BADGERS TIP OFF SEASON WEDNESDAY

- Wisconsin will open the 2020-21 season on Nov. 25 vs. Eastern Illinois. The Badgers also hosted EIU in their home opener last season, claiming a 65-52 win. UW has won 21 of the last 22 home openers (back to 1998-99).
- The Badgers begin the season ranked No. 7 in both the AP and Coaches polls, marking the second-highest preseason ranking in school history, trailing only the 2014-15 season when UW debuted at No. 3.

GAME 1 - FAST BREAK FACTS

- Wisconsin begins its 24th season in the Kohl Center, sporting an all-time record of 312-52 (.857) in its home building the 10th-best win percentage of any Div. 1 home venue.
- Head coach Greg Gard was named 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year by both the coaches and media. Gard became Wisconsin's second coach to earn that award, joining four-time winner Bo Ryan (2002, '03, '13 and '15).
- Gard enters the season with a career record of 101-57 overall. He is the 2nd-fastest Wisconsin coach to 100 wins in the NCAA tournament era, doing so in 157 games. Only Bo Ryan reached 100 faster (138 games).
- With a conference record of 59-35, Gard's .628 conference win percentage ranks 6th among all Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years (page 2).
- Last season, Wisconsin finished the season with 8 consecutive wins to win a share of the 2020
 Big Ten Championship, the 19th title in school history, and first since 2015.
- Wisconsin has won 5 Big Ten championships since 2000, matching Ohio State for the 2ndmost during that span. Only Michigan State (7) has more league titles since 2000.
- During Wisconsin's 8-game win streak, 6 different Badgers tallied double-digit points. All 6 led UW in scoring in a game during the streak.
- The Badgers return their entire starting 5 from the final game of last season and bring back 7 of the top 8 scorers overall from a season ago.
- UW returns 77.5% of its minutes from last season as well as 78.7% of points, 83.6% of rebounds, 86.1% of assists, 79.7% of steals and 88.6% of blocks.

 Wisconsin has a trio of players on watch lists for major awards: PG D'Mitrik

Trice (Bob Cousy Award), PF **Nate**

Reuvers (Karl Malone Award) and C **Micah Potter** (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar).

- Reuvers was also named to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team.
- UW's leading scorer a year ago, senior forward Nate Reuvers was Mr. Reliable last season.
 The Third-Team All-Big Ten forward scored in double figures in 24 of 31 games (12 of last 15).
- In UW's home opener last season vs. EIU, Reuvers was 1 block shy of his first career triple-double: 14 pts, career-high 14 reb, 9 blk.
- Micah Potter positioned himself as the Big Ten's most valuable reserve. In B1G play last year, Potter was UW's second-leading scorer averaging 10.7 ppg, 6.2 rpg while shooting 53.7% FG and 47.8% 3FG (more on page 3).
- Third-Team All-Big Ten guard **D'Mitrik Trice** rounded out his game, averaging 9.8 ppg, 4.2 apg, 4.0 rpg. His 2.5 ast-to-TO ratio tied Josh Gasser for 8th best in UW history (more pg 2).
- Wisconsin's active career scoring leader,
 Brad Davison ranks 43rd in UW history with
 1,052 points. During UW's 8-game win streak,
 he led UW avg 13.5 ppg (45.2% FG, 47.6% 3FG).
- Senior Aleem Ford ended last season strong. He entered his Junior year with 9 career doubledigit scoring games, but tallied 14 last year alone (including 7 over UW's final 10 games).

In his 6th season as head coach, **Greg Gard** is quickly placing himself among the greatest Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years.

 With a conference record of 59-35, Gard's .628 conference win percentage ranks 6th among Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years (since 1980).

- Gard is now 101-57 overall, and became the 2nd-fastest (157 games) Wisconsin coach to 100 wins in the NCAA tournament era. Only Bo Ryan reached 100 faster (138 games).

B1G CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

- Wisconsin won the program's 19th Big Ten championship last season and first since 2015. Only Purdue (22), Indiana (22) and Ohio State (20) have won more B1G titles.
- The Badgers have won 5 Big Ten titles since 2000, matching Ohio State for the 2nd-most during that span. Only Michigan State (7) has more league titles since 2000.
- UW won 14 Big Ten games for the secondconsecutive season, equaling the 3rd-highest single-season total in school history.

