

FAST BREAK FACTS

- With a 72-34 win over Green Bay last Friday, Wisconsin opened the season 2-0 for the 4th time in the last 5 seasons under Greg Gard.
- The Badgers look to open 3-0 for the 3rd time in the last 4 seasons with a win Monday night.
- Against Green Bay, Steven Crowl led the Badgers with 18 points (7-11 FG) and 7 rebounds. Johnny Davis (15pts, 5reb, 2ast) and Brad Davison (15pts) rounded out double-digit scorers for UW (more page 3).
- Through 2 games, UW is out-rebounding opponents 49.0 to 31.0, while averaging just 9.5 turnovers per game. Defensively, the Badgers are limiting foes to 46.0 ppg and just 32.5% shooting (21.6% from deep). UW is also shooting 82.1% (32-39) from the FT line on the year (page 3).
- The Badgers have won 23 consecutive nonconference home games dating back to the 2017-18 season.
- Head coach Greg Gard improved his overall record to 121-70 (.634), including a mark of 74-20 (.787) at the Kohl Center (page 2).
- Gard has led the Badgers to appearances in 4 of the last 5 NCAA tournaments.
- Wisconsin owns one of the greatest home court advantages in college basketball with an all-time record of 325-57 (.851) at the Kohl Center.
- Sophomore Johnny Davis is poised for a breakout season and is off to a big start, leading the Badgers averaging 15.0 ppg. He also paces the team with 7 assists with zero turnovers.
- UW returns 2 starters from last year in 5th-yr senior Brad Davison and junior Tyler Wahl.





Sophomore Johnny Davis leads the Badgers averaging 15.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game (with 0 TOs).

- Davison ranks 4th all-time at UW in games started (126), 8th in minutes played (4,059), 19th in scoring (1,386), 5th in 3FGs (225), 12th in steals (135) and 5th in FT% (.831).
- **Tyler Wahl** played in all 31 games last season, including starts in the final 17 contests. He averaged 5.2 ppg and 4.3 rpg.
- Freshman Chucky Hepburn became the first true freshman to start a season opener for Wisconsin since Devin Harris in 2001-02. He also became just the 5th UW freshman to score double digits (13 pts) in a season opener since 2000. On the season, Hepburn is 4th on the team averaging 8.0 ppg, going 3-for-6 on 3FGs.
- This season's Wisconsin roster features 12 underclassmen, including 5 true freshmen.
- Wisconsin is tied with Nebraska (2 So., 10 Fr.) for the most underclassmen in the Big Ten.
- With 12 underclassmen (7 soph. and 5 fresh.), it marks UW's largest group of underclassmen in at least 20 years (going back to 2001-02).
- The average age of UW's starting lineup this season is 19.8 years old. In comparison, last year's lineup had an average age 22.6 yrs old.

FOR STARTERS

With a 72-34 win over Green Bay last Friday, Wisconsin opened the season 2-0 for the 4th time in the last 5 seasons under Greg Gard.

- Last Tuesday, Wisconsin improved to 6-0 in home openers under Greg Gard.
- Wisconsin has now won 23-straight nonconference home games dating back to the 2017-18 season.
- The Badgers look to open 3-0 for the 3rd time in the last 4 seasons with a win Monday night.
- Wisconsin is 52-25 (.675) in non-conference games under head coach Greg Gard.
 - Last 4 seasons: 23-8 (.742) in non-con. play
- The Badgers' best start to a season under Gard was when they began 5-0 in 2018-19.

GARD AMONG THE BEST

In his 7th season as head coach, **Greg Gard** has put together one of the most successful careers in Wisconsin history and is quickly placing himself among the greatest Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years.

 Gard has guided the Badgers to a record of 121-70 (.634), owning the 5th-best win total and 3rd-highest win percentage in UW annals.

 Wisconsin coach to 100 wins in the NCAA tournament era. Only Bo Ryan reached 100 faster (138 games).
- With a conference record of 69-45, Gard's .605 conference win percentage ranks 8th among Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years (since 1980).

