BADGERS LOOK FOR 2-0 START ON FRIDAY

- Wisconsin will follow up Tuesday's season-opening win over St. Francis by hosting in-state rival Green Bay on Friday at 7 p.m. on B1G+. The Badgers are 25-1 all-time against the Phoenix, including 22-0 at home.
- Up next, the Badgers will welcome Providence to the Kohl Center for the annual Gavitt Games between the Big Ten and Big East conferences.

FAST BREAK FACTS

- Legendary retired coach Bo Ryan will make his return to the Kohl Center on Friday night and will be saluted at a special halftime recognition.
- In 15 seasons as head coach, Ryan led the Badgers to a school-record 364 wins, 7 Big Ten championships (4 regular season, 3 tourney) and 14 NCAA tournament appearances, including back-to-back Final Fours in 2014 and 2015.
- Ryan was recently inducted in the UW Athletics
 Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2020.
- With an 81-58 win over St. Francis, Wisconsin won its home opener for the 6th consecutive season and the 23rd time in the last 24 years.
 UW is 6-0 in home openers under Greg Gard.
- UW shot 45.5% (10-for-22) from 3-point range, turned the ball over just 12 times (3 in the first half), and tallied 13 fast break points.
- Johnny Davis led the Badgers with 15 points, while first-time starters Chucky Hepburn and Steven Crowl scored 13 and 11 points, respectively (page 3).
- The Badgers have won 22 consecutive nonconference home games dating back to the 2017-18 season.
- Head coach Greg Gard improved his overall record to 120-70 (.632), including a mark of 74-20 (.787) at the Kohl Center (page 3).
- Gard has led the Badgers to appearances in 4 of the last 5 NCAA tournaments.
- Wisconsin is 1 of just 5 teams in the country that has played in 21 of the last 22 NCAA tournaments, joined by Gonzaga (22), Kansas (22), Michigan State (22) and Duke (21).
- Wisconsin owns one of the greatest home court advantages in college basketball with an

- all-time record of 324-57 (.850) at the Kohl Center.
- UW returns 2 starters from last year in 5th-yr senior
 Brad Davison and junior Tyler Wahl
- junior Tyler Wahl. career-high 5 assists (0 TOs).

 UW's top returning scorer, Brad Davison averaged 10.0 ppg last season. He's played in
 - Davison ranks 4th all-time at UW in games started (125), 8th in minutes played (4,035), 19th in scoring (1,371), 5th in 3FGs (224), 12th in steals (134) and 5th in FT% (.830).

all 128 games he's been eligible (124 straight).

- Tyler Wahl played in all 31 games last season, including starts in the final 17 contests. He averaged 5.2 points and 4.3 rebounds per game last year for the Badgers.
- Serving as sixth man last season, Johnny Davis is poised to step into a larger role this season after ranking 5th in minutes played (24.3) last season, averaging 7.0 ppg and 4.1 rpg.
- This season's Wisconsin roster features 12 underclassmen, including 5 true freshmen.
- Wisconsin is tied with Nebraska (2 So., 10 Fr.) for the most underclassmen in the B1G. Indiana and Michigan each have 11 underclassmen.
- With 12 underclassmen (7 soph. and 5 fresh.), it marks UW's largest group of underclassmen in at least 20 years (going back to 2001-02).
- The average age of UW's starting lineup this season is 19.8 years old. In comparison, last year's lineup had an average age 22.6 yrs old.

FOR STARTERS

With an 81-58 win over St. Francis Brooklyn on Tuesday night, Wisconsin won its home opener for the 6th consecutive season and the 23rd time in the last 24 years.

- The Badgers won their 22nd-straight nonconference home game dating back to the 2017-18 season.
- Wisconsin improved to 6-0 in home openers under **Greg Gard**.
- Under Gard, UW has started the season 2-0 or better three of the last four seasons.
- Wisconsin is 51-25 (.671) in non-conference games under head coach Greg Gard.
- Last 4 seasons: 22-8 (.733) in non-con. play
- The Badgers' best start to a season under Gard was when they began 5-0 in 2018-19.

GARD AMONG THE BEST

In his 7th season as head coach, **Greg Gard** has put together one of the most successful careers in Wisconsin history and is quickly placing himself among the greatest Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years.

 Gard has guided the Badgers to a record of 120-70 (.632), owning the 5th-best win total and 3rd-highest win percentage in UW annals.

- blow the game open and cruise to an 81-58 win on Tuesday.
- UW had 13 fast break points, its most since 17 vs. Rutgers on Jan. 15, 2021. UW had 13 or more fast break points just 5 times last season.
- Wisconsin out-rebounded SFC, 48-31, and racked up 15 offensive rebounds.
- UW shot 45.5% from 3-pt range (10-for-22).
- Sophomore G **Johnny Davis** started his first game in a Badger uniform and posted 15 points, 3 rebounds and a career-high 5 assists with zero turnovers.
- Sophomore F Steven Crowl made his first career start, setting career highs with 11 points and 8 rebounds.
- Freshman PG Chucky Hepburn became the first true freshman to start in a season opener for UW since Devin Harris in the 2001-02 opener, scoring 15 points in thew in.
- Off the bench, freshman Lorne Bowman made his UW debut and tallied 9pts (3-4 3FGs), while senior Chris Vogt led the team with 9reb in his first Badger appearance.

