OPENING TIP

Indiana University is in its 120th season of competition in men's basketball and will travel to Wisconsin to open up the Big Ten campaign. The Hoosiers are coming off an 80-64 win over #17/19 Florida State in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge. A victory on Saturday would give IU a 9-0 start for the first time since the 2012-13 season when they began that year 9-0. After starting the season with 8 straight home games, the Hoosiers will be away from Assembly Hall in 3 of the next 4 contests.

THE COACHES

Indiana Coach **Archie Miller** is in his third season of guiding the Cream and Crimson. He is 182-94 in eight-plus years as a head coach, which includes six years at the University of Dayton. His Flyer teams made NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his last four seasons, including a trip to the Elite Eight in 2014. He is 43-31 at IU. Greg Gard is in his 5th season of leading Wisconsin. He is 84-48 during his time as the head coach of the Badgers.

NEWS & NOTES

Senior **Devonte Green** scored a career-high 30 points and added 6 rebounds and 3 assists in leading the Hoosiers over the Seminoles. He also added 5 of 7 from long distance. Green's 30 points are the most off the bench for a Hoosier since **Matt Roth** had 29 against Ohio State in 2009. He is averaging a team-high 15.8 points. Freshman **Trayce Jackson-Davis** had 15 points, 8 boards and 2 blocks against FSU. He is averaging 15.5 points and 9.4 rebounds. He leads the team shooting 65.61% from the floor and in blocked shots with 18. He has had 4 double-doubles in 8 games this season. Among freshmen nationally, he is 2nd in FG% and free throw made per game, 3rd in blocked shots and free throws attempted per game and 6th in rebounding. For his efforts last week, the Center Grove graduate was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the second time this season after averaging 20.0 points and 12.5 rebounds in wins over Louisiana Tech and South Dakota State. Junior **Justin Smith** had 14 points and 5 boards against FSU and is averaging a 14.3 points and 5.1 rebounds and leads the team in steals with 14. Junior Aljami Durham is averaging 12.6 points and is shooting 53.8% from the field and 39.3% from long distance. Freshman Armaan Franklin scored a season-high 9 points against FSU and sophomore win Damezi Anderson provided staunch defense and is shooting 41.2% from long range.

ODDS AND TRENDS

IU leads the nation in free throws made per game at 21.4 and free throws attempted at 30.1 per game. The Hoosiers are 4th in the nation in field goal percentage (51.8), 6th in scoring margin (22.0), and 8th in scoring (85.6). IU shot 55.6% from the floor and 46.7% from long distance against a FSU team that has the 5th best rated defense in the country according to Ken-Pom

POSTGAME NOTES AGAINST FLORIDA STATE

- The game marked the fifth-straight year that IU has faced a ranked team in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge and seventh out of the last eight.
- The Hoosiers are now 8-11 in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge and 5-0 all-time against Florida State. This was their first meeting in the Challenge.
- This is head coach Archie Miller's sixth win against a ranked team while at IU. The victory gives the Hoosiers three-straight wins against ranked opponents at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. Miller is now 11-3 during the month of December with the Hoosiers.
- The Hoosiers outrebounded the Seminoles 35-25 and Indiana is 35-10 when outrebounding its opponents in the Miller era.
- After falling behind 11-4, the Hoosiers went on a 12-0 run and took their first lead of the game on a layup from freshman forward Trayce Jackson-Davis with 14:14 remaining in the first half and never relinquished the lead.
- Indiana came into the game leading the nation in free throws made per game (21.0) and free throw attempts per game (29.0). The Hoosiers put up 38 and made 23 on Tuesday night.
- Senior guard **Devonte Green** hit three straight 3-pointers over the course of a 10-2 IU run late in the first half. Green has converted multiple 3-point tries in four out of five games. He has made at least three in three games this season.
- After Florida State cut the lead to three with 8:17 left in the game the Hoosiers went on a 13-2 run, capped off by a 3-pointer from sophomore forward **Damezi Anderson** that forced a timeout with 3:23 remaining. The Hoosiers have yet to trail in the second half this season.
- **Green's** fifth 3-pointer with 1:39 remaining gave the Hoosiers its largest lead of the game at 17 points. The lead never went under double digits over the last 4:08 of the game.
- Indiana's point total marked the most points allowed by the Florida State defense through nine games this season. The Seminoles had previously yielded a season-high 74 points against Western Carolina.
- Three scored in double figures, **Green** (30), **Jackson-Davis** (15) and junior forward **Justin Smith** (14).
- **Green** put up a career-high 30 points on a game high five 3-pointers and added six rebounds and three assists in 24 minutes.
- He is the first Hoosier to score at least 30 points in a game since Juwan Morgan (35) against Butler on Dec. 15, 2018.
- The reigning Big Ten Freshman of the Week, **Jackson-Davis**, tallied 15 points and finished just shy of his fifth double-double with eight rebounds. He also added a team-high two blocks.
- Smith scored 14 points for the Hoosiers and grabbed five rebounds in 35 minutes.
- Armaan Franklin scored a career-high nine points and dished out an assist in 26 minutes of playing time.

