The Marquette University men's basketball team (2-0, 0-0 BIG EAST) hits the road for the first time in 2019-20 when the squad travels to rival Wisconsin (2-1, 0-0 Big Ten) for a 12 p.m. CT tip at the Kohl Center. FS1 will feature the national television broadcast, with Brian Anderson (play-by-play) and Bill Raftery (analyst) calling the action. Following Sunday's outing, the Golden Eagles will have a week off prior to hosting Robert Morris at 1 p.m. CT on Saturday, Nov. 23 at Fiserv Forum.

## All-Time Series Dates Back To 1917

Marquette's all-time series with Wisconsin dates back to 1917, with the first meeting coming in just MU's second season of competition.

Wisconsin owns a 67-58 edge in the previous matchups, with each squad enjoying an extended run of success at various points in the series. Marquette's best streak came between 1969 and 1984 when the team claimed 15-straight wins and 19-of-21 overall.

MU has met Wisconsin and DePaul more times (125) than any other opponent in program history.

The Golden Eagles have claimed three of the last four overall outings in the annual home-and-home series and have also been victorious in three of their last four visits to the Kohl Center.

In the most recent matchup, Marquette posted a 74-69 home victory in overtime on Dec. 8, 2018. Guard Markus Howard led the way with 27 points and forward Ed Morrow blocked a layup by UW's Ethan Happ in the closing seconds of regulation to force overtime.

In the latest trip to Madison, Howard and backcourt mate Andrew Rowsey combined for 47 points and nine 3-pointers in an 82-63 win on Dec. 9, 2017.

Traditionally played prior to Marquette's finals week in December, the matchup has been moved up to accommodate the expanded Big Ten Conference schedule. The two programs haven't met in November since the 1997-98 campaign.

## Defense, McEwen Help MU Rally Against Purdue

Marquette trailed by as many as 18 points in the first half before rallying to win 65-55 over Purdue, thanks in large part to a strong second half at the defensive end and guard Koby McEwen's production on offense.

The Golden Eagles held the Boilermakers to just 20 percent (5-of-25) shooting following intermission, including a 1-of-10 effort from behind the 3-point line. MU also reversed the battle on the boards, allowing just four offensive rebounds on the 20 missed shot attempts after giving up 12 second-chance opportunities in the first half.

Offensively, McEwen did the heavy lifting in the second stanza, outscoring Purdue 18-17 over the course of the final 20 minutes. The Toronto, Ontario, native now owns 19 career 20-point games (previous 18 at Utah State). He netted 18 of his 23 total points after halftime and also chipped in five rebounds and four assists in 37 minutes of action.

## Cain Makes Presence Felt In Latest Outing

Junior forward Jamal Cain was a key contributor in Marquette's win over Purdue on Wednesday night, resulting in extended playing time.

The Pontiac, Michigan, native's 27 minutes matched his season high from 2018-19 (27 vs. Southern, Dec. 28, 2018) and he has seen more action on just a handful of occasions in his 65 career appearances.

Cain chipped in six points, seven rebounds and a blocked shot off the bench and was on the court for nearly 15 minutes of the second half when Marquette rallied for the win.

## Howard Makes Quick Work Of Scoring Record

Senior guard Markus Howard entered the season opener 31 points away from becoming the program's all-time leading scorer and had many Marquette fans targeting the matchup with Purdue as the likely game he would move into the top spot.

The Chandler, Arizona, native had other ideas, however, netting 30 points in the first half versus Loyola Maryland and scoring the record-setting points on a transition 3-point-er with 19:07 left in the second half. Howard finished the game with 38 points and is now Marquette's top scorer with 2,011 points-and-counting.

Howard is just the fifth player in BIG EAST history to collect 1,000 career points in league play in three seasons. He joined Pat Garrity (Notre Dame), Dominique Jones (USF), Richard Hamilton (UConn) and Ray Allen (UConn) in the exclusive group and has a chance to become the league's top scorer (Lawrence Moten, Syracuse, 1,405).

