancer Awareness Game featuring a partnership with Garding Against Cancer and the UW Carbone Cancer Center.

UWL hosted the Garding Against Cancer reception in UWL's Student Union on September 12.

LAST YEAR: UWL finished 17-10 overall and 10-4 in the WIAC in 2018-19, placing second in the league standings under head coach **Kent Dernbach**. It was the Eagles' highest finish in the WIAC since capturing the regular-season crown in 2015-16. UWL also hosted a WIAC Tournament Semifinal in 2018-19 for the first time since 2015-16. The 17 victories in 2018-19 were the most since finishing 17-10 in 2013-14.

The Eagles earned an at-large bid to the 2019 National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division III Championships, falling 80-66 to the University of St. Thomas (Minn.). UWL was one of 20 teams to earn an at-large bid to the national championships.

UWL went 4-3 against nationally-ranked opponents in 2018-19, including a 66-61 victory over third-ranked UW-Oshkosh. The win snapped UW-Oshkosh's 21-game winning streak and handed the Titans their first league loss of the season.

HEAD COACH: Kent Dernbach is in his third season as head coach at UW-La Crosse in 2019-20. Named head coach on March 12, 2018, Dernbach served as the Eagles' interim head coach for the 2017-18 season. He is 30-23 overall and 15-13 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) in his first two seasons at UWL.

Dernbach served as UW-Stevens Point's interim head coach for the last 13 games of the 2016-17 season, finishing with a 8-5 record.

UWL finished 17-10 overall and 10-4 in the WIAC in 2018-19, placing second in the league standings. It was the Eagles' highest finish in the WIAC since capturing the regular-season crown in 2015-16. UWL also hosted a WIAC Tournament Semifinal in 2018-19 for the first time since 2015-16. The 17 victories in 2018-19 were the most since finishing 17-10 in 2013-14.

The Eagles earned an at-large bid to the 2019 NCAA Division III Championship under Dernbach, the team's second appearance (2006, 2019) in school history. UWL was one of 20 teams to earn an at-large bid to the national championships.

The team went 4-3 against nationally-ranked opponents in 2018-19, including a 66-61 victory over third-ranked UW-Oshkosh. The win snapped UW-Oshkosh's 21-game winning streak and handed the Titans their first league loss of the season. UWL also secured the second-seed for the WIAC Tournament with the win.

The Eagles led the WIAC in steals (7.56 per game) and three-point field goal percentage defense (31.7%) in 2018-19 while ranking second in scoring defense (65.5), blocks (3.00 per game) and turnover margin (+2.37). The team was also third in free throw shooting (76.2%).

UWL finished 13-13 overall in Dernbach's first year as head coach, losing six games by three points or less. The Eagles led the WIAC in steals (9.08 per game), turnover margin (+3.08), turnovers forced per game (16.3) while ranking second in offensive rebounds (10.5) in 2017-18. UWL's 236 steals in 2017-18 ranks second in single-season school history.

The Eagles' **Ben Meinholz** and **Brendon Manning** were voted to the 2018-19 All-WIAC First Team, two of 11 players named to the team. It marked the second straight year Meinholz earned All-WIAC First Team honors while Manning was named to the 2017-18 All-WIAC Honorable Mention Team with **Taulvish McCray**. McCray was voted to the 2017-18 and 2018-19 All-WIAC Defensive Team, one of five players on the team each season.

Dernbach served as associate head coach at UW-Stevens Point from 2011-17. He was the Pointers' interim head coach for the last 13 games of the 2016-17 season, leading the team to an 8-5 record. UW-Stevens Point made four straight NCAA Division III Tournament appearances from 2012-15. His fourth season with the Pointers culminated in winning the national championship in 2014-15. UW-Stevens Point won three consecutive WIAC titles from 2013-15.

Prior to arriving at UW-Stevens Point, Dernbach was the director of basketball operations and an assistant coach at Northern Illinois University from 2009-11. He served as director of basketball operations at George Mason University (Va.) from 2007-09 and was an assistant coach at Marymount University (Va.) from 2005-07.

A native of Almond, Wisconsin, Dernbach earned his bachelor's

degree in sport management and psychology from Carthage College (Wis.) in 2004 and completed his master's degree in physical activity and educational services from The Ohio State University in 2006.

He was a two-year letter winner at Carthage (Wis.) as the Red Men went 46-8 overall and won a pair of College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin (CCIW) Championships. Carthage (Wis.) finished third in the 2002 NCAA Division III Tournament. Dernbach was an assistant boys' basketball coach at North Central High School (Salem, Wis.) in 2003-04 and at Whetstone High School (Columbus, Ohio) in 2004-05.

SEASON PREVIEW: UWL is predicted to finish third in the 2019-20 WIAC Preseason Poll conducted by the league's head coaches and sports information directors. The conference office announced the preseason poll October 29. UW-Oshkosh, the defending NCAA Division III champion, is the preseason choice to win the conference title.