- UW has won 12+ B1G games in 10 of last 11 seasons, the most of any Big Ten team.
- Including last season, Wisconsin has finished among the top four of the Big Ten standings in 18 of the last 19 seasons. No other Big Ten team can make that claim.

■ Since 2001-02, <u>UW</u> has the most Big Ten wins and best win pct. at 230-103 (.692).

RELIABLE REUVERS

From Mike Wilkinson to Brian Butch to Jon Leuer to Frank Kaminsky and Ethan Happ, Wisconsin basketball has a rich tradition of first-team All-Big Ten big men. **Nate Reuvers** is poised to be the next in that great lineage.

- A 2020 Third-Team All-Big Ten honoree, Reuvers finished last season averaging 13.1 points, 4.5 rebounds and 1.9 blocks per game.
- He scored in double figures in 24 of 31 games last season, including 12 of the last 15. That included matching his career high (22 pts) on two different occasions last year (vs. #20 Saint Mary's and vs. Milwaukee).
- Reuvers has scored 20+ points 6 times in his career, with 3 of those coming last season.
- Reuvers enters his senior season 179
 points away from joining teammates Brad
 Davison (1,052) and D'Mitrik Trice (1,000) in
 Wisconsin's 1,000-point club.
- Reuvers recorded 58 blocks last year, tied for the 7th highest single-season mark at UW.
- Reuvers also owns UW's 5th-highest singleseason blocks total with 60 blocks in 2018-19.
- Reuvers is tied for 3rd in UW history with 144 career blocks. He needs just 11 swats to break Ethan Happ's school record (154).

POTTER MAGIC

- Senior Micah Potter proved his value the moment he joined UW's active roster on Dec. 21, 2019, emerging as one of the most valuable players in the Big Ten last season.
- During Big Ten play, Potter averaged
 10.9 ppg, 6.5 rpg while shooting 54.2% FG
 and 46.9% from 3FG.

Among reserves, Potter trailed only Ohio State's Duane Washington, Jr. (11.8 ppg) in scoring. In conference play, Potter led all reserves in rebounding, FG% and 3FG%.

- Potter developed into one of the Big Ten's best 3-point shooters, going 23-for-49 (46.9%) from long range during conference play last year (2nd-best mark in the Big Ten).
- Among players 6-foot-10 or taller, only South Dakota's Tyler Hagedorn (51.4%) had a better 3-point field goal pct. than Potter last season.
- From an efficiency standpoint, Potter put together one of Wisconsin's better seasons in the past 25 years. Per 40 minutes of action, Potter averaged 22.8 ppg and 14.1 rpg.

- Potter started in UW's B1G title-clinching win at Indiana, finishing with 14 points and 11 rebounds (3rd double-double of the season).
- In 13 minutes off the bench vs. #17 Maryland, Potter scored 14 points (6-7 FG, 2-3 3FG).
- Potter broke out last year at #20 Penn State, posting his first double-double at UW with career highs in points (24) and rebounds (13).

REKINDLE THE MAGIC?

Not only did Wisconsin finish last season on an 8-game win streak, but it closed the year as one of the nation's best offenses.

CLASS OF 2021 RECRUITING CLASS

Coach Greg Gard announced Nov. 11, 2020 that high school seniors **Chucky Hepburn**, **Chris Hodges** and **Matthew Mors** have signed their National Letters of Intent and will play basketball for the Badgers in the fall of 2021.

ESPN ranked each as a four-star prospect.

