### BADGERS OPEN SEASON AGAINST UW-OSHKOSH

- Wisconsin opens its first season under head coach **Marisa Moseley** when it hosts UW-Oshkosh in an exhibition on Sunday. Tip time is 2 p.m. from the Kohl Center.
- The Badgers are 4-1 against UW-Oshkosh, including a 1-1 mark in Madison. The two teams have not met since 1979.
- With the exception of 2020-21, UW has hosted a member of the WIAC during exhibition play for the last 15 years. Wisconsin last played the Titans in 2018, winning 79-51 in the Kohl Center.

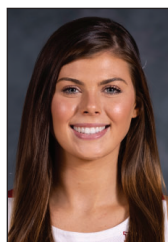


*Sydney Hilley returns as the Badgers' leading scorer.*

### FAST BREAK FACTS

- The Badgers open their first season under head coach **Marisa Moseley** in 2021-22. Moseley spent the last three seasons at her alma mater, Boston University, where she was 45-29. She was named the 2019 Patriot League Coach of the Year and aided her 2020-21 team to the conference tournament for the first time in program history.
- Wisconsin returns nine letter winners and three starters from last season. Leading the team will be junior guard **Sydney Hilliard**, who averaged a team-best 15.5 ppg last season. She earned consensus honorable mention All-Big Ten selection in 2021. Other returning starters include junior guard **Julie Pospíšilová** (8.9 ppg / 3.7 apg) and junior forward **Sara Stapleton** (6.5 ppg / 4.0 rpg).
- UW adds five newcomers to its team in 2021-22, including **Katie Nelson**, a guard from Boston University. Nelson was a 2021 first-team All-Patriot League selection. Redshirt sophomore **Alex Duckett** returns after joining the Badgers last season but didn't see any playing time due to injury. The Badgers also add three freshmen in **Krystyna Ellew** (5-10, G, Chicago; **Sacia Vanderpool** (6-4, F, Byron, Minn.; and **Maty Wilke** (5-10, G, Beaver Dam, Wis.)
- The Badgers return 83.4% of their assists, 72% of their 3-pointers, 62% of their points, and 60% of their rebounds from last season.
- In Sunday's match up with the Titans, sophomore guard **Brooke Schramek** will face off against her older sister, Kendal. Both played high school ball at Benet Academy and this will be the first time they face-off as rivals in college.

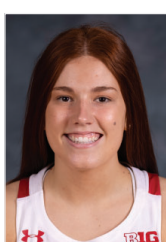

**HILLIARD NAMED ALL-BIG TEN**

- Sophomore **Sydney Hilliard** was a unanimous honorable mention All-Big Ten selection in 2021.
- Hilliard led the Badgers and ranked 14th in the Big Ten with 15.5 points per game. The 5-foot-11 guard led the UW in scoring in 11 games and also led the team in assists in 11 games, averaging a team-best 4.0 assists per game, which ties for 12th in the conference.
- Hilliard scored a career-high 26 points at Iowa on Dec. 5 and scored 20-plus points in seven games. She was named to the Big Ten Honor Roll on Dec. 21, 2020 and earned Academic All-Big Ten accolades.

**MOST IMPROVED SCORER**

- **Sydney Hilliard** was the 10th most improved scorer in the Big Ten last season. Hilliard has improved her scoring from 9.2 ppg in 2019-20 to 15.5 ppg in 2020-21, a jump of 6.3 ppg. Sophomores **Sara Stapleton** and **Julie Pospíšilová** rank among the top 15 most improved scorers. Stapleton ties for 13th, improving her scoring from 2.3 ppg as a freshman to 6.9 ppg this season, an improvement of 4.6 ppg. Pospíšilová ranks 15th with an improvement of 3.9 ppg (5.1 to 9.0).

- Graduate student **Alex Luehring** is counting down to 200 career points, needing one tally. She is also 11 rebounds away from 100 rebounds.
- Junior **Julie Pospíšilová** is counting down to 200 career rebounds, needing 27 karooms. She will also reach 400 points with 39 tallies.
- Sophomore **Sara Stapleton** will reach 200 career points with 14 tallies.

**NINE DOUBLE-DOUBLES ON YEAR**

- Three Badgers recorded double-doubles this season. **Sydney Hilliard** tallied the second double-double of her career vs. Minnesota on Jan. 3 with 21 points and a career-high 11 assists. Her first double-double came as a freshman with 15 points and 11 rebounds vs. Prairie View on Dec. 20, 2019. Sophomore **Sara Stapleton** had her first two career double-doubles last season. The 6-foot-3 post recorded her first career double-double vs. Western Illinois on Nov. 29, tallying 11 points and 11 rebounds. She picked up her second career double-double against Ohio State on Feb. 10 with 14 points and 10 rebounds.