The Hoosiers began the season with 8 straight home games, the most since they also opened the season with 8 straight home games in 2014-15.



W. ILLINOIS

- · Indiana is now 99-21 all-time in season openers and has won 21 of its last 22 opening night games.
- · Joey Brunk, Trayce Jackson-Davis, and **Armaan Franklin** made their first career starts at Indiana on Tuesday night.
- · A pair of freshmen received the starting nod, Trayce Jackson-Davis and Armaan Franklin. Last season, Romeo Langford and Rob Phinisee received starts as freshmen against Chicago State. In 2014, James Blackmon Jr. and Robert Johnson appeared in the starting lineup.
- Indiana's largest lead of the night was 37 with 2:12 remaining in the game. Al Durham's layup gave the Hoosiers 16-15 lead at the 9:51 mark in the first half as they never trailed again.
- The Hoosiers biggest run of night ended the first half as they went on 34-10 run to extend their lead to 45-25 at the halftime break.
- Indiana shot the ball 38-for-65 (58.5 percent) from the floor and 5-for-11 (45.5 percent) from behind the arc, which is the best 3-point percentage since Feb. 2, 2019 at Michigan State. The Hoosier defense only allowed Western Illinois to shoot 22-for-64 (34.4 percent) from the field.
- The Hoosiers shot 21 of their 25 free throws in the second half and only put Western Illinois on the line for 15 attempts.
- •The Indiana bench contributed 29 of the Hoosiers 98 points.
- · Four Hoosiers scored in double figures, Justin Smith (24), Al Durham (21), Rob Phinisee (14), Joey Brunk (11).
- Junior forward Justin Smith led the team in scoring and matched his career high of 24 points (March 2, 2019 vs. Michigan State), shooting 11-for-17 from the field. He also added seven rebounds in 22 minutes of action.
- · Junior guard Al Durham tallied 21 points, shooting 7-for-7 from the field. He is the 10th Hoosier to accomplish this feat since **De'Ron** Davis went 7-for-7 at lowa on Mar. 9, 2017.
- Sophomore guard **Rob Phinisee** scored 14 points, three assists, and two rebounds.
- Redshirt junior **Joey Brunk** added 11 points for his first in his career at Indiana. He also grabbed seven rebounds.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Freshman forward Trayce Jackson-Davis saw his first career points as he ended the night with eight points and six rebounds.
- Redshirt freshman Jerome Hunter played his first career minutes while tallying his first seven points of his career and three rebounds.
- Freshman guard Armaan Franklin scored his first five points as a Hoosier and while also securing a team-high eight assists.

PORTLAND STATE

- · This was the first meeting between the Hoosiers and the Vikings.
- Indiana's largest lead of the afternoon was 18 with under one minute left in the second half. The Hoosiers took over the lead at the 16:45 mark in the first half and never trailed again.
- The Hoosiers shot 30-of-60 (50.0 percent) from the field and made 22-of-30 (73.3 percent) free throws.
- Indiana saw 52 points in the paint while also scoring 18 off of turnovers.
- · The Indiana bench contributed 26 of the Hoosiers' 85 points.
- · Indiana outrebounded the Vikings 41-24, which included 16 offensive boards.
- · Three Hoosiers scored in double figures, Al Durham (18), Justin Smith (16), Trayce-Jackson Davis (13), and Race Thompson (10).
- · Junior guard Al Durham led the team in scoring with 18 points. He also assisted on two baskets while adding one rebound.
- Freshman forward Trayce Jackson-Davis earned his first career double-double, scoring 13 points and grabbing 10 rebounds.
- · Junior forward Justin Smith scored 16 points and snagged eight rebounds.
- · Sophomore guard Rob Phinisee dished out a team-high seven assists and secured seven points.

