BADGERS HOST IN-STATE RIVAL MARQUETTE

- Winners of 11 straight non-conference home games, Wisconsin hosts Interstate 94 rival Marquette at the Kohl Center on Sunday.
- The Badgers and Golden Eagles meet for the 126th time (dates back to 1917). UW has a 67-58 advantage in the all-time series, but the 2 schools have split the last 10 matchups.
- Wisconsin is just 1 win shy of claiming its 300th victory at the Kohl Center (299-51, .854 all-time), a venue that opened in Jan. of 1998. The Badgers' .854 win percentage is the 9th-highest among all NCAA Div. 1 venues.



Reigning Big Ten Player of the Week Nate Reuvers is averaging 15.3 points, 8.0 rebounds and 4.7 blocks per game this season.

FAST BREAK FACTS

- In his 5th season at helm, **Greg Gard** has led the Badgers to a mark of 82-48 (.631) overall, the 3rd-highest win percentage in program history.
 Under Gard, UW has tallied 4 wins over top-5 teams, the most in the Big Ten during that span. UW has 7 wins over AP Top 10 teams (7-8, .467).
- The Badgers return 6 of their top 8 scorers from a year ago when they went 23-11 overall and 14-6 in the Big Ten, earning a No. 5 seed in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
 In total, Wisconsin returns 61.9% (1,443 of 2,333 points) of its scoring from last season, led by returning starters **D'Mitrik Trice** (11.6 ppg), **Brad Davison** (10.5 ppg) and **Nate Reuvers** (7.9 ppg). UW returns 69.7% of its minutes played (4,828 of 6,924).
- UW has displayed balanced scoring this season, with 7 different players averaging at least 7.0 points per game: .
- Wisconsin ranks 2nd in the Big Ten shooting 79.0% (49-for-62) at the free throw line this season, averaging 20.7 FTAs per game. Both are improvements from a year ago when the Badgers shot 64.8% and averaged 15.6 FTAs per game.
- The Badgers rank 33rd in the NCAA in adjusted defensive efficiency according to KenPom.com. UW has finished among the NCAA's top-15 in defensive efficiency in 3 of Gard's 4 seasons, including No. 4 in 2018-19.
- Gard has led the Badgers to the NCAA tournament in 3 of his first 4 seasons as head coach, making him one of only 10 active coaches to do so.
Gard (Wisconsin), Jim Boeheim (Syracuse), Mark Few (Gonzaga), Bob Huggins (West Virginia), Lon Kruger (Oklahoma), Matt Painter (Purdue), Steve Prohm (Iowa State), Bill Self (Kansas), Mike White (Florida) and Roy Williams (North Carolina).
- Wisconsin is 1 of just 5 teams to participate in 20 of the last 21 NCAA tournaments, joined by Duke, Kansas, Michigan State & Gonzaga.
 The Badgers are 1 of 3 teams to reach the Sweet 16 in 6 of the last 9 seasons (2011, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017).
 Kansas and Kentucky are the only other 2 schools to reach 6 of the last 9 seasons.
- UW players have earned 16 first-team All-Big Ten honors over the last 18 seasons. That is 3 more than any other team in the conference.

BALANCED BADGERS

■ Wisconsin has displayed balanced scoring, with 7 different Badgers averaging at least 7.0 points per game and 5 players at 9.0+ ppg:

- **Brad Davison** (16.0 ppg), **Nate Reuvers** (15.3), **Kobe King** (12.0), **Aleem Ford** (11.3) and **Walt McGrory** (9.0).

■ The last time UW had at least 5 players averaging 9.0+ ppg was in 2002-03, when Kirk Penney (16.2 ppg), Devin Harris (12.7), Alando Tucker (12.0), Freddie Owens (10.3) and Mike Wilkinson (10.3) all did.

UW won the Big Ten championship that year.

REUVERS ON THE RISE

■ With the departure of Ethan Happ, **Nate Reuvers** figures to take on a bigger workload for Wisconsin this season. So far, the junior forward has shown he's ready for the role.

