PACK TRACKS

- NC State fell to #16 Memphis, 83-78, on Thanksgiving Day. The Pack trailed by 20 points, 61-41, with 17:27 to play, but battled back to cut the deficit to three, 74-71, on two Jericole Hellems free throws with 4:31 to go. NC State missed a tying three-pointer with three minutes to go and could never get closer than three points in the final minutes.
- Senior guard Markell Johnson had his best game of the season, finishing with a season-high 22 points, while also leading the team in assists (6) and steals (3) and tying for team-high honors with five rebounds. Sophomore forward Jericole Hellems added a career-high 17 points while D.J. Funderburk scored 14 points off the bench.
- The Pack has had a balanced scoring attack all season. NC State's top eight scorers all average at least seven points per game and all eight players have scored in double figures in at least two games this season.
- Senior guard C.J. Bryce leads the team in scoring (16.1), rebounding (7.3) steals (1.9) and field goal percentage (54.3%). The Charlotte native ranks second in the ACC in field goal percentage and is sixth in the conference in steals, eighth in scoring, eighth in free throw percentage (81.5%) and 14th in rebounding.

Head Coach Kevin Keatts

- Hired by NC State on March 17, 2017 as the 20th head coach in program history
- Has a record of 45-24 (.652) in two seasons as head coach of NC State



- His NC State teams have averaged over 80 points per game in both seasons he has been with the Pack. Prior to Keatts first team at NC State, the Pack hadn't had a team average over 80 points since the 1995-96 season
- Led NC State back to the NCAA Tournament in his first season with the program and took the team to the NIT quarterfinals in his second season
- Compiled a record of 72-28 (.720) in three seasons as head coach at UNC-Wilmington, including a 41-13 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play
- Led Seahawks to three-straight regular season conference titles and was named the CAA Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2016
- Coached UNCW to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2016 and 2017
- Served as an assistant coach at Louisville for three seasons, helping lead the Cardinals to a 96-21 (.821) record from 2011-14
- Prior to Louisville, Keatts served as the head coach at Hargrave Military Academy for 10 seasons
- With two separate stints at Hargrave (1999-2001, 2003-2011), he compiled a 263-17 (.939) record with two national prep championships (2004, 2008), three runner-up finishes (2005, 2006, 2009) and two other appearances among the final four prep teams (2007, 2010)
- Coached 14 players that have gone on to the NBA
- Three Sweet 16 appearances, two Final Four berths and one National Championship as a coach.
- Keatts and his wife Georgette have two sons, K.J. and Kaden

NOTING NC STATE

- NC State returns six of its top-seven scorers from last season.
- The Pack will only have 10 scholarship players in uniform in the 2019-20 season. Junior guard Thomas Allen is sitting out the season after transfering from Nebraska. Freshman guard Dereon Seabron is sitting out as an academic redshirt and junior guard Blake Harris left the program in October.
- Thursday's game against Memphis marked the first time this season NC State played more than eight scholarship players in a game. Nine scholarship players saw action against the Tigers. NC State had only dressed out eight scholarship players in the first five games. Markell Johnson missed the first game (injury). D.J. Funderburk missed the first two games (suspended). A.J. Taylor has not dressed out for a game since the season-opener against Georgia Tech (injury) and Danny Dixon missed games three through five with an injury.
- Redshirt freshman Manny Bates made his NC State debut on Nov. 5 against Georgia Tech. The Fayetteville native missed his senior season of high school with a shoulder injury and sat out last season after having preseason shoulder surgery. Bates' appearance against Georgia Tech was his first game representing his school since his junior season of high school wrapped up on Feb. 24, 2017 that is a span of 985 days.
- For the third consecutive season, Keatts has added two grad transfers to the roster (2017-18 Allerik Freeman (Baylor) and Sam Hunt (North Carolina A&T); 2018-19 Eric Lockett (FIU) and Wyatt Walker (Samford). This year, the Pack has added Pat Andree and Danny Dixon. Andree comes to NC State from Lehigh. One of the top-shooters in the Patriot League, Andree averaged 12.9 points and 6.2 rebounds per game last season. Dixon averaged 7.5 points and 3.6 rebounds per game last season at UMKC.

WEDNESDAY STORYLINES

- NC State has won 35 of its last 36 non-conference games at PNC Arena. The Pack is 20-1 in non-conference home games at PNC Arena under head coach Kevin Keatts.
- The Pack has an all-time record of 7-12 in the ACC-Big Ten Challenge. NC State is 6-3 in home challenge games. Kevin Keatts is 1-1 at NC State in the ACC-Big Ten Challenge.
- Notable stats from last year's game:
 - Markell Johnson scored a then-career-high 21 points to lead NC State in scoring.
- -The Pack was outscored 26-10 in bench points in the loss to the Badgers. The 10 bench points were the second-fewest of the season for NC State and marked one of only five times in 36 games last year that NC State's bench was outscored by the opponents bench.
- Wisconsin had 16 assists against just 10 turnovers. It was one of only 11 times in 36 games that an opponent had a positive assist-to-turnover ratio against NC State. The Badgers' 10 turnovers were the fewest by a non-conference opponent and tied for the fourth-fewest by an opponent all season.
- Wisconsin finished the game 11-of-21 from three-point range. Wisconsin's three-point percentage of 52.4% was the highest given up by NC State last season. The Badgers were one of only four teams to hit double-digit three-pointers against the Pack last season and one of only two teams to shoot over 50% from three-point range.
- Contrasting styles on display on Wednesday night. NC State pushes the pace on offense and ranks 15th in the NCAA in scoring offense at 83.6 points per game, while Wisconsin ranks 254th in scoring offense at 68.3 points per game. Conversely, Wisconsin ranks 56th in the NCAA in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 61.7 points per game, while NC State ranks 215th and allows 70.4 points per game.