NORTH ALABAMA

- · This was the first meeting between the Hoosiers and the Lions.
- Indiana's largest lead was 27 at the 7:02 mark in the second half. The Hoosiers never trailed again after freshman forward Trayce Jackson-Davis hit two free throws at the 9:36 mark in the first half to take a 19-18 lead.
- · In the second half the Hoosiers held North Alabama to only 5-of-18 shooting (27.8 percent), while outscoring the Lions 44-25. The five field goals were the fewest the Hoosiers have allowed in a half since Nov. 25, 2012 against Ball State when they made five. The Hoosiers also only allowed five field goals against Michigan (Jan. 15, 2011) and four field goals against Notre Dame (Dec. 17, 2011) and Duke (Nov. 28, 2006).
- Indiana shot 50 percent or better for the third straight game. For the season, the Hoosiers are shooting 53.2 percent from the field.
- The Hoosiers scored 46 points off the bench and through three games the Hoosiers are averaging 33.7 points per game off the bench.
- Indiana went 37-of-45 (82.2 percent) from the free-throw line. The 37 made free throws marks the most since draining 39 at lowa on Feb. 21, 2017.
- The Hoosiers had five players score in double figures, Jackson-Davis (20), sophomore guard **Rob Phinisee** (13), redshirt freshman forward Jerome Hunter (12), junior guard Al **Durham** (11) and sophomore guard **Damezi** Anderson (10). This is the first time Indiana has had five players in double figures since March 7, 2019 against Illinois.
- Jackson-Davis tallied a career-high 20 points on 3-of-4 (75.0 percent) shooting from the field and 14-of-15 (93.3 percent) shooting from the free throw line. Jackson-Davis also grabbed a team-best eight rebounds. The game marked the second time in as many outings that he scored in double figures.
- Jackson-Davis' 14 free throws made is the most since Eric Gordon went 14-of-14 on Dec.



29, 2007 against Chicago State.

- · The 20-point outing from Jackson-Davis is the highest for a true freshman at Indiana since Romeo Langford also recorded 20 points on March 10, 2019 against Rutgers.
- Hunter tallied a career-high 12 points and added two steals in 16 minutes of action.
- · Durham had 11 points and matched a careerhigh with two blocked shots.
- Anderson secured a career-high 10 points, three rebounds and two assists in 19 minutes.
- · Redshirt junior Joey Brunk tallied six points (2of-2 shooting) and two rebounds in his third start of the season.
- Freshman guard Armaan Franklin compiled five points, two rebounds and three assists in his third collegiate start.
- Redshirt sophomore forward Race Thompson notched five points, four rebounds, three blocks and two steals in a reserve role.

- This was the first ever meeting against Troy. The game marked the first of the Indiana Challenge.
- The Hoosiers never trailed and used a 15-2 run beginning at the 14:06 mark to take a commanding 33-12 lead. Indiana led 58-32 at the break.
- Indiana's 58 first-half points are the most in a single half in head coach Archie Miller's tenure. The last time Indiana scored 58 points or more in a half was Dec. 10, 2016 against Houston Baptist when they scored 61 points in the second half.
- The Hoosiers hit the 100-point mark at the 2:02 point of the second half on a redshirt sophomore forward Race Thompson free throw. Indiana last scored 100 or more points when they scored 104 against Chicago State on Nov. 4, 2018.
- The Hoosiers shot the ball 35-of-65 (53.8 percent) while only allowing Troy to shoot 20-of-63 (31.7 percent). Indiana also out-rebounded Trov 51-38.
- · The Hoosiers had four players score in doublefigures, Justin Smith (22), Trayce Jackson-Davis (17), Al Durham (17) and Damezi Anderson (14).
- · Smith had his fourth career game with at least 20 points, scoring 22 and adding five rebounds and three steals.
- Anderson set a career high in his second straight game, scoring 14 points and grabbing six boards in only eight minutes.

