GAME 2

Eastern Illinois continues one of the most difficult opening weeks in program history on Friday evening as they play at Big Ten member Wisconsin. EIU opened the season with an 85-60 loss at No. 12 Texas Tech. Wisconsin lost its season opener to No. 20 Saint Mary's in overtime in a neutral site game in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. EIU will play its home opener next Tuesday hosting Chicago State.

DIXON DOUBLE-DOUBLE DEBUT

Junior college transfer George Dixon made the most of his debut game with the Panthers as he posted a double-double against Texas Tech, last year's NCAA National Runner Up. Dixon finished with 13 points and ten rebounds (2 offensive). He was 6-of-9 from the floor adding two assists. In the Panthers exhibition win over Missouri St. Louis, Dixon had seven points and six rebounds. Last season at Vincennes University, Dixon led the NJCAA ranks in offensive rebounds with 164.

MADISON HOMECOMING

Eastern Illinois will have two players returning home this Friday when the Panthers play at Wisconsin. Shareef Smith and Deang Deang both are from Madison and were All-Conference selections in high school before going on to play at Highland (Ill.) Junior College. Smith attended Memorial HS where he was the Big Eight Conference Player of the Year as a senior and fourth team All-State. Deang played at East HS where he was the Area Player of the Year and first team All-State as a senior. Smith had six points in the opener at Texas Tech going 2-of-3 from 3-point range. Deang had nine points and five rebounds in the season opener.

SKIPPER-BROWN SCORES TEN AT TECH

Jordan Skipper-Brown was the second Eastern Illinois player in double figures in the opener at Texas Tech. The junior college transfer was 4-of-5 from the floor finishing with ten points. In the Panthers exhibition win over Missouri St. Louis, Skipper-Brown pulled down 12 rebounds to go with seven points. At Texas Tech, he was held off the glass as he was credited with no rebounds in 20 minutes on the floor.

EASTERN ILLINOIS HEAD COACH JAY SPOONHOUR

Jay Spoonhour is in his eighth season as the Panthers head coach having been hired on April 9, 2012. Spoonhour was previously the head coach at Moberly Area Community College where he coached for three seasons. He was a long time assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level and served as the interim head coach at UNLV to complete the 2004 season posting a 6-4 record and taking the team to the finals of the Mountain West Conference Tournament along with an NIT appearance. In 2001 Spoonhour was named the National Junior College Coach of the Year leading Wabash Valley College to the NJCAA National Championship with a 36-1 record. He is the son of the late legendary coach Charlie Spoonhour. Spoonhour played basketball at Pittsburg State earning his degree in 1994. He was an honorable mention All-Conference selection. He has assistant coaching stops at Central Missouri, Saint Louis, UNLV, Missouri and Texas San Antonio. Spoonhour's career mark is 199-157; 99-129 at the NCAA Division I level. His EIU record is 93-125 with an OVC mark of 51-65. Spoonhour led the program to its first NCAA Division I postseason win on March 17, 2015 with a 97-91 win at Oakland in the CIT.

LAST TIME OUT

Eastern Illinois opened the 2019-20 season at 2019 NCAA National Runner-Up Texas Tech as the Panthers face a difficult road swing to open the year. The Red Raiders jumped out to a 7-0 lead. EIU closed to within three points on a Mack Smith 3-pointer midway through the first half. TTU would then pull away for the 85-60 win. George Dixon had a double-double with 13 points, ten rebounds.

SCOUTING WISCONSIN

Greg Gard is in his fifth season as the head coach at Wisconsin. The Badgers won 23 games last season and lost in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. This season Wisconsin lost its season opener in overtime on Tuesday night to nationally ranked Saint Mary's. Nate Reuvers scored 22 points in the loss while Brad Davison added 16 points. Wisconsin held SMC to only 39 percent shooting from the floor.

SERIES INFORMATION

This will be the seventh meeting between Eastern Illinois and Wisconsin. The Badgers hold a 5-1 all-time series lead including convincing wins in the last two meetings in 1995 and 2003. In 2003, Wisconsin was ranked No. 15 in the nation as they beat EIU 81-47 on Nov. 25, 2003. EIU does hold one win the series as the Panthers beat Wisconsin, 59-52, on Dec. 3, 1987 in a game played in Lantz Arena in Charleston.

• Eastern Illinois set a school single season record for 3-pointers made last year as the Panthers knocked down 272 3-pointers. The total ranked 54th in the NCAA and third in the OVC last season. EIU made 10 or more 3-pointers in a game 11 times last season with a high of 13 in a road win at Bradley. The Panthers had a streak of five straight games making double digit 3-pointers from Feb. 1 to Feb. 16. EIU was 6-of-16 in the opener at Texas Tech.

• Guard Josiah Wallace was named a first team All-Ohio Valley Conference selection last season after leading the Panthers in scoring at 15.5 points per game. Wallace became only the sixth different EIU player to earn first-team honors since the Panthers joined the OVC in 1996-97. In addition he was named to the OVC All-Newcomer team and a second team NABC All-Region selection. This season Wallace was named to the preseason All-OVC team announced that the conference media day in late October. Wallace was held in check at Texas Tech finishing with two points matching his lowest career total as a Panther (2 at Iowa State last season)

• Mack Smith knocked down a 3-pointer midway through the first half at Texas Tech as the junior extended his NCAA leading consecutive game streak with at least one 3-pointer made to 50 games. Smith started the streak in January of his freshman season. Last season he was fourth in the OVC with 81 made 3-pointers which was the fifth best single season total in school history. Smith needs four 3-pointers to crack the EIU career top 10. He currently has 137.

• Eastern Illinois roster features five newcomers this season but in terms of age the Panthers may feature the most veteran team in the NCAA. EIU does not have any freshmen or sophomores on its 2019-20 roster and entering the season will be the only team in the NCAA Division I ranks that does not have an underclassman suiting up. EIU's roster make-up includes seven juniors, five seniors and one graduate transfer. Four returners started 20 games or more last season. Guards Josiah Wallace, Mack Smith and Shareef Smith started all 32 games last season with JaQualis Matlock starting 20 games. Senior Rade Kukobat announced his intention to transfer the day before the season opener after starting 19 games last season.

• Dondre Duffus joined the Panthers team for this season as a graduate transfer from Bethune-Cookman University. Duffus was granted an NCAA waiver to play this year on Monday afternoon just one day before the season opener. He scored two points with one rebound in his Panther debut. Last season at Bethune-Cookman, Duffus made 11 starts averaging 7.6 points per game. He will face his former team later this season when EIU plays the Wildcats at the Incarnate Word MTE Tournament in San Antonio.

• Eastern Illinois blocked 12 shots in the exhibition win over Missouri St. Louis on Oct. 30. In the season opener EIU had one block with JaQualis Matlock collecting that in the second half. Last season EIU ranked sixth in the OVC in team blocks at 3.8 but increased that production in league games leading the OVC with 4.5 blocks per game. EIU had 81 of its 120 blocks for the season come during the 18 conference games.
