BADGERS LOOK TO KEEP WIN STREAK ALIVE VS. GREEN BAY


- Winners of 10 straight, Wisconsin hosts Green Bay on Tuesday at the Kohl Center in a meeting of former colleagues. Head coaches Greg Gard and Will Ryan, son of Bo Ryan, served on UW's staff together (2002-07).
- The Badgers rose three spots to No. 4 in the AP Top 25. This marks UW's highest ranking since being ranked No. 3 on March 16, 2015. It's also just the fourth season in which Wisconsin has appeared in the AP Top 5.

GAME 3 - FAST BREAK FACTS

- Wisconsin's 10-game win streak is tied for the 6th-longest win streak in the nation and is the longest among major conference teams (page 2).
- Wisconsin begins its 24th season in the Kohl Center, sporting an all-time record of 314-52 (.858) in its home building the 10th-best win percentage of any Div. 1 home venue.
- Head coach Greg Gard was named 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year by both the coaches and media. Gard became Wisconsin's second coach to earn that award, joining four-time winner Bo Ryan (2002, '03, '13 and '15).
- Gard owns a career record of 103-57 (.644) overall. He is the 2nd-fastest Wisconsin coach to 100 wins in the NCAA tournament era, doing so in 157 games. Only Bo Ryan reached 100 faster (138 games).
- With a conference record of 59-35, Gard's .628 conference win percentage ranks 6th among all Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years (page 2).
- Last season, Wisconsin finished the season with 8 consecutive wins to win a share of the 2020 Big Ten Championship, the 19th title in school history, and first since 2015.
- Wisconsin has won 5 Big Ten championships since 2000, matching Ohio State for the 2ndmost during that span. Only Michigan State (7) has more league titles since 2000.
- The Badgers return their entire starting 5 from the final game of last season and bring back 7 of the top 8 scorers overall from a season ago.
- UW returns 77.5% of its minutes from last season as well as 78.7% of points, 83.6% of rebounds, 86.1% of assists, 79.7% of steals and 88.6% of blocks.

- Reuvers also named Preseason All-Big Ten Team.
- UW's leading scorer a year ago, Third-Team All-Big Ten senior forward Nate Reuvers has scored in double figures 14 of the last 17 games (including 18pts in UW's season opener).
- Reuvers tallied 5 blocks against EIU and has 150 for his career. He is now 5 away from the school's all-time record held by Ethan Happ (154).
- Micah Potter positioned himself as the Big Ten's most valuable reserve. In B1G play last year, Potter was UW's second-leading scorer averaging 10.7 ppg, 6.2 rpg while shooting 53.7% FG and 47.8% 3FG (more on page 3).
- Third-Team All-Big Ten guard **D'Mitrik Trice** rounded out his game, averaging 9.8 ppg, 4.2 apg, 4.0 rpg. His 2.5 ast-to-TO ratio tied Josh Gasser for 8th best in UW history (more pg 2).
- In UW's season-opening win over EIU (11/25), freshmen Ben Carlson, Steven Crowl and Jonathan Davis combined for 23 points, the most by a freshmen class in an opener since 2010 when Josh Gasser, Ben Brust and Duje Dukan combined for 25 points.
- Wisconsin's active career scoring leader, Brad Davison ranks 42nd in UW history with 1,063 points. During UW's 8-game win streak last season, led UW avg 12.7 ppg (47.2% 3FG).

- The Badgers' 10-game win streak is the team's longest since having an 11-game win streak snapped in the 2015 National Championship game.
- Wisconsin also owns a 10-game win streak, the longest active in the Big Ten. UW's home win streak began with a 56-54 win over No. 17 Maryland on Jan. 14, 2020.
- The Badgers have won 17 consecutive home games against non-conference opponents, a streak that began nearly 3 years ago. UW's home non-conference win streak began with an 81-80 win over Western Kentucky on Dec. 13, 2017.

RELIABLE REUVERS

A third-team All-Big Ten pick last season, **Nate Reuvers** is poised to make that a first-team pick in 2020-21.

- Through 2 games, Reuvers is averaging 16.0 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 3.0 bpg. The big man is shooting 64.7% from the field, 66.7% (2-3) from deep and 72.7% (8-11) at the FT line.
- Now his senior season, Reuvers is just 147 points away from joining teammates Brad

- Davison (1,063) and D'Mitrik Trice (1,026) in Wisconsin's 1,000-point club.
- Dating back to last season, Reuvers has scored in double figures in 14 of the last 17 games.
 - Reuvers has scored 20+ points 6 times in his career, with 3 of those coming last season.
- With 5 blocks vs. EIU, Reuvers moved into 3rd place on UW's career blocks list and now trails only Frank Kaminsky and Ethan Happ. He needs just 5 swats to break Happ's school record.

SERIES VS. GREEN BAY

Wisconsin and Green Bay renew a rivalry on Tuesday that has been played every year except one dating back to 1999. The schools meet for the 26th time, with the Badgers owning a 24-1 record against Green Bay, going 21-0 in Madison.