- · Jackson-Davis recorded his second doubledouble of his young career with 17 points and 14 rebounds.
- · Senior guard Devonte Green made his first appearance of the season and scored six points and added four assists in 25 minutes.

- · Thompson tallied seven points and six rebounds for the Hoosiers while playing 19 minutes.
- · In 18 minutes, freshman guard Armaan Franklin scored six points while grabbing three rebounds and adding two assists.
- · Redshirt junior forward Joey Brunk scored five points, grabbed two rebounds and dished out three assists in 19 minutes.
- Redshirt freshman forward Jerome Hunter scored four points and tallied three rebounds in 19 minutes of action.
- · Senior forward De'Ron Davis played eight minutes for the Hoosiers and put up two points, four rebounds and three assists.
- · Both freshman forward Nathan Childress and junior guard Cooper Bybee checked in during the final two minutes for the Hoosiers.

PRINCETON

- Indiana improved to 5-0 on the season for the first time since the 2013-14 season after defeating Princeton, 79-54. The Hoosiers lead the all-time series with the Tigers, 3-2. IU is now 10-3 all-time against teams in the lvy League.
- Indiana shot 18-of-29 (62.1 percent) from the floor in the second half, while holding Princeton to 7-of-25 (28.0 percent). The Hoosiers outscored Princeton 44-23 in the final 20 minutes
- · IU outscored Princeton 22-9 on points off turnovers. IU won the paint battle, 50-22, and the fast break battle, 13-2.
- The Hoosiers went 14-of-17 (82.4 percent) from the free throw line, which is the best team percentage of the season.
- After converting 31-of-55 (56.4 percent) from the floor, IU has shot above 50.0 percent in every game this season and has yet to trail in the second half.
- · The Hoosiers had four players in double figures, Devonte Green (16), Joey Brunk (16), Justin Smith (14) and Trayce Jackson-Davis (11).

- Green led the Hoosier offense with 16 points on 5-of-8 shooting from the floor and 2-of-3 from behind the 3-point line. Green added four assists in 26 minutes of run.
- Brunk also added 16 points on 7-of-11 shooting and finished with eight rebounds in 25 minutes. Both his point total and rebound output marked a season high.
- · Smith finished the game with 14 points and tallied three rebounds in a team-high 31 minutes.
- Jackson-Davis recorded 11 points on 5-of-6 shooting and grabbed four rebounds in 23 minutes. He has been in double figures in the scoring column in his last four contests.
- Junior guard Aljami Durham added six points for the Hoosiers in 29 minutes and also recorded four rebounds and a game-high six assists.
- Redshirt sophomore forward Race Thompson grabbed five rebounds for the Hoosiers while adding five points and two assists.
- · Freshman guard Armaan Franklin scored four points and dished out two assists in 12 minutes of action.
- Junior guard Cooper Bybee hit a 3-pointer in the final minute of action for the Hoosiers.
- · Sophomore guard Rob Phinisee scored two points while also recording three rebounds and two assists in 11 minutes.
- Sophomore forward **Damezi Anderson** recorded eight minutes of playing time and dished out two
- Freshman forward Nathan Childress entered the game in the final minutes of action.

LOUISIANA TECH

- Indiana is 6-0 for the first time since the 2012-13 season (9-0) after defeating the Louisiana Tech Bulldogs by a score of 88-75 on Monday night.
- · Louisiana Tech entered the game with the 10th-highest turnover rate in the country (13.8 percent). The Hoosiers forced 20 turnovers and outscored the Bulldogs, 20-16, off turnovers.
- The 52-first half points scored by Indiana marked the second most points scored by the Hoosiers in the opening half. IU tallied a seasonbest 58 points against Troy on Nov. 17.
- · Three-straight coast-to-coast layups gave the Hoosiers their first six points of the game and a 6-2 lead. The last layup by junior guard Aljami **Durham** resulted in an and-one opportunity and a timeout by Louisiana Tech.