LAST TIME OUT

WISCONSIN 72, GREEN BAY 34 Nov. 12 | Kohl Center | Madison, Wis.

- Wisconsin opened the season 2-0 for the 4th time in the last 5 seasons.
- Allowing just 34 points, UW surrendered the fewest points defensively in the Gard era and

- the fewest overall since a 62-31 win over Northern Kentucky on Nov. 14, 2014.
- The Badgers defense held the Phoenix to 12-for-51 shooting (23.5%), which marked the lowest FG% by a UW opponent since holding Virginia to just 23.4% on Dec. 4, 2013.
- GB's 23.5% FG is also the 4th-lowest shooting mark ever by an opponent in the Kohl Center.
- UW grabbed 18 offensive rebounds, creating 25 second-chance points. The last time the Badgers pulled down 18 offensive boards came against Maryland on Feb. 19, 2017.
- Sophomore F **Steven Crowl** led Wisconsin with a career-high 18 points (7-11 FG) and 7 boards.
- Sophomore G **Johnny Davis** scored 15 points for the second straight game, plus 5 reb, 2 ast.
- Senior G **Brad Davison** made his 126th career start, finishing with 15 pts, 3 reb and 2 ast.
- Freshmen Gs Chucky Hepburn and Lorne Bowman II combined for 7 steals, swiping 4 and 3, respectively.

NEW FACES, NEW PLACES

Wisconsin has plenty of new faces, plus familiar ones in new places, that are making their mark:

- UW's roster features 12 underclassmen, tied with Nebraska for most in the Big Ten. It marks UW's largest group of underclassmen in at least 20 years (going back to 2001-02).
- Freshman G Chucky Hepburn became the first true freshman to start in a season opener for Wisconsin since Devin Harris in 2001-02.
- He also became just the 5th UW freshman to score in double figures (13 points) in the season opener since 2000.
- Sophomore G Johnny Davis made his firstcareer start last week and is averaging 15.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 3.5 apg with 0 turnovers.
- Sophomore F **Steven Crowl** is averaging 14.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per game this season.
- In total, six Badgers made their UW debuts in UW's opener last Tuesday: Lorne Bowman II, Chucky Hepburn, Markus IIver, Isaac Lindsey, Jahcobi Neath, and Chris Vogt.

LET THE (GAVITT) GAMES BEGIN

Wisconsin and Providence meet for just the fifth time in series history and first time since 1996.

- Providence leads the all-time series, 3-1, having won three straight. UW's lone win against the Friars came in a 95-84 victory back in 1961 in New York City, N.Y.
- The two meet this season as part of the sixth-annual Gavitt Tipoff Games, a unique early-season series between the BIG EAST and Big Ten (named in honor of Hall of Famer Dave Gavitt, founder of the BIG EAST)
- Wisconsin is 100-90 all-time against teams in the BIG EAST Conference.
- This marks UW's 4th appearance in the Gavitt Tipoff Games, last participating in 2018 earning a 77-68 road win at Xavier.

 Senior Brad Davison is the only Badger on this year's roster with experience in the Gavitt Tipoff Games. At Xavier in 2018, Davison tallied 19 points (4-6 3FG) including a 3-point dagger with 1:04 remaining.

DE-FENSE! DE-FENSE!

Wisconsin has stiffled its first two opponents, holding the opposition to an average of 46.0 points per game, 32.5 FG% and 21.6% 3FG.

- UW ranks 8th in the nation in Ken Pomeroy's Adjusted Defensive Eficiency (15th last year), averaging 88.6 points per 100 possessions.
- UW has led the B1G in scoring defense 4 of the last 6 seasons under Gard (2 straight yrs).
- Allowing 34 points vs. Green Bay (11/12), the Badgers surrendered the fewest points of the Greg Gard era and fewest overall since a 62-31 win vs Northern Kentucky (11/14/14).
- Wisconsin limited Green Bay to 23.5% FG, the lowest opponent FG% since UW held Virginia to 23.4% FG back on Dec. 4, 2013.
- GB's 23.5% FG marked the 4th-lowest mark ever by a UW opponent in the Kohl Center.

