**OPENING TIP:** Working to improve to 7-0 at home, Rutgers welcomes Wisconsin to the RAC on Wednesday for its Big Ten home opener. The Scarlet Knights will wear retro uniforms and warm-ups that throwback to the 1970's, including RU's 1976 undefeated regular season and Final Four run. It marks the first of two matchups against the Badgers this season, with the second taking place Feb. 23 at the Kohl Center.

Rutgers is coming off a 77-65 loss at No. 11/12 Michigan State on Sunday evening. RU held a first half lead and battled to within one point on multiple occasions after the break, but was unable to hold off the Spartans. Akwasi Yeboah scored a season-high 17 points on 6-of-9 shooting. Michigan State made 22 free throws (22-of-27) and were the first opponent to out-rebound the Scarlet Knights (40-32) this season.

**THE OPPONENT:** Under 5th-year head coach Greg Gard, Wisconsin earned an 84-64 home win over previously undefeated Indiana on Saturday. The Badgers are looking for their first road win of the season. Nate Reuvers ranks sixth in the Big Ten in scoring (15.4) and third in blocks (2.56). Kobe King had a career-best 24 points against the Hoosiers and provides 12.1 points-per-game. Since 2001-02, Wisconsin owns the best win percentage and most wins among Big Ten teams, posting a mark of 218-97 (.692). UW is the only team to clinch a top-four finish in the Big Ten in 17 of the last 18 seasons.

**THE SERIES:** Rutgers and Wisconsin meet for the 10th time, with Wisconsin winning seven of the first nine matchups. Since joining the Big Ten, the Scarlet Knights have won twice in six meetings, and are 2-0 against the Badgers at the RAC. In UW's last visit on Jan. 5, 2018, RU earned a 64-60 victory. With the game tied and two minutes remaining, Rutgers went on a 9-2 run to ensure the win. RU had just six turnovers, a program record for fewest in a Big Ten game since joining the conference. In 2015, Rutgers downed No. 4 Wisconsin 67-62 for the highest-ranked victory in program history. Myles Mack scored 21 points and Kadeem Jack added 20 points to deal the Badgers one of their four losses during their national finalist campaign.

## Scarlet Knight Notables

- Rutgers is undefeated at home (6-0), when shooting a better percentage than its opponent (5-0), and when limiting foes to less than 60 points (5-0).
- Rutgers remains a young squad, ranking 235th nationally in experience per Pomeroy. The starting lineup has featured one junior and four sophomores.
- Rutgers announced the signings of 6-7 F Mawot Mag, 6-8 F Oskar Palmquist and 6-10 F Dean Reiber.
- Rutgers entered the Fall 2019 semester with a 3.06 cumulative team GPA.
- Rutgers is second in the Big Ten in steals (6.9), and turnovers forced (15.0), fourth in FG% defense (39.2), and fifth in blocks (5.1) and scoring defense (63.0).
- Rutgers ranks 32nd nationally in blocks (5.1) and 43rd in rebounding margin (+6.8).
- Geo Baker is 4th in the Big Ten in steals (1.56) and 6th in assists (4.3).
- Paul Mulcahy is 3rd in the Big Ten in assist/turnover ratio (2.75).
- Myles Johnson is second in the Big Ten in FG% (69.6), 7th in offensive rebounds (2.67), 9th in blocks (1.56) and 10th in rebounds (7.7).
- Montez Mathis is third in the Big Ten in steals (1.6).
- Rutgers was named the Most Improved Team of the 2018-19 season by Sports Illustrated in its year-end awards. The Scarlet Knights improved 70 positions in the Pomeroy ratings since the season's initial rating, best among all power conference programs.
- Rutgers was among the approximately 30,000 individuals who joined in the 18th annual Tunnel to Towers 5K Run & Walk on Sept. 29. It marked the third consecutive year the team has participated in the event, with proceeds benefitting first responders and catastrophically injured service members. Under Steve Pikiell, RU has maintained 100 percent team participation in Leadership Development and Strategic Partnerships community service initiatives.
- Rutgers posted a 4-0 record against professional club teams during a tour of Spain in August. RU outscored its opponents 387-284 and had five players with double figure scoring averages.
- Of Rutgers' 11 scholarship players, 10 are 6'4 or above and seven are 6'6 or taller.