· After allowing a bucket on the opening

- possession of the game, Indiana rattled off a 14-2 lead to seize control of the game. The Hoosiers never trailed again.
- A layup by **Durham** at the 7:29 mark in the first half gave the Hoosiers their largest lead of the game at 23 points.
- The Hoosiers went 28-of-38 (73.7 percent) from the free throw line. Indiana has shot above 70.0 percent from the free throw line in five of its six games this season.
- · Four Hoosiers reached double figures in the scoring column, led by a career-best 21 points from freshman forward Trayce Jackson-Davis. Durham secured 18 points, senior guard Devonte Green tallied 16 points, and redshirt junior forward Joey Brunk scored 12 points.
- · Jackson-Davis scored 20-plus points for the second time and grabbed double-figure rebounds (11) for the third time this season. The game marked his third double-double of the season after he secured 13 points and 10 rebounds against Portland State and 17 points and 14 boards against Troy.
- · The Greenwood, Ind., native also knocked down 11-of-13 (84.6 percent) of his free throws, the second time this season he made at least 10 free throws. Jackson-Davis finished 5-of-9 from the floor.
- Green tallied 16 points on 3-of-5 shooting from behind the 3-point line in 27 minutes for the Hoosiers. He also grabbed two rebounds.
- **Durham** had 18 points in 31 minutes and added a team-high four assists and four rebounds.
- Brunk scored 12 points and nearly finished as the second Hoosier with a double-double with eight rebounds. He also dished out four assists.
- · Junior forward Justin Smith scored three points and added three rebounds and a teamhigh three steals in 33 minutes.
- Redshirt sophomore forward Race Thompson made his first career 3-pointer and finished the game with six points and two rebounds.

SOUTH DAKOTA STATE

- · Indiana completes an undefeated month for the second time in two seasons (6-0, Dec. 2018).
- · This was the fourth and final game of the Indiana Challenge. Indiana finished 4-0.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Freshman forward Trayce Jackson-Davis was named MVP of the Challenge averaging 17.0 points and 11.8 rebounds in the four-game series. He finished today's game with his fourth double-double of the season with 19 points and 14 rebounds.
- Indiana took the lead, 4-2, on a Jackson-Davis layup at the 16:51 point of the first half and never trailed again.
- A 6-0 run by the Hoosiers and a 26-18 lead capped off by a junior forward Justin Smith dunk triggered a Jackrabbit timeout at the 5:36 mark in the first half. The Hoosiers followed defensively by forcing a shot clock violation.
- · The Hoosier defense forced 11 first-half turnovers, which helped lead to 11 fast-break points. Indiana forced a total of 17 turnovers and have forced double-digit turnovers in all seven games to begin the season.
- Indiana finished the first half on a 17-8 run and led South Dakota State at halftime, 37-26.
- Indiana took its largest lead of the game at 16 at the 11:00 mark of the second half on a Jackson-Davis layup.
- Indiana held the Jackrabbits to 18-of-48 (37.5 percent) shooting, which marks the fourth time this season the Hoosiers have held an opponent under 40.0 percent from the floor.
- Three Hoosiers scored in double figures on Saturday, Jackson-Davis (19), Smith (18) and senior guard **Devonte Green** (11).
- Jackson-Davis scored a team-high 19 points while tying career-highs of 14 rebounds and four blocks in 27 minutes.
- Nine of Jackson-Davis' 14 rebounds were on the offensive side, which is the most offensive rebounds by an IU player since Freddie McSwain Jr. grabbed nine against Michigan State on Feb. 3, 2018.
- Smith scored 18 points for IU and grabbed eight rebounds in 29 minutes.
- Green made a game-high three 3-point baskets to help with his 11 points and he also grabbed two rebounds and dished out three assists.
- Junior guard Aljami Durham tallied five points for the Hoosiers and grabbed three rebounds while recording a team-high two steals in 29 minutes.
- Freshman guard Armaan Franklin had a 3-pointer and added three rebounds and a team-high four assists.

Indiana Seminary was founded on January 20, 1820. It became Indiana College in 1828 and Indiana University in 1838. An early Trustee noted that when IU welcomed its first students, "a fire was kindled on the altar of learning that has never been extinguished."

Over 200 years, that fire has grown stronger. It has fueled an engine of prosperity for Indiana and the nation, sparked discoveries that solve the world's problems, and illuminated possibilities of human imagination. The original class of 12 men has become a diverse student community more than 110,000 strong from 139 countries. The single building that comprised our first campus is today a statewide network of IU campuses and a global online learning environment. And with the nation's third largest alumni body, IU has graduates in every corner of the world.

