BADGERS CONTINUE OPENING HOMESTAND

- Coming off a 65-52 win over Eastern Illinois last Friday night, Wisconsin continues its homestand this week hosting McNeese State on Wednesday.
- Led by reigning Big Ten Player of the Week Nate Reuvers posting a near triple-double (14p, 14r, 9b), the Badgers won last week's home opener for the 21st time in the last 22 seasons.
- Up next, Wisconsin hosts in-state rival Marquette at the Kohl Center on Sunday for a noon tip on FS1. Fans are encouraged to wear white on Sunday as the rivalry game will serve as this season's "White Out" game.



Reigning Big Ten Player of the Week Nate Reuvers is averaging **18 points, 10 rebounds and 6.5 blocks per game this season.**

FAST BREAK FACTS

- Wisconsin begins its 123rd season of men's basketball in 2019-20 and the 5th with Greg Gard as the head coach. Gard has led the Badgers to a mark of 81-48 (.628) overall, the 3rd-highest win percentage in program history.
- The Badgers return 6 of their top 8 scorers from a year ago when they went 23-11 overall and 14-6 in the Big Ten, earning a No. 5 seed in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- In total, Wisconsin returns 61.9% (1,443 of 2,333 points) of its scoring from last season, led by returning starters **D'Mitrik Trice** (11.6 ppg), **Brad Davison** (10.5 ppg) and **Nate Reuvers** (7.9 ppg). UW returns 69.7% of its minutes played (4,828 of 6,924).
- In the first four seasons under head coach **Greg Gard**, Wisconsin has tallied 4 wins over top-five teams, the most in the Big Ten during that span. UW has 7 wins over AP Top 10 teams (7-8, .467).
- Gard has led the Badgers to the NCAA tournament in 3 of his first 4 seasons as head coach, making him one of only 10 active coaches to do so.
Gard (Wisconsin), Jim Boeheim (Syracuse), Mark Few (Gonzaga), Bob Huggins (West Virginia), Lon Kruger (Oklahoma), Matt Painter (Purdue), Steve Prohm (Iowa State), Bill Self (Kansas), Mike White

(Florida) and Roy Williams (North Carolina).

- Wisconsin is 1 of just 5 teams to participate in 20 of the last 21 NCAA tournaments, joined by Duke, Kansas, Michigan State & Gonzaga.

The Badgers are 1 of 3 teams to reach the Sweet 16 in 6 of the last 9 seasons (2011, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017).

Kansas and Kentucky are the only other 2 schools to reach 6 of the last 9 seasons.

- Including last season, Wisconsin has won at least 20 games in 15 of the last 17 years, equaling Michigan State for the most 20-win seasons in the Big Ten over that span.

UW finished 4th in the Big Ten last season.

- UW players have earned 16 first-team All-Big Ten honors over the last 18 seasons. That is 3 more than any other team in the conference.

- Since opening in 1998, the Kohl Center is among the toughest venues for road teams to come in and steal a win. UW's .854 home win percentage at the Kohl Center is tied for 9th among active venues.

Gard's teams are 47-14 (.770) at the Kohl Center.

SERIES VS. MCNEESE STATE

- Friday's game marks the first-ever meeting between Wisconsin and McNeese State.
- UW holds a 7-0 all-time record against teams from the Southland Conference.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Including last Friday's 65-52 win over Eastern Illinois, the Badgers have won 21 of their last 22 home openers dating back to 1998-99.
- Wisconsin is beginning its 23rd season in the Kohl Center, sporting a record of 298-51 (.854) all-time in that building.
- Since 2001-02 when Greg Gard first joined the staff, UW has compiled a 262-38 (.874) record at the Kohl Center.
- Over the last 15 seasons, 195 of the Badgers' 262 home wins have come by at least 10 points (74.4 percent).
- This season, Wisconsin sold out its 2,100-person "AreaRED" student section for the seventh straight season.
 - AreaRED is the 3rd-largest student section in the Big Ten

- Since the Kohl Center opened in 1998, Wisconsin has been nearly unbeatable on its home floor. In fact, among active venues, the Kohl Center is among the toughest for road teams to come in and steal a win.