### PERSONAL BESTS SET

- The Badger returnees and upperclassmen set or tied 60 personal bests in 2020-21.
- Sophomore **Julie Pospíšilová** set or tied 12 personal bests while sophomore **Sara Stapleton** recorded or tied 10 personal bests.
- Sophomore **Sydney Hilliard** tallied nine personal bests while **Tara Stauffacher** has tallied recorded eight personal bests. Junior **Alex Luehring** set or tied two personal bests.

### HAVING CAREER SEASONS

- Eight Badgers had the best seasons of their careers in 2020-21.  
Sophomore **Sydney Hilliard** averaged a career-best 15.5 points per game while shooting 31.6% from 3-point range and 74% from the free-throw line. The guard averaged season bests of 5.3 rebounds per game and 4.0 assists per game, surpassing her freshman year total of 66 dimes with 95 last season.  
Junior **Alex Luehring** shot a season-best 30.6% from 3-point range.  
Sophomore **Julie Pospíšilová** averaged career bests of 8.9 points and 3.8 rebounds per game while shooting season highs of 40.8% from field goal range, including 36.6% from 3-point range. She also had 39 steals (1.7/game), surpassing her freshman-season total of 19; 27 blocks (1.2/game), surpassing last year's total of 15 stuffs; and assists (3.7/game), 25 more than her freshman season total.  
Sophomore **Sara Stapleton** averaged season bests of 6.5 points and 4.0 rebounds per game. She also shot a season high 77.3% from the free-throw line. Stapleton also has seven steals, four more than her freshman year total; 17 blocks, five more than her 12 from her freshman season; and 12 assists, 10 more than last year.  
Sophomore **Tara Stauffacher** tallied season bests of 2.7 points and 1.9 rebounds per game. She is shooting a season best 31.8% from the field, including 29.8% from 3-point range. Stauffacher has also started the first three games of her career last year.

### DOWNING A RANKED TEAM

- For the first time in eight years, the Badgers took down a top-15 ranked opponent, defeating No. 12 Ohio State, 75-70, Feb. 10 at the Kohl Center.  
The last time Wisconsin upset a top-15 team was on Jan. 31, 2013, when it downed No. 7 Penn State, 63-61, and the last time it defeated a ranked team was on Feb. 14, 2019, when UW upset No. 24 Michigan State, 79-62.

### YOUNG GUNS

- Wisconsin had one of the youngest teams in the Big Ten with only four upperclassmen and 10 underclassmen. Only Minnesota (3) and Maryland (3) had fewer upperclassmen while the Badgers and Penn State had the most sophomores and freshmen with 10.

### BADGER STATE PRIDE

- The Badgers' goal is to keep the best talent from the state at the UW and the coaches are doing that.  
Wisconsin's 2021-22 roster features four Badger state natives, including two players from Monroe.  
**Sydney Hilliard** was honored as the 2019 Point Guard of the Year. **Tara Stauffacher** was ranked as the No. 1 player in the state by MaxPreps.com. Freshman **Maty Wilke** joins the Badgers this season after standout career at Beaver Dam.

### BADGERS WELCOME THREE

- The Badgers signed three for the 2021-22 season—**Maty Wilke**, a 5-foot-10 guard from Beaver Dam; **Sacia Vanderpool**, a 6-foot-4 forward from Byron, Minnesota; and **Krystyna Ellew**, a 5-foot-10 guard from Chicago.
- A three-time first-team all-conference selection as a junior, Wilke was named the 2020 Badger Conference Player of the Year. In 2019-20, she averaged 16.6 points, 7.4 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 3.6 steals per game. Under coach Tim Chase, Wilke led the Golden Beavers to three Division 2 state tournaments, including two state championships, and earned unanimous first-team All-State honors in 2020.

- Vanderpool had a breakout junior season for Byron High School, averaging 15.1 points, 9.3 rebounds and three blocks per game. Under coach Jeremy Baumbach, Vanderpool led the Bears to their first state appearance in 2018. She was named team MVP and earned all-conference honors as a junior and set a school record for most blocks in a game with 13.  
■ In just three seasons, Ellew is already the all-time leading scorer (1,758 pts) for coach Iveta Salkauske at Taft High School. She is a three-time all-conference and Chicago All-City selection. Ellew has averaged 20-plus points and eight-plus rebounds per game throughout her career, recording career highs of 58 points and 20 rebounds. She was named All-State Third-Team in 2019 and 2018.