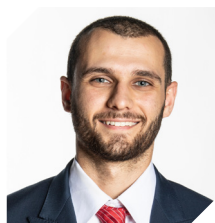

## **GIVING BACK**

A commitment to the community has been emblematic of Rutgers basketball under Steve Pikiell, with all student-athletes participating in Leadership Development and Strategic Partnerships community service initiatives. The team participated in the annual Tunnel to Towers 5K Run & Walk on Sept. 29 for the third consecutive year. The team has also volunteered at Elijah's Promise Soup Kitchen in New Brunswick, participated in the SAAC Holiday Toy Giveaway and visited children at RWJBarnabas Health facilities around the state.

## **PERFORMING IN THE CLASSROOM**

Rutgers entered the fall semester with a team cumulative GPA of 3.06, an APR score of 984 (4th in the conference) and a GSR score of 82. The program was recognized with two Dean's List honorees in the spring (Joey Downes and Myles Johnson). Downes was named a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar for 2018-2019 and was recently inducted into Chi Alpha Sigma – the National Scholar Athlete Honor Society. In both Fall 2018 and Spring 2019, over half (53%) of the roster earned GPAs of 3.0 or higher each semester.

## **RUTGERS, A BIG TEN SUPER SATURDAY STAPLE**

Rutgers men's basketball and wrestling will be featured in Big Ten Super Saturday - College Hoops & Wrestling in both 2020 and 2021 at the legendary Madison Square Garden. On Saturday, Feb. 1, 2020, Michigan and Rutgers will compete in both men's basketball and wrestling. Michigan will serve as a home team for both events in 2020. The wrestling event will start at 1 p.m. and air on BTN. The basketball game will tip-off at 4:30 p.m. and will also air on BTN. The following year on Jan. 30, 2021, Rutgers will play Michigan State in men's basketball while the Scarlet Knights will compete against Penn State in wrestling with Rutgers serving as the host in both competitions. Times will be announced at a later date.

## **HAPPY ANNIVERSARY**

The 2019-20 season marks the 100th anniversary of the 1919-20 team, the first Rutgers basketball team to play in a postseason tournament. The team played in the National Amateur Athletic Union basketball tournament in Atlanta, the lone national postseason tournament at the time, and finished as runner-up. The squad was inducted into the Rutgers Athletics Hall of Fame in October as part of the class of 2019.

## **THE EXCITEMENT IS RISING**

Rutgers has experienced ticket growth each season under the leadership of head coach Steve Pikiell. RU had five sell-outs at the RAC in 2018-19, its most since 2004-05 (7). Average attendance improved 31.1% from 2017-18. Rutgers Athletics has already announced that single game tickets for the Garden State Hardwood Classic match-up with Seton Hall are sold out.

## **UTILIZING THE LATEST TRAINING TECHNOLOGIES**

Assistant Athletics Director-Strength and Conditionin David VanDyke and Athletic trainer Rich Campbell have made a significant impact on the health and well-being of men's basketball student-athletes. In their initial three seasons, men's basketball players have been sidelined a total of 17 combined games due to injury. The Scarlet Knights had three total games missed among players in 2018-19, 11 in 2017-18 and three in 2016-17.

Rutgers strives to implement the latest technologies to benefit its programs and student-athletes. In that effort, men's basketball utilizes Sparta Science, Catapult, Polar Team Pro and GymAware. Sparta Science provides an objective measure of how players react to gravity with validated scientific assessments and provides evidence-based training prescriptions. Catapult replaces laboratory-based performance testing with microtechnology to obtain actionable data in real time regarding performance. Polar Team Pro provides real-time heart rate data to make objective decisions. GymAware is the gold standard Linear Positional Transducer (LPT with angle measurement) for measuring performance, implementing Velocity Based Training and monitoring power.

Before and after every season, men's basketball welcomes BAM (Basic Athletic Measurement) to the RAC to conduct player testing. A team of