UW-Platteville is slotted for second in this year's eight-team league race. The Pioneers are followed by UWL, UW-Stevens Point, UW-Whitewater, UW-River Falls, UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stout.

RETURNERS: Eight letter winners return in 2019-20, including one starter from a year ago. Senior forward **Terek Nesheim** of **Mount Horeb (H.S.)** played in all 27 games last season with 19 starts. He averaged 6.7 points and 2.1 rebounds per game while scoring in double figures in nine contests.

Other returning letter winners include senior guards **Sam Burkart** of **Xavier (H.S.)**, **Zac Haese** of **Wrightstown (H.S.)** and **Luke Norcia** of **Highland Park, Ill. (H.S.)** along with junior forward **Wyatt Cook** of **Pewaukee (H.S.)**, sophomore guards **Ethan Anderson** of **Black River Falls (H.S.)** and **Craig Steele** of **Portage (H.S.)** and sophomore forward **Seth Anderson** of **Marshfield (H.S.)**.

Burkart played in 26 games in 2018-19, averaging 3.1 points and 2.2 rebounds per game while Haese appeared in 18 games with one start and averaged 2.5 points and 1.2 rebounds. Norcia played in 11 games a year ago. Appearing in 20 games last season, Cook averaged 1.7 points and 1.3 rebounds while shooting 48.4% (15-of-31) from the field.

Ethan Anderson played in 25 games as a freshman, averaging 6.2 points per game. He tied for third on the team in three-point field goals made (20) while recording at least one three-point field goal in 14 games. Steele appeared in seven games in 2018-19 while Seth Anderson played in eight games.

NEWCOMERS: UWL welcomes eight newcomers to the 2019-20 squad, including three transfers. Junior guard **Sean Suchomel** of **Sun Prairie (H.S.)** earned two letters at Madison College (Wis.) while sophomore forward **Dylan Bunders** of **Almond (Almond-Bancroft)** earned one letter at St. Norbert College (Wis.) and sophomore forward **Jimmy Vollbrecht** of **Jordan, Minn. (H.S.)** earned one letter at the University of Minnesota-Duluth.

Five freshmen are on the roster, including guards **Henry Noone** of **Oshkosh (Lourdes)**, **Joey Platz** of **Brookfield (Marquette University)** and **Zion Turner** of **Wausau (D.C. Everest)** along with forwards **Cole Kleiner** of **Cuba City (H.S.)** and **Austin Westra** of **De Forest (H.S.)**.

TRANSFERS: Junior guard **Sean Suchomel** averaged 10.7 points, 5.2 rebounds and 3.5 assists at Madison College (Wis.) in 2018-19. He led the team in assists while ranking second in rebounding and steals and fourth in scoring while playing in 26 games with 23 starts. Playing in 28 games with 17 starts in 2017-18, Suchomel averaged 8.9 points, 5.9 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 1.3 steals per game.

Sophomore forward **Dylan Bunders** played in nine games at St. Norbert College (Wis.) in 2017-18 while sophomore forward **Jimmy Vollbrecht** appeared in six games at the University of Minnesota-Duluth in 2018-19. Bunders scored over 1,200 career points at Almond-Bancroft High School, earning all-state honors as a senior and honorable mention awards in his junior season. Vollbrecht was the Minnesota River Conference MVP in his senior season at Jordan (Minn.) High School after averaging 24.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game. He scored over 1,400 career points.

Along with Suchomel, Bunders and Vollbrecht, **Sam Burkart** and **Zac Haese** also transferred to UWL. Burkart played at UW-Milwaukee for two seasons, appearing in eight games. Haese earned two letters at Lindenwood University (Mo.), playing in 44 games while averaging 2.3 points per game.

FRESHMEN: **Henry Noone** earned All-State honors at Oshkosh Lourdes High School as a senior while being named the Trailways East Player of the Year. He averaged 21.3 points per game while shooting 58.0% from three-point range.

Joey Platz averaged 15.5 points per game while shooting 41.0% from three-point range in his senior season at Marquette University High School. He was an All-Greater Metro Conference First Team selection.

Averaging 23.0 points and 4.8 assists per game in his senior season at D.C. Everest High School, **Zion Turner** was selected to the All-Wisconsin Valley Conference First Team.

Cole Kleiner averaged 7.2 points per game as a senior at Cuba City

High School while earning All-Southwest Activities League (SWAL) Honorable Mention accolades.

Named the All-Badger North Conference Player of the Year in his season year at De Forest High School, **Austin Westra** averaged 17.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game. He earned first team all-state honors during his senior season.

ROAD RECORD: UWL is 13-11 on the road under head coach **Kent Dernbach**, including 7-5 last season.

HOME RECORD: UWL is 15-9 at home the last two seasons under head coach **Kent Dernbach**. The Eagles finished 9-3 in Mitchell Hall in 2018-19, matching their most since going 9-3 in 2015-16. UWL went 9-1 at home in 2013-14, its most home victories since finishing 10-3 in 2010-11.