NC STATE - WISCONSIN SERIES

- Wednesday's meeting is the 4th game all-time in the series. Wisconsin leads the series, 3-0.
- The two teams first met in the Sweet 16 of the 2005 NCAA Tournament. The #10-seed Wolfpack had a nine-point halftime lead on the #6-seed Badgers, but Wisconsin outscored NC State by 18 points in the second half to advance to the Elite 8.
- The other two meetings were part of the ACC-Big Ten Challenge. Wisconsin defeated NC State, 87-48, in 2010 and beat the Pack, 79-75, last season. The Pack led for almost 32 minutes of game-time last year, but Wisconsin ended the game on a 15-6 run to win.

DANIELS = BEST BENCH SCORER IN THE ACC

- Junior guard Devon Daniels has emerged as the ACC's premier scorer off-the-bench through the first three weeks of the season.
- The Battle Creek, Mich., native currently ranks second on the team and 24th in the ACC in scoring at 12.7 points per game. Daniels is the only player ranked in the top-25 of the ACC in scoring to come off-the-bench.
- Daniels started the first game of the season against Georgia Tech when senior point guard Markell Johnson sat out because of injury, but since Johnson's return to the lineup, Daniels has transitioned to the team's sixth man role.
- In the six games off-the-bench, Daniels is averaging 12.8 points per game and is shooting 56.1% from the field (32-of-57)
- Daniels scored his NC State-high of 23 points in the team's win over Alcorn State on Nov. 19. The 23 points are the most for an NC State player off-the-bench since Allerik Freeman scored 29 points in the win at North Carolina on 1/27/18.
- Daniels also ranks among ACC leaders in field goal percentage (5th 50.7%) and steals (1lth 1.7 spg)

BENCH PRODUCTION

- NC State's bench is averaging 28.9 points per game this season and is outscoring the opponent's bench by 64 points, 202-138.
- The Pack's bench has had at least one player score in double-digits off-the-bench in every game but one this season. Devon Daniels (4), D.J. Funderburk (4) and Pat Andree (1) have all had double-digit scoring performances after not starting this season.
- NC State's bench scored a season-best 42 points in the win over Alcorn State on Nov. 19.
- Last season, NC State had the most prolific scoring bench in the ACC, averaging to score 29.0 points per game and outscoring the opponent's bench by 469 points.

MANNY BATES EMERGING AS ONE OF NATION'S TOP SHOT BLOCKERS

- Just six games into his NC State career, Manny Bates is already making his mark on the NC State record book. He currently ranks second in the ACC and sixth in the NCAA with an average of 3.67 blocks per game.
- Bates has had multiple blocked shots in all seven games this season. He had five blocked shots in his NC State debut against Georgia Tech on Nov. 5.
- The Fayetteville, N.C., native had a season-best seven blocked shots (most by an ACC player this season) in NC State's win over Detroit Mercy on Nov. 10. The seven blocked shots tied for the sixth-most in a single-game in NC State history and ranks as the second-most in a game in the 20-year history of PNC Arena.
- Seven games into the season, Bates is already almost halfway to making the top-15 list for most blocks in a single season in NC State history. At his current pace (3.43 blocks per game), Bates would finish the regular season with 106 blocked shots which would break the current single season record of 95 by Thurl Bailey in the 1982-83 National Championship season.

BEVERLY & JOHNSON BOTH HAVE CAREER TOP-10 ASSIST-TO-TURNOVER RATIO

- Junior guard Braxton Beverly and senior guard Markell Johnson both currently rank in NC State's top-10 for career assist-to-turnover ratio. Beverly ranks third with a career ratio of 2.60 (224-to-86), while Johnson ranks seventh with a ratio of 2.12 (437-to-206).
- Johnson ranks eighth in the ACC this season with a 2.22 assist-to-turnover ratio.

PACK INKS SIGNING CLASS THAT CURRENTLY RANKS FIFTH IN NATION

- NC State has signed five Class of 2020 prospects Ebenezer Dowuona, Nick Farrar, Josh Hall, Cam Hayes and Shakeel Moore to National Letters of Intent to join the Wolfpack Basketball Program starting next season
- NC State's five-man recruiting class is currently ranked as the fifth-best class in the team recruiting rankings by 247Sports and Rivals.
- Four of the five signees are North Carolina natives. Josh Hall (Durham, NC) is a five-star prospect and a consensus top-50 recruit in the Class of 2020 and Cam Hayes (Greensboro, NC) is also a consensus top-50 recruit and a four-star prospect.