NEW FACES, NEW PLACES

Wisconsin has plenty of new faces, plus familiar ones in new places, that are making their mark:

- Freshman Chucky Hepburn became the first true freshman to start in a season opener for Wisconsin since Devin Harris in 2001-02.
- He also became just the 5th UW freshman to score in double figures (13 points) in the season opener since 2000.
- Sophomore Johnny Davis made his firstcareer start Tuesday, tallying 15 pts, 3 reb, 2 stl, and a career-high 5 assists (0 turnovers).
- Sophomore **Steven Crowl** had a near double-double (11 pts, 8 reb) in his first career start.
- In total, six Badgers made their UW debuts in UW's opener on Tuesday: Lorne Bowman II (8pts), Chucky Hepburn, Markus Ilver, Isaac Lindsey, Jahcobi Neath, and Chris Vogt.

SERIES VS. GREEN BAY

Wisconsin and Green Bay renew a rivalry on Friday that has been played every year except one dating back to 1999. The schools meet for the 27th time, with the Badgers owning a 25-1 record against Green Bay (22-0 in Madison).

- Greg Gard's first game as head coach was against Green Bay, an 84-79 win on Dec. 23, 2015. Gard is 5-0 all-time against Green Bay.
- Wisconsin has won each of the last 10 games against Green Bay by an average of 17.8 points per contest.
- Green Bay head coach Will Ryan is the son of UW Hall of Fame coach Bo Ryan. Among the credentials for the elder Ryan:
- The winningest coach in UW history with a record of 364–130 (.737) in 14-plus seasons
- Led UW to 4 Big Ten regular season championships and 3 Big Ten Tournament titles
- Received 4 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors
- Guided UW to 14 consecutive NCAA tournament appearances, 7 Sweet 16s, 3 Elite Eights, 2 Final Fours and the 2015 national championship game
- Inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame in 2017
- Greg Gard and Will Ryan worked together on the UW staff from 2002-07, with Gard serving as assistant coach and Will Ryan holding the positions of video coordinator and director of basketball operations.
- Green Bay assistant coach Freddie Owens appeared in 111 games (61 starts) at Wisconsin, scoring 796 career points. Owens helped the Badgers win the 2002 and 2003 Big Ten regular-season and 2004 Big Ten Tournament championships.
- Green Bay assistant coach Brandon Pritzl is the older brother of former Badger Brevin Pritzl (2016-20). Brevin Pritzl, who appeared in 122 games for Wisconsin, is currently playing professional basketball in Serbia.

Green Bay director of operations Sam Vander Plas was a student manager for UW women's basketball, graduating in 2018.

- UW is 8-3 against in-state opponents under Greg Gard and has gone 47-12 (.797) in such games dating back to 2000.
- A total of 9 current Badgers have seen action against Green Bay, led by **Brad Davison**, who is averaging 14.3 ppg in 3 appearances vs. the Phoenix. He has scored in double figures in all 3 meetings, posting 18 points in 2017, 15 in 2019 and 10 in 2020.

reg Gard, a coaching veteran of 30-plus years, enters his seventh season leading the Wisconsin men's basketball program in 2021-22 after proving himself as one of the best head coaches in the Big Ten. Gard earned 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors after leading the Badgers to the regular season conference championship in 2019-20.

Wisconsin's incredible postseason success hasn't wavered on Gard's watch either, participating in the NCAA tournament in five of his first six seasons (Big Ten automatic qualifier status in canceled 2020 Big Dance, due to COVID pandemic). Most recently in 2020-21, Gard led the Badgers to an NCAA tournament first-round win over North Carolina, advancing UW to the second round of the NCAA tournament for the fifth time in its last six trips to The Big Dance.

Gard's postseason ledger includes a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in each of his first two seasons at the helm. In fact, Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

In his first six seasons as head coach, Gard posted a record of 119-70, the second-fastest (157 games) Wisconsin coach to 100 overall wins in the NCAA tournament era. He also guided UW to a conference record of 69-45. His .605 conference win percentage ranked eighth among Big Ten coaches the last 40 years.

After initially taking over on an interim basis midway through the 2015-16 season, Gard would go on to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award that season and was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. Through six seasons, Gard has already risen to fifth on the school's all-time wins list and owns the third-best win percentage in Wisconsin program history.

The 2020-21 season brought unprecedented challenges due to the global COVID-19 pandemic, but the leadership of Gard and his staff helped navigate the Badgers to an NCAA tournament appearance. The Badgers finished the season 18-13 overall (10-10 Big Ten), highlighted with an 85-62 win over North Carolina in the first round of the NCAA tournament.

Gard's leadership during the 2019-20 season might have been his best. After opening 5-5 overall and 5-5 in the Big Ten, Wisconsin won nine of its last 10 games, including its final eight games of the season to win a share of the 2020 conference championship and claim the No. 1 seed for the later canceled Big Ten tournament. During that run, UW knocked off No. 14 Michigan State, won at No. 19 Michigan and closed the season with a win at Indiana to clinch the title.

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tourney. UW capped off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 2018-19, Gard piloted the Badgers back to the Big Dance, posting a 23-11 overall record. Wisconsin also boasted a mark of 14-6 in Big Ten play, winning 14 conference games for just the 3rd time in school history, joining 16-win seasons in 2008 and 2015.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes in 2016 and third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in both 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to constructing future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard helped guide the Badgers to back-to-back Final Fours in 2014 and 2015, and in 2015 UW reached its first national championship game since 1941.

In fact, Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 13 winningest seasons at Wisconsin.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. Previously, Gard served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division Ill titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.

One of the most decorated players in Eastview history, Crowl finished his prep career as the school's all-time leading scorer (1,747 pts), rebounder (832 reb) and shot blocker (103 blk). The 6-foot-9 forward also set Eastview school records for career field-goal percentage (59% FG), rebounds in a season (332), rebounds in a game (19) and single-game field-goal percentage (90% FG). As a senior, he averaged 26.7 points and 12 rebounds per game, while also leading his team in assists (4.3 per contest). Crowl played travel basketball for D1 Minnesota, the same program as current Badger teammate Tyler Wahl.