- Chucky Hepburn | G | Bellevue, Neb. ESPN four-star recruit Chucky Hepburn comes to Wisconsin as the 20th-ranked point guard in the nation. A native of Bellevue, Nebraska, Hepburn was named the state's Gatorade Player of the Year in 2020 after leading Bellevue West to a record of 21-3 and the Class A state championship. Hepburn was a three-time All-Metro First-Team honoree (2018, '19, '20) and earned First-Team All-Class All-State honors in 2019 and 2020. He averaged 17.7 points, 6.1 assists, 4.6 rebounds and 3.1 steals per game as a junior. During his sophomore season, Hepburn took home 2019 First Team Super-State honors from the Lincoln Journal Star averaging 18.3 points, 5.1 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 3.4 steals per game. Hepburn garnered third-team All-Metro honors from the Omaha World-Herald in 2018 after leading Bellevue West to the state championship game as a freshman.
- Chris Hodges | F | Schaumburg, III. ESPN four-star commit Chris Hodges from Schaumburg, Illinois continues a long line of Badgers to come from the suburban Chicago area. Last season as a junior, Hodges was named Mid-Suburban League West Player of the Year after leading Schaumburg High School to a 25-7 record, winning the MSL championship and advancing to the Regional Finals. He earned Second-Team Class 4A All-State honors with the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association, while also being named a unanimous MSL all-conference honoree and a unanimous all-area selection. The 6-foot-9 power forward averaged 15.5 points (69.8% FG shooting), 8.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game last season. As a sophomore, Hodges earned All-Area honors from the Daily Herald after posting 16 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2 blocks per game helping Schaumburg to a regional championship.
- Matthew Mors | F | Yankton, S.D.

A consensus top-150 recruit, Matthew Mors enters his senior season as the rare four-time all-state selection and reigning back-to-back Gatorade Player of the Year in South Dakota. The 6-foot-7 forward first joined the Yankton High School varsity team as a seventh grader and promptly helped the Bucks to the 2016 state championship. The 2020 South Dakota Basketball Coaches Association Class AA Player of the Year, Mors enters his senior season as South Dakota's Class AA all-time leading scorer with 2,127 career points and counting. As a junior, he averaged 19.4 points, 8.2 rebounds, 2.9 assists and 2.1 steals per game while shooting 51.4% from the field, leading Yankton to the No. 1 seed in the state playoffs before the season was ended prematurely. Mors has averaged at least 19.0 points per game in each of the last four seasons.

coaching veteran of 30 years, Greg Gard will enter his sixth season atop the Wisconsin men's basketball program in 2020-21 after proving himself as one of the best head coaches in the Big Ten. Gard earned 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors after leading the Badgers to the regular season conference championship last season.

Wisconsin's incredible postseason success hasn't wavered on Gard's watch either, participating in the NCAA tournament in three of his first four seasons and earning the Big Ten's automatic qualifier status in the canceled 2020 Big Dance. Gard's postseason ledger includes a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

In just five seasons as head coach, Gard has posted a record of 101-57, becoming the second-fastest (157 games) Wisconsin coach to 100 overall wins in the NCAA tournament era. He has also guided the Badgers to a conference record of 59-35, and his .628 conference win percentage ranks sixth among Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years.

After initially taking over on an interim basis midway through the 2015-16 season, Gard would go on to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award that season and was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. Through five seasons, Gard has already risen to fifth on the school's all-time wins list and owns the third-best win percentage at UW.

Gard's most recent season leading the Badgers might have been his best. After opening the season 5-5 overall and then 5-5 in the Big Ten, Wisconsin won nine of its last 10 games, including its final eight games of the season to win a share of the 2020 conference title and claim the No. 1 seed for the later canceled Big Ten tournament. During that run, UW knocked off No. 14 Michigan State, won at No. 19 Michigan and closed the season with a win at Indiana to clinch the title.

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in

both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 2018-19, Gard piloted the Badgers back to the Big Dance, posting a 23-11 overall record. Wisconsin also boasted a mark of 14-6 in Big Ten play, winning 14 conference games for just the 3rd time in school history, joining 16-win seasons in 2008 and 2015.

In 19 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings just once while amassing a combined mark of 231-103 (.692) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes earned the nod in 2016 and third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in both 2017. 2018 and 2019.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. During that time, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard's 13th and 14th seasons in Madison were some of the program's most memorable. He helped guide the Badgers to back-to-back Final Fours in 2014 and 2015, and in 2015 UW reached its first national championship game since 1941. UW shattered the school's single-season wins record (36) in 2015, becoming one of just 10 teams with at least 36 wins in DI history. In 2014, UW finished 30-8 and won at least 30 games for just the third time in school history.

In fact, Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 13 winningest seasons at Wisconsin.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. Previously, Gard served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.