"The IU Bicentennial is an opportunity to reflect on Indiana University's first 200 years, and to envision all that it will become in its next century," said Indiana University President Michael A. McRobbie.

The Indiana University Bicentennial is a multi-year, multi-campus program that is academically driven, historically grounded, intellectually stimulating, and enjoyable. Through focused study and criticism, reflection, celebration, and documentation, the Bicentennial demonstrates how Indiana University has served as a "people's university." The Program includes a dynamic series of Bicentennial Signature Projects complemented by activities stemming from individuals, departments, schools, and campuses.

Glass Honors Fischer With IU Bicentennial Medal at IU Athletics Hall of Fame Banquet

IU Vice President and Director of Intercollegiate Athletics Fred Glass presented Don Fischer with the IU Bicentennial medal Friday night at the IU Athletics Hall of Fame dinner, recognizing Fischer's nearly five decades of contributions to IU Athletics as the play-by-play voice of IU football and men's basketball.

"As we recognize and chronicle the history of Indiana University during our Bicentennial year, no one has narrated IU Athletics' history like Don has," Glass said. "He is an icon in his profession, is beloved by multiple generations of Hoosier fans, and is a very deserving recipient of this prestigious honor."

The IU Bicentennial medal is awarded to organizations and individuals who, through their personal, professional, artistic, or philanthropic efforts, have broadened the reach of Indiana University around the state, nation, and world. Recipients have enlarged the footprint of IU, or have helped put IU on the map in unique ways, and should be seen as models for future students, faculty, alumni, and organizations to emulate as IU enters its third century.

Fischer clearly reaches that intentionally high bar. Since first coming onto the IU scene in 1973 as the play-by-play voice of Indiana Football, he's been the person that millions of Hoosier fans have trusted to share what unfolds on the field and the court for their beloved Indiana Hoosiers. He's been behind the microphone for many of the truly great moments in IU Athletics history, including three of Indiana's five NCAA men's basketball championships.

His longevity is exceeded only by his excellence at his craft, as he has been honored as the National Sports Media Association's Indiana Sportscaster of the Year 26 times.

THIRD YEAR AT INDIANA • NINTH YEAR AS COLLEGE HEAD COACH

Career Record: 182-94 Overall • 85-48 Conference Record at Indiana: 43-31 Overall • 17-21 Big Ten

- · Named the 29th head coach of the Indiana Men's Basketball program on March 25, 2017, by Indiana University Vice President and Director of Athletics Fred
- · Miller has delivered on his promise to build the program from the inside out, with six Hoosier natives in his first two recruiting classes including McDonald's All-Americans and Indiana Mr. Basketball winners Romeo Langford (2018) and Trayce Jackson-Davis (2019).
- · Last season, the Hoosiers earned their first national ranking under Miller and were rated as high as 21st in the country in early January. IU earned nationally ranked wins over Michigan State (twice), Marquette (Gavitt Games) and Wisconsin and notched triumphs against Louisville and Butler (Crossroads Classic).
- · IU finished with 19 wins and won two post season games in the NIT. Senior Juwan Morgan and Langford would go on to earn All-Big Ten honors and Langford was named to the USBWA All-District team. Morgan would finish his career 24th on the IU all-time scoring list and also finished eighth in career blocks and 10th in career rebounds. The Hoosiers also improved to 32nd in adjusted defense after finishing 65th in 2017-18. IU also finished 36th in the country in blocked shots.
- · In his first season at IU, Miller saw the Hoosiers improve dramatically during his first season. After seeing IU allow 76 points per game on 45.9 percent shooting and 41.7 percent accuracy from 3-point range in the month of November, IU limited teams to 65.4 points on 41.3 percent shooting from the floor and 33.1 percent from long distance in the month of February.
- · IU posted a two-win improvement in the Big Ten from 2016-17 to 2017-18.
- · He saw junior forward Juwan Morgan emerge as the most improved player in the Big Ten adding more than 10 points per game scoring in Big Ten play during the 2017-18 season. Morgan earned secondteam All-Big Ten honors and was named All-District by the USBWA and NABC in 2018. Senior Rob Johnson averaged a career-best 14.0 points per game earned honorable mention All-Big-Ten honors his senior year.