- Greg Gard's first game as head coach was against Green Bay, an 84-79 win on Dec. 23, 2015. Gard is 4-0 all-time against Green Bay.
- Wisconsin has won each of the last 9 games against Green Bay by an average of 15.3 points per contest.
- Green Bay head coach Will Ryan is the son of UW Hall of Fame coach Bo Ryan. Among the credentials for the elder Ryan:
- The winningest coach in UW history with a record of 364–130 (.737) in 14-plus seasons
- Led UW to 4 Big Ten regular season championships and 3 Big Ten Tournament titles
- Received 4 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors
- Guided UW to 14 consecutive NCAA tournament appearances, 7 Sweet 16s, 3 Elite Eights, 2 Final Fours and the 2015 national championship game
- Inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame in 2017
- Greg Gard and Will Ryan worked together on the UW staff from 2002-07, with Gard serving as assistant coach and Will Ryan holding the positions of video coordinator and director of basketball operations.
- Green Bay assistant coach Freddie Owens appeared in 111 games (61 starts) at Wisconsin, scoring 796 career points. Owens helped the Badgers win the 2002 and 2003 Big Ten regular-season and 2004 Big Ten Tournament championships.
- Green Bay assistant coach Brandon Pritzl is the older brother of former Badger Brevin Pritzl (2016-20). Brevin Pritzl, who appeared in 122 games for UW, is currently playing professionally in Serbia.

Green Bay director of operations Sam Vander Plas was a student manager for UW women's basketball, graduating in 2018.

- Wisconsin senior Trevor Anderson played one season with Green Bay before joining the Badgers as a transfer. Anderson started 20 games for the Phoenix in 2016-17.
- UW is 7-2 against in-state opponents under Greg Gard and has gone 46-11 (.807) in such games dating back to 2000.

BADGERS PUSH FOR CHANGE

Wisconsin student-athletes have an addition to their uniforms across all sports during the 2020-21 season

- the school's iconic crest logo with the central "W" changed from its traditional white to black.

An initiative started by Wisconsin's student-athletes of color, the Black Crest is displayed in a show of solidarity between UW's student-athletes and the athletic department



as well as minority students across campus. The Black Crest also symbolizes studentathletes' efforts to enhance the campus experience for all students of color by providing additional resources and creating a platform for their voices to be heard.

Among the initiatives of recent months:

- An on-campus rally for unity and equality organized by student-athletes in September Senior forward Aleem Ford, pictured above, was a key leader of this event.
- Creation of an Equity & Diversity Council made up of alumni that is built to assist with UW Athletics' Diversity and Inclusion Strategic Plan

coaching veteran of 30 years, Greg Gard will enter his sixth season atop the Wisconsin men's basketball program in 2020-21 after proving himself as one of the best head coaches in the Big Ten. Gard earned 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors after leading the Badgers to the regular season conference championship last season.

Wisconsin's incredible postseason success hasn't wavered on Gard's watch either, participating in the NCAA tournament in three of his first four seasons and earning the Big Ten's automatic qualifier status in the canceled 2020 Big Dance. Gard's postseason ledger includes a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

In just five seasons as head coach, Gard has posted a record of 101-57, becoming the second-fastest (157 games) Wisconsin coach to 100 overall wins in the NCAA tournament era. He has also guided the Badgers to a conference record of 59-35, and his .628 conference win percentage ranks sixth among Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years.

After initially taking over on an interim basis midway through the 2015-16 season, Gard would go on to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award that season and was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. Through five seasons, Gard has already risen to fifth on the school's all-time wins list and owns the third-best win percentage at UW.

Gard's most recent season leading the Badgers might have been his best. After opening the season 5-5 overall and then 5-5 in the Big Ten, Wisconsin won nine of its last 10 games, including its final eight games of the season to win a share of the 2020 conference title and claim the No. 1 seed for the later canceled Big Ten tournament. During that run, UW knocked off No. 14 Michigan State, won at No. 19 Michigan and closed the season with a win at Indiana to clinch the title.

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another

12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16

In 2018-19, Gard piloted the Badgers back to the Big Dance, posting a 23-11 overall record. Wisconsin also boasted a mark of 14-6 in Big Ten play, winning 14 conference games for just the 3rd time in school history, joining 16-win seasons in 2008 and 2015.

In 19 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth in the Big Ten standings just once while amassing a combined mark of 231-103 (.692) in league play.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes earned the nod in 2016 and third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in both 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. During that time, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard helped guide the Badgers to back-to-back Final Fours in 2014 and 2015, and in 2015 UW reached its first national championship game since 1941. UW shattered the school's single-season wins record (36) in 2015, becoming one of just 10 teams with at least 36 wins in DI history. In 2014, UW finished 30-8 and won at least 30 games for just the third time in school his-

In fact, Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 13 winningest seasons at Wisconsin.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. Previously, Gard served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.