TRENDING THIS SEASON

Wisconsin's 2-0 start is already revealing a handful of familiar trends. Consider...

- **Defense:** According to KenPom.com, Wisconsin ranks 8th in the NCAA in defensive efficiency. Under Gard, UW has led the B1G in scoring defense 4 of the last 6 years.
- Free Throw Shooting: Wisconsin leads the Big Ten shooting 82.1% (32-39) at the foul line.
- Turnovers: Wisconsin had just 1 turnover on 30 possessions in the first half vs. Green Bay, and it came on the game's first possession. UW is averaging just 9.5 per game.
- Rebounding: UW ranks 2nd in the Big Ten averaging 49 rebounds per game; also 2nd in offensive rebounding (16.5 off reb/game).

reg Gard, a coaching veteran of 30-plus years, enters his seventh season leading the Wisconsin men's basketball program in 2021-22 after proving himself as one of the best head coaches in the Big Ten. Gard earned 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors after leading the Badgers to the regular season conference championship in 2019-20.

Wisconsin's incredible postseason success hasn't wavered on Gard's watch either, participating in the NCAA tournament in five of his first six seasons (Big Ten automatic qualifier status in canceled 2020 Big Dance, due to COVID pandemic). Most recently in 2020-21, Gard led the Badgers to an NCAA tournament first-round win over North Carolina, advancing UW to the second round of the NCAA tournament for the fifth time in its last six trips to The Big Dance.

Gard's postseason ledger includes a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in each of his first two seasons at the helm. In fact, Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

In his first six seasons as head coach, Gard posted a record of 119-70, the second-fastest (157 games) Wisconsin coach to 100 overall wins in the NCAA tournament era. He also guided UW to a conference record of 69-45. His .605 conference win percentage ranked eighth among Big Ten coaches the last 40 years.

After initially taking over on an interim basis midway through the 2015-16 season, Gard would go on to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award that season and was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. Through six seasons, Gard has already risen to fifth on the school's all-time wins list and owns the third-best win percentage in Wisconsin program history.

The 2020-21 season brought unprecedented challenges due to the global COVID-19 pandemic, but the leadership of Gard and his staff helped navigate the Badgers to an NCAA tournament appearance. The Badgers finished the season 18-13 overall (10-10 Big Ten), highlighted with an 85-62 win over North Carolina in the first round of the NCAA tournament.

Gard's leadership during the 2019-20 season might have been his best. After opening 5-5 overall and 5-5 in the Big Ten, Wisconsin won nine of its last 10 games, including its final eight games of the season to win a share of the 2020 conference championship and claim the No. 1 seed for the later canceled Big Ten tournament. During that run, UW knocked off No. 14 Michigan State, won at No. 19 Michigan and closed the season with a win at Indiana to clinch the title.

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tourney. UW capped off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 2018-19, Gard piloted the Badgers back to the Big Dance, posting a 23-11 overall record. Wisconsin also boasted a mark of 14-6 in Big Ten play, winning 14 conference games for just the 3rd time in school history, joining 16-win seasons in 2008 and 2015.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes in 2016 and third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in both 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to constructing future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard helped guide the Badgers to back-to-back Final Fours in 2014 and 2015, and in 2015 UW reached its first national championship game since 1941.

In fact, Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 13 winningest seasons at Wisconsin.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. Previously, Gard served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division Ill titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.



It didn't take long for Johnny Davis to become a key contributor for Wisconsin as a freshman, and the guard from La Crosse, Wisconsin is poised to step into a key role in his second season. Davis played in all 31 games last year for the Badgers, averaging 24.4 minutes per game (fifth-most on the team). GET TO KNOW TYLER

Junior forward Tyler Wahl has had an immediate impact at Wisconsin since stepping onto campus. Having played in over 60 career games as a Badger, the Lakeville, Minnesota native played in all 31 games for the Badgers last season (18 starts). Averaging 5.2 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game last year, one of Wahl's best games came when he led the Badgers in scoring for the first time in his career with 14 points, plus a team-high 6 rebounds and 2 assists in a win vs. Northwestern.