## Theo John Blocks Where He Left Off In 2018-19

Junior forward Theo John established himself as one of the top shot blockers in the country in 2018-19 and was quick to remind everyone he was ready to continue that reputation in 2019-20.

John swatted a career-best eight shot attempts in the win over Loyola Maryland, tying the second-best single-game total in school history. It's the most since Amal McCaskill has eight blocks against Virginia Tech on Jan. 17, 1995.

The Minneapolis native finished first in the BIG EAST and 34th in the nation in blocked shots (2.1 bpg.) last season. His total of 70 thwarted field goal attempts (at least one in 26 games) as a sophomore is the seventh-best mark in program history.

John (8th, 105) has plenty of work to do if he wants to top the MU career list. Jim McIlvaine (1991-94) currently owns that honor with his 399 swats, which is tied for 21st all-time in NCAA history. McIlvaine also owns the single-game record of 13 blocks (vs. Northeastern Illinois, Dec. 8, 1992).

## Anim Poised To Continue Development

Senior forward Sacar Anim might not be the team's most experienced player in terms of career games played (Markus Howard, 101), but he is the longest-tenured member of the roster.

The Minneapolis, Minnesota, native played sparingly as a freshman in 2015-16 before redshirting in 2017-18 to focus on skill development. He has become a mainstay in the starting lineup, on the court for the opening tip in 64-of-71 contests over the course of the past two seasons.

Anim has increased his production in each of his three seasons, chipping in 8.3 points and 3.1 rebounds per contest in 2018-19 while shooting nearly 40.0 percent from behind the 3-point line.

## Foreign Tour Gives MU Jump On 2019-20

The Golden Eagles were able to get a jump start on the 2019-20 campaign with a foreign tour in early August to Spain and France.

The travel party made stops in Barcelona and Paris during the 10-day excursion, and the itinerary included stops in Normandy and the Spanish coast and exposure to cultural experiences throughout the trip.

Marquette finished the game schedule 3-0 against all-star teams from both countries and also took advantage of the 10 full practices allowed leading up to the trip.

## BIG EAST Conference Celebrates 40 Years

The BIG EAST Conference, which was established on May 29, 1979, will celebrate its 40th season during the 2019-20 campaign.

The official release, written by future commissioner Mike Tranghese in 1979, states that "the new league brings together seven nationally prominent teams that are committed to producing the best basketball league in the East. Over the last 10 years the seven schools have qualified on 24 occasions for the NCAA basketball championship."

The seven original BIG EAST members were Boston College, the University of Connecticut, Georgetown University, Providence College, Seton Hall University, St. John's University and Syracuse University. Villanova University was added one year later.

Today, the conference is thriving in its 10-school configuration that began in 2013-14 when Butler, Creighton and Xavier joined. Marquette and DePaul were added for the 2005-06 season.

## Howard Member Of NCAA Oversight Committee

Junior guard Markus Howard was named to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee as a non-voting member during the 2017-18 campaign and will serve his term through June of 2020.

The committee is comprised of coaches and administrators from across the country, including Purdue head coach Matt Painter and Butler AD Barry Collier. The only other student-athlete in the group is Romaro Gill of Seton Hall.

The Men's Basketball Oversight Committee will ensure that appropriate oversight of men's basketball is maintained, will enhance the development and public perception of the sport and make recommendations related to regular-season and postseason men's basketball. The committee will prioritize enhancement of the student-athlete educational experience (academically and athletically), and in doing so, promote student-athletes' personal growth and leadership development.

## Steve Wojciechowski

Head Coach | Sixth Season  
Duke, 1998

The 2019-20 campaign will mark the sixth at Marquette University for head coach Steve Wojciechowski, who has enjoyed a wealth of success in collegiate basketball as both a player and a coach.