- · Regarded as one of the top young coaches in the country, Miller is a tireless recruiter, noted developer of talent, and a gifted tactician whose teams are known for their stout defense and efficient offense. His 2018 recruiting class at IU was ranked 7th in the nation after a successful haul of players from the Big Ten footprint.
- · The 41-year old native of Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania, came to IU after serving six seasons as head coach at the University of Dayton, where he won Atlantic 10 Conference regular season championships in 2016 and 2017.
- · He guided the Flyers to a 139-63 record (69.8) and a 68-34 mark (66.7) in the Atlantic 10. He took Dayton to the NCAA Tournament each of the last four years with the Flyers advancing to the Elite Eight in the 2014 Tournament. UD was nationally ranked in three of Miller's six seasons (2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16).
- · During their elite eight run, UD topped Ohio State (60-59), Syracuse (55-53) and Stanford (82-72) before falling to Florida (62-52) in the regional finals. In 2015, they defeated Boise State (56-55) and Providence (66-53) and were eliminated by Oklahoma (72-66) in the Sweet Sixteen. In 2016, they were defeated by Final Four participant Syracuse (70-51) in the second round and by Wichita State (64-58) in their first tournament game this season.
- · Miller is one of five active coaches who had at least five NCAA wins in his first four seasons. The others are Mark Few, Thad Matta, Shaka Smart and Roy Williams. With three NCAA wins in 2014 and another two in 2015, Dayton was one of just six teams to have at least five NCAA tournament wins in those two years. The others were Arizona, UConn, Kentucky, Michigan State and Wisconsin.
- For his efforts during the 2016-17 season, he was named Atlantic 10 and NABC District Coach of the Year. He led UD to perform at a championship level despite playing a 2016-17 campaign where the team's top six scorers missed a total of 32 games during the year due to injury. He also was a finalist for the 2015 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award.
- · He comes from a family of coaches with his father, John, having guided Archie and his brother Sean at Blackhawk High School in Beaver Falls. His brother Sean has been the head coach at the University of Arizona and also was the head coach at Xavier University. John was one of the country's top high school coaches when he retired in 2005, with 657 wins in a 35year coaching career. Archie, Sean and their sister Lisa all played Division I college basketball.

- Miller is regarded as a top recruiter - Arizona's 2011 recruits were a Top 10 class - and game strategist - he was the architect of the Wildcats upset of eighthranked Texas to get them to the Sweet 16. He was reunited with his brother during the summer of 2015 on the coaching staff of USA Basketball's U19 World Championship. When Sean was elevated to the team's head coach, he turned to his brother to help USA basketball win the gold at the 2015 FIBA U19 World Championship that was held June 27-July 5 in Heraklion, Crete, Greece.
- He was a four-year letterwinner at North Carolina State from 1998-2002. A point guard, he is currently third at NC State in career FT% (.846, 165-195), sixth in career 3-pt. FG% (.429, 218-509), and fourth in career threes (218). As a senior, he helped lead the Wolfpack to the finals of the ACC championship game and was named to the all-tournament team. That season was coach Herb Sendek's first NCAA team at NC State.
- · As an assistant, Miller coached in the Big Ten, Pac-12 and ACC, where he honed his craft under some of the most respected coaches in the country. He began his coaching career at NC State, serving as a coaching intern under Sendek in 2002-03. Miller then went to Western Kentucky as a full-time member of Darrin Horn's staff for one season. He returned to NC State, first as Director of Basketball Operations (2004-05), and then as a fulltime assistant coach (2005-06). When Sendek went to Arizona State in 2006-07, Miller remained on his coaching staff before joining Thad Matta at Ohio State for two seasons (2007-09). As a coach, he has been part of 20-plus win and NCAA seasons at NC State (2005-06), Ohio State (2008-09), Arizona (2010-11), and Dayton (2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17).
- · In April, 2015, he joined his father and brother in the Beaver County Sports Hall of Fame. Other greats in the Beaver County Hall include Mike Ditka, Tony Dorsett, Terry Francona, Pete and Press Maravich, Joe Namath, Babe Parilli and Norm Van Lier.
- · Miller earned his bachelor's degree in Parks, Recreation and Tourism from NC State in 2002. He was born October 30, 1978. He is married to the former Morgan Nicole Cruse and they have a 15-year old daughter, Leah.