REUVERS ON THE RISE

- With the departure of Ethan Happ, **Nate Reuvers** figures to take on a bigger workload for Wisconsin this season. So far, the junior forward has shown he's ready for the role.
- Reuvers ranks 10th in the Big Ten in scoring (18.0 ppg), 7th in rebounding (10.0 rpg) and leads the Big Ten averaging 6.5 blocks per game. No Big Ten TEAM has more blocks than Reuvers (13).
 - Against Eastern Illinois, Reuvers finished 1 block shy of his first career triple-double, tallying 14 points, a career-high 14 rebounds and 9 blocks.
 - He is the first Big Ten player since at least 1996-97 to record at least 14 points, 14 rebounds and 9 blocks in a game.
 - Reuvers matched a UW school record with 9 blocked shots, equaling his 9-block effort last season vs. Stanford and Brad Sellers, who had 9 vs. Toledo in 1982.



4 MOORE

On the night of May 25th, our Wisconsin basketball family was forever changed. Assistant coach Howard Moore and his family were involved in a horrific auto accident that claimed the lives of Moore's wife, Jen, and 9-year old daughter, Jaidyn.

■ His 13-year old son, Jerell, survived with minor injuries, while Moore sustained severe burns and later endured a heart attack that has left him facing a long and challenging recovery.

■ Throughout the season, our team will be honoring the Moore family through a simple motto:

DO MOORE. BE MOORE. 4 MOORE.

■ The number 4 represents the four members of the family. The six words represent far more than a saying, but instead a symbol of strength and an inspiration for how to live our lives.

■ Our game uniforms will feature a "4MOORE" patch, (includes the names of Jen and Jaidyn). Also featuring on shooting shirts & wristbands.

■ An assistance fund has been established with the name "The Howard Moore Family Fund." Text the word "MOORE," to 69050 to donate.

■ Reuvers also shined in UW's season opener vs. #20 Saint Mary's, matching a career high with 22 points. He also tallied 6 rebounds and 4 blocks playing a career high 42 minutes.

■ With 13 blocks in 2 games, Reuvers now has 99 in his career, tying Marcus Landry for 8th place on the Badgers' all-time list.

■ Among players who have played in multiple games, Reuvers leads the NCAA this season averaging 6.5 blocks per contest.














WHO'S NEXT AT WISCONSIN?

- Wisconsin basketball is built on player development and a tradition of having its next star player waiting in the wings.
- Including Ethan Happ last season, Wisconsin players have earned 16 first-team all-conference honors during the last 18 seasons – no Big Ten team has had more. The Badgers have boasted a first-team All-Big Ten player in 8 of the last 9 seasons.

PLAYING THE BEST

- Wisconsin's season opener against #20 Saint Mary's tipped off what will be a challenging non-conference schedule for the Badgers this season.
- Wisconsin's non-conference slate features 3 teams that made the NCAA tournament last season: Saint Mary's, Marquette and Tennessee.
 - Could also face Auburn (at the Legends Classic)
- UW's non-conference schedule ranks as the 12th-toughest in the nation, according to a system developed by Matt Norlander/CBS Sports.
 - The formula's point system takes into consideration games: vs. preseason top-25 KenPom teams (2 points), vs. preseason 26-50 KenPom teams (1), road games (2), neutral-court (1), vs. 2019 NCAA tournament teams (0.5), sub-200 KenPom teams (-1).

- The Badgers are one of 3 teams to reach the Sweet 16 in 6 of the last 9 seasons, advancing to the tournament's second weekend in 2011, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017. Kansas and Kentucky are the only other 2 schools to reach 6 of the last 9 seasons.
- UW has won 13 NCAA tournament games since 2014, equaling the most of any Big Ten team and 6th-highest total in the nation. Only Kentucky, UNC, Gonzaga, Villanova and Duke have more.