Wojciechowski (pronounced woe-ju-HOW-skee) was introduced as the program's 17th head coach on April 1, 2014 by Marquette University President Dr. Michael R. Lovell.

From the moment he arrived on campus, Wojciechowski established his "Win Every Day" philosophy as the foundation for the Marquette program. That approach has been extremely successful on the recruiting trail, where the MU staff assembled back-to-back nationally ranked recruiting classes in 2015 and 2016.

MU made its third-consecutive postseason appearance in 2018-19, earning a No. 5 seed in the NCAA tournament following a 24-win campaign and second-place finish in the BIG EAST Conference. The Golden Eagles were ranked among the top-10 programs in the country during the season and concluded the year as one of the most improved defensive rosters in the nation. MU also finished ninth nationally in attendance in the team's first year at Fiserv Forum, marking the best finish in program history.

The Golden Eagles competed in the postseason for the second-straight year in 2017-18, advancing to the quarterfinals of the National Invitation Tournament (NIT). MU finished with a 21-win season and the roster featured all-conference performers Markus Howard and Andrew Rowsey. Marquette's offensive attack was one of the top performers in the country and among the numerous records to fall was the program's all-time 3-point field goals made mark.

Marquette returned to the NCAA tournament in 2016-17, thanks in large part to one of the most productive offensive attacks in the country. The roster featured a pair of all-conference honorees (Howard and Rowsey) and the campaign was highlighted by the program's first-ever regular season win over the top-ranked team (Villanova).

The Golden Eagles collected a 20-win campaign in 2015-16 under Wojciechowski and advanced to the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Conference Tournament. The team's on-court success was led by Henry Ellenson, the league's freshman of the year and first-round NBA Draft selection by the Detroit Pistons. Ellenson was the program's first McDonald's All-America honoree in over 30 years and a top-10 rated prospect.

The Golden Eagles claimed their first win under Wojciechowski in the season opener in 2014-15. The 79-63 win over UT Martin at the BMO Harris Bradley Center was his first as a head coach at the NCAA Division I level. The season also produced wins over Georgia Tech, Tennessee and Arizona State.

Wojciechowski, 42, had previously served as an assistant coach at Duke since the 1999-2000 season and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2008. As a player and coach, he was a part of Duke's winning tradition, serving on the coaching staff for two NCAA tournament champions. During his tenure, the Blue Devils posted an incredible 441-92 record and competed in the NCAA tournament every year.

Wojciechowski also served as court coach and scout for the USA Basketball Men's National Team. He helped lead on-court duties as well as game preparation from 2006-12, including the program's gold-medal performance at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics. The Olympic teams included NBA greats such as Marquette alumnus Dwyane Wade, Kobe Bryant and LeBron James.

### Earning national titles

In 2001, in his second year as an assistant at Duke, Wojciechowski and the Blue Devils won the national championship. The team also captured the Atlantic Coast Conference regular season and tournament crowns and posted a 35-4 record.

Wojciechowski saw one of his former teammates and pupils, Shane Battier, earn the consensus National Player of the Year award in 2001 as well as National Defensive Player of the Year for the third consecutive season.

Wojciechowski achieved repeated success at the highest level with an NCAA title in the 2009-10 season as associate head coach. On the road to the championship, the Blue Devils also won the ACC Tournament, the ACC Regular Season and NIT Season Tip-Off titles. Defense and rebounding were key for the Blue Devils who had one of the nation's top defenses, holding opponents to 61.0 points per game, and ranked 14th out of 334 teams in rebounding margin.

As a player, Wojciechowski (who was often referred to as "Wojo,") was named the top defensive player in the country his senior year, a two-time All-ACC choice and honorable mention Associated Press All-America. He appeared in 128 career games for

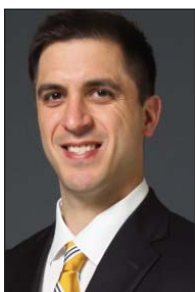