■ Reuvers ranks 12th in the Big Ten in both scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (8.0 rpg), while leading the Big Ten and ranking 4th in the nation with 4.7 blocks per game.

■ vs. EIU, Reuvers finished 1 block shy of his first career triple-double, tallying 14 points, a career-high 14 rebounds and 9 blocks.

- He's the first B1G player since at least 1996-97 with 14 pts, 14 reb and 9 blk in a game.

■ Reuvers matched a UW record with 9blks, equaling his 9-blk effort last season vs. Stanford and Brad Sellers (9 vs. Toledo, 1982).

■ Reuvers also shined in UW's season opener vs. #20 Saint Mary's, matching a career high with 22 points. He also tallied 6 rebounds and 4 blocks playing a career high 42 minutes.

■ With 14 blocks in 3 games, Reuvers now has 100 in his career, surpassing Marcus Landry for sole possession of 8th place on UW's all-time list.

- He's 2 blocks from tying Kurt Portmann (7th) and only 54 away from Ethan Happ's school record 154 blocked shots.

WHO'S NEXT AT WISCONSIN?

■ Wisconsin basketball is built on player development and a tradition of having its next star player waiting in the wings.

■ Including Ethan Happ last season, Wisconsin players have earned 16 first-team all-conference honors during the last 18 seasons – no Big Ten team has had more. The Badgers have boasted a first-team All-Big Ten player in 8 of the last 9 seasons.

4 MOORE

On the night of May 25th, our Wisconsin basketball family was forever changed. Assistant coach Howard Moore and his family were involved in a horrific auto accident that claimed the lives of Moore's wife, Jen, and 9-year old daughter, Jaidyn.

■ His 13-year old son, Jerell, survived with minor injuries, while Moore sustained severe burns and later endured a heart attack that has left him facing a long and challenging recovery.

■ Throughout the season, our team will be honoring the Moore family through a simple motto:

DO MOORE. BE MOORE. 4 MOORE.

■ The number 4 represents the four members of the family. The six words represent far more than a saying, but instead a symbol of strength and an inspiration for how to live our lives.

■ Our game uniforms will feature a "4MOORE" patch, (includes the names of Jen and Jaidyn). Also featuring on shooting shirts & wristbands.

■ An assistance fund has been established with the name "The Howard Moore Family Fund." Text the word "MOORE," to 69050 to donate.

■ During that same time span, Wisconsin has also produced 76 Academic All-Big Ten honors, a figure that trails only Purdue and Northwestern in the Big Ten over that span.

DAVISON TAKES THE LEAD

■ Team captain **Brad Davison** is leading the Badgers on the court as well as off. Through 3 games, Davison leads UW and ranks 10th in the Big Ten averaging 16.0 ppg. He is also 2nd on the team with 6 assists and leads the Badgers with 5 steals.

■ Davison paces the Badgers in every shooting category on the year.

- Shooting 59.3% overall, including 12-for-17 on 2-point shots
- Shooting 40.0% from 3-point range, going 4-for-10
- Shooting 92.3% from the foul line (12-13)

■ In the win over McNeese State, Davison scored a season-high 24 points on 7-for-8 shooting overall, 3-for-4 from 3-point range and 7-for-7 at the FT line. Davison reached the 20-point threshold for the 6th time in his career. Davison also matched his career-high with 4 steals.

■ Davison has scored 804 career points, needing 196 to become UW's 43rd 1,000-point scorer.

SERIES VS. MARQUETTE

Wisconsin and Marquette renew one of the best rivalries in college basketball on Sunday. Separated by just 75 miles, the Badgers and Golden Eagles meet for the 126th time in a series that began in 1917. UW and MU have played every year but one since the 1958-59 season.

■ Overall, Wisconsin owns a 67-58 advantage in the series, making Marquette the Badgers' most played non-conference foe.