- Wisconsin won its home opener for the 21st time in the last 22 seasons with a 65-52 win over Eastern Illinois.
- The Badgers used an 15-0 spurt in the second half to put the game away. During that run, UW held EIU scoreless for a span of 6:06.
- UW went 20-for-24 at the free throw line, while EIU was just 3-for-8.
- Wisconsin limited Eastern Illinois to just 33.3% shooting, the second consecutive opponent UW has held below 40%.
- **Nate Reuvers** finished 1 block shy of his first career triple-double, tallying 14 points, a career-high 14 rebounds and matching the school record with 9 blocks.
- **Kobe King** scored a career-high 18 points and matched his personal-best with 6 rebounds. King went 8-for-10 from the free throw line, both establishing new career bests.
- **Aleem Ford** finished with 11 points, reaching double-figures for the 10th time in his career.

■ **D'Mitrik Trice | Junior | Guard**

Trice has had a big impact at Wisconsin since stepping onto campus in 2016. With 81 games and 46 starts under his belt, Trice is the most experienced Badger on the roster. Now in his redshirt junior season, Trice has developed into a threat on both ends of the court. Trice started all 34 games in 2018-19, earning All-Big Ten honorable mention after averaging 11.6 points per game, 39% 3FG shooting and 2.8 assists per game. The Huber Heights, Ohio native projects be one of UW's leaders, both on and off the court and is poised for a productive junior season.

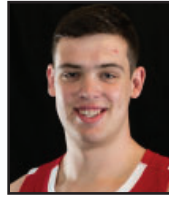

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

■ 2016 JIM PHELAN NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR

A coaching veteran of nearly 30 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard has led the Badgers to the NCAA tournament in three of his four seasons, including a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in each of his first two seasons. Owner of one of the highest win percentages in Wisconsin history, Gard now enters his fifth season as the head coach in 2019-20.

After initially taking over on an interim basis, Gard was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. In four seasons, he owns the third-highest winning percentage in UW history, piloting the Badgers to a record of 80-47 (.630).

In just four seasons as head coach, Gard is quickly climbing Wisconsin's win charts. Gard is already 45-29 in Big Ten play, surpassing Dick Bennett for seventh on UW's all-time wins list. He enters 2019-20 just eight conference wins away from fourth place on the school's all-time ledger. Gard's .608 Big Ten win percentage equates to the third-best mark in Badger annals.

Gard reached 40 conference wins in a mere 66 games, making him the third-fastest active Big Ten coach to 40 conference wins. That number trails only Maryland's Mark Turgeon and MSU's Tom Izzo, who did it in 57 and 62 games, respectively.

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to its fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

Wisconsin maintained its place among the top of the Big Ten during the transition to Gard as well. In his first season, the Badgers finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would post another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin

would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 2018-19, Gard piloted the Badgers back to the Big Dance, posting a 23-11 overall record. Wisconsin also boasted a mark of 14-6 in Big Ten play, winning 14 conference games for just the third time in school history, joining 16-win seasons in 2008 and 2015.

In 18 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings just once while amassing a combined mark of 217-97 (.691) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes (2016) and third-team All-American Ethan Happ (2017, '18, '19).

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. In 2015, Gard was ranked as the fourth-best "X&O" assistant coach in college basketball by coachstat.net. In 2012, Gard was named No. 3 on the list of top assistant coaches in college basketball according to Bleacher Report. FOX Sports also listed Gard No. 10 on its list of the nation's top 25 assistant coaches.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at UW-Milwaukee and served as an assistant coach at UW-Platteville from 1993-99.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School and one at Platteville High School, where he served in junior high and assistant varsity coaching capacities.

In 2016, Gard and his wife, Michelle, partnered with the University of the Wisconsin and Wisconsin Foundation and Alumni Association, to launch Garding Against Cancer. This fundraising initiative raises funds and awareness for cancer research and care within the state of Wisconsin. In its first two years of hosting fundraising events across the state, GAC raised more than \$2 million dollars in the fight against cancer.

Gard is a 1995 graduate of UW-Platteville with a degree in physical and health education. He received a master's degree in counselor education from Platteville in 2007. Gard and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters, Mackenzie and Peyton, and a son, Isaac.