PACK SCORING PLENTY UNDER KEATTS

The NC State men's basketball team has averaged over 80 points per game in both of the seasons Kevin Keatts has been head coach of the Pack. Prior to Keatts arriving at NC State, the Pack hadn't averaged over 80 points per game in a season since the 1995-96 team averaged 81.2 points per game last season. Last year's team set a program-record for most points scored in a single season with 2,882 points. NC State has scored over 80 points in five of seven games in the 2019-20 season.

LETHAL FROM LONG-RANGE

- The Pack's returning players this season account for 256 of the 292 three-pointers NC State made last season. The 292 threes ranked as the second-most in a single-season in program-history.
- Markell Johnson hit 68 three-pointers last season and finished the season fourth in the ACC in three-point field goal percentage at 42.2%. He is the top-returning three-point shooter in the ACC this season (by shooting percentage).
- Braxton Beverly led the team with 76 three-pointers last season and has hit 136 three-pointers in his first two seasons at NC State which are the most for any player in program history through their sophomore season.
- C.J. Bryce (38 three-pointers last season) and Devon Daniels (37) both averaged to make over one three-pointer per game last season.
- In addition, NC State welcomes grad transfer Pat Andree to this year's team. Andree made 189 three-pointers in three seasons at Lehigh, including 149 the last two seasons where he shot over 40 percent from long distance in both seasons.
- Last season, NC State averaged 8.17 three-pointers made per game. In the Kevin Keatts' era, the Pack is 19-4 when it hits 10 or more three-pointers in a game.

PACK PICKED SIXTH; JOHNSON NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC 2ND TEAM

NC State was selected sixth in the ACC Basketball Preseason Poll and senior guard Markell Johnson was named to the Preseason All-ACC Second Team. The Pack was preseason selected 12th in Keatts first season and eighth last season. In 2017-18, NC State finished in a tie for third after being picked 12th. Last season after being picked eighth in the preseason poll, NC State finished in a tie for eighth place.

JOHNSON DEVELOPING INTO ONE OF ACC'S TOP SHOOTERS

■ Senior guard Markell Johnson has turned a weakness his freshman season into one of the strengths of his game entering his senior season. The Cleveland, Ohio native hit just 12 three-pointers and shot 25 percent from long range as a freshman. As a sophomore, he improved his three-point percentage to over 40 percent and averaged one three-pointer made per outing. Last season as a junior, Johnson was a true threat from outside. He finished fourth in the ACC in three-point percentage at 42.2% and averaged over two three-point makes an outing (68 in 33 games). Johnson enters his senior season as the top-returning three-point shooter in the ACC (by shooting percentage).

■ Senior guard Markell Johnson entered his senior season ranked 10th in program history in career assists with 397. The Cleveland, Ohio passed out 10 assists in his season-debut against Detroit Mercy on Nov. 10, passing Nate McMillan and Cat Barber to move into eighth place. Johnson led the ACC in assists in his sophomore season with a 7.3 average per game. Johnson is aiming to become the first NC State player since Lorenzo Brown (2010-13) to lead the team in assists in three consecutive season. At his current pace, Johnson will finish his career in the top-five in program history for career assists.

DEFENSIVE PRESSURE UNDER KEATTS

■ The Pack has led the ACC in forcing opponent turnovers in both of head coach Kevin Keatts seasons. In his first season with NC State in 2017-18, the Pack forced 487 opponent turnovers, an average of 14.8 per game. Last season, NC State forced 560 turnovers, an average of 15.6 per game. The 560 opponent turnovers are the third-most forced turnovers in program history. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 32-11 (74.4%) when it forces an opponent into 15 or more turnovers.

46.5 PACK HAS FINISHED SECOND IN TURNOVER MARGIN LAST TWO SEASONS

■ NC State has finished second in the ACC in turnover margin in both seasons with Kevin Keatts as head coach. The Pack had a +2.64 turnover margin in 2017-18 and a +3.08 turnover margin last season. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 42-16 (72.4%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent and just 8-10 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.

PACK COMING OFF OF BEST REBOUNDING SEASON FOR PROGRAM IN YEARS

■ NC State finished the season with a +4.31 rebounding margin last season. It's the best rebounding margin for an NC State team since the 1998-99 team had a +5.9 rebounding margin. The Pack was 16-4 last season when it outrebounded its opponent and just 8-8 if it tied or lost the rebounding battle.

NC STATE LED ACC IN OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING IN 2018-19

■ The Pack averaged 13.56 offensive rebounds per game last season to lead the ACC. NC State had more offensive rebounds than its opponent in 25 games last season.

CELEBRATING 20 YEARS OF PNC ARENA

This year marks the 20th year of PNC Arena. NC State played its first game inside PNC Arena on Nov. 19, 1999, a 67-63 win over Georgia. NC State has an all-time record of 239-98 (.709) in PNC Arena. Kevin Keatts teams have a record of 32-8 (.800) inside PNC Arena.