■ In Madison, UW holds a 38-18 edge.

■ UW won the first-ever meeting in 1917, 15-14, on a controversial free throw from All-American William Chandler in the final seconds. MU unsuccessfully protested that the corresponding foul had occurred after time expired. Ironically, Chandler would later serve as the head coach at Marquette from 1930-51.

■ Brad Davison (Maple Grove, Minn.) is childhood friends and prep rivals with Marquette's Theo John (Minneapolis).

MILWAUKEE, WIS. — Wisconsin was unable to overcome cold outside shooting in a 74-69 overtime loss at Marquette.

■ The game featured 13 lead changes and the largest lead by either team was 6 points.

■ Wisconsin shot 50.0% overall, but went just 5-for-24 from 3-point range and 10-for-21 at the free throw line.

■ The Badgers held Marquette to 35.4% shooting overall and 33.3% from outside the arc. However, MU out-rebounded UW, 14-3, on the offensive glass, resulting in a 12-2 edge on second-chance points.

■ The Golden Eagles went 22-for-34 at the free throw line, attempting 15 more FTAs than any other UW opponent this season.

■ Happ scored a career-high 34 points with 11 rebounds. Nate Reuvers (11) and D'Mitrik Trice (10) also finished in double figures.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

■ 2016 JIM PHELAN NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR

A coaching veteran of nearly 30 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard has led the Badgers to the NCAA tournament in three of his four seasons, including a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in each of his first two seasons. Owner of one of the highest win percentages in Wisconsin history, Gard now enters his fifth season as the head coach in 2019-20.

After initially taking over on an interim basis, Gard was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. In four seasons, he owns the third-highest winning percentage in UW history, piloting the Badgers to a record of 80-47 (.630).

In just four seasons as head coach, Gard is quickly climbing Wisconsin's win charts. Gard is already 45-29 in Big Ten play, surpassing Dick Bennett for seventh on UW's all-time wins list. He enters 2019-20 just eight conference wins away from fourth place on the school's all-time ledger. Gard's .608 Big Ten win percentage equates to the third-best mark in Badger annals.

Gard reached 40 conference wins in a mere 66 games, making him the third-fastest active Big Ten coach to 40 conference wins. That number trails only Maryland's Mark Turgeon and MSU's Tom Izzo, who did it in 57 and 62 games, respectively.

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to its fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

Wisconsin maintained its place among the top of the Big Ten during the transition to Gard as well. In his first season, the Badgers finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would post another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin

would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 2018-19, Gard piloted the Badgers back to the Big Dance, posting a 23-11 overall record. Wisconsin also boasted a mark of 14-6 in Big Ten play, winning 14 conference games for just the third time in school history, joining 16-win seasons in 2008 and 2015.

In 18 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings just once while amassing a combined mark of 217-97 (.691) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes (2016) and third-team All-American Ethan Happ (2017, '18, '19).

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. In 2015, Gard was ranked as the fourth-best "X&O" assistant coach in college basketball by coachstat.net. In 2012, Gard was named No. 3 on the list of top assistant coaches in college basketball according to Bleacher Report. FOX Sports also listed Gard No. 10 on its list of the nation's top 25 assistant coaches.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at UW-Milwaukee and served as an assistant coach at UW-Platteville from 1993-99.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School and one at Platteville High School, where he served in junior high and assistant varsity coaching capacities.

In 2016, Gard and his wife, Michelle, partnered with the University of the Wisconsin and Wisconsin Foundation and Alumni Association, to launch Garding Against Cancer. This fundraising initiative raises funds and awareness for cancer research and care within the state of Wisconsin. In its first two years of hosting fundraising events across the state, GAC raised more than \$2 million dollars in the fight against cancer.

Gard is a 1995 graduate of UW-Platteville with a degree in physical and health education. He received a master's degree in counselor education from Platteville in 2007. Gard and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters, Mackenzie and Peyton, and a son, Isaac.