TEAM SCORING: UWL averaged 69.0 points per game in 2018-19 after averaging 68.9 points in 2017-18. The Eagles scored a 2018-19 season-high 92 points in their win (92-72) over UW-Stout on January 2. The 92 points were the most since a season-opening 94-64 victory at Luther College (Iowa) on November 15, 2017 in **Kent Dernbach's** first game as head coach.

UWL had a season-low 51 points last year in a loss (61-51) to UW-Platteville in the WIAC Tournament Semifinal. The 51 points are the fewest under Dernbach.

SCORING DEFENSE: Opponents averaged 65.5 points per game in 2018-19 after averaging 66.5 in 2017-18. UW-Eau Claire scored an opponent season-low 39 points on January 9, 2019 in its 58-39 loss to UWL. The 39 points matched the fewest since North Park University (Ill.) fell 72-39 to UWL on December 22, 2011. Viterbo University (Wis.) scored 36 points in its 53-36 loss to UWL on November 22, 2011.

Central College (Iowa) scored an opponent season-high 89 points last year in its win (89-77) over UWL on December 1.

SHOOTING: UWL shot 44.8% from the field in 2018-19 after finishing at 44.4% in 2017-18 and 45.4% in 2016-17. The Eagles shot a season-high 55.2% (37-of-67) in their 92-72 victory over UW-Stout on January 2, 2019. UWL shot at least 48.0% from the field in nine games a year ago.

The team shot a season-low 30.9% (17-of-55) in a 61-52 loss to UW-Eau Claire on February 9, 2019.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING: The Eagles shot 31.6% (151-of-478) from three-point range last season after shooting 34.1% (178-of-522) in 2017-18. UWL had a season-high 12 three-point field goals made (season-high 32 attempts) in a 81-65 victory over Lake Forest College (Ill.) on December 28, 2018.

The team made at least six 3-point field goals in 11 different games a year ago.

UWL had a school record 20 three-point field goals made against MacMurray College (Ill.) on November 26, 2016 and school record 40 attempts versus UW-Stout on December 8, 2010.

The team was 249-of-610 (40.8%) from three-point range in 2013-14. The 249 three-point field goals made set a school record, breaking the mark of 242 established in 1990-91. The Eagles' 610 attempts ranks third in single-season school history. UWL had a school record 629 attempts in 1999-2000 while finishing with 616 in 2012-13.

MORE THREE-POINTERS: UWL has at least one three-point field goal made in 334 consecutive games and 461 of the last 462 overall. The Eagles missed all eight of their three-point attempts in a 69-56 victory at on UW-Platteville December 6, 2006, snapping a streak of 127 consecutive games with a three-point field goal. The Eagles didn't

have a three-point field goal in a 146-136 win over Grinnell College (Iowa) December 9, 2001, but the team also didn't attempt a three-point-er. Prior to the win over Grinnell, UWL had gone 152 consecutive games with a three-point field goal.

Prior to missing all eight three-point attempts in 2006 at UW-Platteville, the most recent game the Eagles didn't make a three-point field goal while attempting one came December 6, 1995 when they finished 0-of-11 at UW-Platteville, the same day as the game at UW-Platteville in 2006.

FREE THROW SHOOTING: UWL shot 76.2% (330-of-433) at the free throw line last season after 70.9% (261-of-368) in 2017-18. The 76.2% shooting is tied for third in single-season school history. UWL shot a school record 77.0% (475-of-617) in 1984-85. The Eagles set single-game highs a year ago in free throws made (28) and attempted (34) in a 82-63 win at UW-Whitewater on January 26, 2019.

REBOUNDING: Opponents outrebounded UW-L, 33.2 to 33.0, last season. The Eagles were 12-2 last year when outrebounding their opponent and 4-7 when the opponent held the advantage. UWL was 1-1 in 2018-19 when the rebounding totals were even.

AT THE HALF: UWL went 10-1 when leading at halftime last season and 6-8 when trailing. The Eagles were 1-1 in 2018-19 when the game was tied at halftime.

TEAM NOTES: UWL averaged 10.2 assists and 10.9 turnovers per game last year ... The Eagles had a season-high 19 assists in a 86-77 victory over Wartburg College (Iowa) on December 9, 2018 ... The team had at least 10 assists in 14 different games last season ... UWL had a season-high 16 turnovers in a 60-58 loss at UW-River Falls on February 6, 2019 ... The Eagles recorded double-digit turnovers in 21 contests a year ago ... UWL averaged 7.6 steals and 3.0 blocks per game in 2018-19 ... The team had a season-high 14 steals at UW-River Falls on February 6, 2019 and season-high eight blocks against Buena Vista University (Iowa) on December 8, 2018 ... The Eagles recorded at least one block in all 27 games last season.

NEXT UP: UWL opens its regular-season Tuesday, November 12 at Bethel University (Minn.) at 7:45 p.m. The Eagles' home opener is Tuesday, November 26 versus Augsburg University (Minn.) at 7 p.m.
